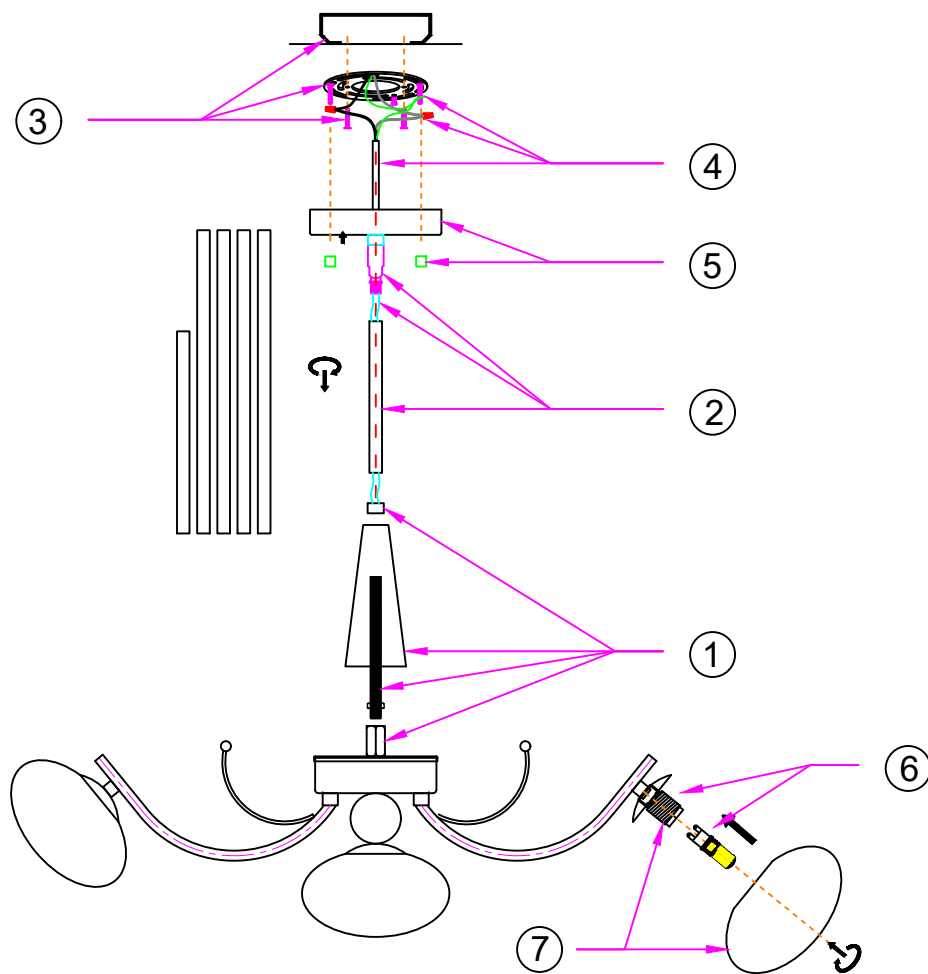


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Screw the threaded pipe into the connector on the fixture body (adjust the nut to set the desired pipe length). Slide the conical cup over the threaded pipe and secure it in place by tightening the flat nut.
 2. Select a downrod of suitable length. Thread the main wires through the downrod and secure it to the fixture body. Then, feed the wires through the ceiling canopy and secure the canopy to the downrod.
 3. Secure the mounting bracket to the junction box using the provided screws.
 4. Wiring Connections
 - Use wire connectors to connect the black (hot) wire to the black wire, the white (neutral) wire to the white wire, and the ground wire to the grounding terminal.
 - Ensure no exposed conductors remain outside wire connectors or outside the junction box.
 5. Secure the ceiling canopy to the mounting bracket using the provided nuts.
 6. Insert the light source into the socket to test (bulb not included).
 7. Install the glass shade onto the socket, aligning the threads carefully. Do not over-tighten.
- Installation complete.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
