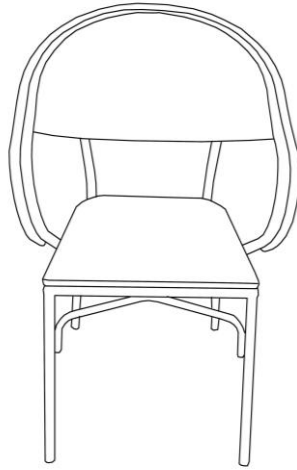

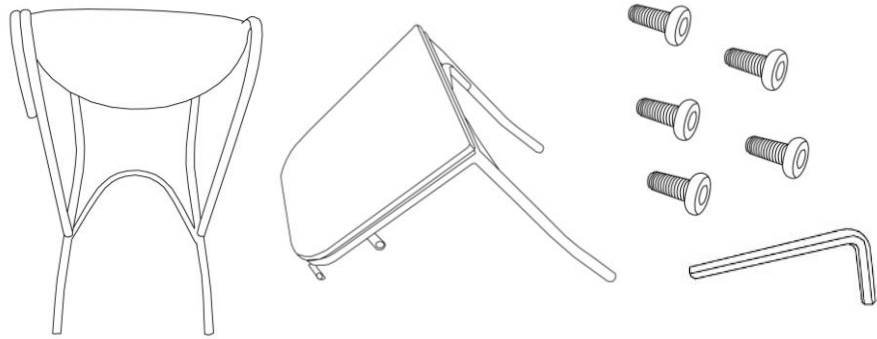

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



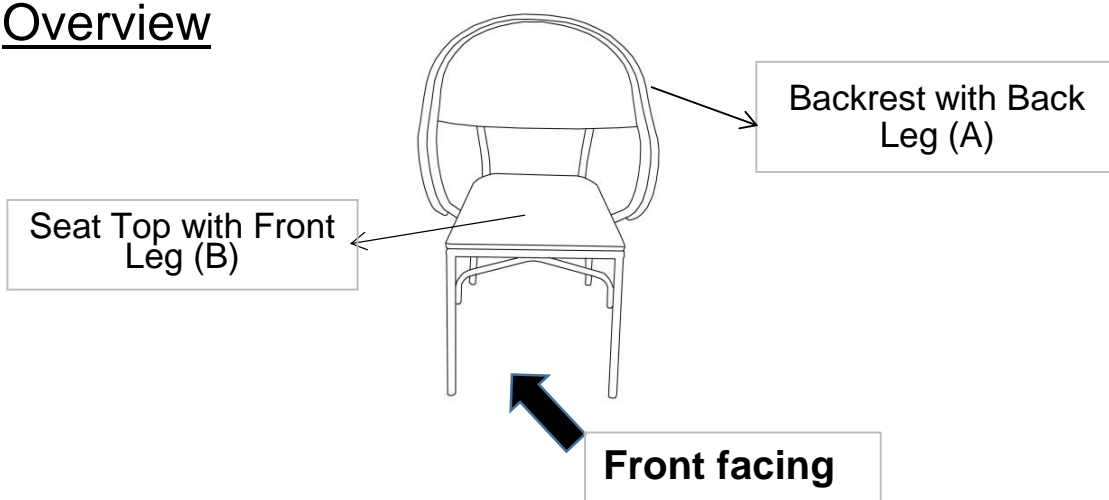

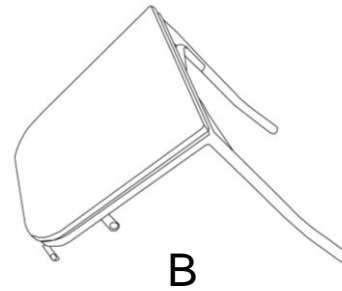
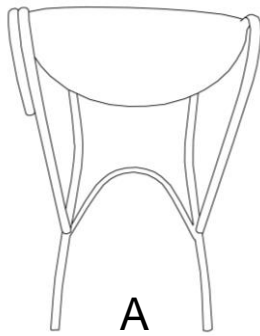

Overview



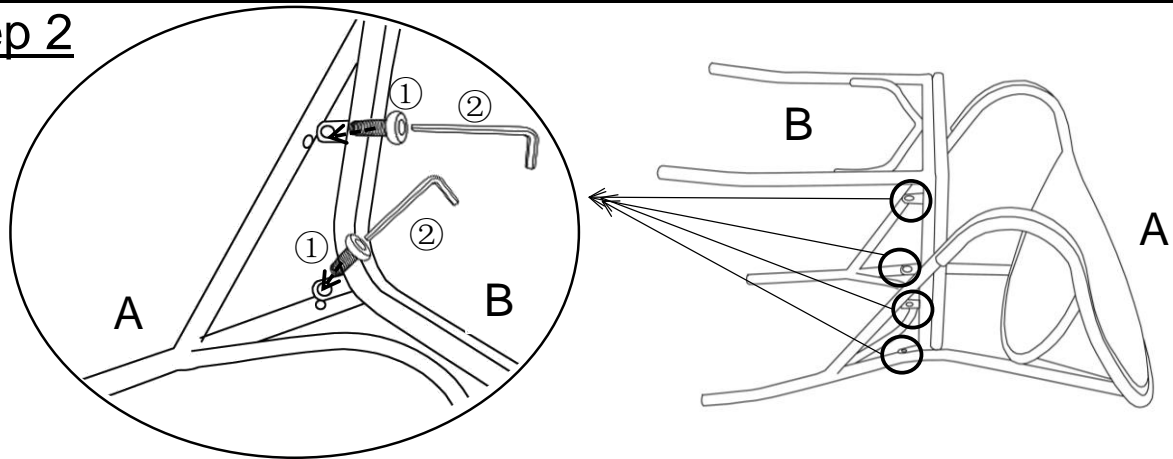

Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

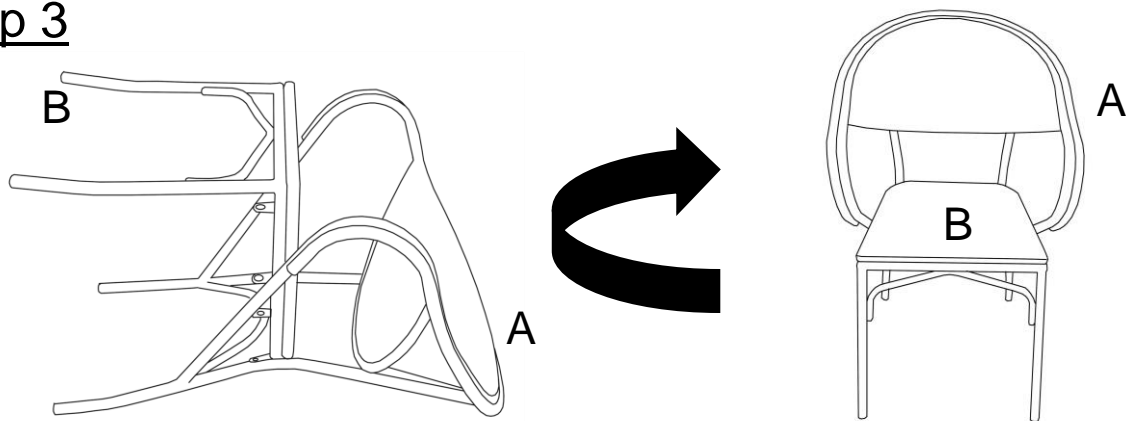
Step 2



Lay the Backrest with Back Leg(A) facedown onto a clean, non-marring surface. Attach the Seat Top with Front Leg(B) to Backrest with Back Leg(A) using Bolts(①) with Allen Key(②).

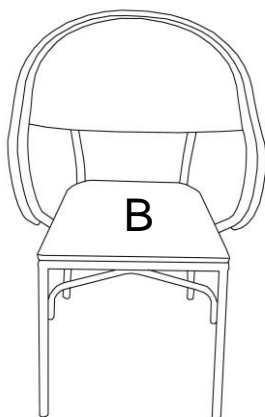
Tighten the Bolts fully in a sequential manner.

Step 3



Stand the Chair up.

Your Chair is ready for use.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

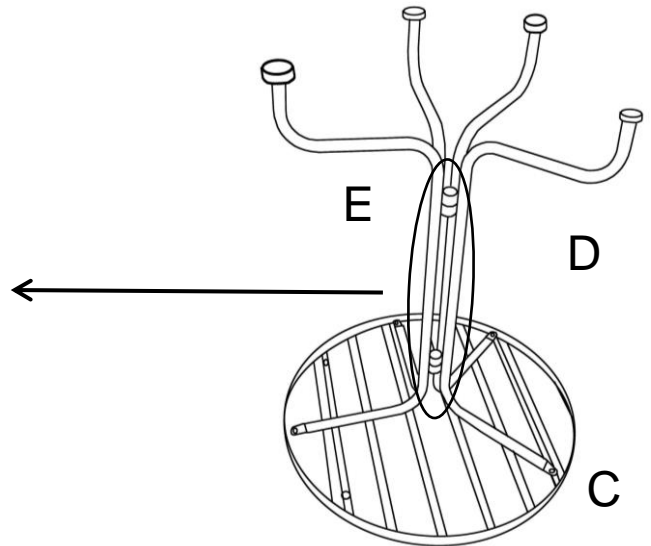
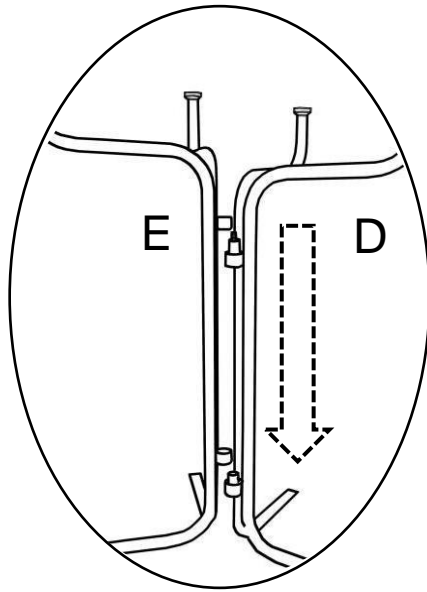
Step 2



Lay the Table Top(C) facedown onto a clean, non-marring surface.
Attach the Table Leg-Left Part(D) to Table Top(C) using Bolts(①) with Allen Key(②).

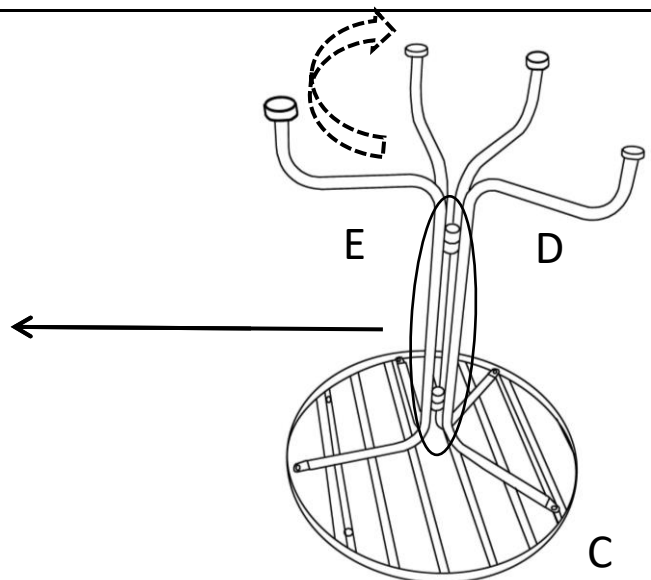
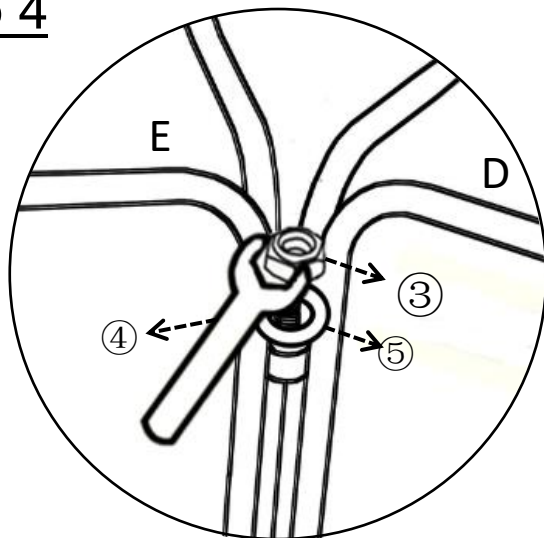
Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 3



Insert the Table Leg-Right Part(E) into Table Leg-Left Part(D).

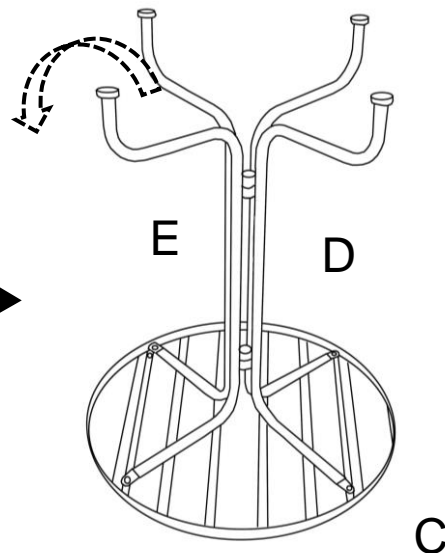
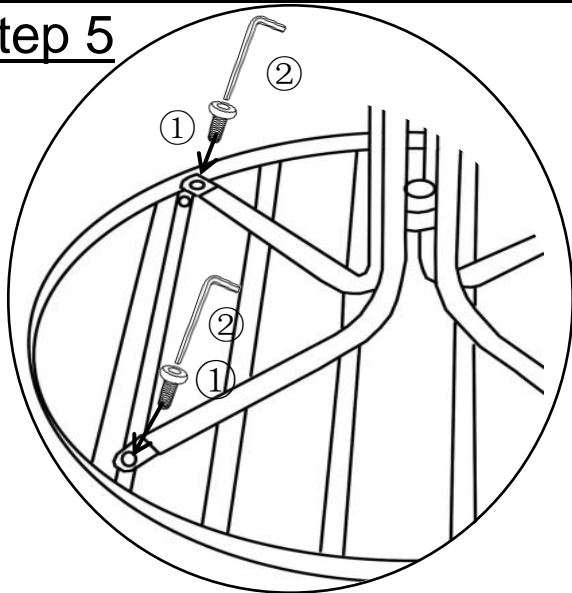
Step 4



Attach the Table Leg-Right Part(E) to Table Leg-Left Part(D) using Washer(⑤) and Nuts(③) with Spanner(④). Keep Table Leg-Right part(E) toward to the side of Table Leg-Left Part(D).

Tighten the nuts.

Step 5

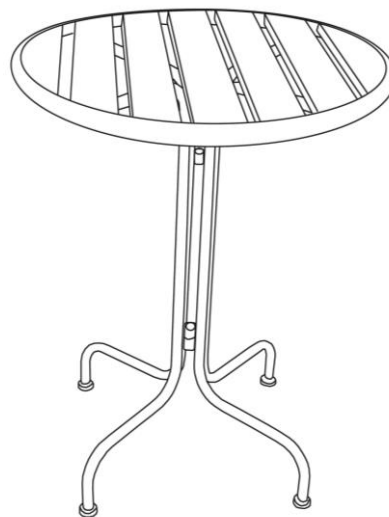
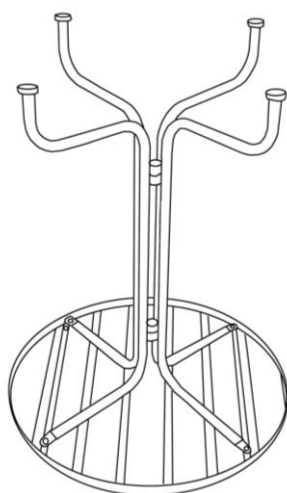


Rotate the Table Leg-Right Part(E) to the required position on Table Top(C) as shown.

Attach Table Leg-Right Part(E) to Table Top(C) using Bolts(1) with Allen Key(2)

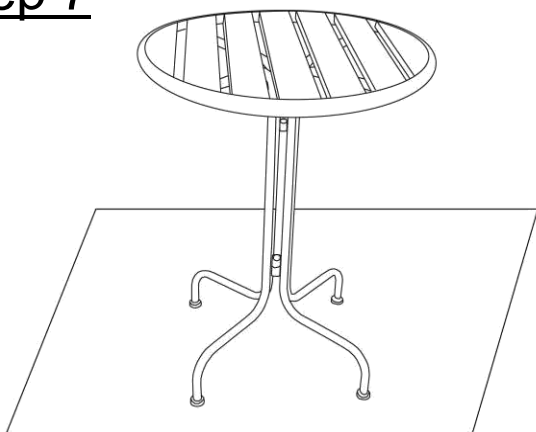
Do not fully tighten the Bolts

Stand the Table up.

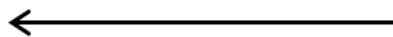

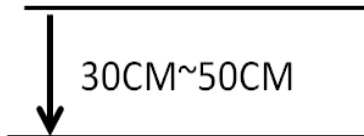
If wobble



Test again

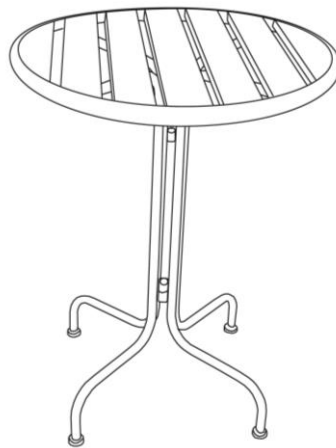

Place the Table on a LEVEL SURFACE to see if it wobbles.
 If it wobbles, lift the Table to some 30cm to 50cm high from the ground.
 Keep your feet and toes well away from the drop zone.
 Drop the Table freely and vertically with the four legs, hitting the ground, at the same time.
 This Drop Test will help to ensure that all the bolts and gaps to all reach full alignment status.
 Test again for evenness on a LEVEL SURFACE.
 If no wobbles found, lay down the Table and proceed to tighten all the Bolts.
When tightening these Bolts, tighten sequentially.
DO NOT tighten any Bolt fully and then move on towards the next one.
If there is still wobbles, loosen the Bolts and execute this same drop tests.

Step 8



Your Table is ready for use.
