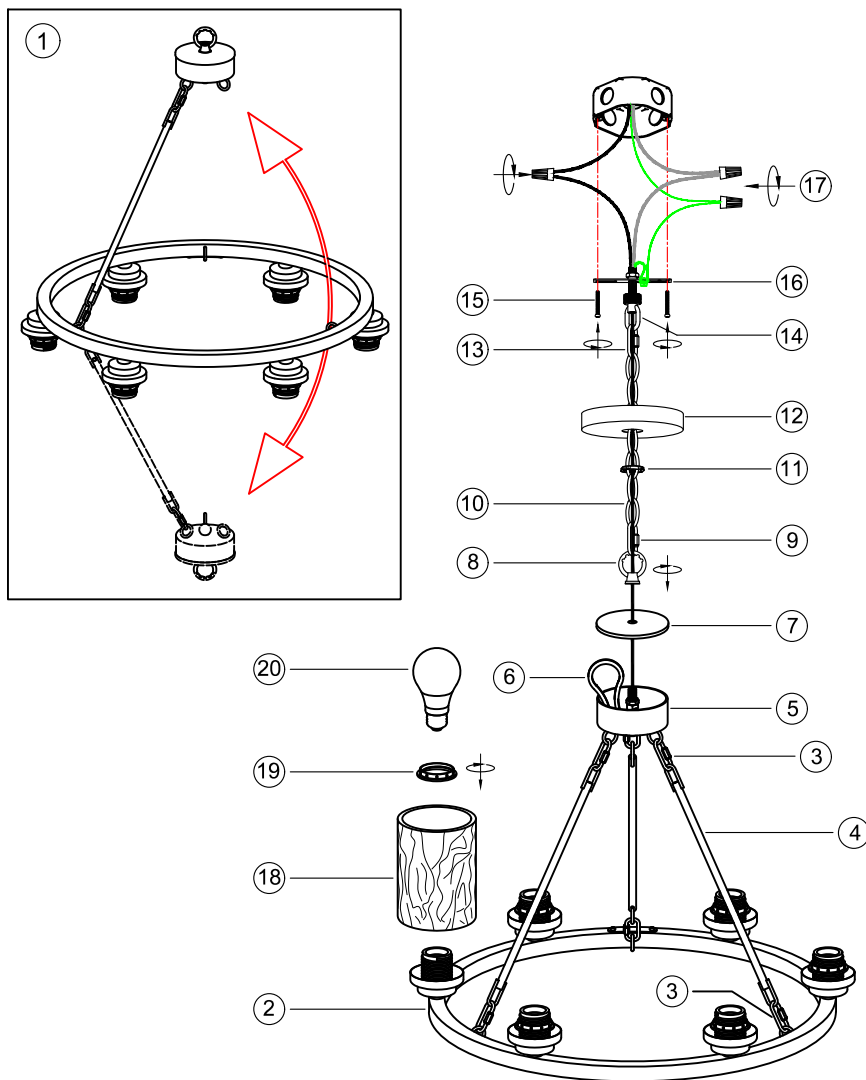


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1-2. Confirm Mounting Orientation

• Default: Fixture lampshades faces upward

• For downward facing: Move the central metal box (5) from the circular body (2) to the other side as shown in diagram.

3-5. Use the quick links (3) and connecting rods (4) to connect the central metal box (5) and the circular body (2).

6. Tuck any excess wire into the central metal box (5).

7-8. Use the retaining ring (8) to secure the cover plate (7).

9-10. Use the quick link (9) to connect the desired length of the chain (10) to the retaining ring (8).

11-12. Thread the chain (10) through the decorative collar nut (11) and the canopy (12).

13-14. Use the quick link (13) to connect the chain (10) and the top ring (14).

15-16. Secure the mounting plate (16) to the junction box using screws (15).

17. Connect the fixture wires to the supply wires using wire connectors.

• Connect the black (hot) wire to the black wire, the white (neutral) wire to the white wire, and the ground wire to the green grounding wire.

• Ensure no exposed conductors remain outside wire connectors or outside the junction box.

18-19. Secure the glass shades (18) onto the fixture bases using the retaining rings (19).

20. Install the bulbs (20) into the socket. (Bulbs Not Included)

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
