Assembly Steps



This sideboard has multiple parts and may require up to some 60 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the sideboard parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

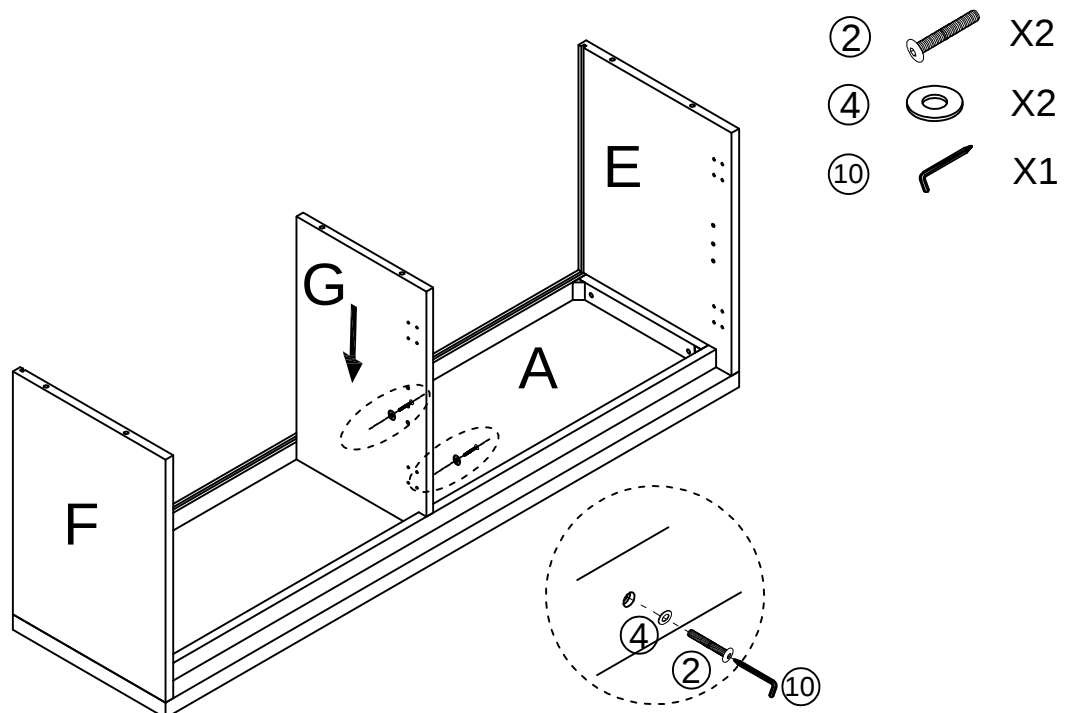
Step 1



Attach the right side board(F), left side board(E) to the top board(A) with bolt(②)and flat washer (④)using wrench(⑩).

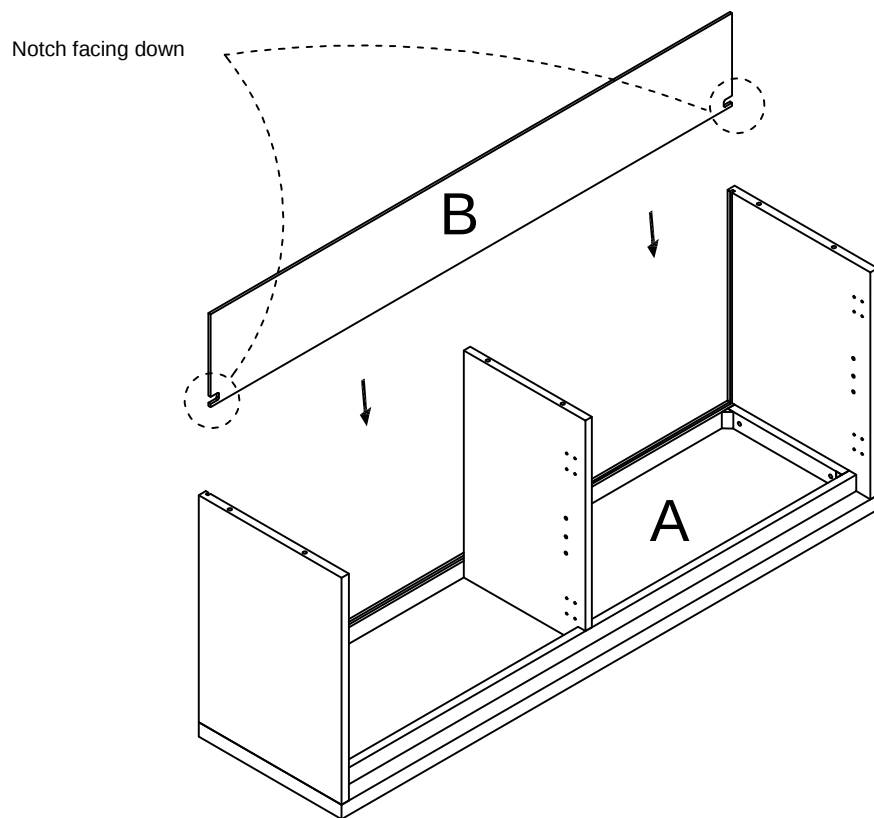
ATTENTION: All the grooves must stay in one side(backside).

Step 2



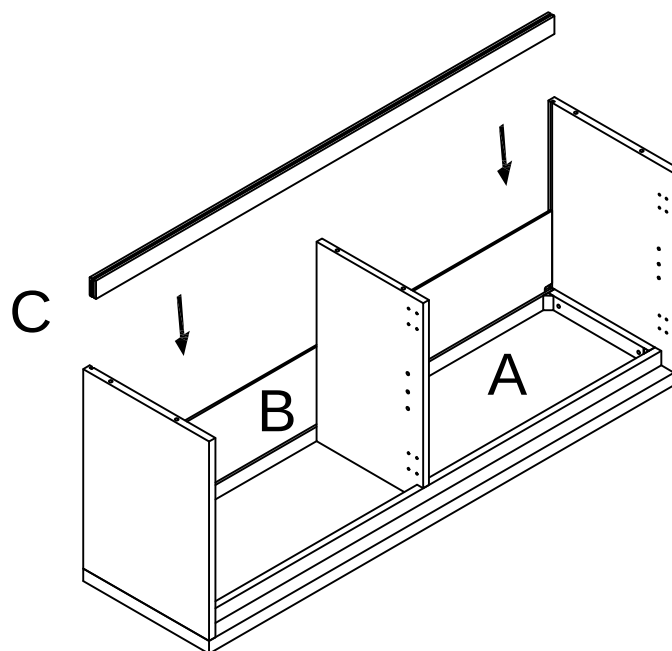
Attach the middle clapboard (G) to the top board (A) with bolt (②) and flat washer (④) using wrench(⑩).

Step 3



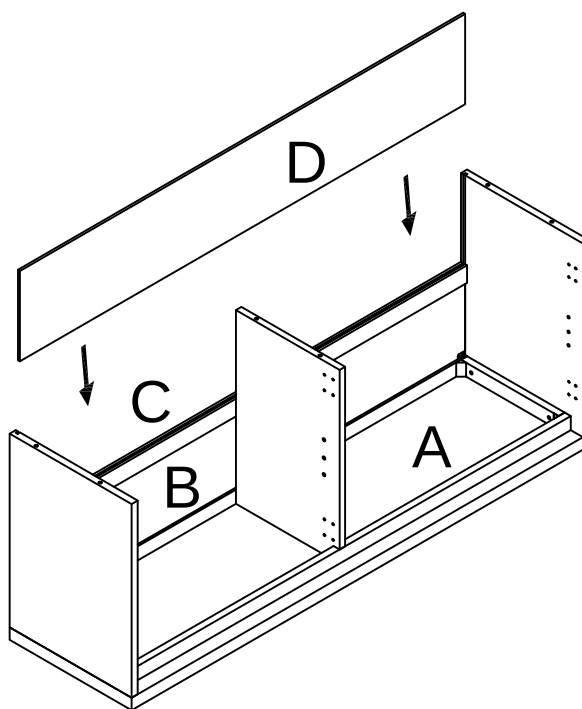
Insert the upper back board(B) to the grooves.
Attention: Notch facing down.

Step4



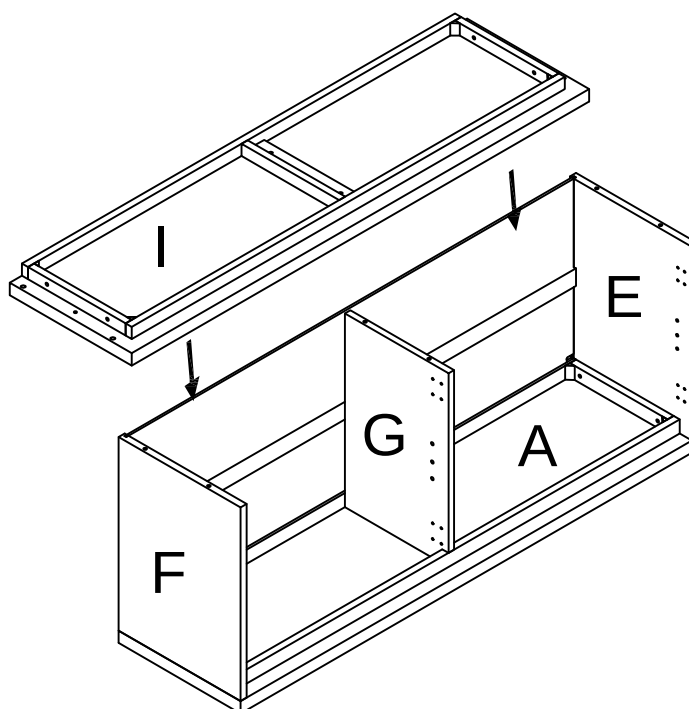
Insert the slot(C)to the grooves.

Step 5



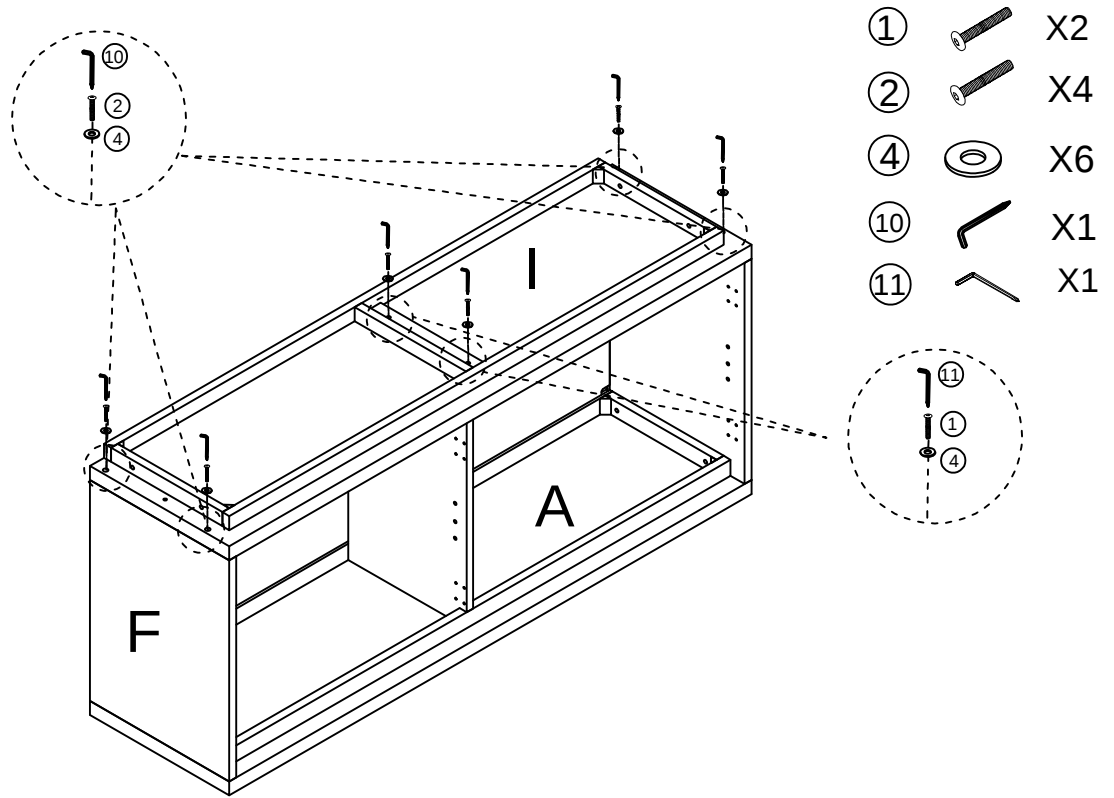
Insert the lower back board(D)to the grooves.

Step6



Align the bottom Board(I) to the middle clapboard(G),right side board(F)and left side board(E).

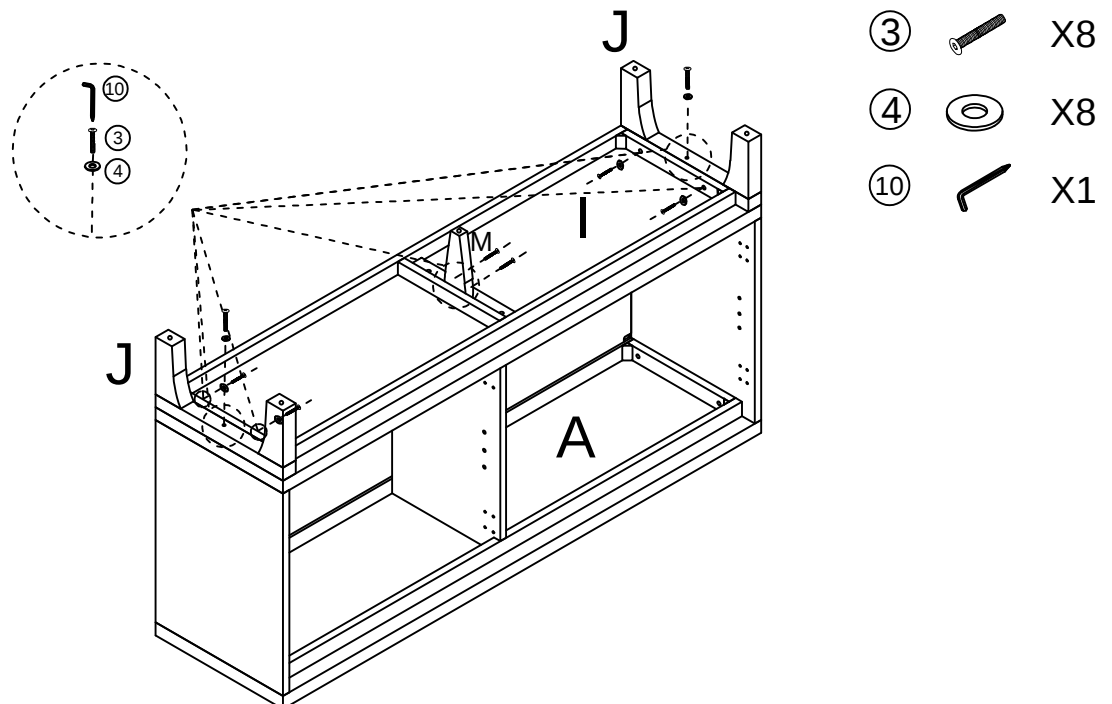
Step 7



Attach the bottom board (I) to the middle clashboard (G) with bolt (①) and flat washer (④) using wrench(⑩).

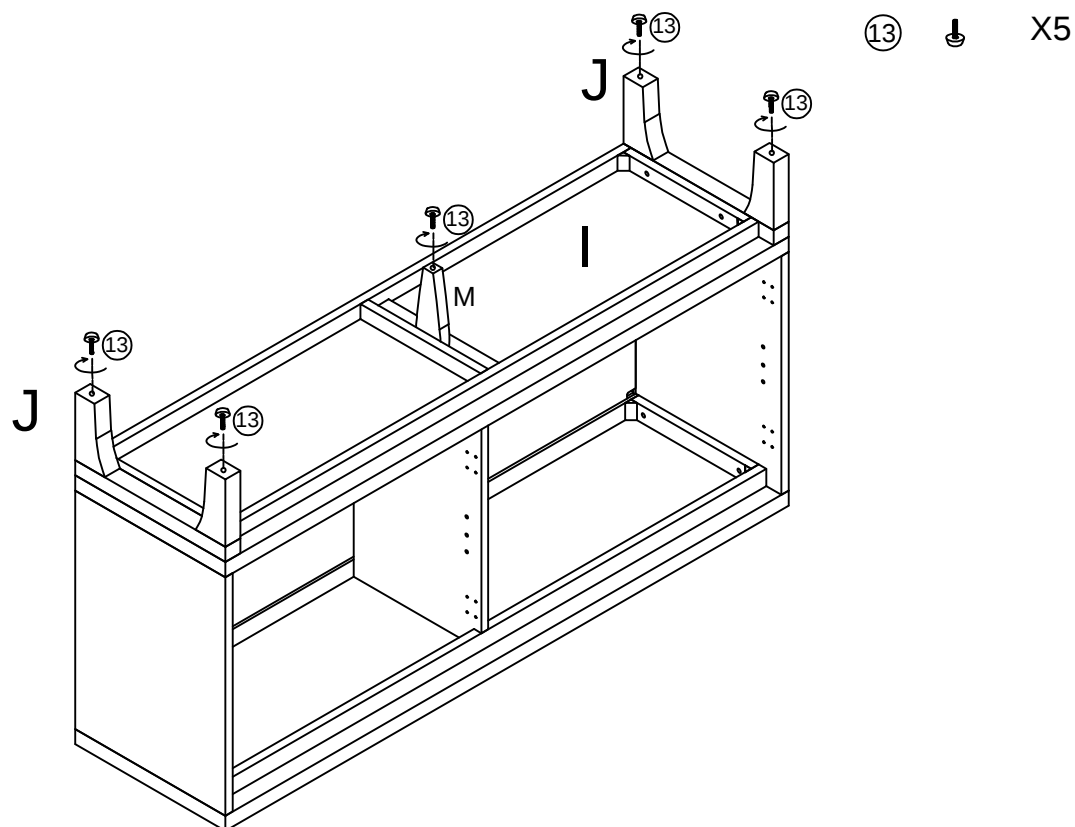
Attach the bottom board (I) to the right side board (F) and left side board (E) with bolt (②) and flat washer (④) using wrench(⑩).

Step 8



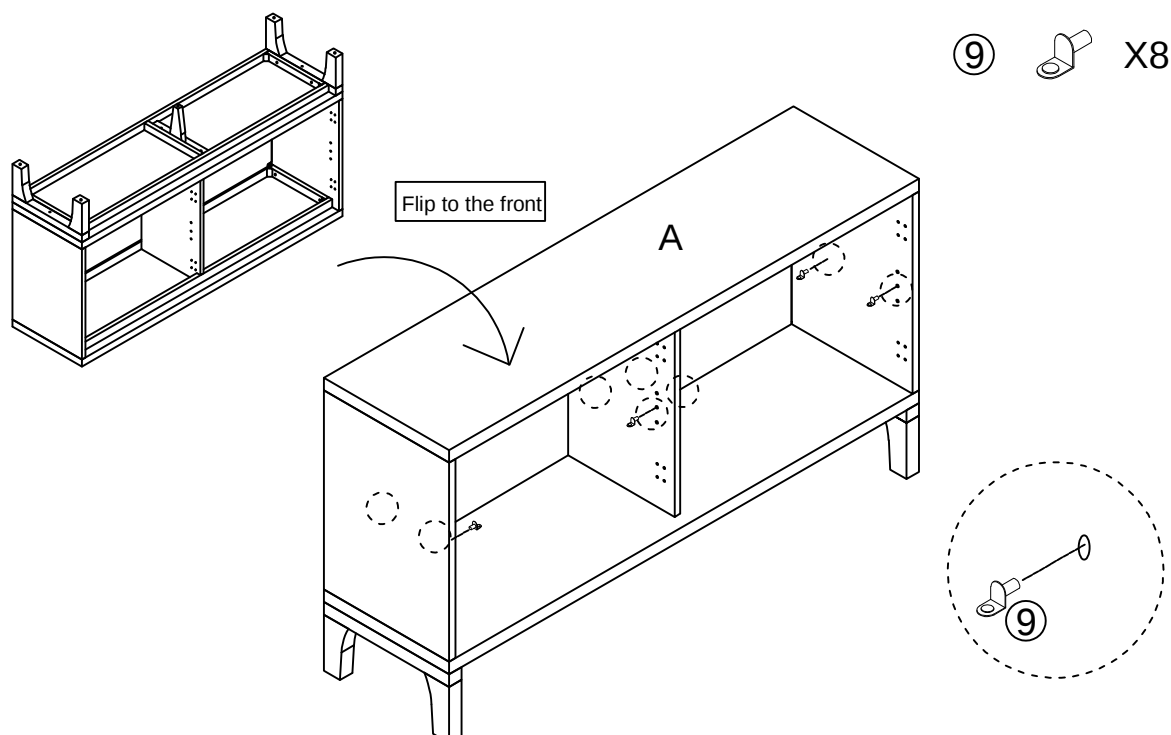
Attach the table leg(J) and middle leg(M) to bottom board(I) with bolt (③) and flat washer(④) using wrench(⑩).

Step 9



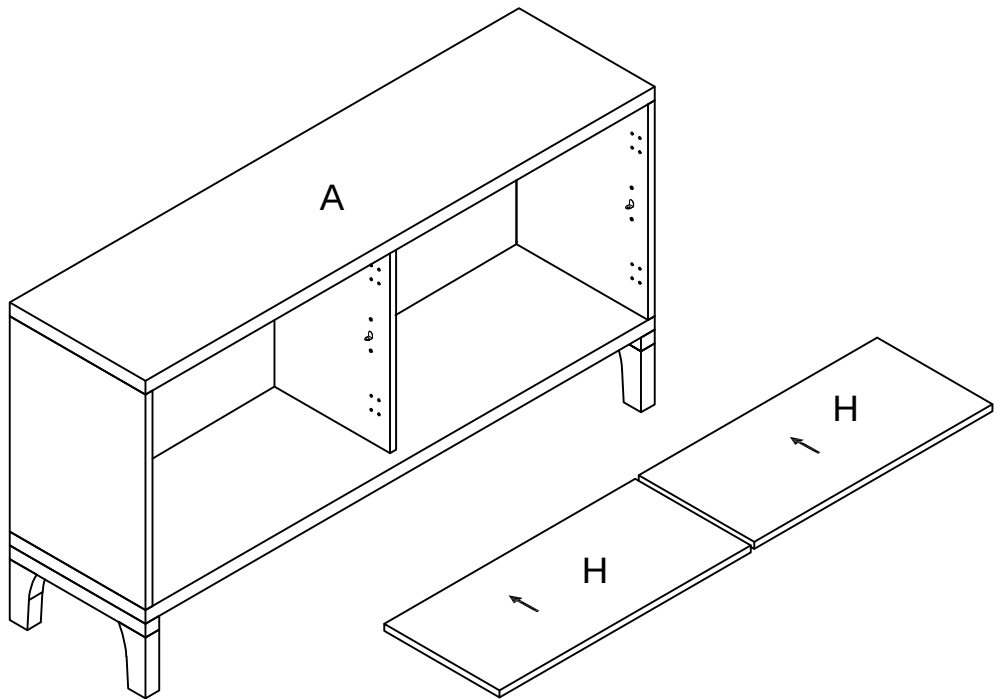
Screw the adjustable leveling glides (13) onto table leg(J) and middle leg(M).

Step 10



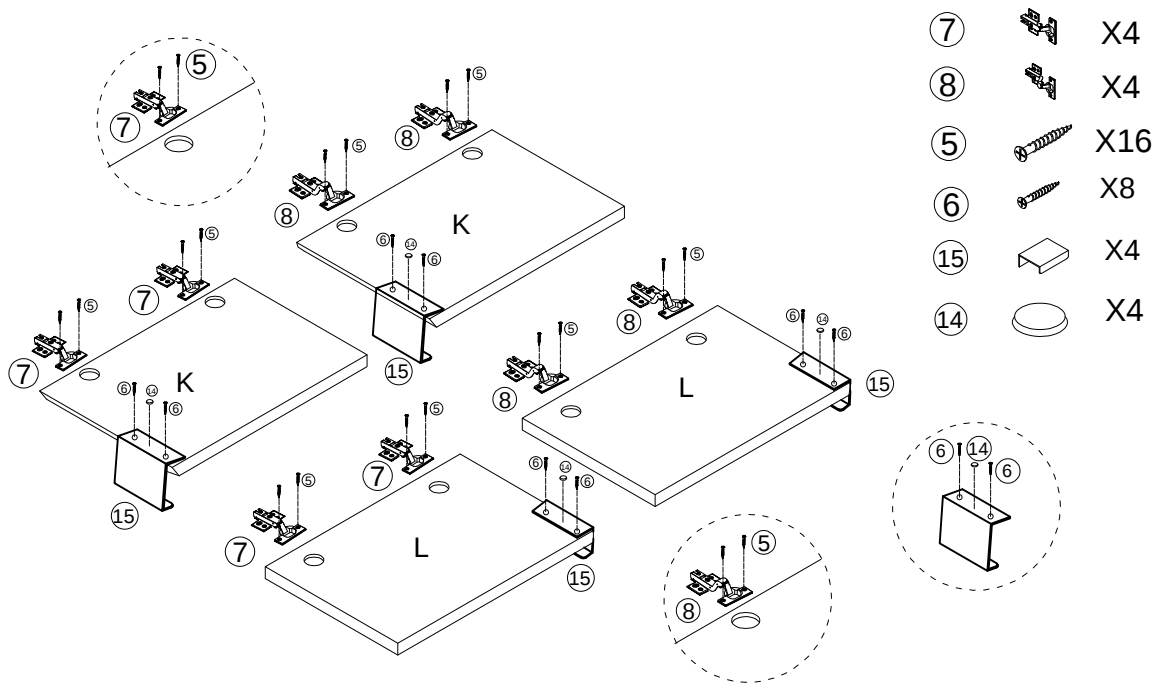
Stand the mounted sideboard up, and insert shelf support pin(9) into the pre-drilled holes of side board and middle board.

Put the shelf board(H) on the shelf support pin(⑨).

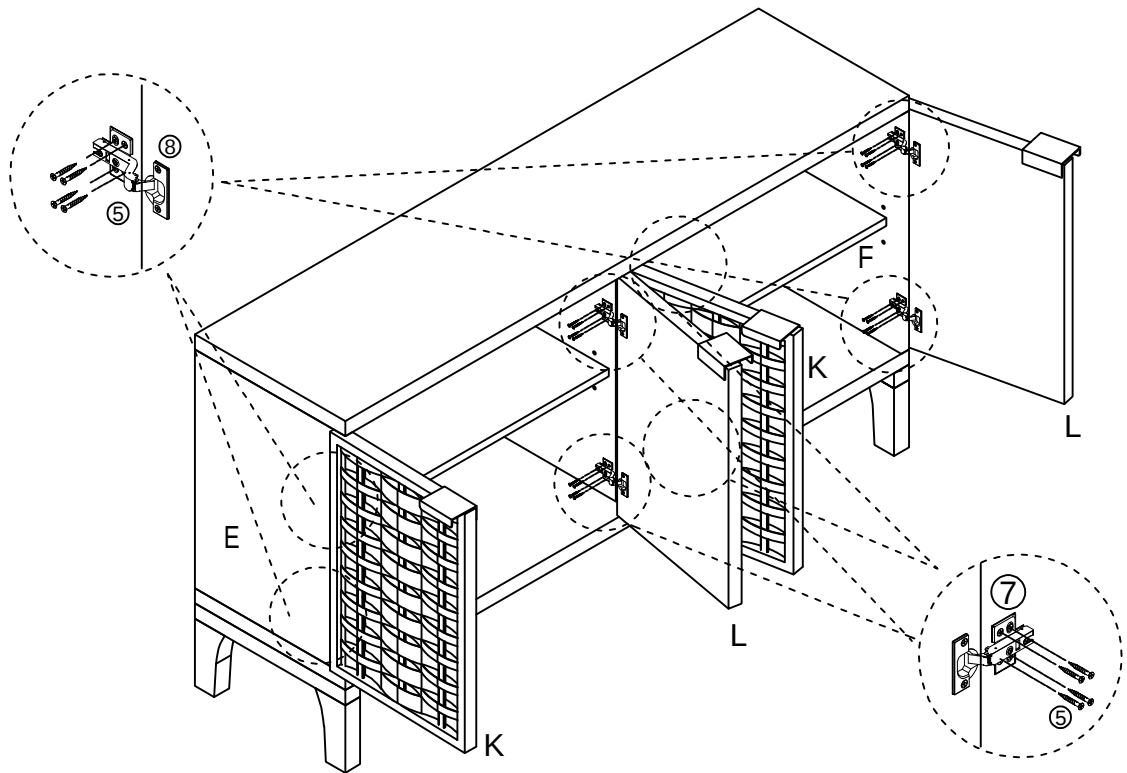
Step12



Install the hydraulic door hinge() on one of the left door(K) and right door(L) with screw().Install the hydraulic door hinge() on another left door(K) and right door(L) with screw().Attach handle(?)to left door(K) and right door(L) with screw(),and stick Eva mat (⑭)onto handle(⑮).

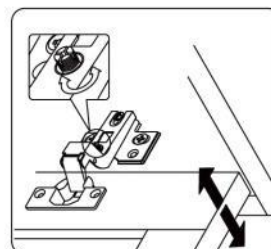
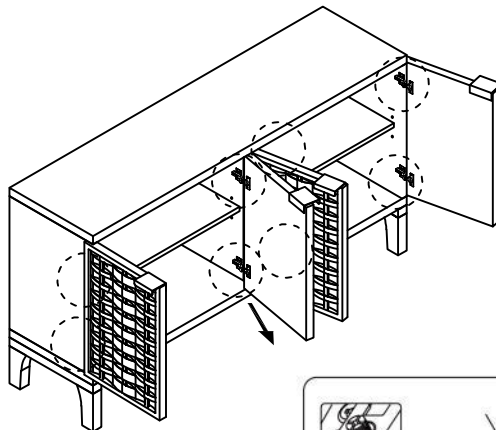

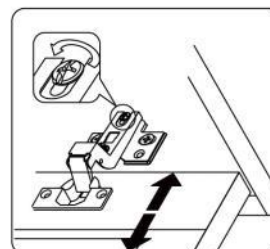


Attach one of the left doors(K) with hydraulic door hinge() to left side board(E) with screw(⑤).
 Attach one of the right doors(L) with hydraulic door hinge() to right side board(F) with screw(⑤).
 Attach another right door(L) and left door(K) with hydraulic door hinge() to middle clapboard(G) with screw(⑤).

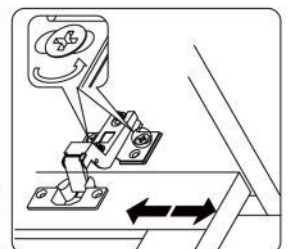

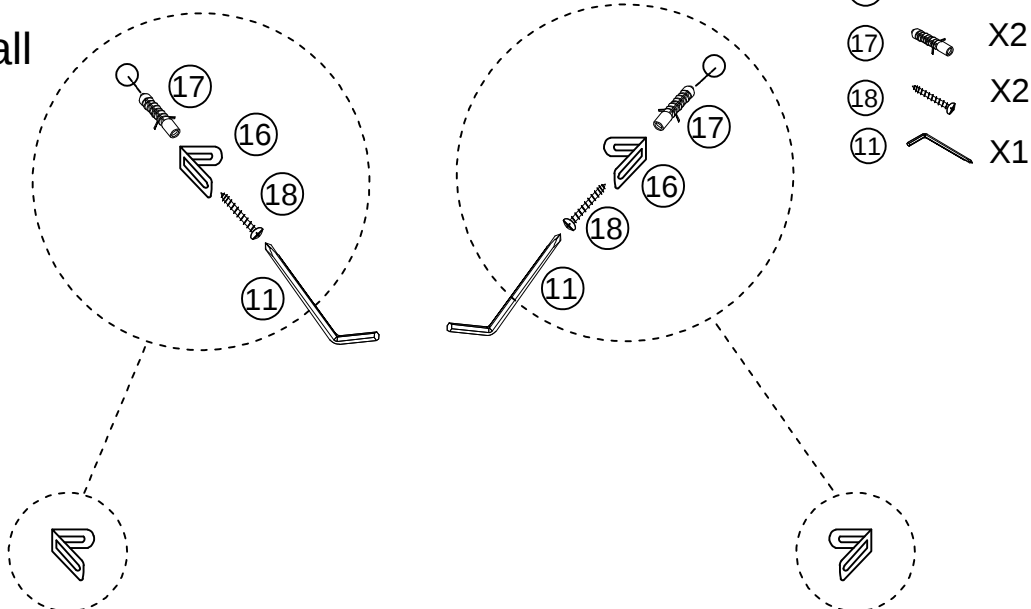


Marking on the wall

Place the sideboard against the wall. Mark the positions for the expansion screws on the wall.

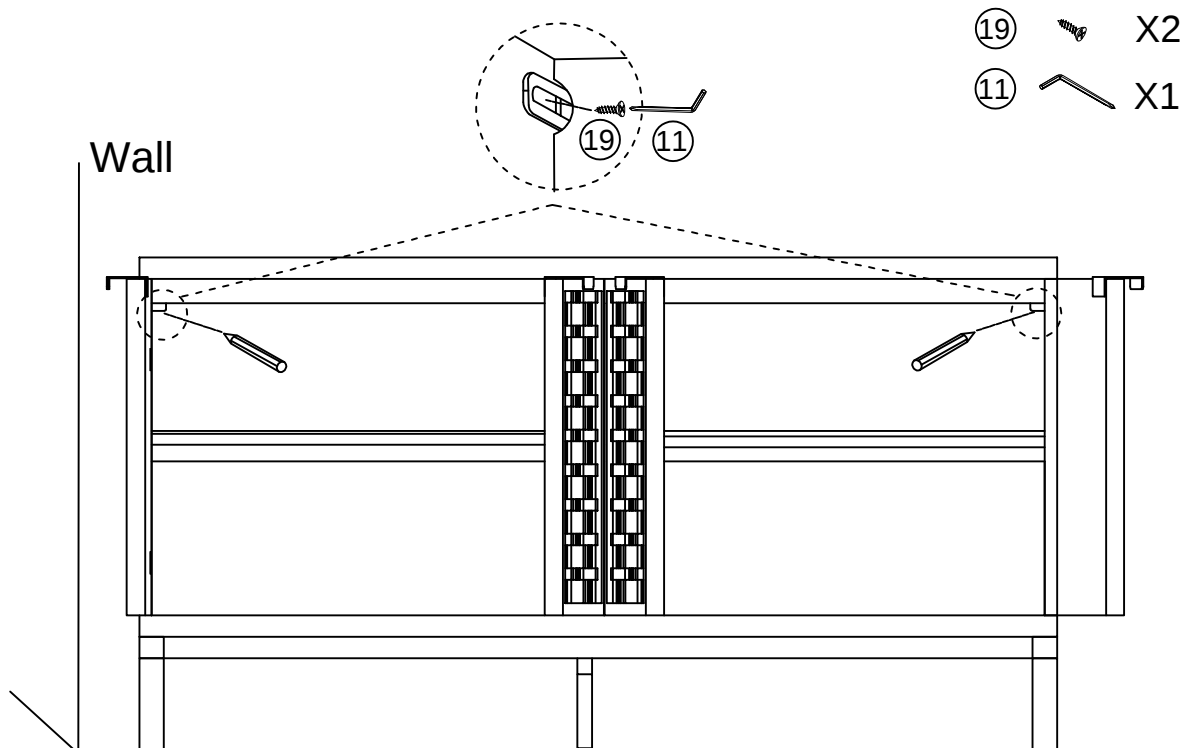

Drill holes on the wall at the marked positions, insert the expansion plugs (17) into the holes, align the sideboard with the expansion plugs (17), and fasten the short end of the anti-tip wall bracket (16) using the long screws (18).

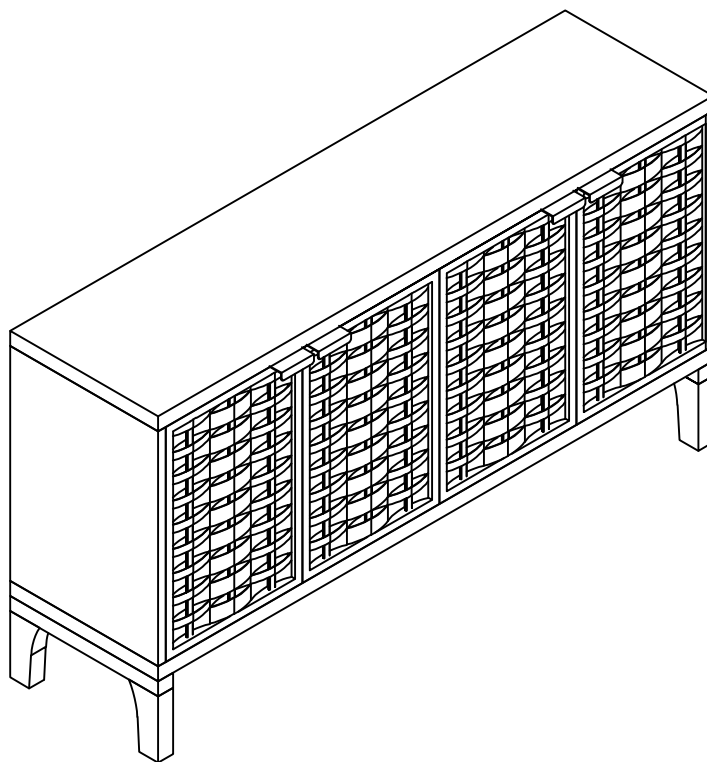

Attach the long side of the anti-tip wall bracket (16) to the right side board (F) and left side board (E) with the short screws (19) using wrench(11).

Questions &Answers about proposition 65

what is proposition 65?

proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces , or that are released into the environment. BY requiring that this information be provided , proposition 65 enables californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

proposition 65 also prohibits california businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

proposition 65 requires california to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987 .

what types of chemicals are on the proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides , common household products, food , drugs , dyes , or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction , or they maybe byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

what does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace , a business, or in rental housing , the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

BY law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
