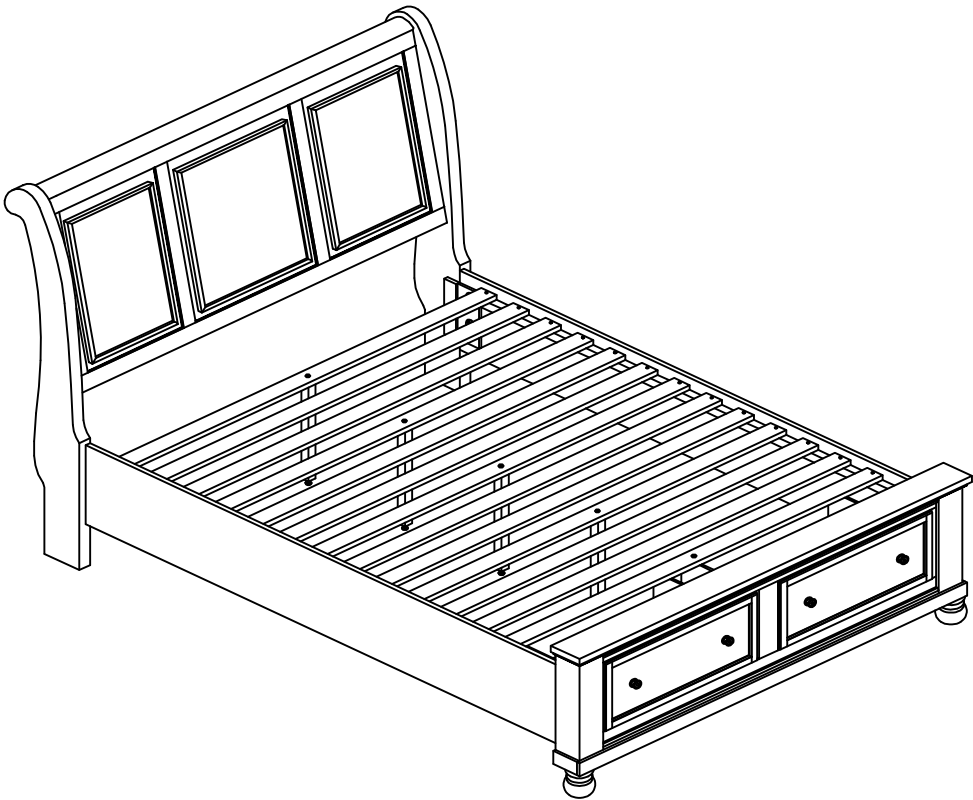
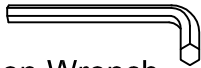

PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



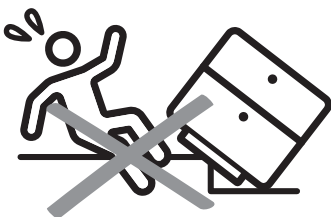
Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

ASSEMBLY AND CARE ADVICE

Position each part correctly
and insert screws or bolts into
their respective holes.



Turn clockwise to tighten and
only tighten when step is
completed or when instructed
to do so.



Save the instructions and store
any supplied tools for later
maintenance.

Use the appropriate hand tools
or power tools for assembly.
Select steps, such as tightening
screws and/or bolts, may require
hand tools to avoid causing
damage during assembly.



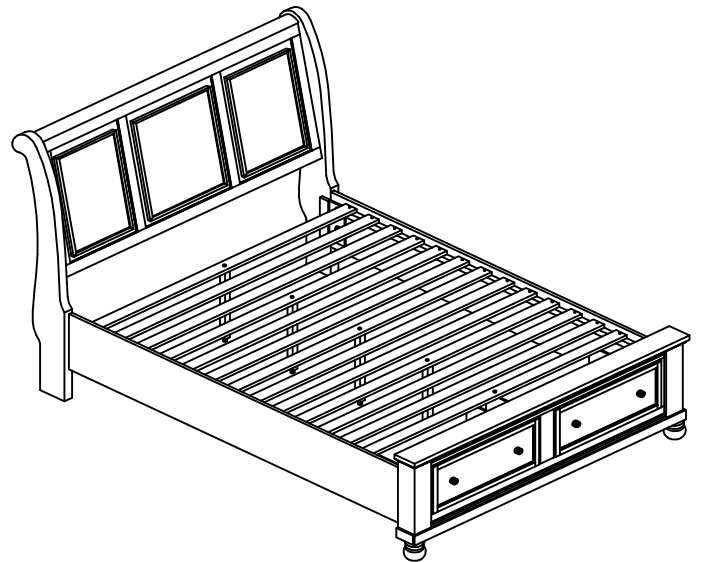
After two weeks, check and
tighten any loose hardware and
repeat again every six months
thereafter.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Prepare 8 bolts assembly by inserting lock washer (#B), then flat washer (#C) onto bolts (#A). Align headboard (#1) and headboard cross bar (#3) to the holes of the headboard legs (#2R/L). Secure by using bolts (#A).

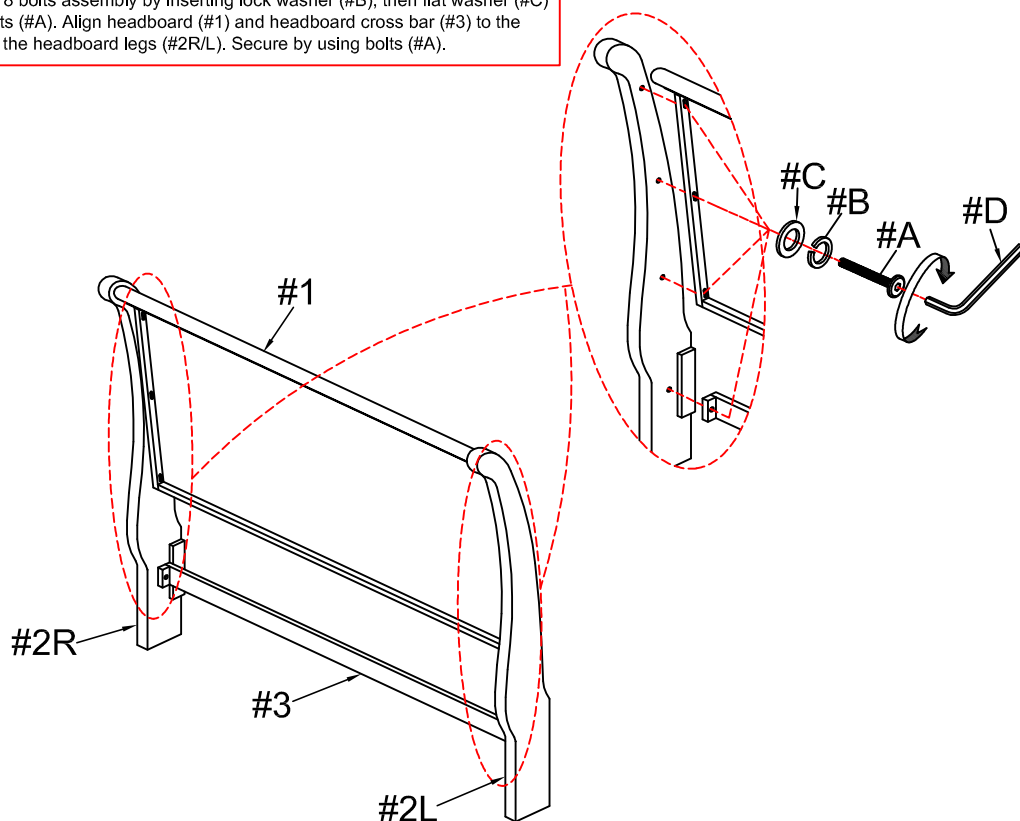

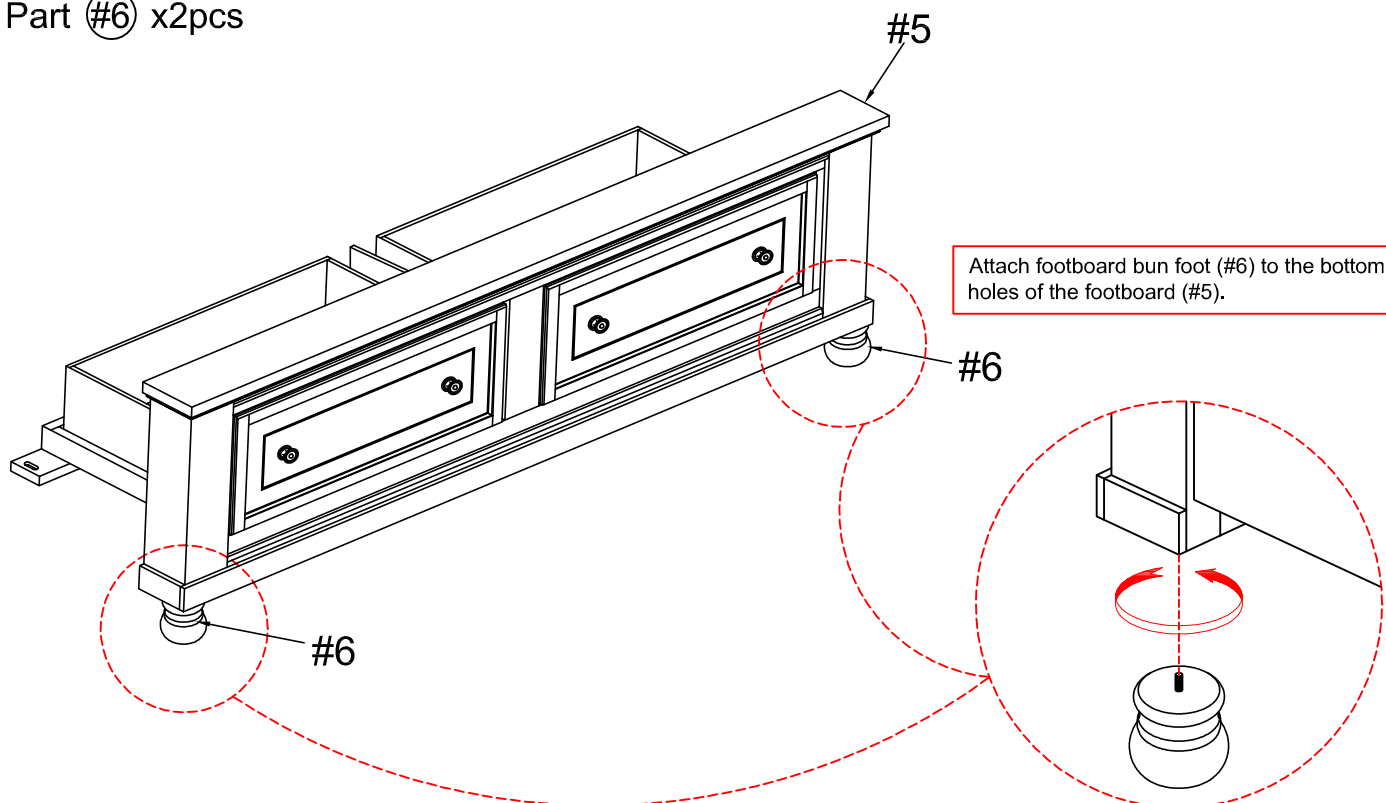

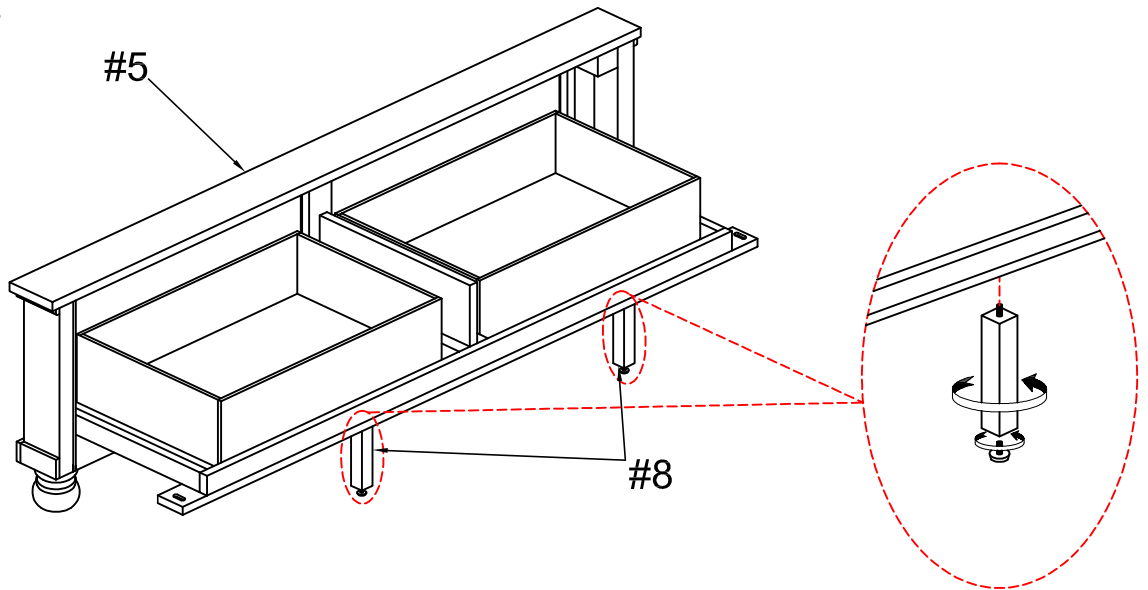
Attach footboard bun foot (#6) to the bottom holes of the footboard (#5).

Attach support legs (#8) to the bottom holes of the footboard (#5).
Adjust the leveler of the support legs (#8) according to ground level.

Attach threaded bolts (#1) to the foot board (#5) and headboard (#1). Align side rails (#4) to the threaded bolts of the foot board (#5) and headboard (#1). Secure by inserting half moon (#J), flat washer (#C), lock washer (#B) and hex nut (#K).

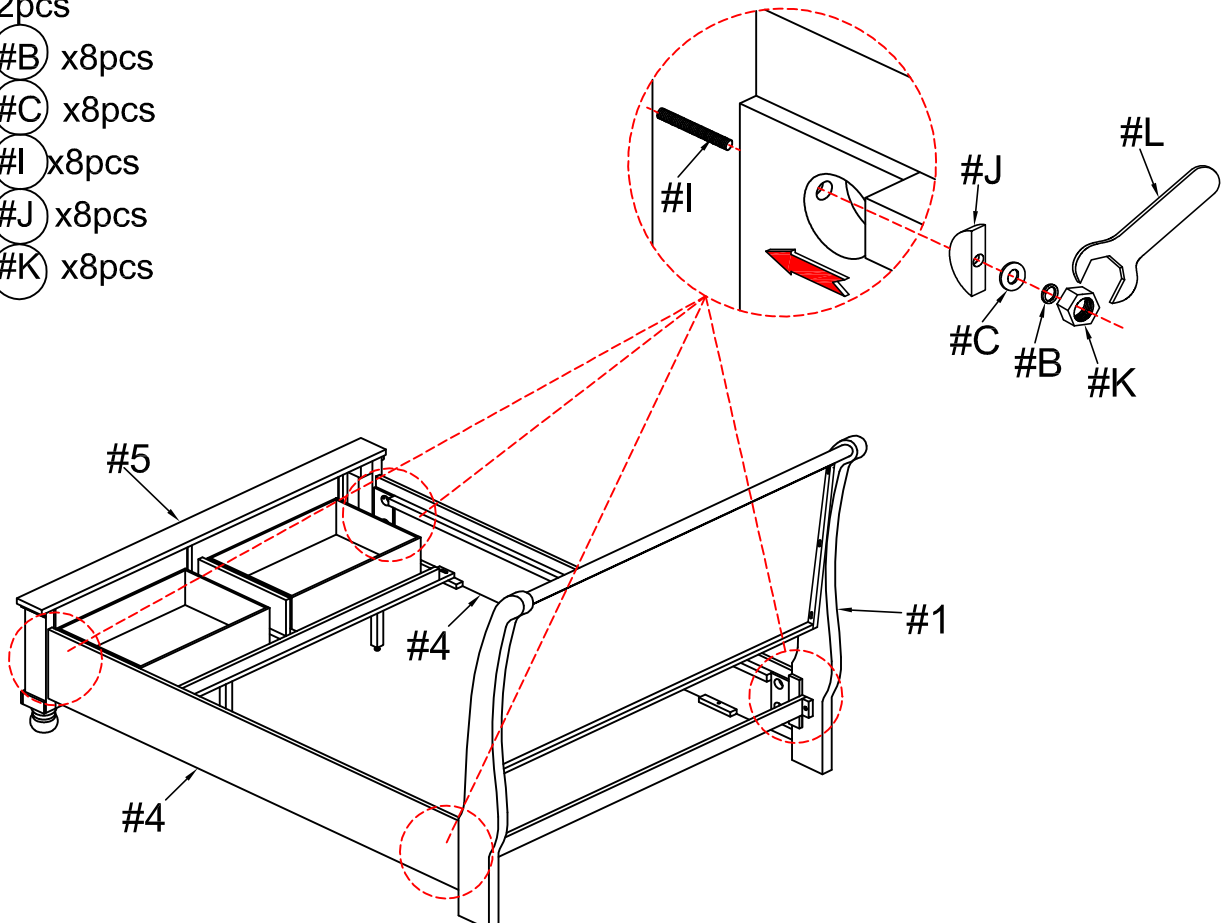

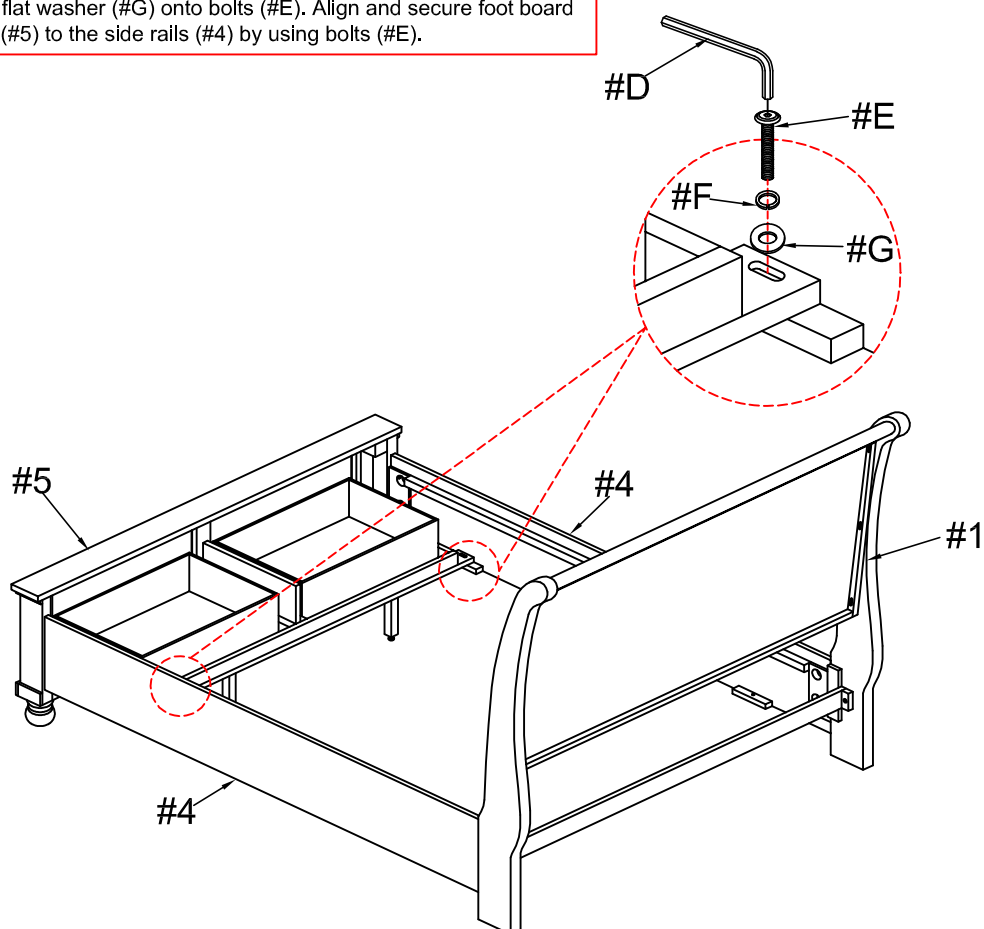

Prepare 2 bolts assembly by inserting lock washer (**#F**), then flat washer (**#G**) onto bolts (**#E**). Align and secure foot board (**#5**) to the side rails (**#4**) by using bolts (**#E**).

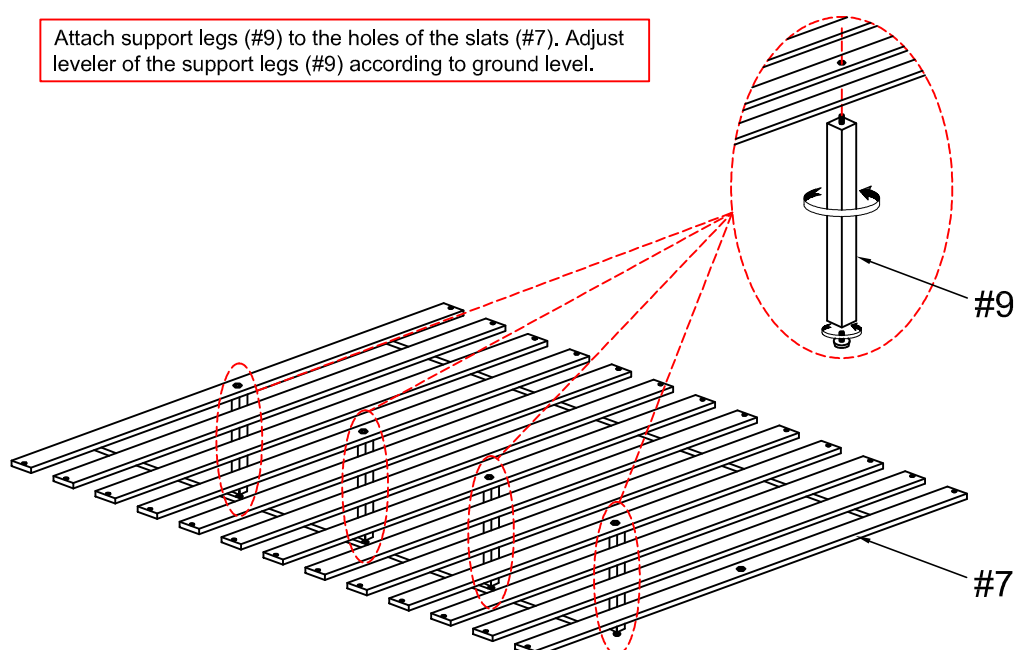

Attach support legs (**#9**) to the holes of the slats (**#7**). Adjust leveler of the support legs (**#9**) according to ground level.

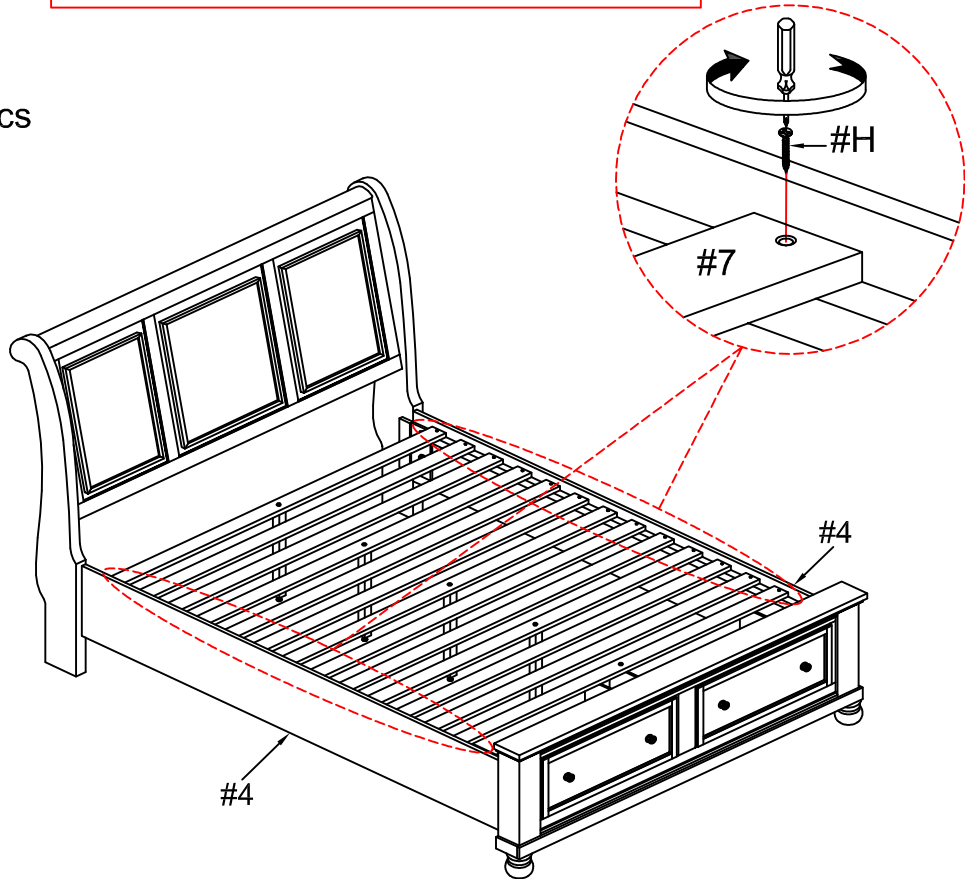

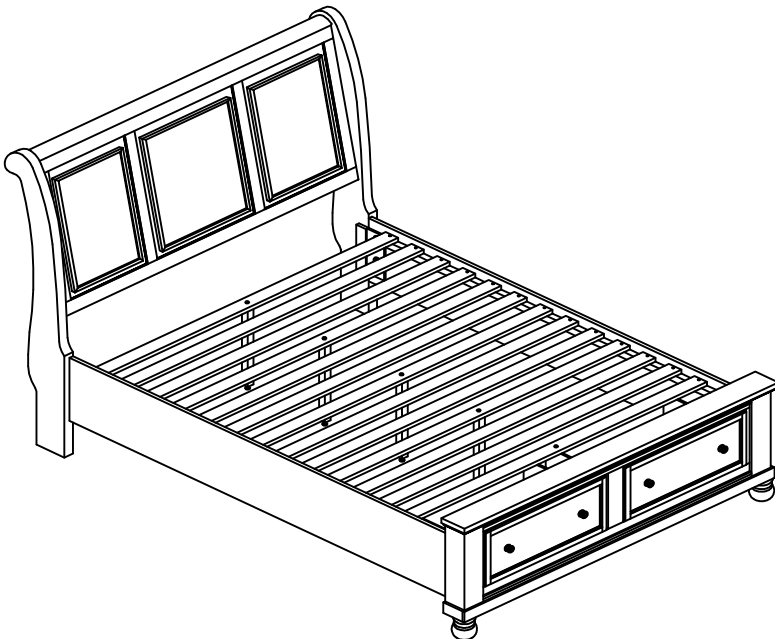
