Exploded View

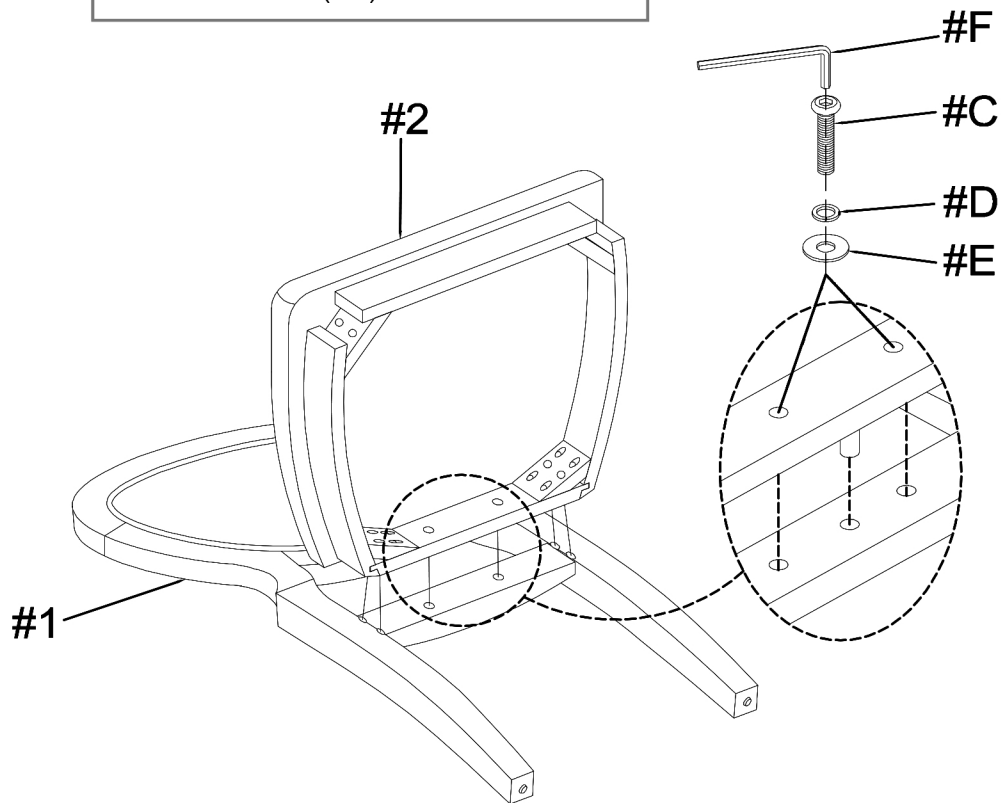

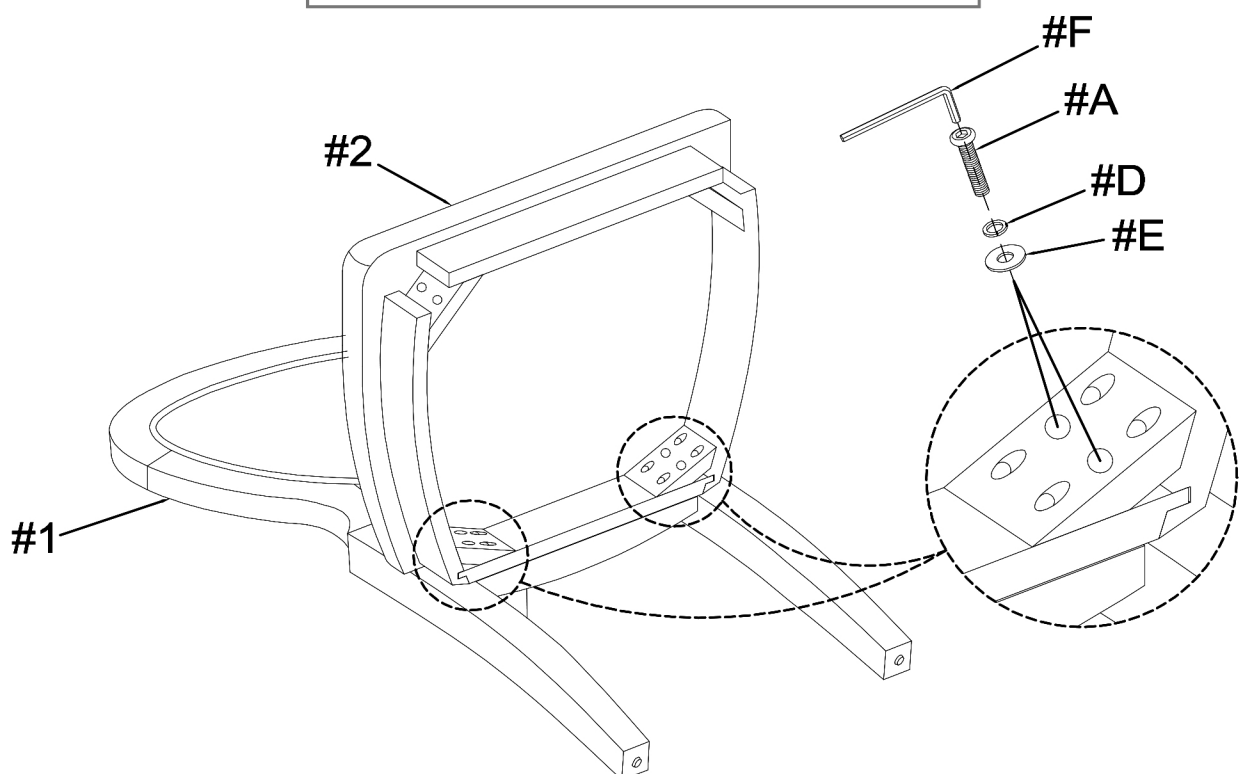
Align the Cushion with frame (#2) to the Back frame (#1). Secure the center by using Bolt (#C) with Lock washer (#D) and Flat washer (#E).

Align the Front legs (#3) to the cushion with frame (#2) and secure using Bolt (#B) with Lock washer (#D) and flat Washer (#E).

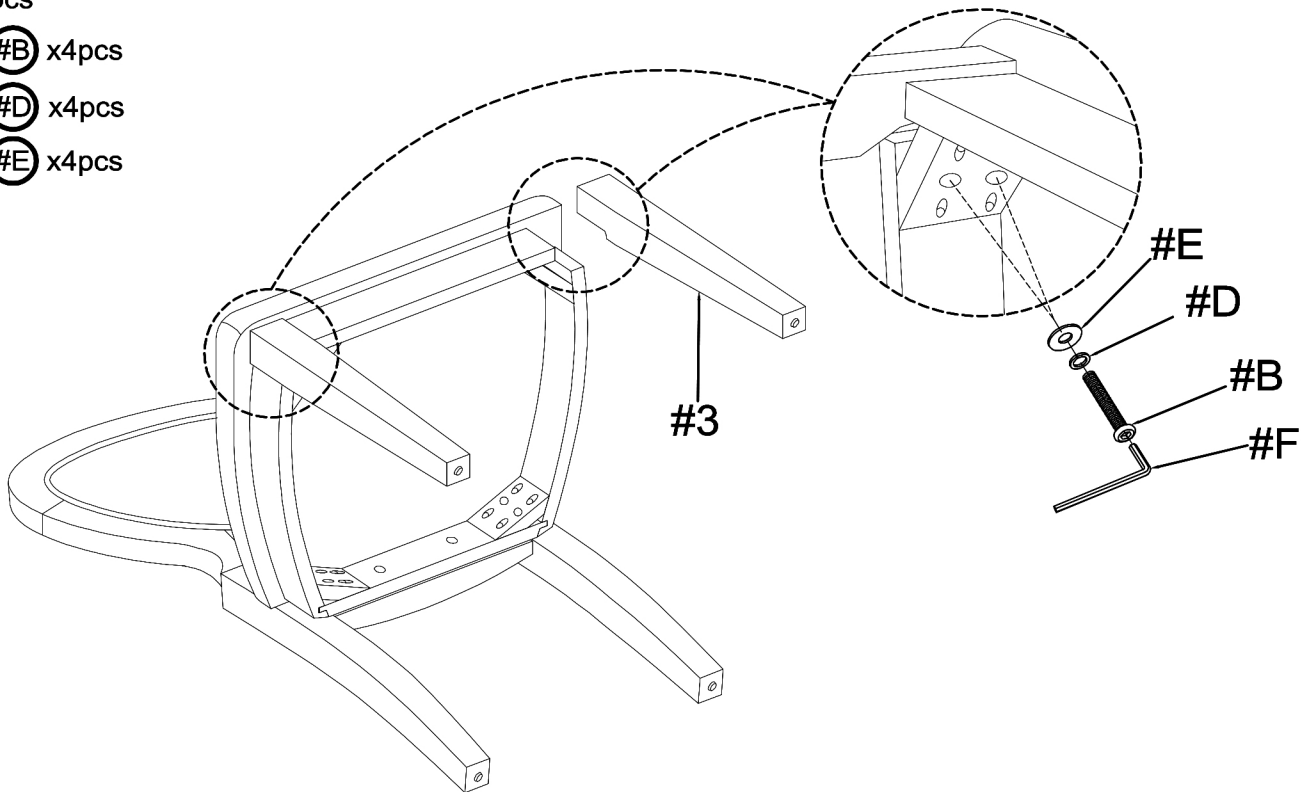

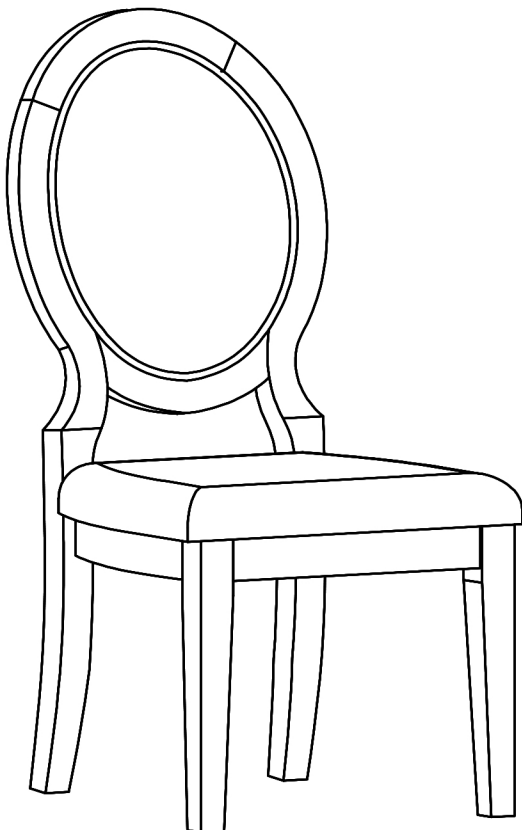
