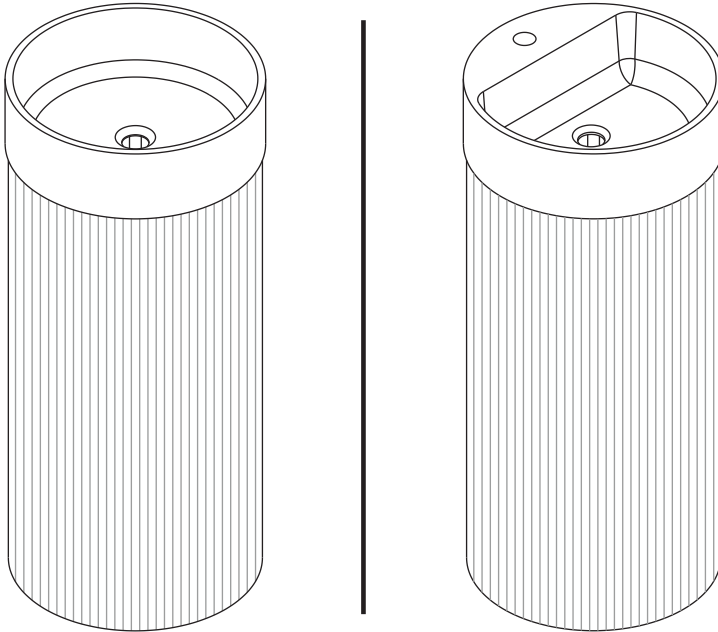




For this style, two different types of countertop basins can be paired. Please refer to the corresponding installation method based on the style you choose.

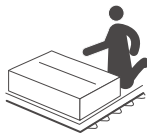
Your order will be shipped in multiple packages, and delivery times may vary. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

Notice:

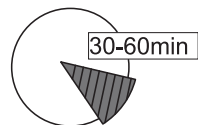
- 1. Follow the installation instructions. Please confirm all accessories are preset before installation.

For easy installation, pre-drilled holes are thoughtfully placed at the back of the cabinet. Please refer to the diagram for their exact locations. Please check your on-site measurements before purchasing to ensure a proper fit.

If the base/back panel does not fit, you may trim it as needed.

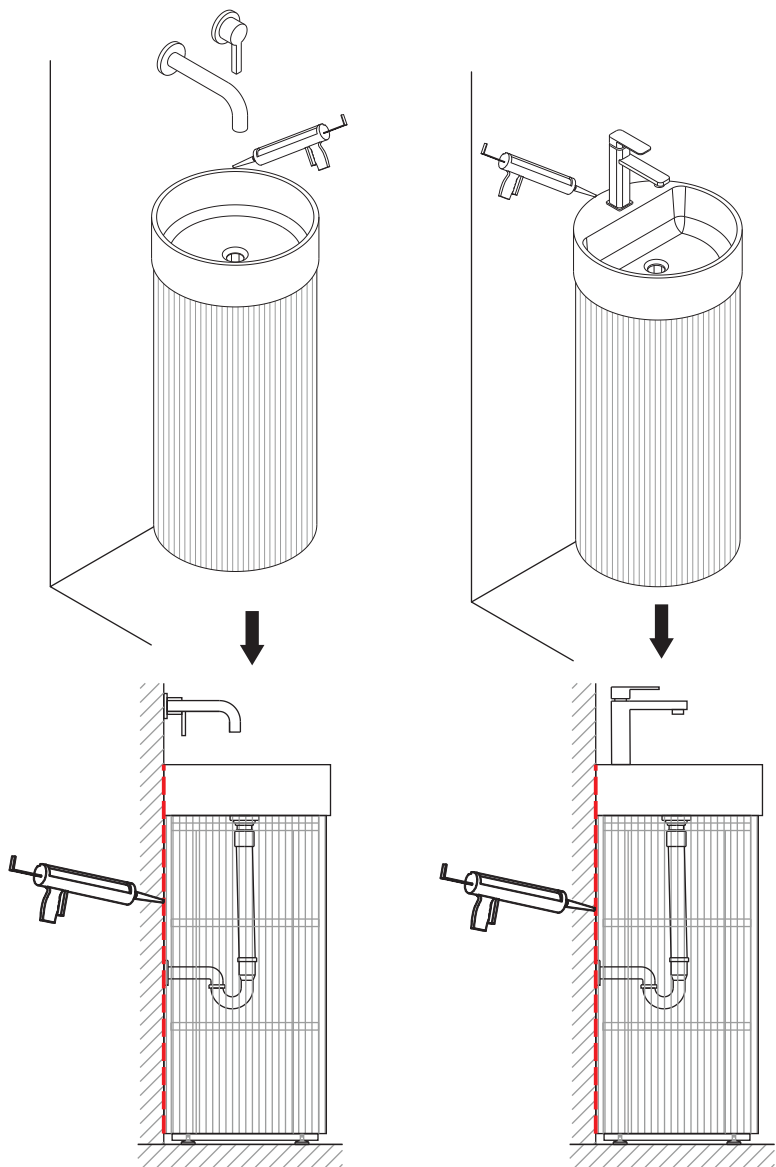

Bring your own tools

Apply a bead of silicone along the gap between the back of the basin/cabinet and the wall to secure the unit and prevent it from tipping forward.

Pop-up Waste Installation

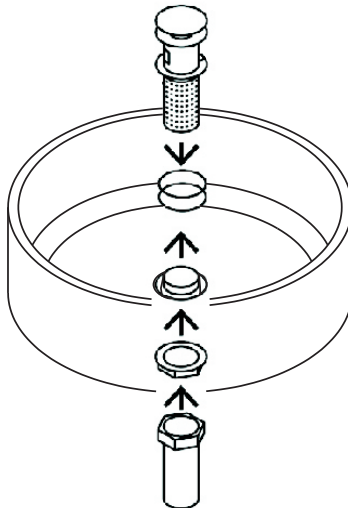
STEP 1

Install Pop-up Waste with over flow.

Connect the drain pipe.
