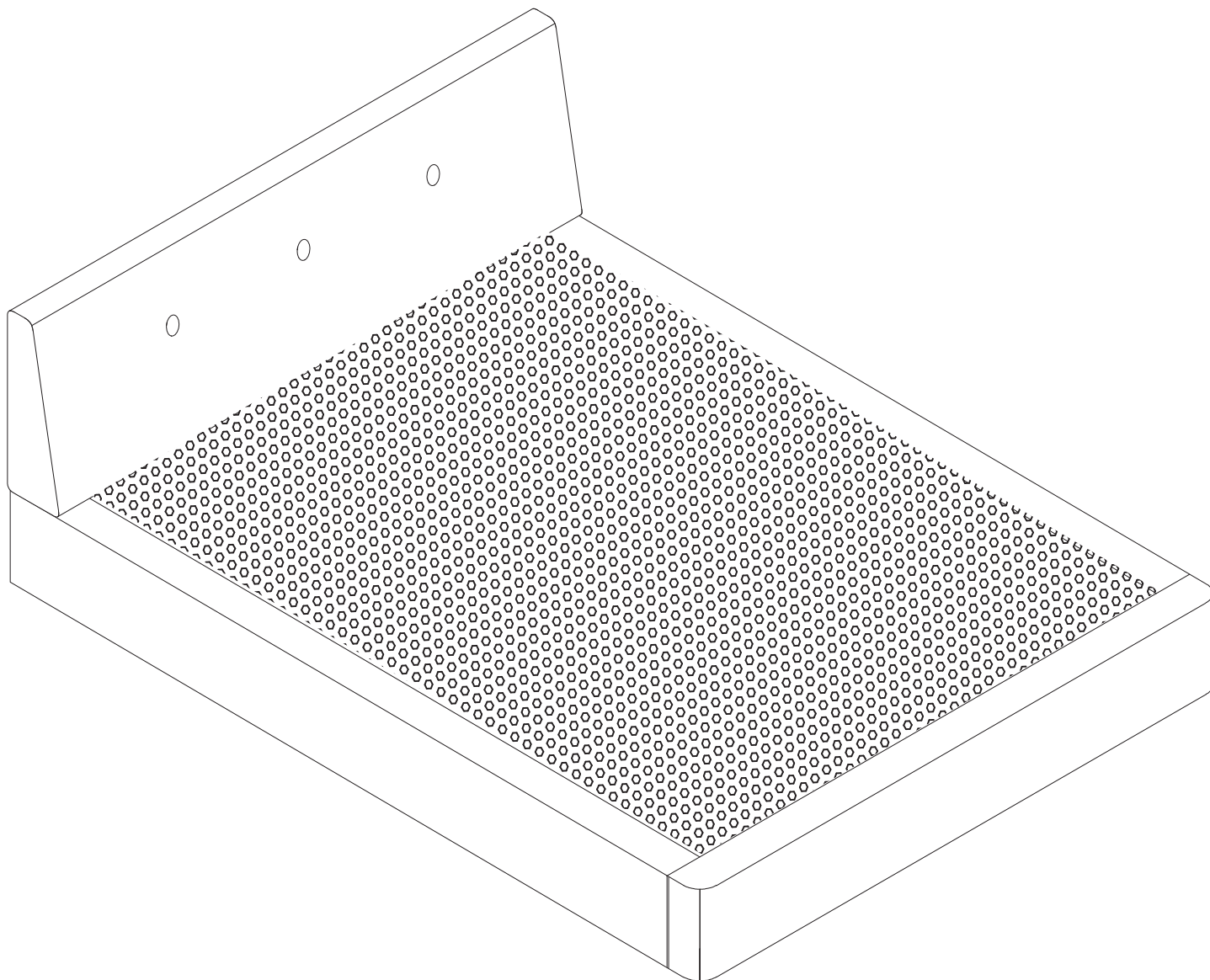


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION





Disclaimer

To Valued Customers:

Thank you for purchasing furniture products from our store. To ensure your safety and the best user experience, please read and understand all the contents of this notice carefully before installation and use. Once you start installing or using this product, it is deemed that you have accepted all the following terms.

I. Regarding Installation

● **Professional Installation Recommendation:** For large, modular, or wall-mounted furniture, we strongly recommend that you hire qualified professionals for installation. Self-installation may involve risks.

● **Self-Installation Liability:** If you choose to install the product yourself, it means that you confirm you have the corresponding installation capability and voluntarily assume all risks and responsibilities arising from improper installation, including personal injury and property damage. Improper installation includes, but is not limited to, damage to product components due to ignoring installation instructions during the installation process, loose, missing, or wrong installation of connectors, and obvious instability such as tilting and shaking due to improper placement after installation.

● **Follow Official Instructions:** Installation must strictly follow the steps in the Installation Manual and diagrams provided with the product. Do not rely on any installation guidance from unofficial channels. Our company shall not be responsible for any problems caused by failure to follow official instructions.

● **Safe Installation Environment:** Please carry out the installation in a spacious, bright, and well-ventilated environment and use appropriate tools. During installation, please keep children and pets away from the work area to prevent accidental ingestion of small parts or accidental injuries.

II. Regarding Usage

● **Weight Capacity Limit:** Please strictly comply with the maximum weight capacity limit indicated on the product. Overloading may cause structural damage, deformation, or overturning of the furniture, leading to serious accidents. Our company shall not be responsible for any consequences arising therefrom.

● **Special Warning:** The fixing method must fully comply with the requirements in the manual. Failure to fix as required may cause the furniture to overturn, resulting in serious injury or death. Our company shall not be responsible for any furniture overturning and all consequences caused by failure to perform wall mounting or improper fixing.

● **Regular Inspection and Maintenance:** It is recommended that you regularly (especially in the early stage of installation and after moving) inspect and tighten all connectors (screws, bolts, etc.) to ensure the structural stability of the furniture (see the maintenance method in the manual for details). Problems caused by neglect of inspection and maintenance are not covered by the warranty.

● Proper Use and Placement:

Place the furniture on a flat and solid floor.

Do not use the furniture for purposes other than its designed use (for example, standing on drawers or shelves, using a chair as a ladder, etc.).

Do not place heavy objects such as televisions or items that attract children on the upper part of the furniture.

Avoid placing the furniture in humid, sun-exposed, or extreme temperature environments to avoid affecting the product's service life or structural stability.

Misuse, abuse, negligence, or unauthorized repair or modification without our company's authorization;

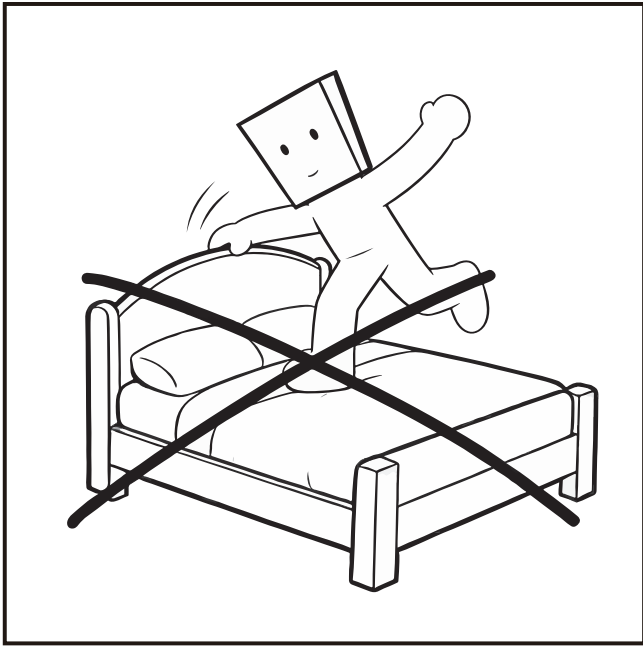
Improper installation (whether carried out by the user or a third party not designated by our company);

Force majeure events.

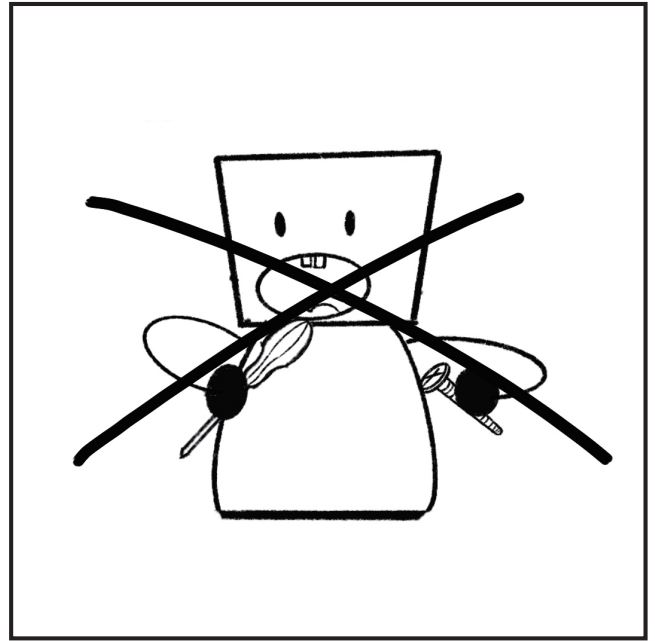

Weight Capacity:

–Do not place items exceeding the maximum weight capacity of the product. (For the product's weight capacity, please refer to the product link.)

Usage Scenarios and Maintenance Methods

- Do not place the product in a humid environment.
- Avoid direct exposure to high temperatures and keep it away from heat sources.
- Clean and maintain the product regularly.
- Place it on a flat surface. When moving is required, ensure that at least two people lift it together.
- Check the condition of screws regularly. If any screws are loose or fall off, reinforce them promptly.

Sponge products

Preparation before Installation

–Please read the assembly instructions carefully Before installation and keep this manual for future reference. Check that all parts are complete, including hardware accessories, screws, plastic parts and other small components.

Ensure that **only adults** perform the installation, and keep children away from the installation area.

Instructions for Use

(1) **Proper Placement:** Ensure that sponge – like products are placed on a flat and dry surface. Avoid deformation caused by uneven force.

(2) **Usage Scenarios:** Sponge – like products can only be used in indoor environments. Avoid long – term exposure to direct sunlight or humid environments to prevent aging, yellowing, or mildew.

(3) **Even Force Application:** Avoid sitting in the same position for a long time, which may cause local collapse, so as to extend the service life.

(4) **Cleaning Frequency:** Regularly clean surface dust and stains to maintain hygiene.

(5) **Prevent Pet Scratching:** Pets may damage textiles. It is recommended to use protective covers or regularly trim your pets' nails.



Notes

- **Avoid Sharp Objects:** Prevent sharp objects from scratching or piercing the sponge surface, which may damage the internal materials.
- **Keep Away from High Temperatures and Fire Sources:** Sponges are flammable. Keep them away from high temperatures, open flames or heat sources to prevent fires.

- **Moisture and Mildew Prevention:** Use moisture – proof mats or ventilate regularly in humid environments to prevent the sponge from getting moldy.
- **Load – Bearing Limit:** Pay attention to the load – bearing range of the product and avoid overloading.
- **Avoid Jumping on the Product or Placing Heavy Objects to Prevent Sponge Deformation.**
- **Avoid Pulling Forcefully, Which May Cause Structural Damage.**
- **Do not use an iron to dry sponge products.**



Maintenance Methods

- (1) **Regular Turning:** It is recommended to rotate or swap the position of the sponge pad every 3 months to ensure even force distribution on the sponge and prevent sagging.
- (2) **Cleaning Method:** Use a vacuum cleaner to remove surface dust. For local stains, gently wipe with a neutral cleaner. Avoid using strong acid or strong alkali cleaners.
- (3) **Dust – Proof Protection:** Use a dust cover or sofa cover to reduce direct contact with dust and stains.
- (4) **Ventilation and Air – Drying:** Regularly place sponge – like products in a well – ventilated area indoors for air – drying. Make sure not to expose them to direct sunlight outdoors.
- (5) **Moisture – Proof Measures:** Use a dehumidifier or place a moisture absorbent during humid seasons, and put a moisture – proof mat under the product.

Metal products

Preparation before Installation

–Please read the assembly instructions carefully Before installation and keep this manual for future reference. Check that all parts are complete, including hardware accessories, screws, plastic parts and other small components.

Ensure that **only adults** perform the installation, and keep children away from the installation area.



Notes

- Metal furniture is susceptible to moisture and rust. Avoid prolonged exposure to water, direct sunlight, or humid environments.

Keep away from corrosive substances such as acids and alkalis to

- prevent damage to the surface coating.

Regularly check for loose screws or connectors and tighten them

- promptly.

Child Safety: Install appropriate corner protectors to avoid injuries

- from sharp edges. This product is not designed for children.

Ensure adult supervision when children are present. Climbing by adults or children is prohibited. Do not use the product as a support for standing or elevated work.

Secondary drilling is not recommended, as it may compromise

- structural integrity.

Replace the product if: the base material shows extensive rust or

- deformation; connections remain loose after repeated repairs; or load-bearing capacity is significantly reduced.

Use anti-tip devices strictly as instructed.

- Rotate placed items every 2–3 months to prevent prolonged single-point pressure.

- **Do not** exceed the maximum load capacity specified for the product.
- Climbing on the furniture is strictly **prohibited**.
- The upper the layer, the less suitable it is to place heavy objects. It is recommended that heavy objects be placed not beyond the lower vertical bar.



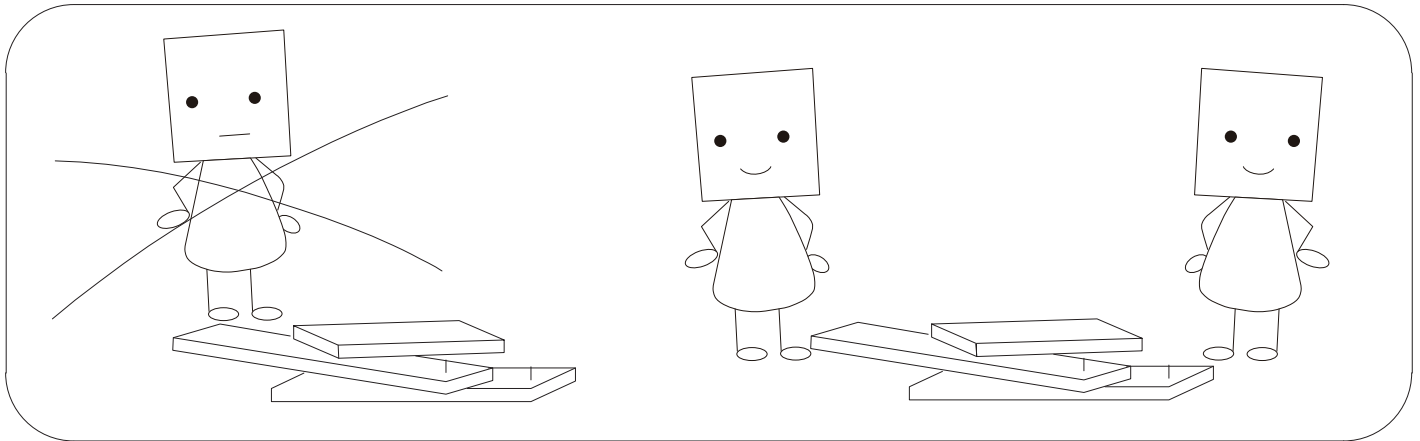
Maintenance Methods

- (1) **Surface Cleaning:** Wipe with a soft, dry or slightly damp cloth. Avoid abrasive tools such as steel wool, hard objects, rough scouring pads, or acidic cleaners to prevent scratching the surface coating.
- (2) **Rust Prevention:** Apply anti-rust oil or wax periodically, especially in humid environments.
- (3) **Coating Protection:** For painted or coated metal furniture, avoid strong acidic or alkaline cleaners to prevent peeling.
- (4) **Check Connections:** Inspect and tighten all connectors every 3 months using the provided wrench if loosening is detected.
- (5) **Wheeled Components:** Regularly remove entangled hair and fibers, and lubricate wheels to ensure smooth movement and prevent tipping hazards caused by jams.

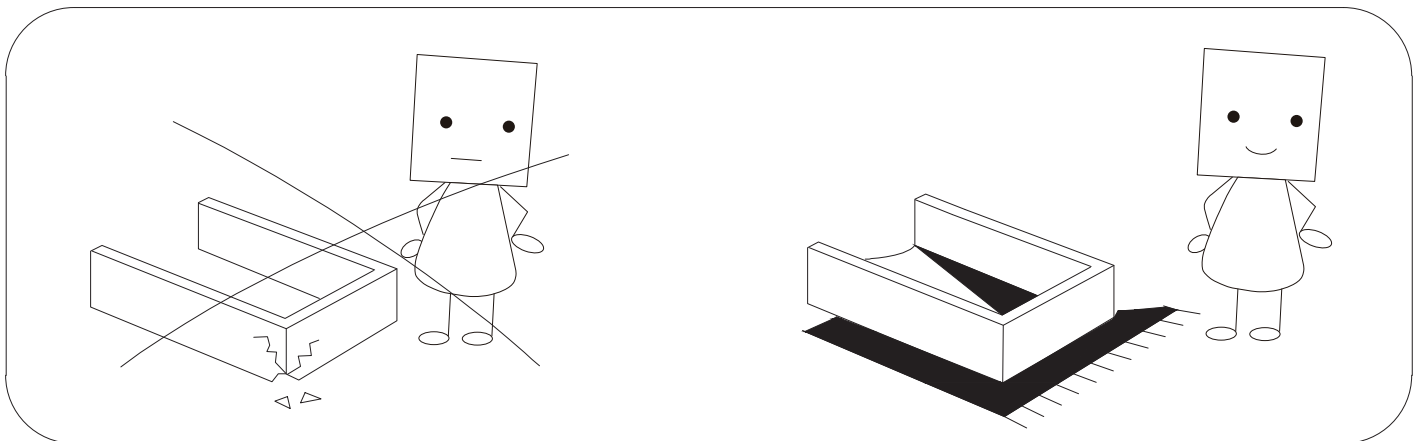

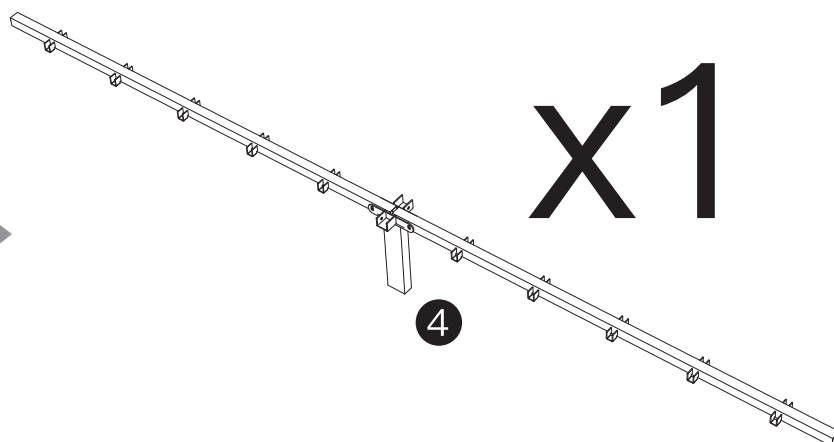
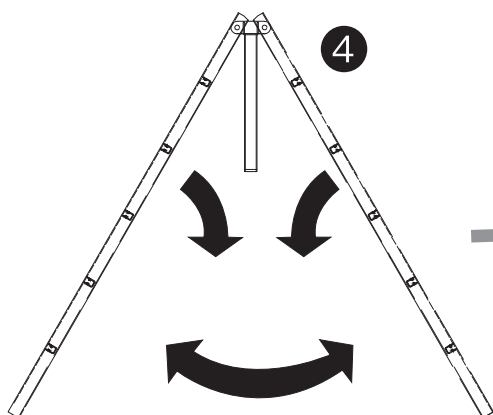
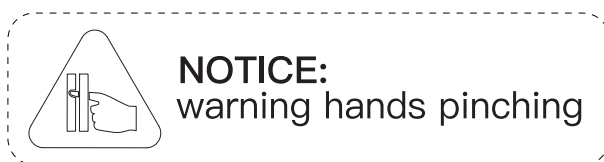
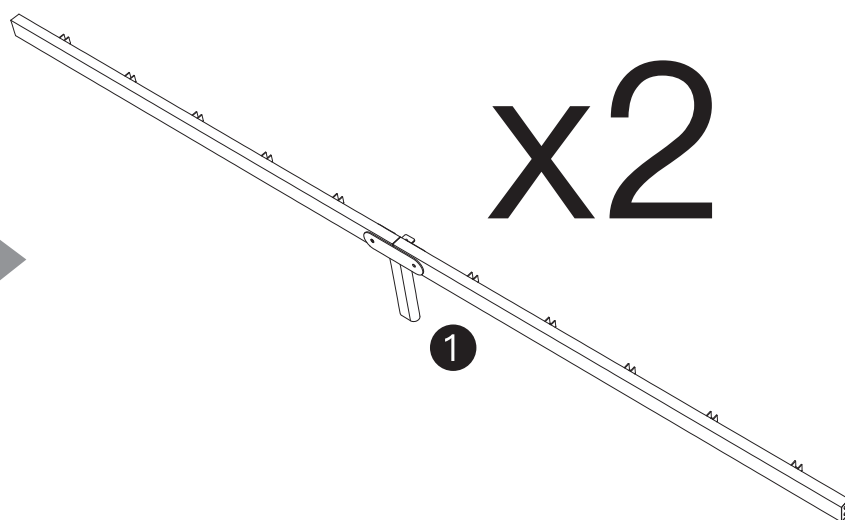
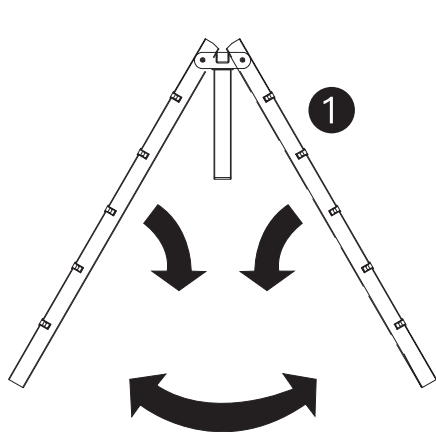
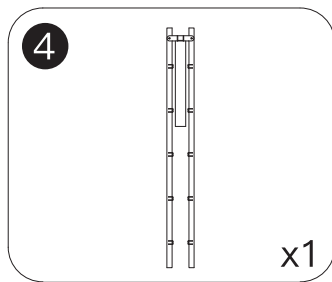
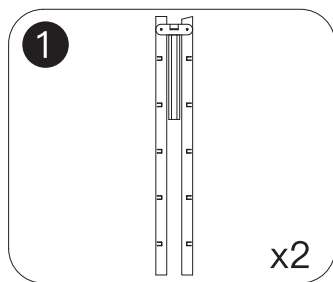
If the inner vacuum packaging is punctured, the compressed component will expand rapidly. When decompressing, stand at the end of the compression bag to avoid injury.

4. Remove hook-and-loop film before use.

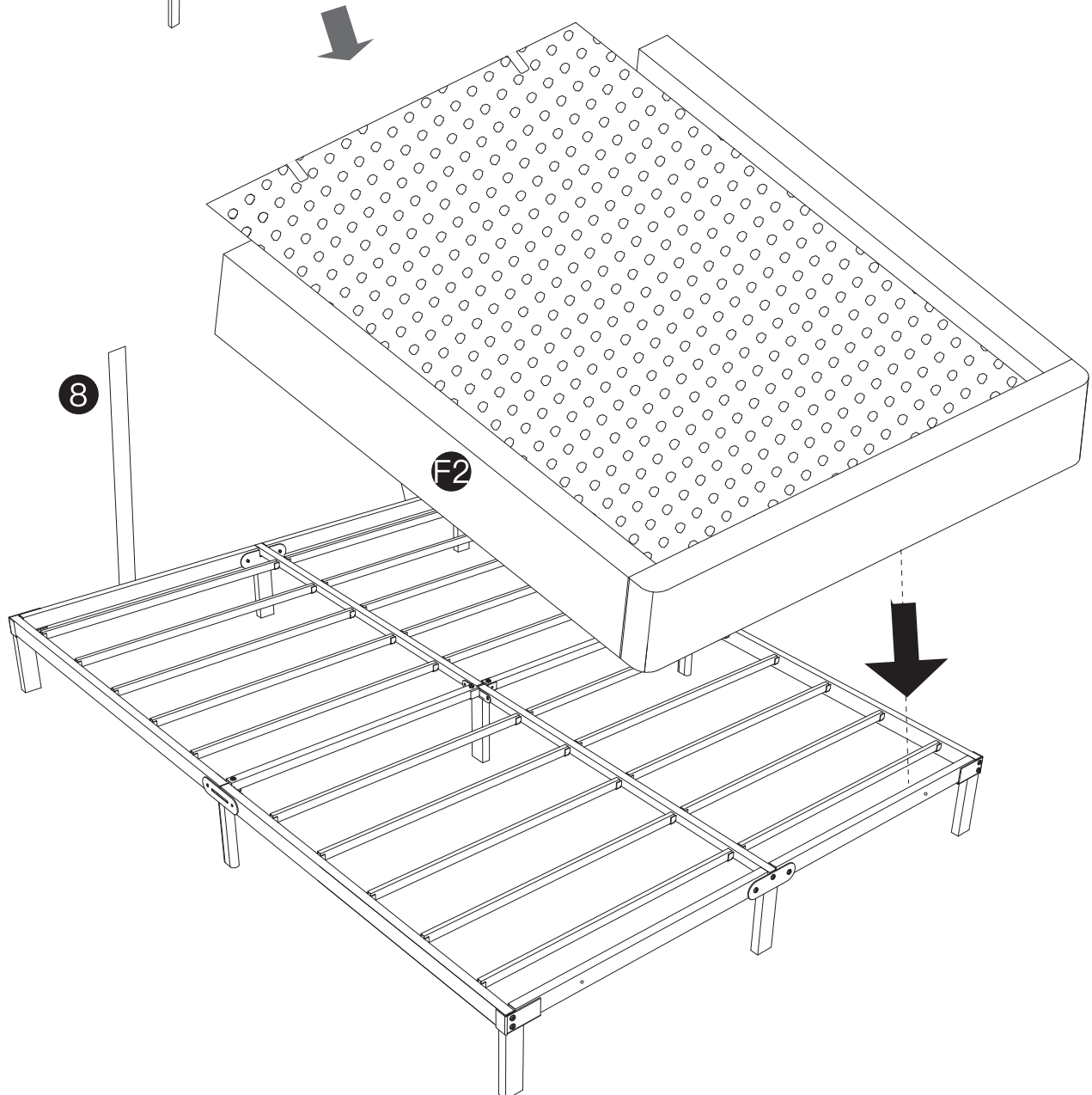
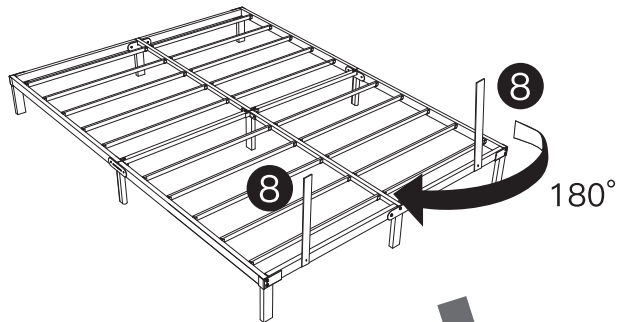

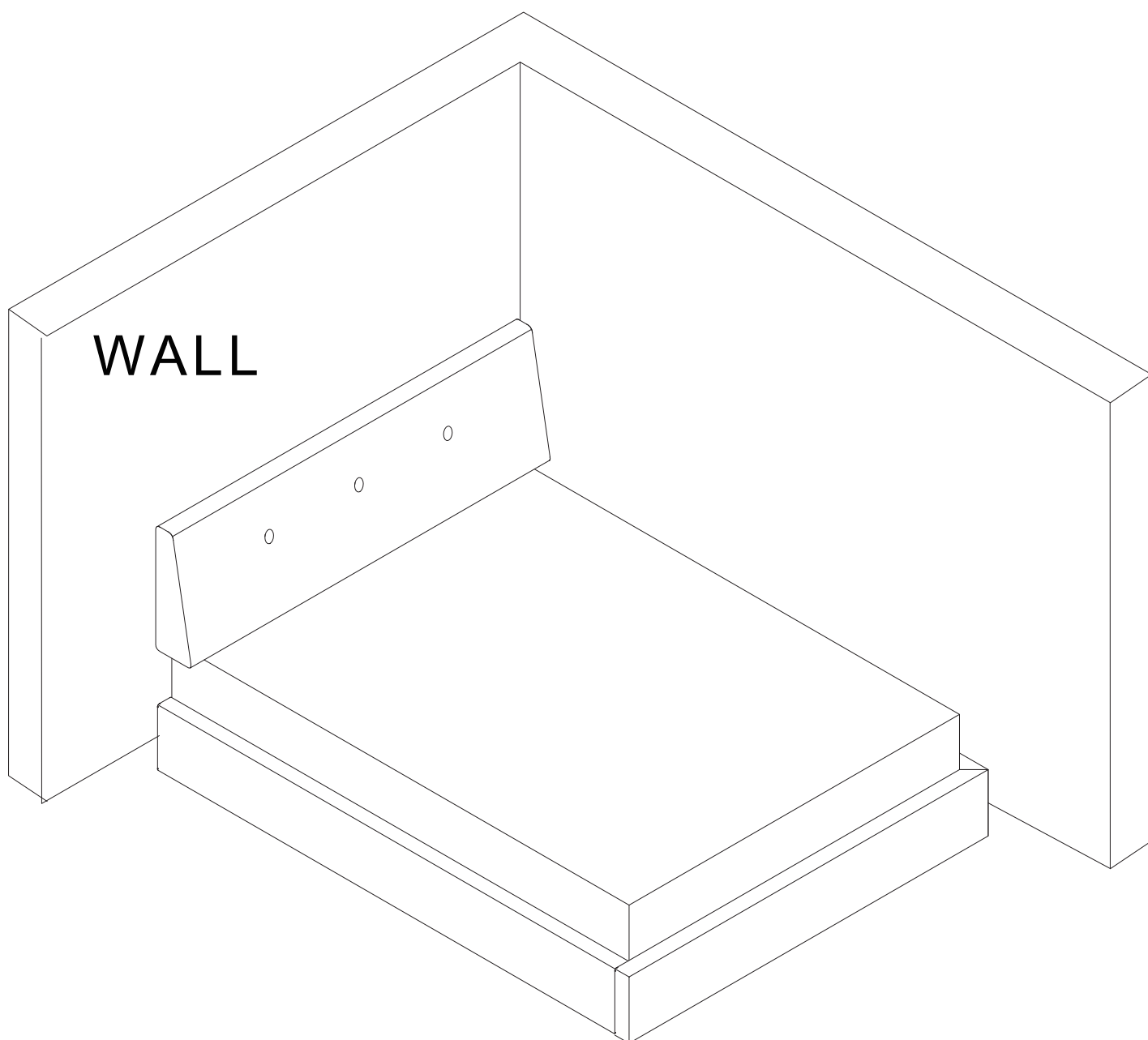
1. It is recommended to assemble with 2 to 4 people.

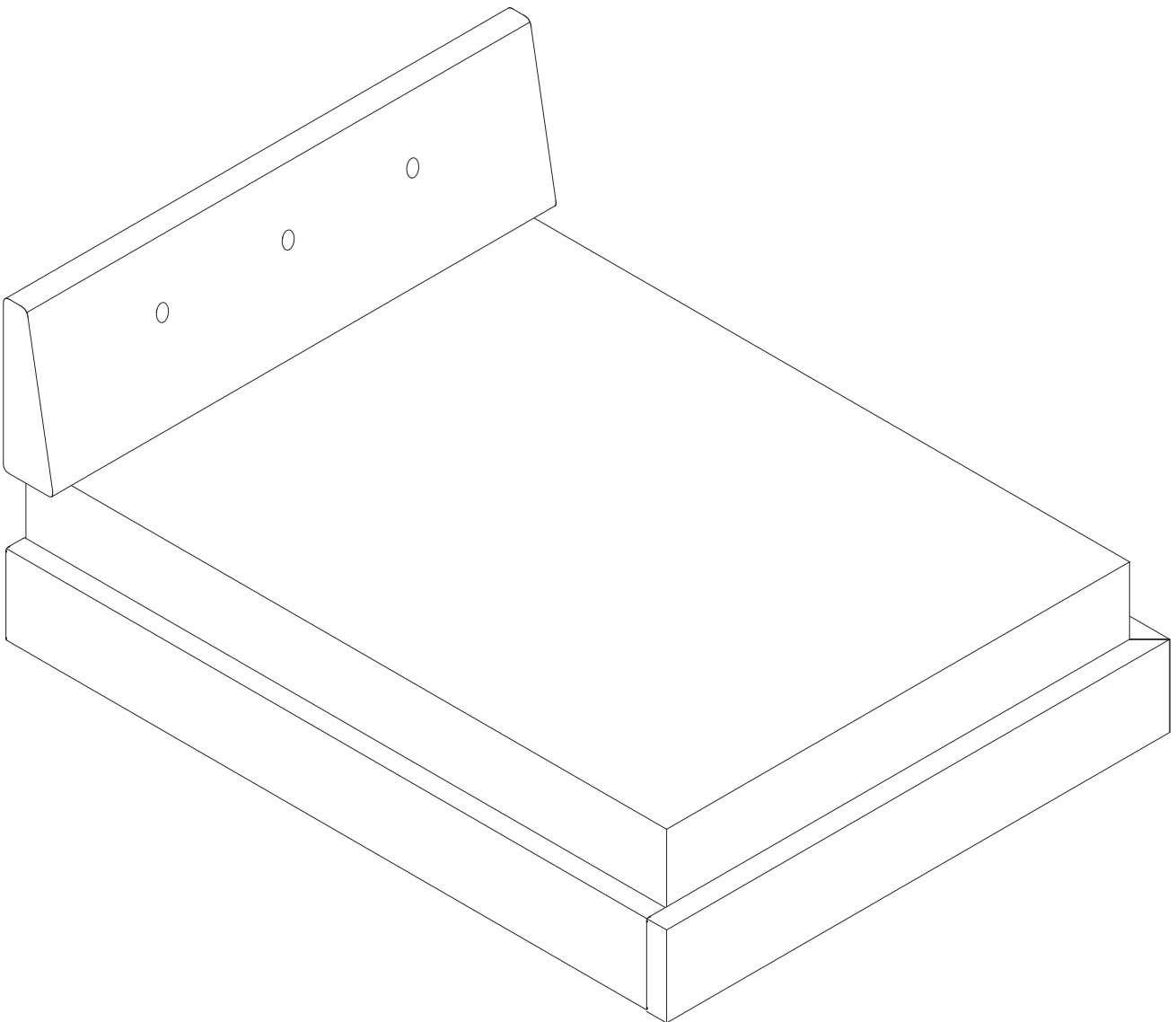
