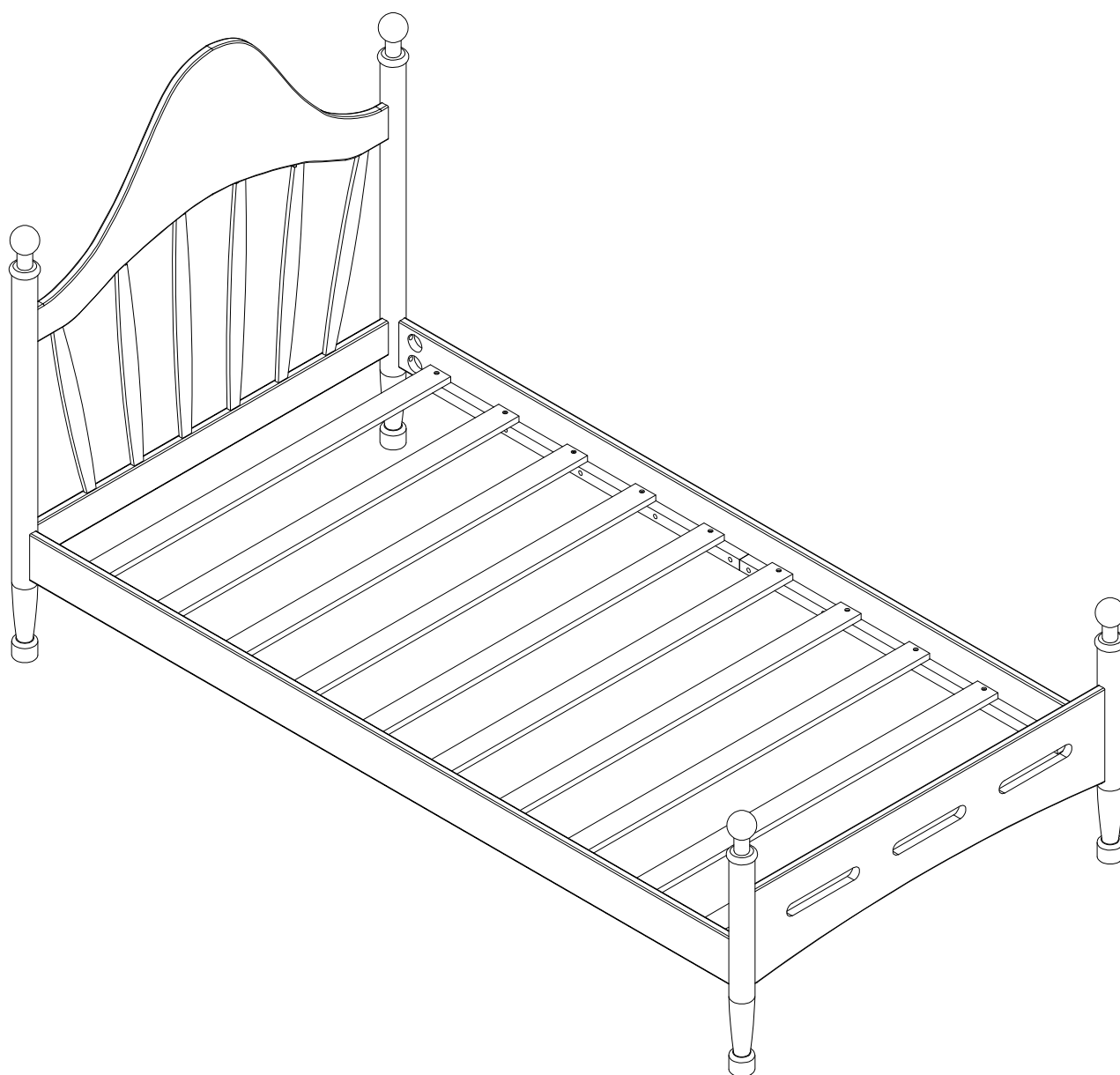


ASSEMBLY INTRUCTIONS



Stated numerically and may additionally be stated in conversion term, for example, 1cm size, twin extra long, and the like. In addition, the thickness or range of thickness of the manufacturer's recommended combined mattress and foundation for the lower bunk shall be stated (see 4.4). The manufacturer's recommended combined maximum thickness of the mattress and foundation for the upper bunk shall be stated (see 7.4.3)

7.5 Replacement Parts--Replacement parts, including additional guardrails, may be obtained

7.6 Safety Warnings--The instructions shall contain the following warning information:

7.6.1 Follow the instructions on the warnings appearing on the upper bunk end structure and on the drawers. Do not remove warning label from the end. 7.6.2 Always use the recommended size mattress on mattress supports, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls. 7.6.3 Surface of guard rails must be at least 5 in. (127 mm) from the edge of the guard. 7.6.4 The end clear distance for beds 4 ft. or less in length, must be: 7.6.5 Prohibitly check end ensure that the guardrail, ladder, and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.

7.6.6 Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.

7.6.7 Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.

7.6.8 Do not use unsuitable parts. Contact the manufacturer dealer for replacement parts.

7.6.9 Use of a night light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.

7.6.10 Always use guardrails on both long sides of the upper bunk. The bunk bed will be placed next to the wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and the wall.

7.6.11 The use of water or sleep flotation mattresses is prohibited.

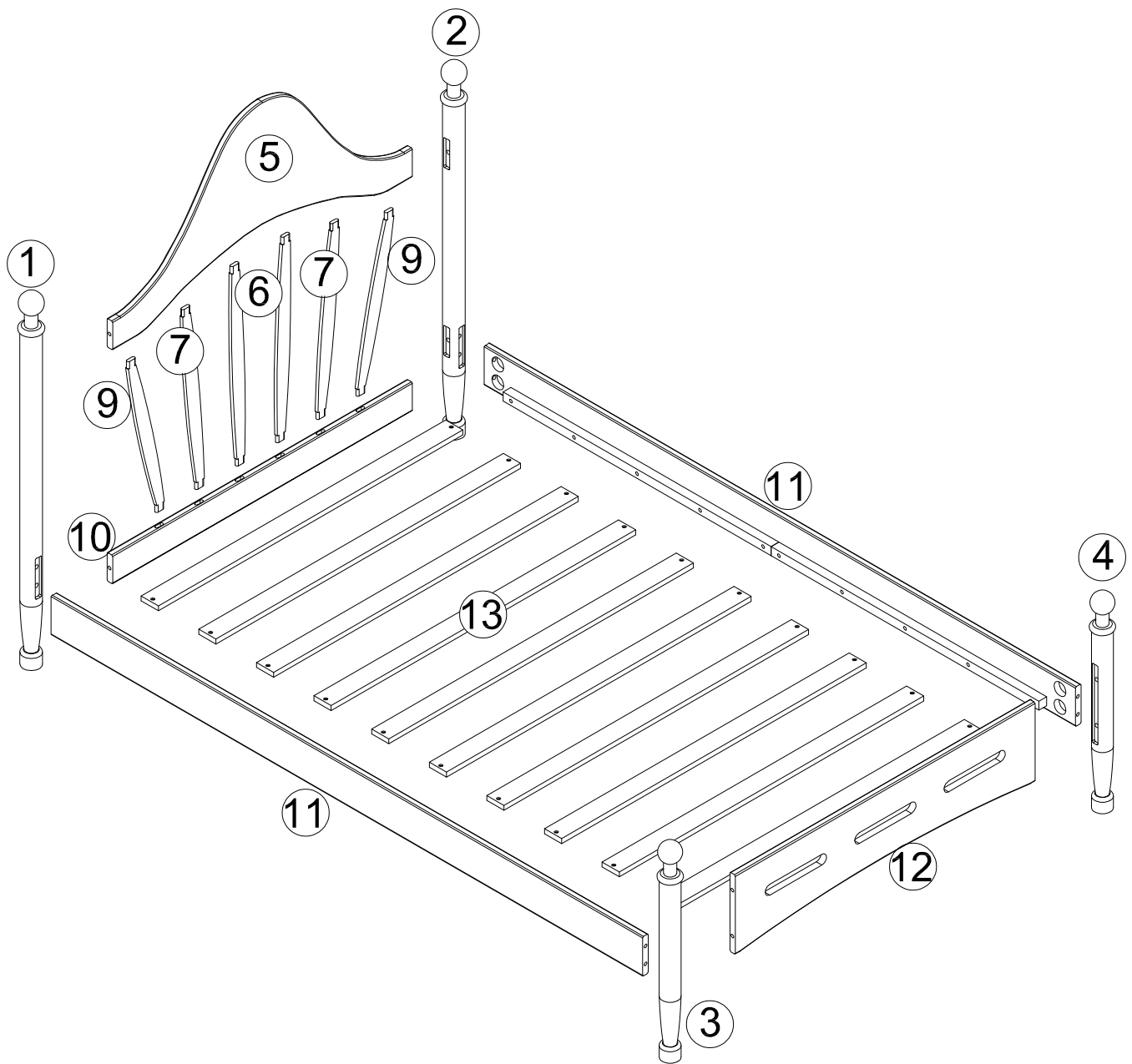
7.6.12 STRANGULATION HAZARD--Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, and jump ropes.
