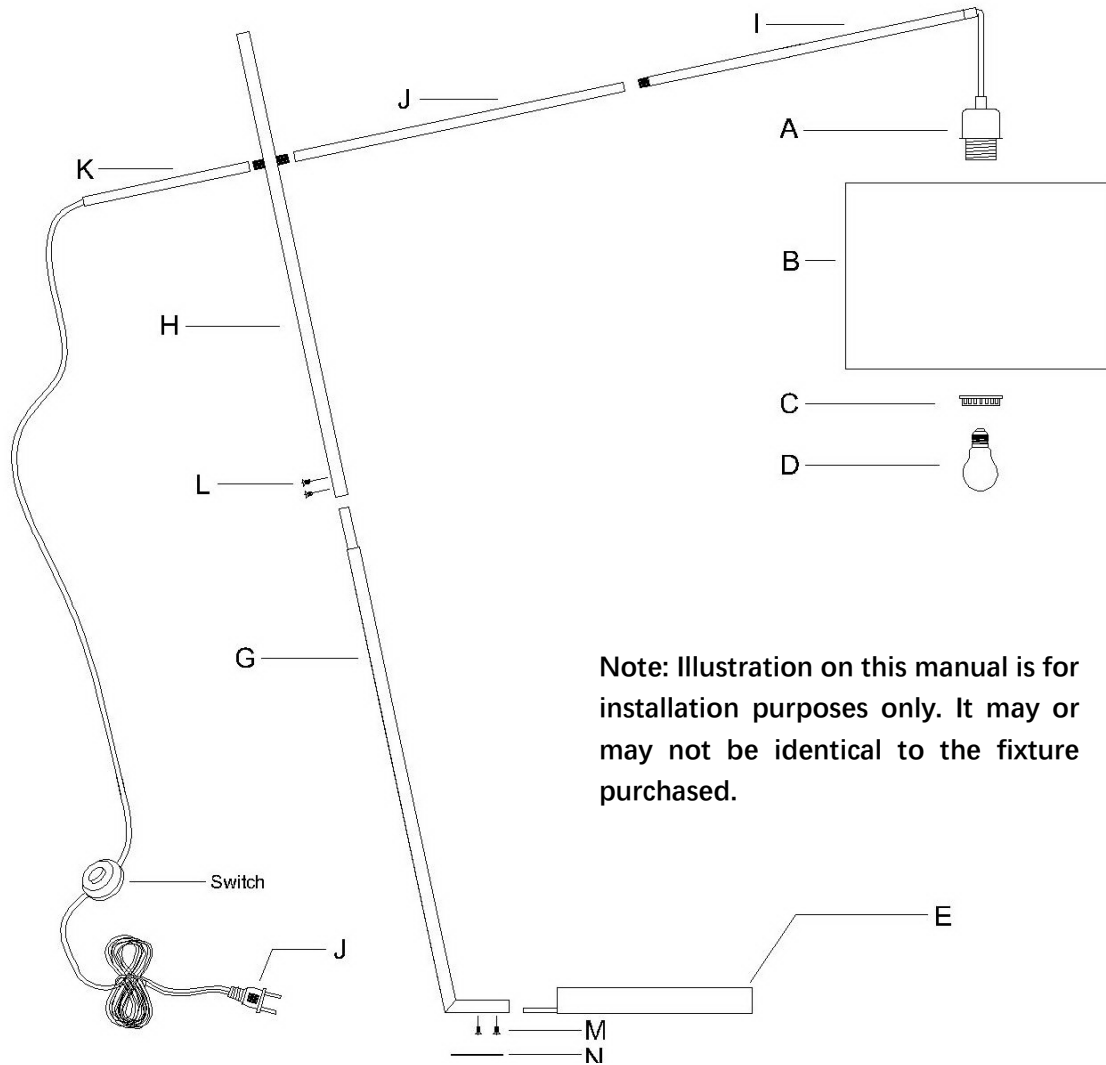


# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

## READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS



Note: Illustration on this manual is for installation purposes only. It may or may not be identical to the fixture purchased.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

This portable lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a safety feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. This plug will fit a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Don't alter the plug.

## WARNING

- Risk of shock, do not plug the unit before assembly.

- Before turning on, please follow the instruction manual step by step.

## INSTALLATION

1. Insert the base (E) into the vertical column (G), secure it using the screws (M) tightly. Paste the felt (N) onto the bottom of the vertical column (G) to protect the floor or rugs. **NOTE: REMOVE THE PAPER BEFORE USING THE FELT!**
2. Insert the vertical column (H) into the vertical column (G), secure it using the screws (L) tightly.
3. Insert the arm (H) into the vertical column (G), secure it using the stem (I) tightly.
4. Screw the stem (I) into the stem (J), and screw them onto the vertical column (H), then screw the stem (K). Make sure all stems are straight and tight.
5. Place the shade (B) onto the socket (A), secure it using the ring (C).
6. Install one Med. base (E26) bulb (D) up to 60W or CFL or LED equivalent (not included) in accordance with the fixture specification. **DO NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM WATTAGE RATING! (NE PAS DÉPASSER LA PUISSANCE NOMINALE MAXIMALE!)**
7. Plug the cord (J) into the outlet. Touch the switch on line. Test the lamp.

## Care & Cleaning Instructions

ALWAYS turn off and/or unplug fixtures prior to cleaning.

**Finishes:** To avoid damage to the finish do not use polish, abrasive cleaners, or harsh chemicals.

**Shade:** Shades can be gently dusted with a dry, clean, soft-bristle brush. Remember to clean the inside of shade as well.

Using any advised against cleaning methods will void the product's warranty.
