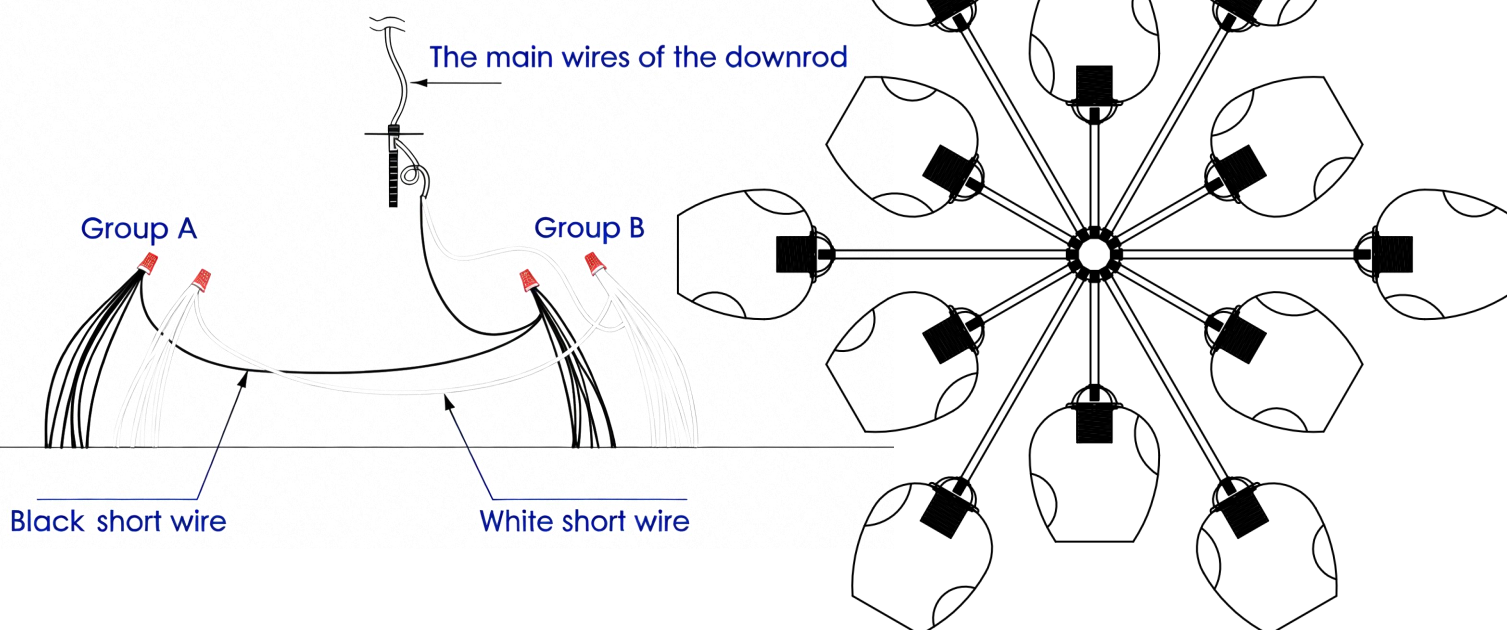
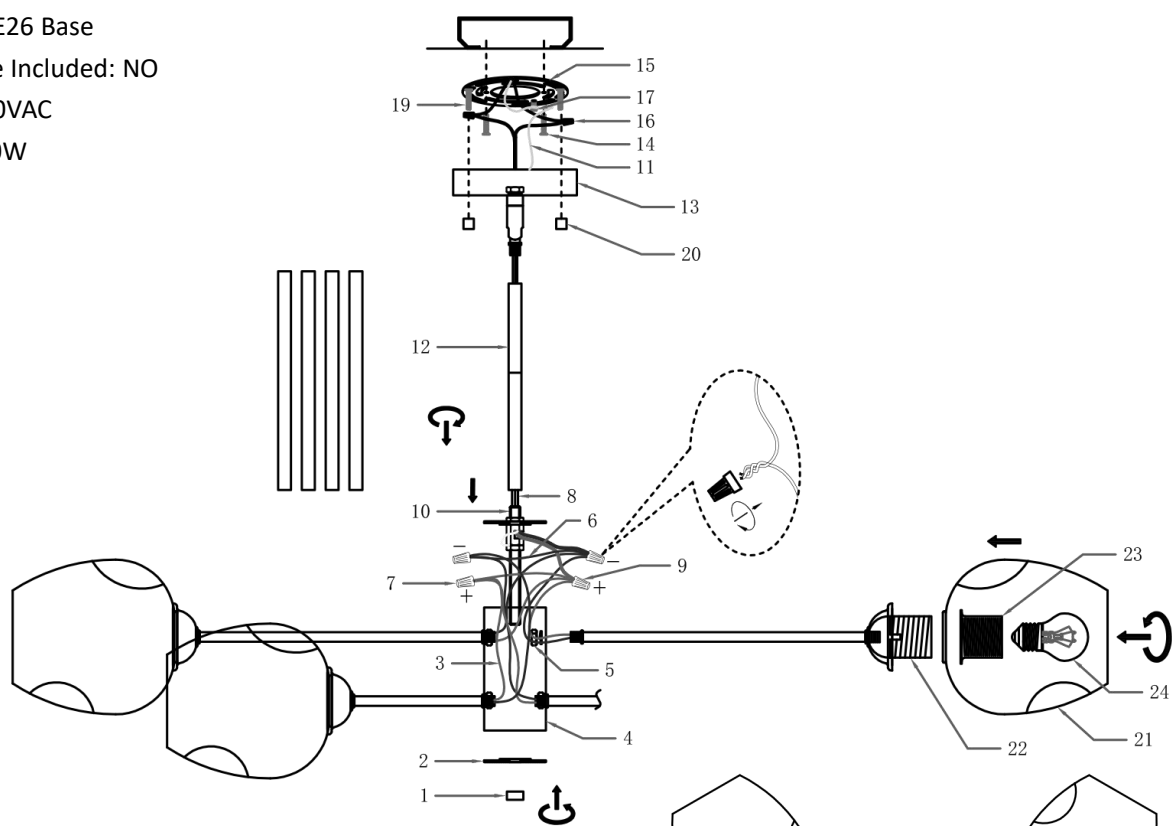

Installation Instructions

A. Loosen the decorative nut (1) and open the cover (2).

B. Get the fixture arm wires (3) through the side hole of the lamp base (4), then tighten the nut (5) to secure the lamp arms.

Equally divide the fixture arm wires (1) into two groups A and B as indicated.

Make wire connection for the group A:

C. Connect the live (black) wire from the fixture arm to the black short lead wire (6) using wire nut (7). Connect the neutral (white) wire from the fixture arm to the white short lead wire (6) using wire nut (7). Ensure all connections are secure and that no bare wires are exposed to prevent electrical hazards.

Wire connection for the group B:

D. Connect the live (black) wire from the fixture arm and the fixture live wire together to the opposite end of the black short lead wire (6) using wire nut (9). Similarly, connect the neutral (white) wire from the fixture arm and the fixture neutral wire to the opposite end of the white short lead wire (6) using wire nut (9). Ensure all connections are fully insulated with no exposed wiring.

E. Pass the bolt (10) through the lamp base (4) and the cover (2), then secure it tightly with the decorative nut (1).

F. Pass the fixture wire (8) through the lamp base (9). Select the appropriate number of down rods (12) and tighten the lower section onto the threaded bolt (10).

G. Thread the fixture wire (8) through the canopy (13), then secure the canopy (13) to the upper section of the down rod (12).

H. Secure the mounting plate (15) onto the junction box using the junction box screws (14).

I. Connect the fixture wires (8) to the corresponding wires reserved in the junction box using wire nuts (16). Insulate all connections with electrical tape and neatly tuck the wires into the junction box. Secure the ground wire (11) from both the fixture and junction box to the mounting plate (15) using the green screw (17) to ensure proper grounding.

J. Insert the mounting plate screw (19) through the two small holes on the canopy (13), then tighten the decorative nut (20) to secure the fixture in place.

K. Slide the lampshade (21) over the lamp base (22), then secure the lampshade (21) using the socket sleeve (23).

L. Attach the light bulbs (24)(not included) to the lamp base (22) as indicated.
