



PEDESTAL & POST TABLES

About Materials

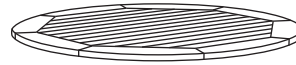
Powder coated aluminum takes metal to a new level of durability, as it is both scratch and rust resistant. Tekwood is a wood-alternative developed from polystyrene. Tekwood provides the look of wood without the weathering process or maintenance. Teak is a tropical hardwood, resistant to rotting, bug infestation, and the effects of wind, rain, sun, and snow. If left untreated Teak weathers naturally to a beautiful silver gray color. Some surface roughness may develop, especially at the end grain, but over a period of about one year, the natural weathering process will stabilize. Small surface cracks that may appear in no way affect the structural integrity of the furniture. Alstone combines a strong aluminum core with a granite polymer finish, creating the look of granite with the weight of aluminum.

Care Instruction

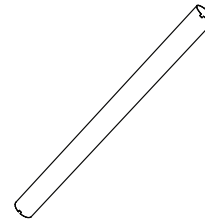
Aluminum and Tekwood require little maintenance, however a regular cleaning is recommended to keep furniture looking new. Wash gently with a mild cleanser, rinse well and let dry. Teak weathers well however, we recommend a routine application of Australian Timber Oil in extremely dry climates. A routine oiling is also recommended for furniture to be used for dining purposes to discourage staining from food and drink spills. For seasonal cleaning rinse the Teak well and then scrub (using a sponge or soft bristle brush) with a mild solution of water, laundry detergent and a little bleach. Rinse with fresh water. Alstone requires little maintenance and will withstand the elements as a durable, weather-resistant material. Wash gently with a mild cleanser, rinse well and let dry.

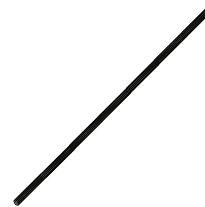

Warranty

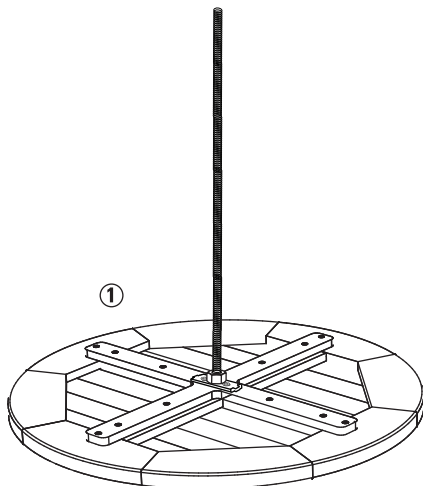
Step 1

Thread one of the hex nut **A** onto one end of rod **3** about one inch.



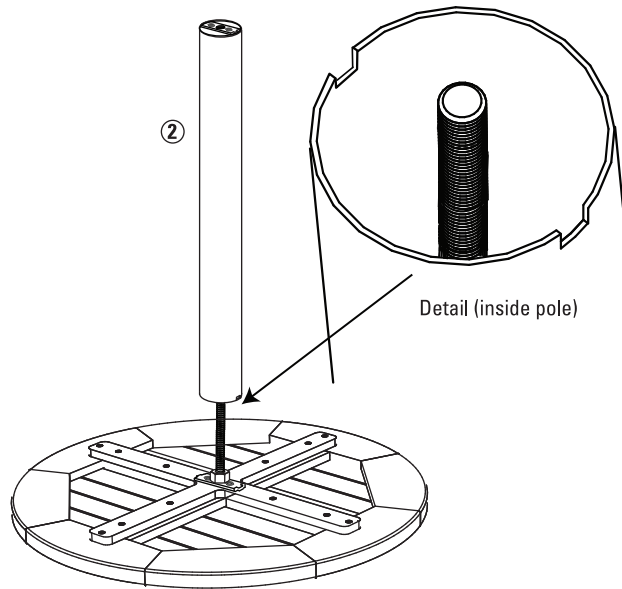
Step 2

Thread rod into table top **1** snugly until you feel it hit the table top. **NOTE: Do not over tighten in this step.** Once you feel the rod is snug, reverse the rod about one half a turn. Tighten hex nut securely with wrench.



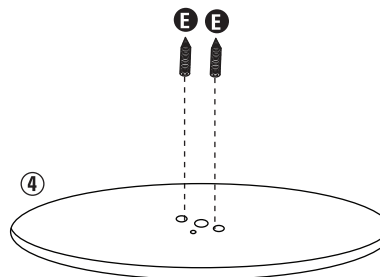
Step 3

Slide pedestal post **2** over the rod and align notches with small plate on bottom of table as shown.



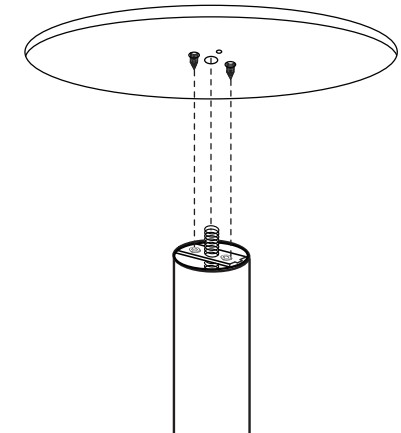
Step 4

Next, thread the studs **E** into the base **4** with the flat head facing down and pointed head facing up. **NOTE:** Thread the stud only until it is flush with the bottom of the base.



Step 5

Next, carefully place the pedestal base over the post making sure to line up the studs with the holes in the plate as shown.



Step 6

Insert flat washer **C**, lock washer **D** and locking hex nut **B** over the rod and secure tightly using wrench.
