

#### **BEFORE YOU BEGIN ASSEMBLY:**


Read your instruction manual fully. Check all parts and hardware. If anything is missing or not satisfactory, please DO NOT call the store or return the product to them. Please email to <a href="mailto:customerservice@cedargreen.net">customerservice@cedargreen.net</a> for assistance. Most problems are resolved promptly without you needing to leave home.

## **Installation Steps**

- Using a level draw a horizontal line across back of closet, 74" above floor.
- Locate studs by using a stud finder, lightly mark wall 1/4" below horizontal line to reference stud locations.
- Mark vertical panel locations: using left wall as starting point; mark X at 25" for left
   Tower Panel (2); mark X at 44" for right Tower Panel (2); mark X at right end for right Wall Panel (1).


#### Hint:

- 74" above floor is just a recommendation, horizontal line could be set higher (e.g. 78") if more hanging space is desired.
- Closet has to be at least 78" wide in order to fit all three sections of the system. Less than three sections can be installed for smaller closet.




- Mount WALL RAIL (G) from left to right on top of the Horizontal Line. To secure the
  wall rail onto the wall Use Panhead Screws (E) on stud reference marks. Mark
  the screw locations then drill pilot holes using a 1/8" drill bit.
- If any of the **Panels** are not within 3" of a stud, **Dry Wall Anchor (C)** are needed.
- Mount Wall Rail (H) from right end to left. Using Panhead Phillips Screw (E) and
   Dry Wall Anchor (C).
- Cover long Wall Rail 44" (G) with Wall Rail Covering Strip (I). Snap fit the cover from top to bottom. Narrow side fits the top and the bottom will snap in.
- Measure and cut Wall Rail Covering Strip (J) to fit remaining area of wall rails and the gap between two wall rails.

- Wall rails must be mounted on studs behind wall. This is very important.




- Attach the Left Panel Hangers (O) onto the left Wall Panel (1) and left Tower panel (2) by using Flathead Phillips Screws (F), put the Left Panel Hanger (O) at the ½ circle Indent at the top of the Panel, locate the Two pre-drilled Holes just below the Indent. The bottom screw Holes of the Left Panel Hanger (O) should match the pre-drilled ones.
- Repeat the steps to attach the two Right Panel Hangers (P) onto the right Tower
   Panel (2) and the right Wall Panel (1).
- Add Panel Bracket (M) onto the bottom of the Wall Panels and Tower Panels (1 & 2) using Flathead Phillips Screws (F).
- Hang left Wall Panel (1) onto Wall Rail (G).
- Hang left Tower Panel (2) onto Wall Rail (G) at marked X location.
- Hang right Tower Panel (2) onto Wall Rail (G) at marked X location.
- Hang right Wall Panel (1) onto right end of Wall Rail (H).

- You can level the Wall and Tower Panels(1 & 2) using the vertical and depth adjustment screws on the Panel Hangers (0 & P).




- Insert **Rafix Connector (Q)** into shelf holes with the openings facing outward. Do this for all shelves (3), (4) and (6).
- Mount Rafix Connector Bolt (A) on the first holes from top of left Wall Panel (1)
  and left Tower Panel (2) using Phillips or Power screwdriver. Top holes are used for
  flat top shelving.
- Place one 24" Shelf (3) onto the Rafix Connector Bolts. Lock the Rafix Connector
   Bolt (A) with Rafix Connectors (Q) by inserting the screwdriver into the Rafix connector Hole and turning Clockwise.
- Repeat the steps for all shelves with Rafix Connectors:
  - Mount the 2nd 24" shelf (3) 6 holes from bottom up on left Wall Panel (1);
  - Mount the Top **18**" **Shelf with Rafix Connector (4)** on the first holes from top between both **Tower Panels (2)**;
  - Mount 2nd 18" Shelf with Rafix Connector (4) at the same level of 2nd 24" shelf (3);
  - Mount the 3rd 18" Shelf with Rafix Connector (4) 2 holes from bottom up;
  - Mount the **Adjustable Shelf (6)** between right **Tower Panel (2)** and right **Wall Panel (1)**, pull or push to adjust the shelf width to the desired Length.

- Rafix Connector Bolt (A) can be mounted in different holes depending on customer's desired shelf locations.




- Mount Wardrobe Tube Support (B) in left wardrobe section, 2 holes down from both 24" shelf (3), with Flathead Phillips Screw (D). Do same for both end pieces.
- Set both Wardrobe Tube 24" (K) in 24" shelving sections.
- Mount Wardrobe Tube Support (B) in right wardrobe section 2 holes down from
   Adjustable Shelf (6).
- Measure distance between two ends of Wardrobe Tube Support (B), mark
   Wardrobe Tube 51" (L) and cut with Hacksaw or a Tube Cutter.
- Set Wardrobe Tube (L) in adjustable shelf section.
- With Shelf Support (N) add three 18" Tower Shelf (5) to desired locations in the middle/tower section.
- Position all Wall and Tower Panels (1 & 2), mount Panel Bracket (M) onto back wall using Panhead Phillips Screw (E) and Dry Wall Anchor (C) if necessary.

- Suggested Shelf and Wardrobe Tube locations can be changed
- Customize you closet to meet your need.



Now your beautiful new cedar closet is finished, enjoy the aromatic scent.
