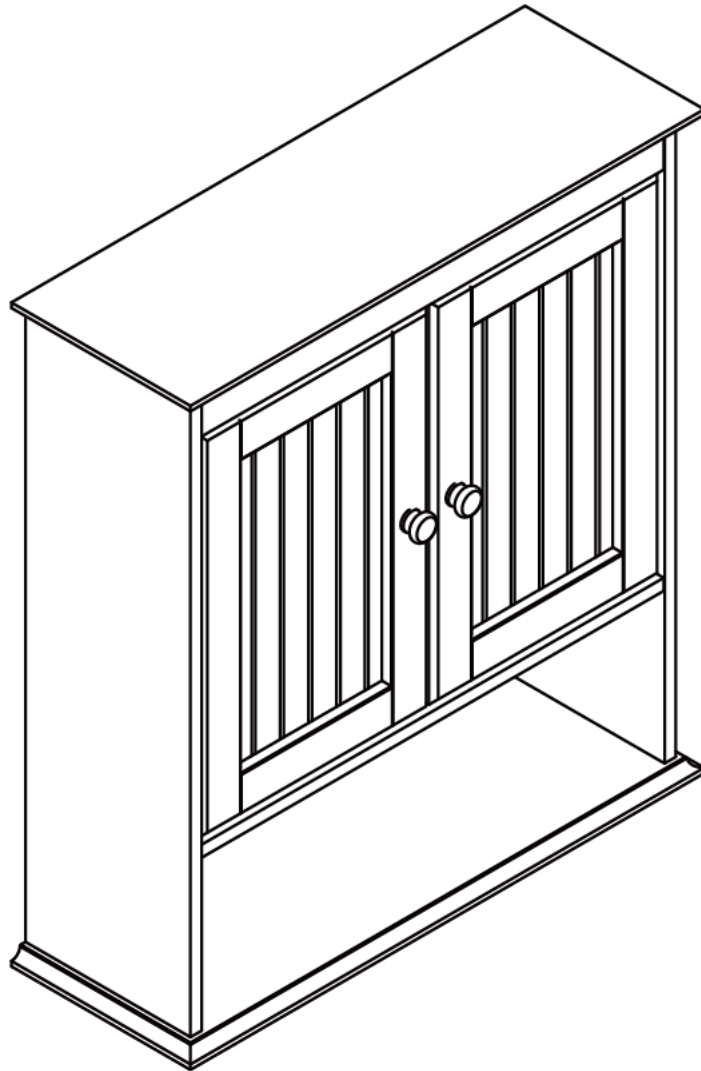

- Please read instructions completely before assembling. Assemble on a soft, smooth area. Adult assembly required.
- Important: when drilling into walls always check that there are no hidden wires or pipes etc.
- Make sure that the screw and wall plugs used are suitable for supporting your unit. Consult a qualified professional if you are unsure.
- Failure of the product due to the use of incorrect fixing is the responsibility of the installer.
- Always use tip over restraints and/or wall anchors to secure furniture to the wall.
- Place heaviest items in the lowest drawers/bins or shelves.
- Do not set TV's or other heavy objects on the top of this product.
- Never allow children to climb or hang on to the drawers/bins, doors or shelves of furniture.
- Never open more than one drawer at a time or defeat or remove any drawer interlock system.

This unit has been designed to support the maximum loads shown.

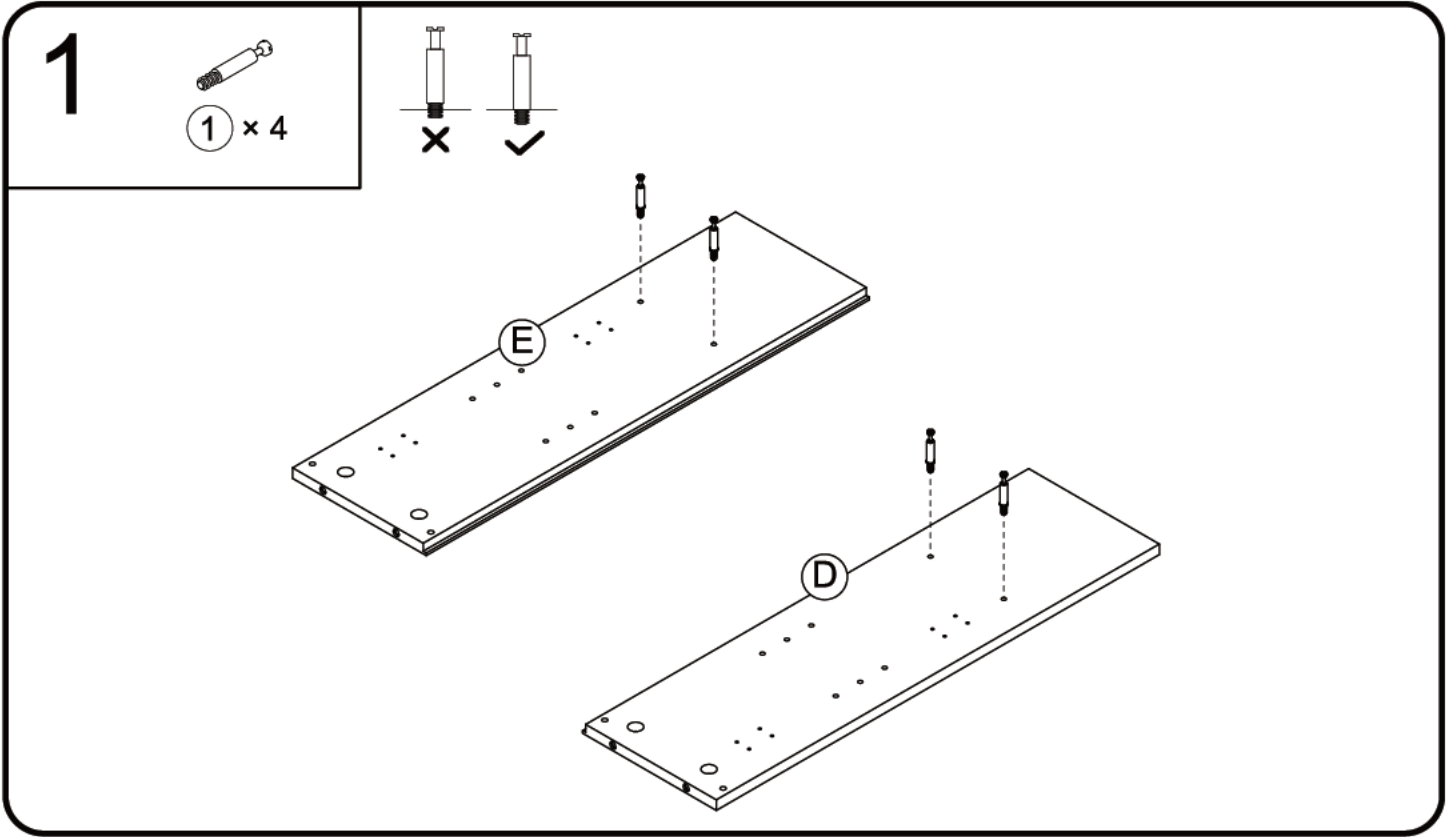
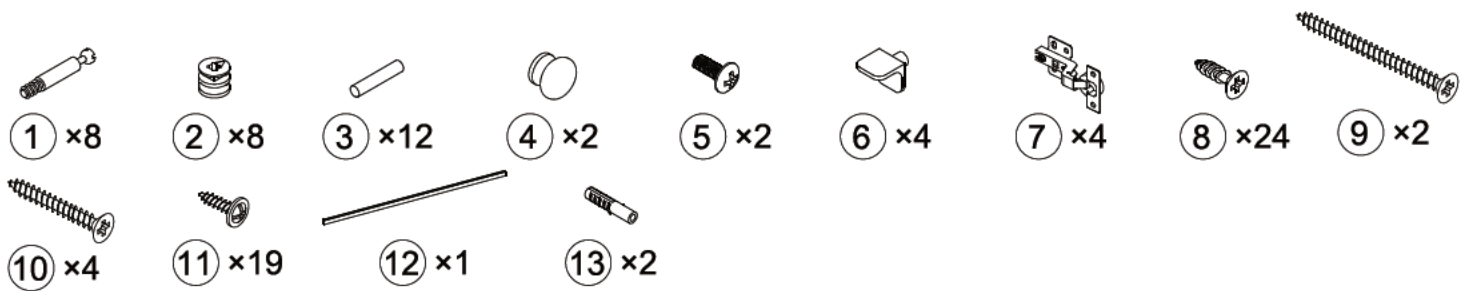
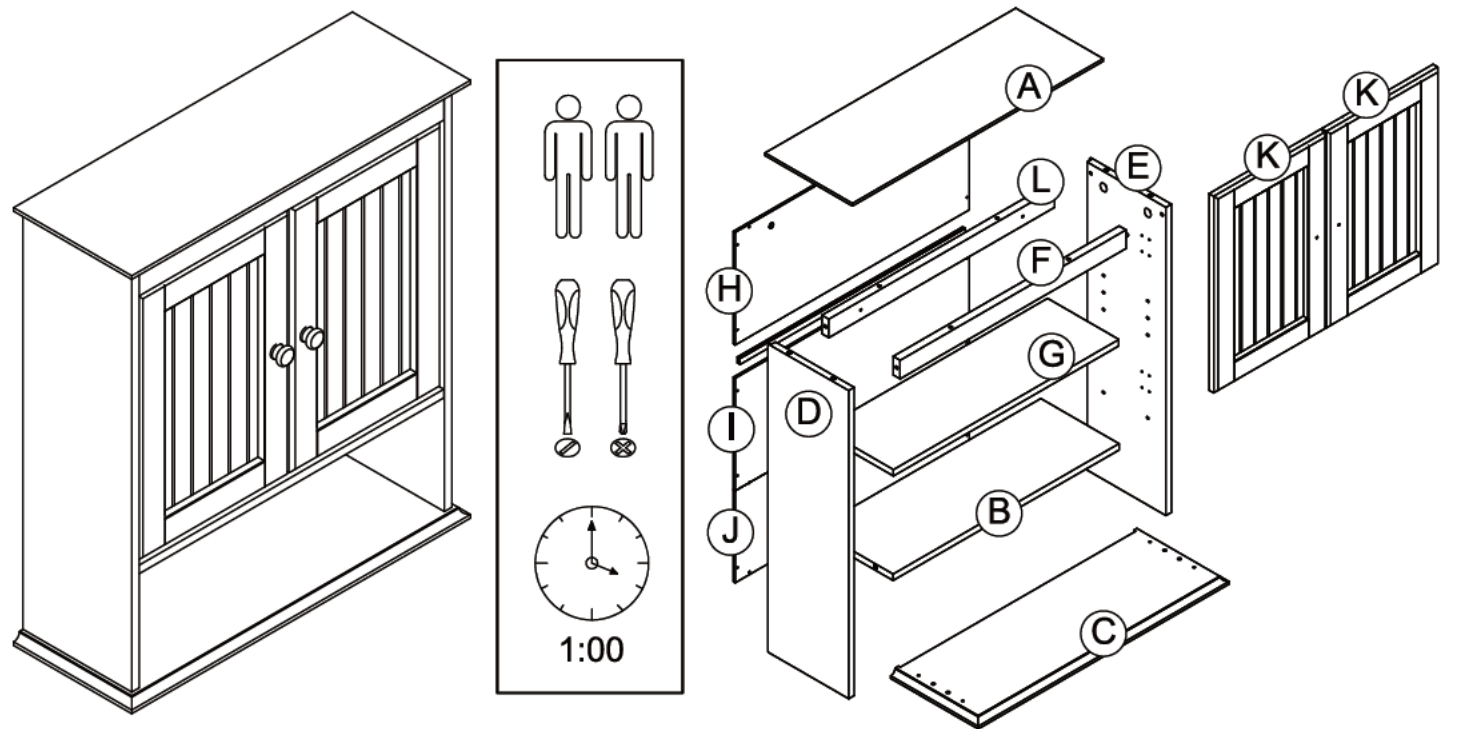

1. Place the drawing with hole position on the wall that you desire to hang the cabinet.
2. Drill 2 holes through the hole position on the drawing.
3. Insert 2 Plastic anchors ⑬ into the holes.
4. Attach the cabinet in place w/holes, then insert 2 Screws ⑨ through the holes on the back of cabinet then tighten cabinet to the wall.
