




Adjustable Metal Curtain Pole Fixing Instructions

	End Finial	Bracket	ROD
			 Φ19mm(or 25mm) Φ16mm(or 22mm)
28-48"	X 2	X 2	Φ19mm(25mm)*1 Φ16mm(22mm)*1
36-72" 48-84"	X 2	X 3	Φ19mm(25mm)*1or*2 Φ16mm(22mm)*1
66-120"	X 2	X 3	Φ19mm(25mm)*2 Φ16mm(22mm)*1

- 1** Unpack your curtain pole package carefully and lay out the contents consisting of:
Curtain Pole and 2 End Finials
2 or 3 Brackets (according to pole size)
Fixing Screws, Wall Plugs & Grub Screws
- 2** Mark fixing positions for brackets ensuring that they are level (see Fig 1).
- 3** Fix brackets to wall (see Fig 2) ensuring that they are spaced evenly.
- 4** Adjust pole to size by simply sliding the outer and inner pole to the desired length, allowing for finials to be fitted at each end.
The centre support should be positioned in the centre of the outer brackets.(only for36-72"& 48-84" & 66-120")
- 5** Slide the curtains/eyelet rings onto the pole and then push on the finials and tighten the grub screw to hold the finial in place (see Fig 3).
- 6** Ensure that at least one eyelet ring is positioned on the outside of the brackets (between the bracket and finial at each end). Position the pole centrally into the brackets and then tighten up the tightening screw on the back of the brackets (see Fig 2) to fasten the pole securely in the brackets .
- 7** Where centre bracket is provided, please ensure that the ring nearest the centre of each curtain is placed at least 5cm in from that edge (see Fig 5) to allow the curtains to overlap.
- 8** The pole is now ready for curtains to be hung.

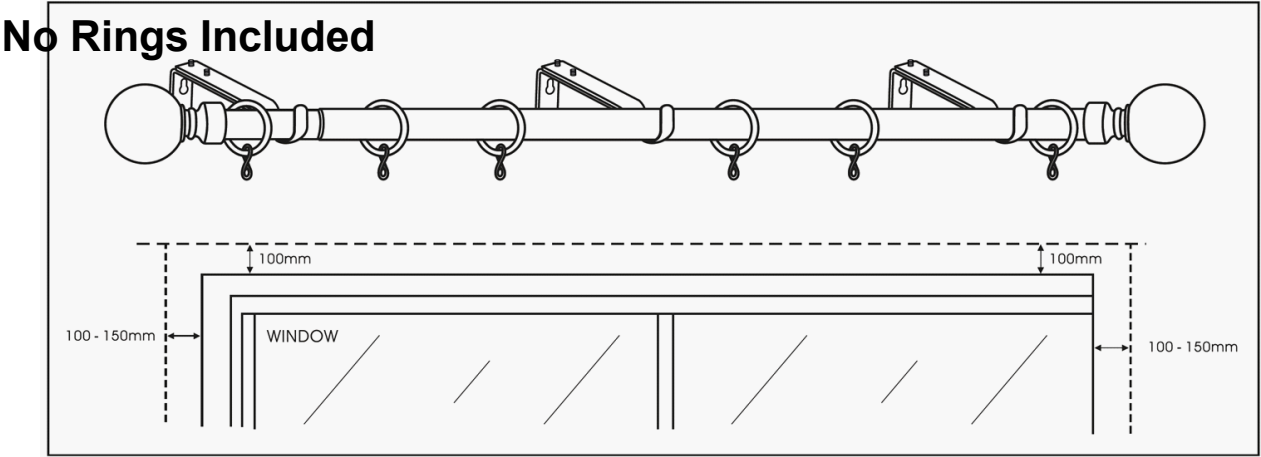

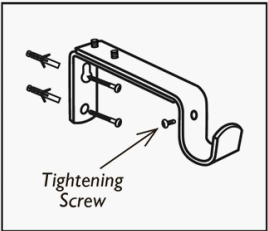

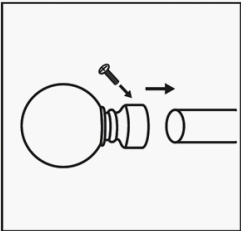

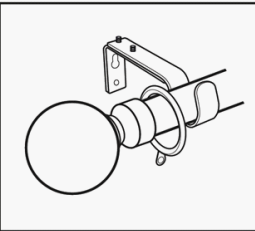

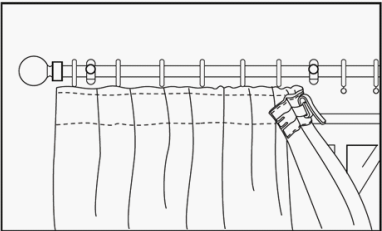
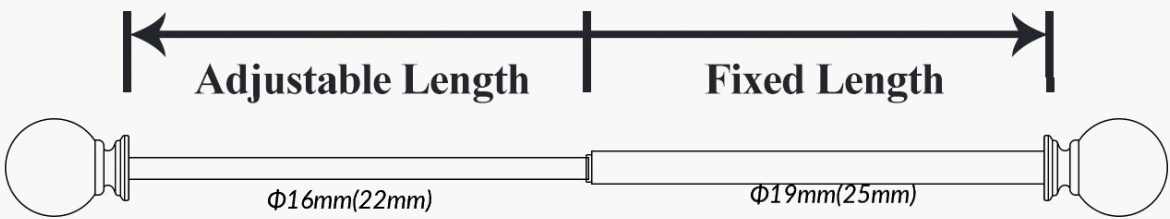
