

Oak Mailbox System *Installation Instructions*

ADDRESSES OF DISTINCTION
MAILBOXES + STREET SIGNS. INSTALLED.

Tools Required: phillips head screw driver, 7/16" wrench or pliers, and allen key.

STEP 1

Place (2) **Bolts** through the top of the **Number Plate**. Slide the (2) **Washers** onto the bolts (rubber side against mailbox). Place the bolts through the pre-drilled holes on top of the **Mailbox**. Open the mailbox and tighten the (2) **Wing Nuts** onto the bolts. See *Illustration A1*

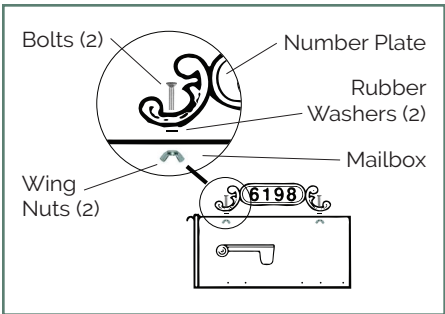
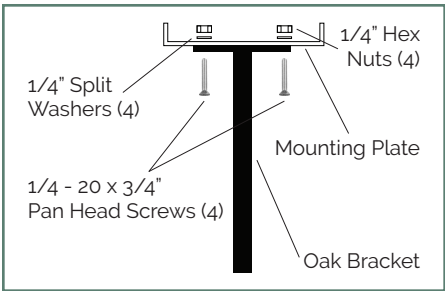

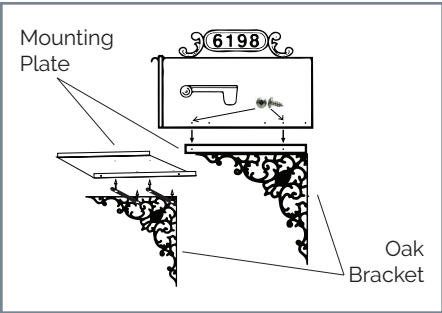
STEP 2 (Fig 1)

Position the Mounting Plate on top of the Oak Bracket. Insert (4) **1/4 - 20 x 3/4" Pan Head Screws** through the bottom of the bracket and into the mounting plate. Secure with (4) **1/4" Split Washers** and (4) **1/4 - 20 Hex Nuts**. See *Illustration A2*

STEP 3 (Fig 2)

Attach the decorative bracket and mounting plate assembly from Step 2 to the **2" Post** with (2) **1/4 - 20 x 2 1/2" Hex Head Bolts**. Attach the mailbox to the mounting plate by inserting the (4) **Type A Screws** into the corresponding pre-drilled holes on the sides of mailbox and mounting plate.

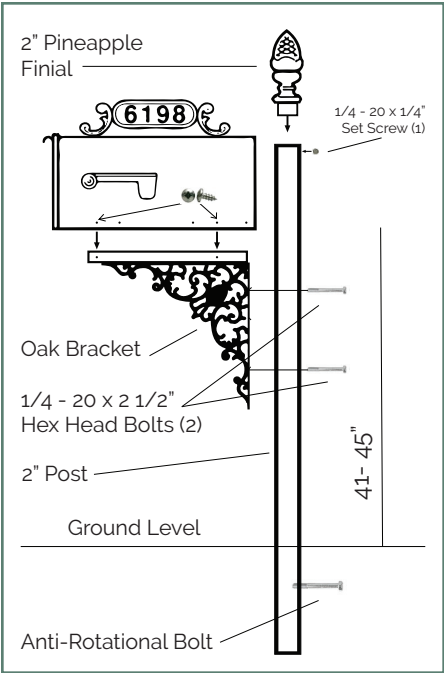

STEP 4 (Fig 2)

Finish the look of your mailbox system by inserting the **2" Pineapple Finial** on top of the post and securing it with (1) **1/4 - 20 x 1/4" Set Screw**. Place (1) **Anti-Rotational Bolt** near the bottom of pole. Your mailbox is ready to be installed into the ground.

What if my mailbox is damaged at some future point?

All of our mailboxes are bolted together so parts can be easily replaced. Simply call the number on the inside of the door and our team will be happy to help you bring your mailbox back to life.

Do you install with concrete?

All mailboxes installed by Addresses of Distinction are installed using concrete. We warranty all installations for a period of one year. When your mailbox is installed, please wait 24 hours before applying pressure to the post, as it takes some time for the concrete to fully cure.
