

INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Maintenance instruction:

Doors:

- 1.Clean with pure cotton cloth, and use a brush to clean the curve seam. The plywood board should be cleaned with furniture wax.
- 2. Open the door and drawer of the bathroom cabinet with proper force. Do not open and close rapidly.

Main Cabinet:

- 1. Keep the cabinet door open for 15 to 20 days before use and ventilate properly to remove residual odor.
- 2.Do not use sharp objects to scrape and knock the surface of the cabinet. Avoid long-term direct sunshine to the bathroom cabinet to avoid partial color difference.
- 3. Avoid direct water sprinkling on cabinet body. Keep dry, resonable dry and wet partition to avoid paint surface damage and cabinet body expansion.

Vanity Top:

- 1. The stone top does not absorb water, dirt, and has not radiated. It will be bright and clean with just a little cleaning.
- 2.Ceramic top is usually cleaned and maintained with neutral detergent or toothpaste. The 2000# water sandpaper can be softened in the water and water mill partially if scratches or fouling occur. After finishing, drying the surface with a dry cloth, coating it with wax, and polishing it with silk fabrics, the surface will be bright as clean.
- 3.Ceramic basins can be cleaned with water and detergent, such as detergent, soap water, and so on. Ceramic basin surface should always be kept clean Dust and gravel should be removed in time to prevent abrasion. When there are slight scratches on the surface of the ceramic basin, a little toothpaste can be applied to the scratches. The scratches can be wiped repeatedly with a soft dry cloth, and then waxed to make the surface as bright as new.

Inlet & Drainage:

- 1 . Keep the sewer unobstructed and prevent blockage. Call a professional plumbing company to clear.
- 2. The joint-line of the basin and vanity top should be kept dry Wipe with a cloth if there is a water stain.
- 3. Pay attention to the expiration date of hoses, sealing materials, and other materials, and replace them in time.
- 4 . Check frequently whether there is leakage in the taps and basins. When running, leaking, dripping and leaking occur, it should be repaired and handled in time.


Hardware:

- 1.Avoid direct spraying of strong acid and alkaline solution on hardware. Wipe it immediately when it happens.
- 2. Keep the hinge opening and closing freely and clean. Keep the sliding rails of drawer freely and clean.


Attention:


- 1. Check the surface of the products and the accessories before installation. This product should be installed by professionals to prevent brutal construction.
- 2. Confirm whether the inlet and drainage outlet is appropriate and interference.
- 3. Keep the air circulation in bathroom, try to keep the space dry and wet separately and avoid water sprinkling. If there are water droplets, wipe them with cloth in time.
- 4. Prevent screwdrivers and other metal objects from scratching the surface of the plate when installing.
- 5.Use neutral detergent and dry them with soft cotton cloth when cleaning the cabinet.
- 6. The wall of bathroom cabinet must be load-bearing wall.







How to install cabinets' handles



Open the cabinet door, release the handle and re-install the handle in front of the door. The handle screw should be replaced with the handle screw in the accessory bag (As above shown)





Release the accessory bag that is tied to the back top panel of the cabinet, take out the handles and handles screws, direct the handle screws to the handle screws hole in the door, install and then tighten with a screwdriver as shown above





Release the fitting belt tied to the back of the cabinet, take out the handles and handles screws, and install the handles according to the drawing with a manual electric drill.









adjustable wrench




1.Remove the T-valve,lock nut and washer from the spout body.Place spout in center hole of sink.Assembly washer and tighten the lock nut to it. Connect the T-valve to the spout body by wrench.




2.Remove mounting hardware from handle body.Connect water supply tube to valve body and tighten with lock nut. Do not let the water supply brass tube twist.Use two wrenches,as shown in the diagram,tighten the flexible hose.




3.Place the spout in center hole of sink and handle body through right hole. (Left is red,right is blue). Assemble the rubber washer, washer and tighten with lock nut.



4. Connect handle body and faucet body with flexible hoses tightenly.





5.Screw and tighten the flexible hose to the faucet.Left is red,right is blue.Do not let the water supply brass tube twist.



6.Attach flexible hose to water supply.




Use a screwdriver to loosen the accessories at the bottom of the adjustable board as shown in the figure.











How to install wall-hung basins




Note: These fixings are suitable for solid walls only. Plasterboard or stud walls may require specialist fixings(not supplied). Caution. Care should be taken when drilling walls and floors to avoid and sunken wires or pipes.




1. According to the number of wall hanging holes on the back of the basin, drill two holes in the desired location in the wall with a 14mm masonry bit to a depth of 75mm.




3. Screw a fixing bolt int each fixing plug using a 8mm spannet until the spanner contacts the wall.




5. Screw a metal nut onto each fixing bolt to securo the basin.Caution do not overtight0n.as this may damage the ceramic.



2. Push a wall plug int each hole.



4. Place the basin in position against the wall, locating the fixing botts through the holes in the rear of the basin. Push a plastic washer, followed by a metal washer, onto each fixing bolt.



6. Finished.
