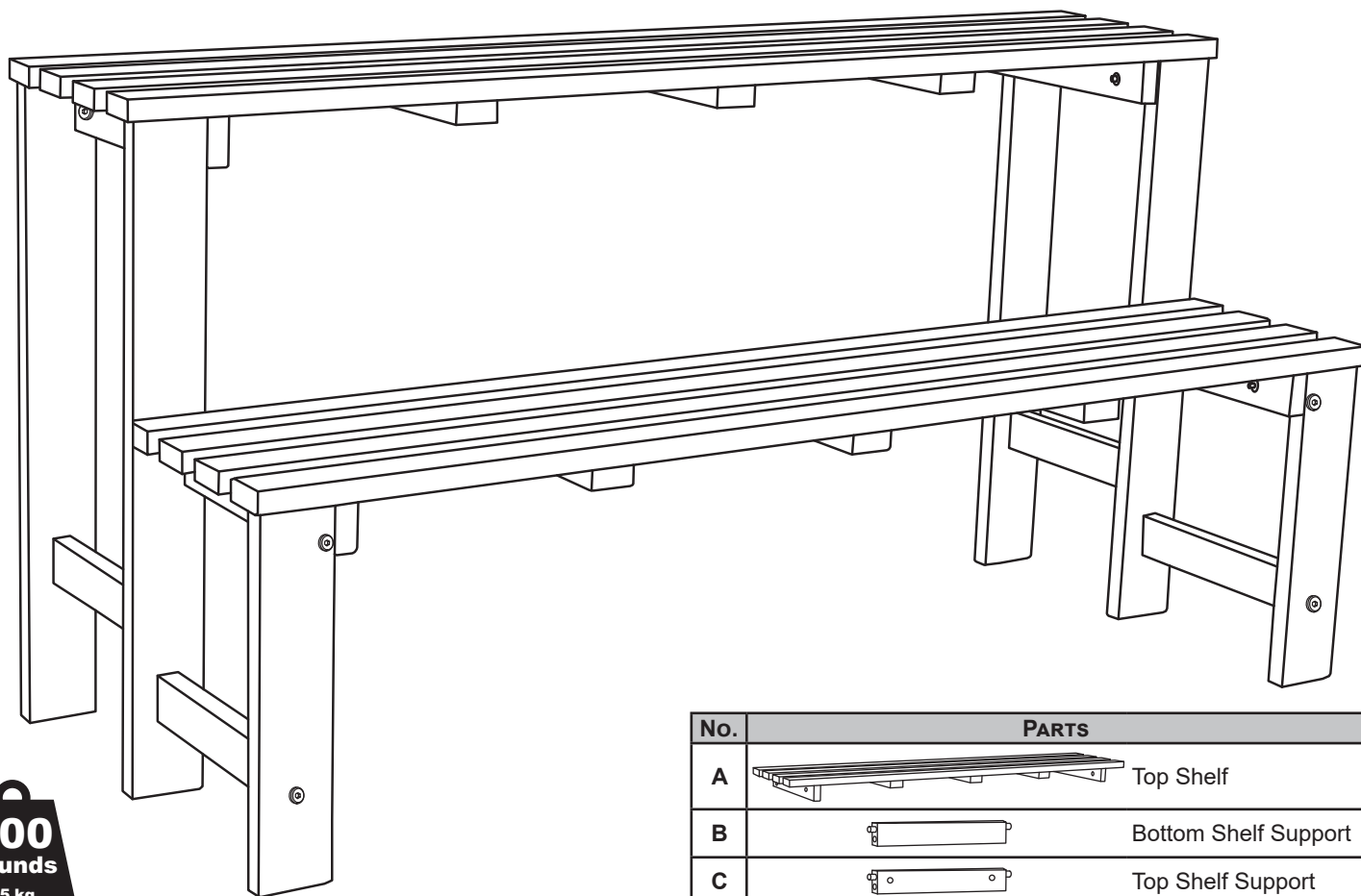


# WOOD PLANT STAND

Assemble components on a soft, clean surface to avoid damaging the finish. Save this manual for future reference.

## HELPFUL HINTS

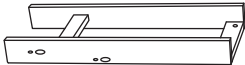
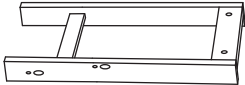
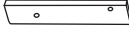
Do not fully tighten hardware until all components are assembled. If hardware is tightened too soon, mounting holes may not align, and parts may not easily fit together.

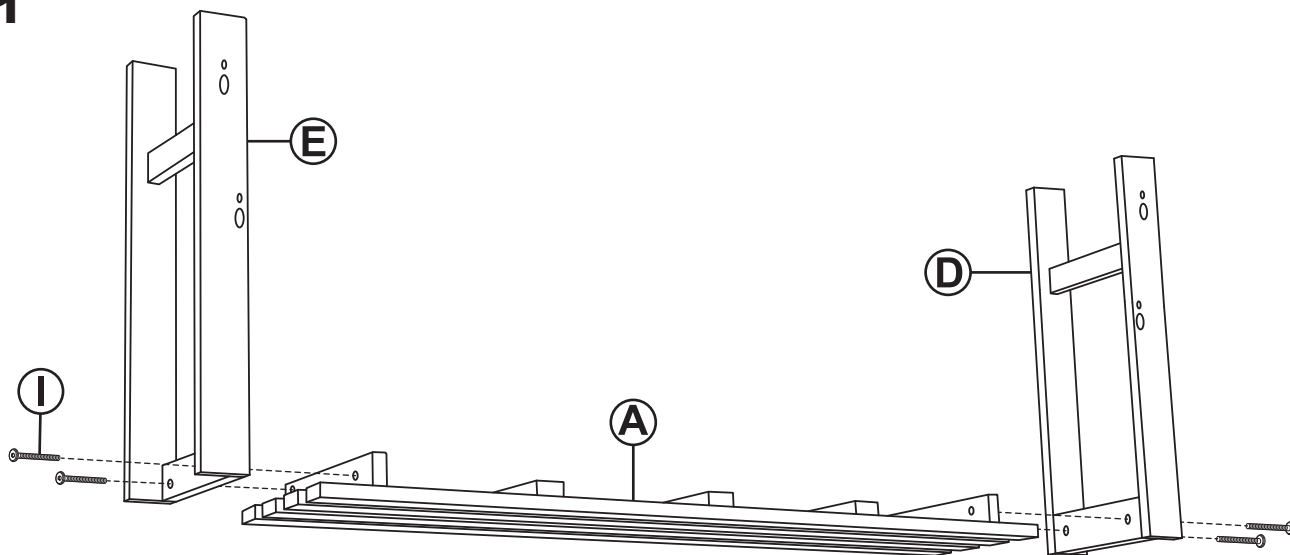
# ASSEMBLY

*Review all steps and understand assembly before beginning.*

***Do not fully tighten hardware until all components have been loosely assembled.***

## STEP 1

A: 1

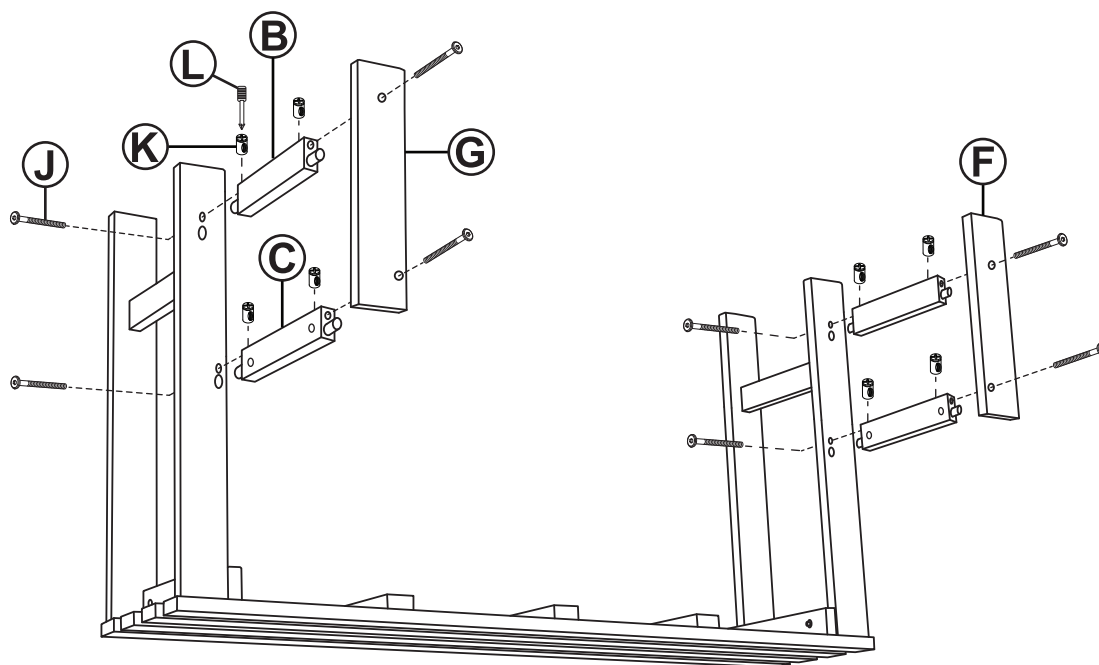


- Place Top Shelf (A) face-down on a soft, clean surface.
- Align Left Side Panel (D) and loosely secure by hand-tightening two M6x45 Bolts (I). Repeat to secure Right Side Panel (E).

**Do not fully tighten any bolts until after Step 3 is complete.**

## STEP 2

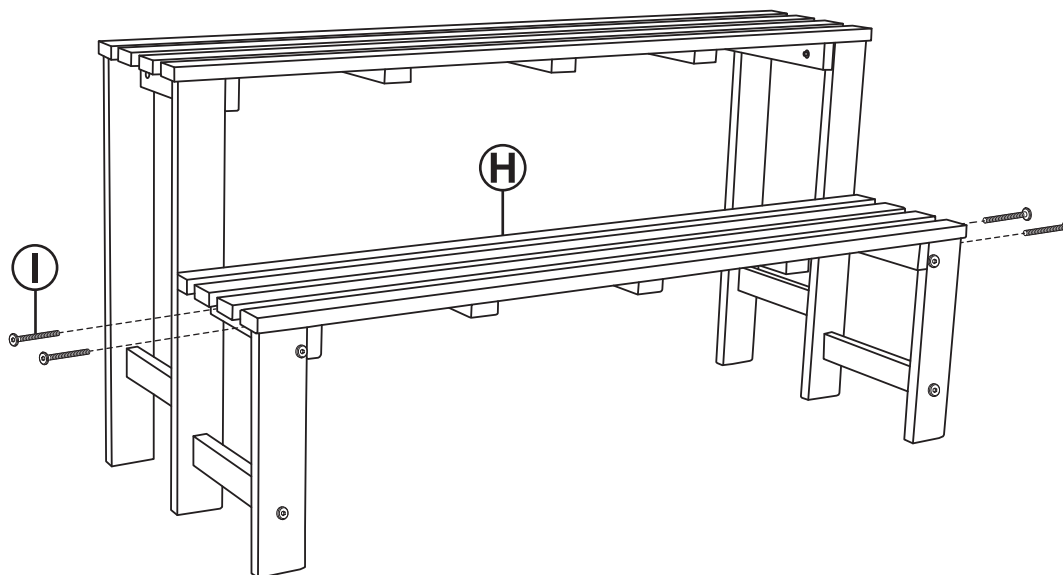
- Insert two Barrel Nuts (K) into each Bottom Shelf Support (B) and Top Shelf Support (C). Use the Barrel Nut Driver to align the opening of the barrel nut with the pre-drilled hole below the peg on the shelf supports.
- Ensuring Top Shelf Support (C) will be on top when the unit is flipped upright, align the pegs and holes of Top Shelf Support (C) and Bottom Shelf Support (B) with Left Side Panel (D) and Left Front Leg (F). Loosely secure by hand-tightening four M6x50 Bolts (J), ensuring the bolts thread into the barrel nuts.
- Repeat the previous step to connect Right Front Leg (G).

**Do not fully tighten any bolts until after Step 3 is complete.**

## STEP 3

- Flip the unit upright.
- Place Bottom Shelf (H) onto the lower level of the stand and secure it using four M6x45 Bolts (I).

**Tighten all bolts using Hex Key (M) after this step is complete.**

## Care & Maintenance

**SAFE USE:** For residential use only. Only use on a flat, level surface. Do not sit, stand or climb on the shelves.

**INSPECT:** Periodically check assembly points and tighten fittings as necessary.

**CLEANING:** Identify the direction of the woodgrain. Following the direction of the woodgrain, wipe surfaces with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials or a pressure washer to clean.

**COVER:** When not in use, cover unit with a breathable cover to help protect it from the harmful effects of sunlight, inclement weather, dust build-up, and collecting debris.

**WINTER CARE & STORAGE:** Protect this item from inclement weather, especially ice and snow. Move to a cool, dry indoor location. Covering while in storage is recommended to help prevent dust build-up.

**MAINTENANCE:** If left untreated, the wood may weather. A suitable wood stain or oil may need to be applied yearly.
