

WARNING \Lambda CAUTION

ADULT ASSEMBLY REQUIRED CHOKING HAZARD

• This product includes small parts, sharp points and sharp edges in its unassembled state. Keep unassembled parts away from children under 3 years of age, and animals.

STRANGULATION HAZARD

• Never attach or hang items to any part of the Wall Entertainment Center that is not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to hooks, belts, and jump ropes.

SAFETY WARNINGS

- Follow the information on the warnings appearing on the Wall Entertainment Center end structure and on the carton.
- Do not allow children under 3 years of age to use the Wall Entertainment Center.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.

FURNITURE TIP-OVER HAZARD

damage. Children should not be permitted to climb or pull on the Wall Entertainment Center. USE, MAINTENANCE & ASSEMBLY


- Periodically check and ensure that the components are in their proper position, free from
- damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- Use on level surfaces only. Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damage to unit or floor.
- Do not use this item if any components are missing or damaged.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
- Only clean using damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- Check you have all components and tools listed on page 4
- Do not stand or put weight on this product during assembly, this could cause damage.
- Remove all hardware from the plastic bags and separate them into groups.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Certain assembly steps may be easier with 2 people.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.
- We do not recommend power screwdrivers. Only use hand screwdrivers to prevent damage to unit.

If neither model fits your TV properly, purchase the compatible screw from any hardware store. To prevent damage to your TV, do not over tighten the screws.


Always take out the TV from the panel in the following situations:

- You are passing new cables.




If the power plug is behind the panel, be sure that the cables are not forcing the panel forward.
