

Oak Mailbox System

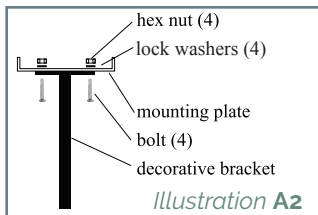
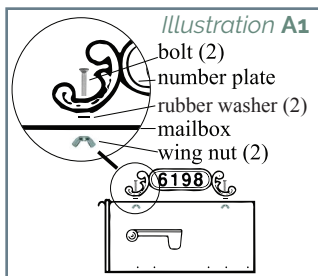
ADDRESSES OF DISTINCTION

MAILBOXES + STREET SIGNS. INSTALLED.

STEP 1 (Fig 1)

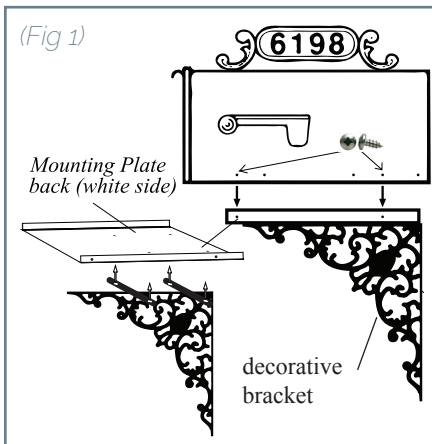
Place bolt through the top of the number plate. Next slide aluminum/rubber washer on to the bolt (rubber side against mailbox). Place bolt through the pre-drilled holes on top of the mailbox. Open mailbox and tighten wing nut on to the bolt.

STEP 2 (Fig 1)

Position mounting plate on top of decorative bracket. Insert bolts through the bottom of decorative base into mounting plate using (4) bolts, (4) washers and (4) hex nuts. See Illustration A2

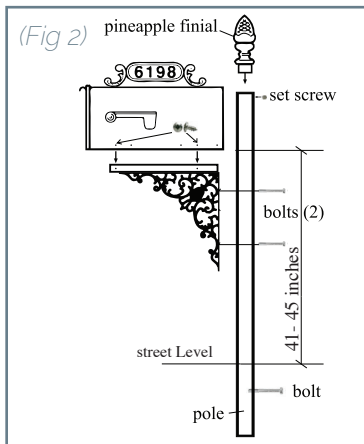


STEP 3 (Fig 2)

Attach decorative bracket with mounting plate to pole using (2) long bolts. Attach mailbox to mounting plate using the 4 screws. Insert screws into corresponding pre-drilled holes on the sides of mailbox and mounting plate.

STEP 4 (Fig 2)

Finish the look of your mailbox system by inserting the finial on top of the pole and securing with set screw. Place long bolt near the bottom of pole. Your mailbox is ready to be installed into the ground.

What if my mailbox is damaged at some future point?

All of our mailboxes are bolted together so parts can be easily replaced. Simply call the number on the inside of the door and our team will be happy to help you bring your mailbox back to life.

Do you install with concrete?

All mailboxes installed by Addresses of Distinction are installed using concrete. We warranty all installations for a period of one year. When your mailbox is installed, please wait 24 hours before applying pressure to the post, as it takes some time for the concrete to fully cure.
