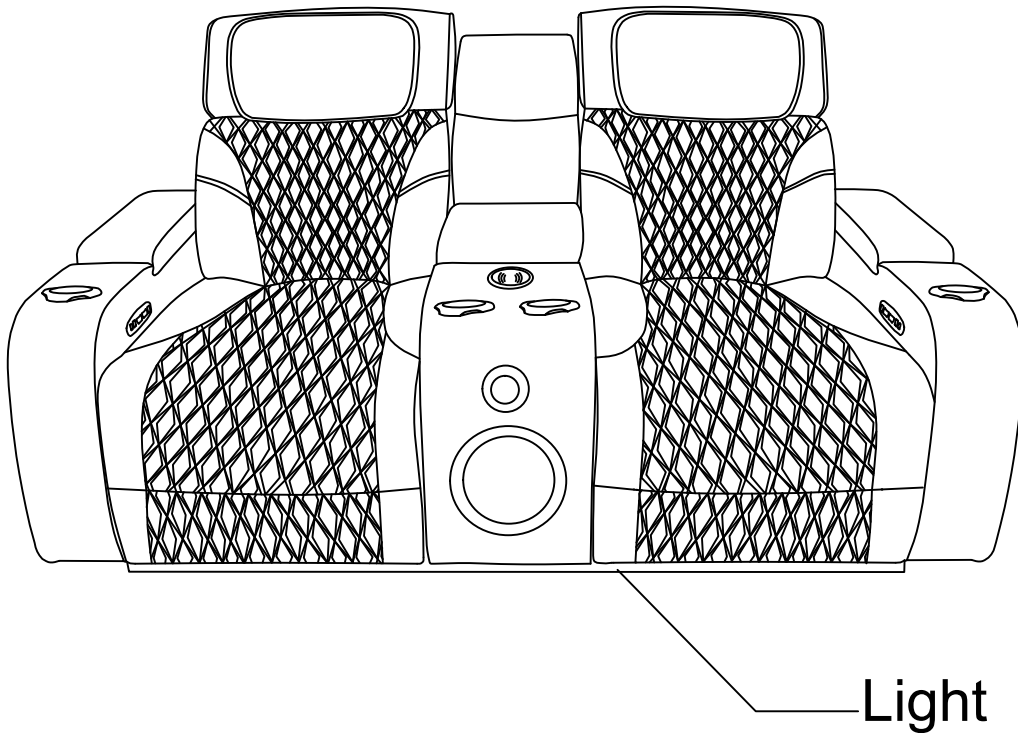


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Caution: Please read instructions thoroughly before unpacking assembly parts. Sharp, exposed staple tips can cause injury, therefore, for your protection, please remove any exposed staple used in packing

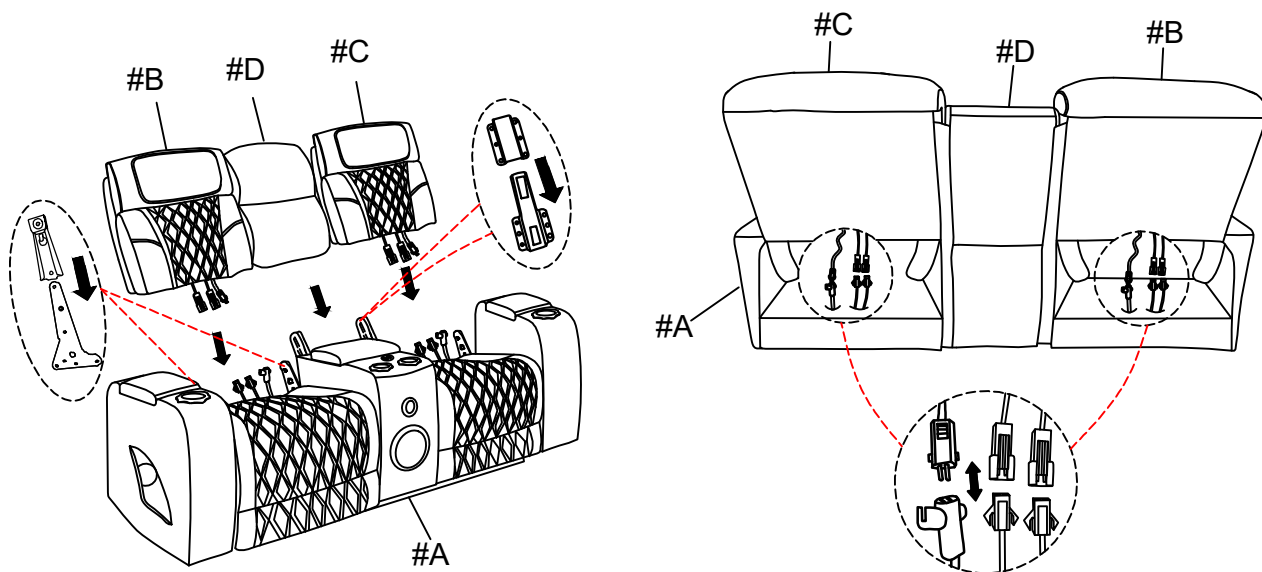

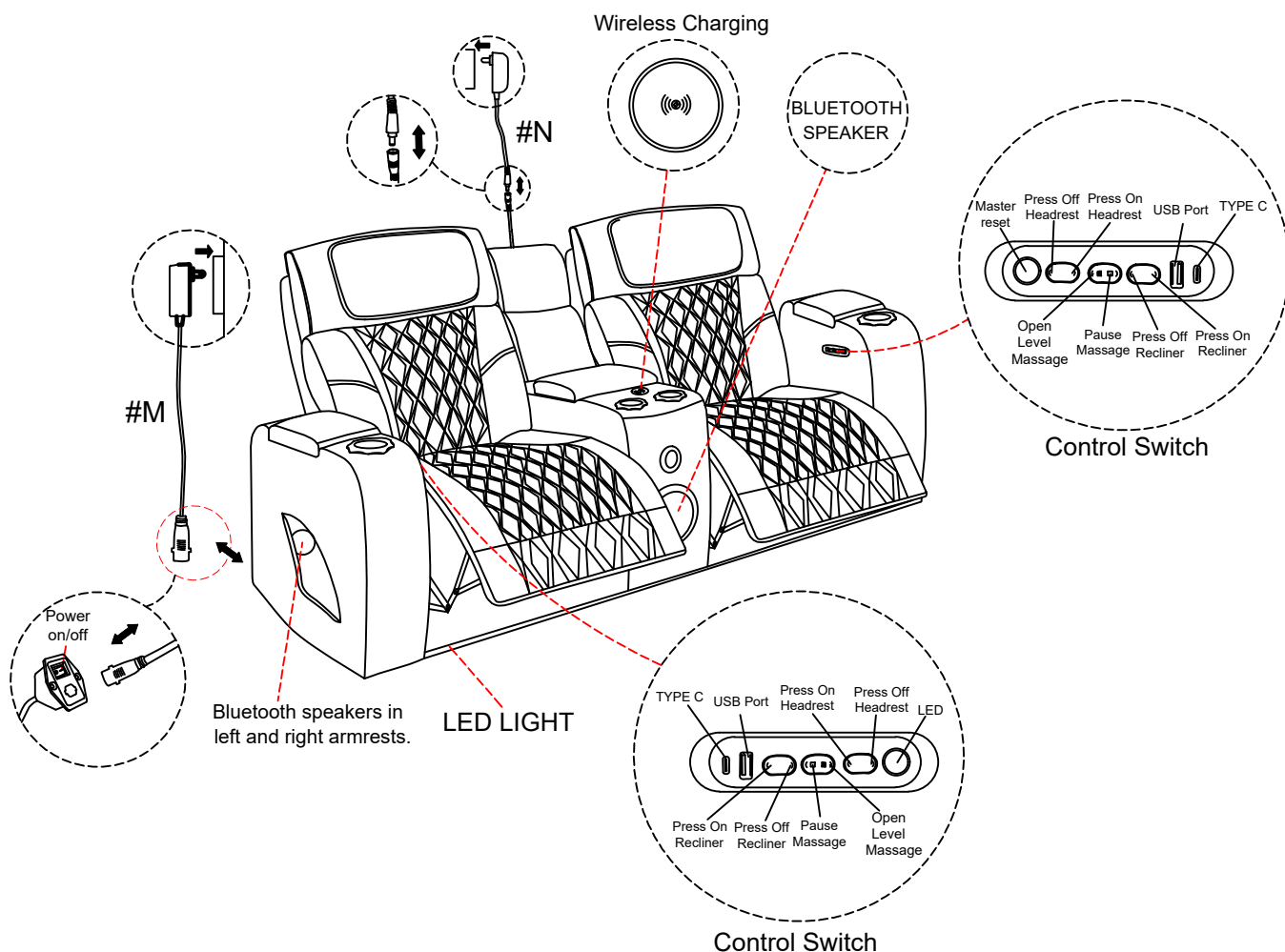
STEP 1#

Insert backrest to loveseat body then push to the end and make sure it is fixed in position securely. Then connect the wire at the back of the backrest onto the wire at the loveseat body. And connect the extension cord from the backrest to the back of the Seat body to activate the massage function.



STEP 2#

Connect the power connector of the loveseat base and the power adapter, and then plug the power adapter into the power socket.





- Disconnect the electrical plug from the wall outlet before cleaning, moving, servicing or when not in use for an extended period of time.
- Plug directly into a wall outlet. Do not use an extension cord or adaptor
- Check the condition of the power transformers, electrical cords, plugs and connectors monthly. Keep the power adaptor and electrical cords away from heat sources. Never operate the unit with a damaged power adaptor, electrical cord, plug or connector.
- Before moving the product, please disconnect the electrical plug from the wall outlet and secure the mechanism to prevent unexpected opening or movement. Never move the product by the mechanism, legrest, handle, or reclining back. Do not attempt to disassemble or service the adaptor or motor. No serviceable parts are inside.
- Do not allow electrical cord to be pinched between moving parts or between the frame and the floor.
- Do not place cord under carpet or in location where it could become worn.
- Unplug the power cord immediately if you detect strange odors or fumes coming from the chair.
