

ASSEMBLY&INSTALLATION

Please read carefully and save these instructions,as you may need them a later date.

CAUTION

Turn off the main power at the circuit breaker before installing the fixture, in order to prevent possible shock.

GENERAL

All electrical connections must be in accordance with local and National Electrical Code (N.E.C) standards. If you are unfamiliar with proper electrical wiring connections obtain the services of a qualified electrician.

Remove the fixture and the mounting package from the box and make sure that no parts are missing by referencing the illustrations on the installation instructions.

ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION

1. Carefully unpack the fixture, lay out all parts on a clean surface.
2. Install the bulb (4 not included) into the socket (3). Make sure they do not exceed the maximum wattage specified on the fixture's wattage rating label.
3. Align the top cover (6) onto the top of the fixture frame (1), use a Phillips screwdriver (not included) to screw the pan screws (5) through the holes on the fixture frame (1) into the threaded holes on the top cover (6).Screw top cover(15)using fixture loop(6).
4. Connect the ground wire from the fixture (12) to the ground wire from the post (13). Connect the white wire from the fixture (10) to the white wire(11 neutral wire) from the post. Connect the black wire from fixture (7) to the black wire (9 live wire) from post. Cover the three connections using the tree wire connectors (8). Position the wires back inside the post cap (14).

ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION (CONT.)

5. Place the post cap (14) onto the post.
6. Screw the screws (2) through the holes on the post cap until the fixture is secure.
7. Turn on the power.
