
Thank you for purchasing this quality product. This product has been designed for easy assembly and constructed for durability. All parts were checked prior to packaging to insure quality. Prior to beginning assembly, however, make sure all parts and hardware are included and free of obvious defect.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

- Place all wooden parts on a clean and smooth surface such as a rug or carpet to avoid the parts from being scratched.
- Remove all wrapping material, including staples & packing straps before you start to assemble.
- DO NOT tighten all screws and bolts until completely assembled.
- Keep all hardware parts out of reach of children.



STEP 1


Attach bottom panel (D) and top (A) to side frames (B) with bolts (1), and washers (2) and (3) as shown below. Tighten with Allen key (4).

Attach supporting bar (C) to side frames (B) with brackets (8) and screws (6) as shown below. Tighten with a screwdriver.



STEP 2


Slide back panel (E) into the grooves, then attach back panel (E) to the unit with screws (5) as shown below. Tighten with a screwdriver.



STEP 3

Attach drawer sides (G) to drawer front (H) with screws (7) as shown below. Tighten with a screwdriver. Slide drawer bottom (I) into grooves of drawer sides (G) and drawer front (H) as shown below. Attach the drawer back (J) to the drawer sides (G) with screws (7) as shown below. Tighten with a screwdriver.

Attach support bar (K) to bottom of drawer with screws (7) as shown below. Tighten with a screwdriver.




STEP 4

Carefully put the drawer into the unit.

Insert brackets (9) into the unit as shown below. Place shelf (F) on the brackets and attach with screws (6). Tighten with a screwdriver.

Attach knob (11) to front of drawer with pan head screw (10) as shown below. Tighten with a screwdriver.



STEP 5

Attach brackets (14) to the back of the unit with screws (12) through the smaller holes in the brackets as shown below.

Important!

Properly attach the other brackets (14) to the wall in an area of *drywall or plaster with a wood stud*:


Mark the attachment point(s) with a pencil at the appropriate height **positioned over the wood stud(s)**in the wall

Place the unit into position so both mounting brackets are vertically in line.

Properly attach the other brackets (14) to the wall stud with screws (13) through the smaller holes as shown below.

Lace the end of flat nylon ties (15) through the larger holes in each mounting bracket. Bring both ends together and slide the flat ends through the locking ends and draw it through until all slack is removed.

Confirm that the strap is securely laced and locked.



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
