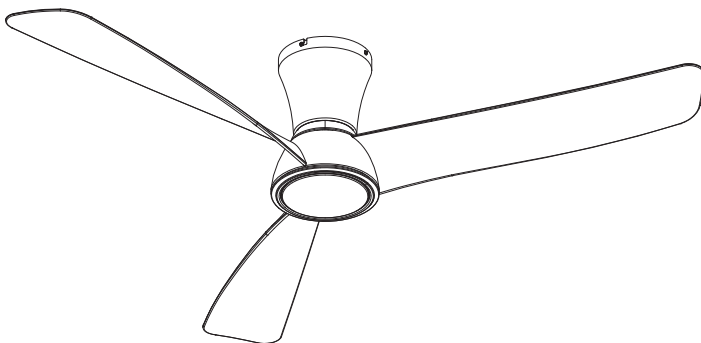
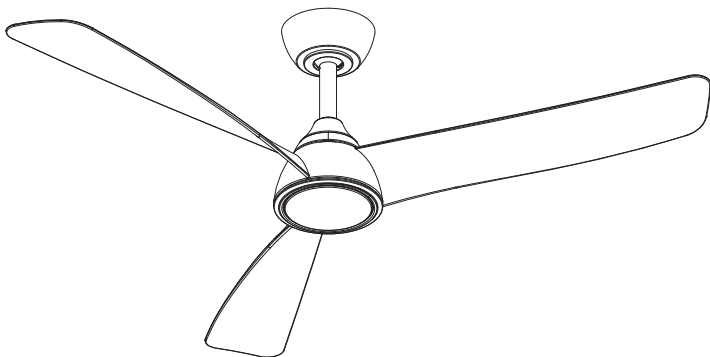

To reduce the risk of electric shock, ensure electricity has been turned off at the circuit breaker before beginning. All wiring must be in accordance with the National Electrical Code "ANSI/NFPA 70" and local electrical codes. Electrical installation should be performed by a licensed electrician.

The fan must be mounted with a minimum of 7 ft. (2.1m) clearance from the trailing edge of the fan blades to the floor and a minimum of 1.5 ft (0.5m) from the edge of the fan blades to the surrounding walls. Never place objects in the path of the fan blades. To avoid personal injury or damage to the fan and other items, please be cautious when working around or cleaning the fan.

To avoid electrical shock or damage to the motor or finish, do not use water or chemicals when cleaning the fan or fan blades. A dry cloth or lightly dampened cloth will be suitable for most cleaning.

After making electrical connections, spliced conductors should be turned upward and pushed carefully up into the outlet box. The wires should be spread apart with the grounded conductor and the equipment-grounding conductor on one side of the outlet box, and the ungrounded conductor on the other side of the outlet box.

All set screws must be checked and re-tightened where necessary before installation.

WARNING: Do not install or use your fan if any part(s) is/are damaged or missing. This product is designed for use only with the supplied parts and/or accessories designated for use with this product by East Grove Home. Substitution of parts or accessories not designated for use with this product by East Grove Home could result in personal injury or property damage and will void the warranty. Contact an authorized dealer or the manufacturer if any parts are damaged or missing.

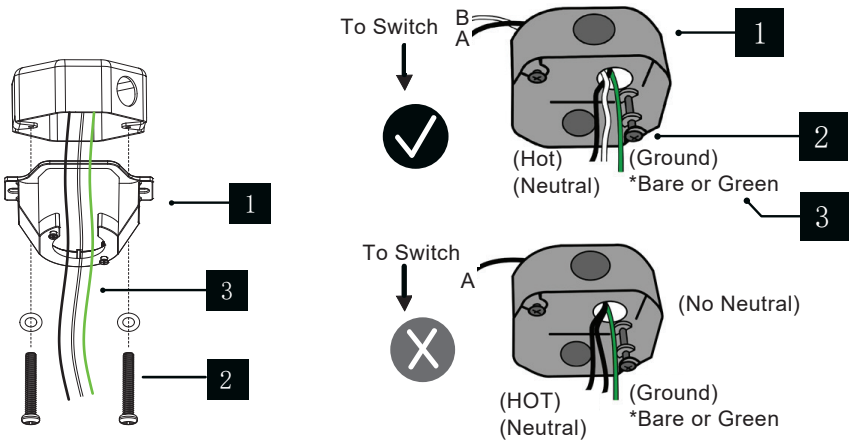
2. Installing the Mounting Bracket

Remember to disconnect the power at the circuit breaker.

1. Check your outlet box to make sure it has a proper Hot, Neutral, and Ground. If not, you will need to consult with a licensed electrician to install a new cUL/UL outlet box.
2. Pass the 120-volt supply wires through the center hole in the mounting bracket as shown (Fig. 2A).
3. Secure the mounting bracket to the ceiling outlet box with the screws and washers provided with your outlet box. Use Part A if needed to mount your Outlet Box.

NOTE: Make sure that mounting screws are tight.

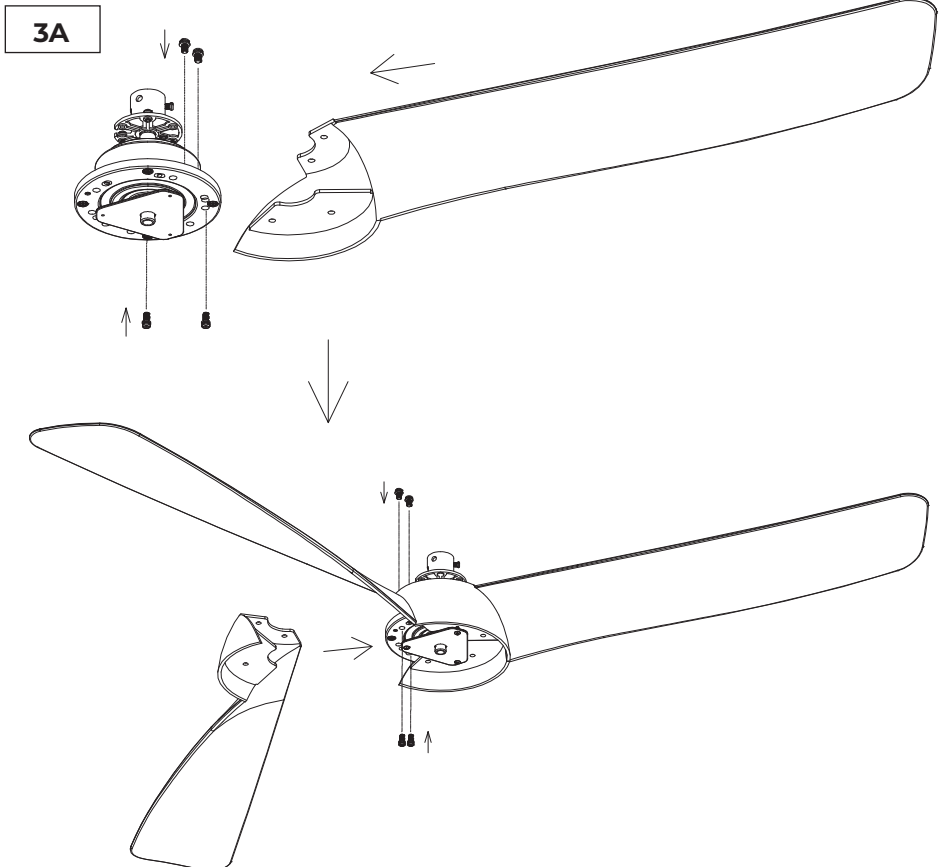

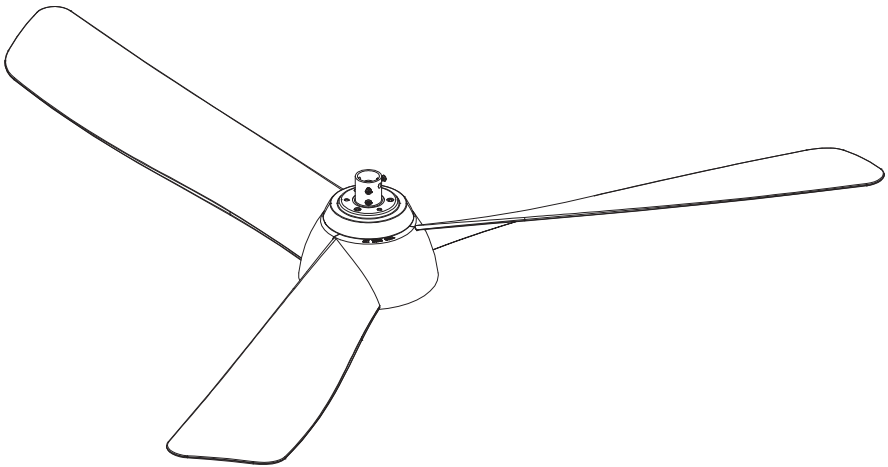
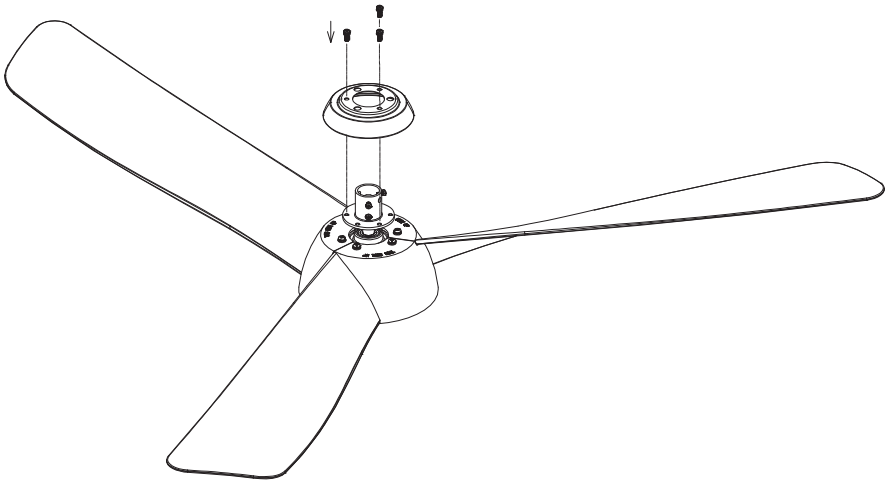

3. Attaching the Fan Blades

1. Place fan motor on a flat surface.
2. Attach fan blades to the motor as shown, using the provided screws with metal washer.(Fig 3A)
3. Then, install the motor cover through the motor cover screws. (Fig 3B)



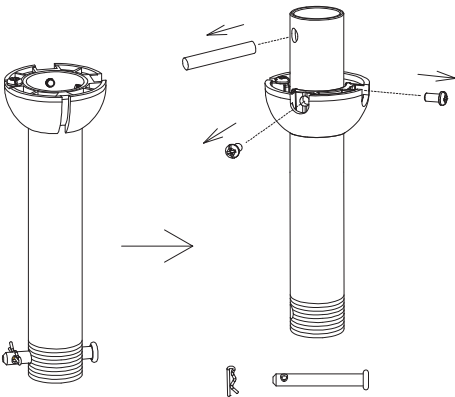

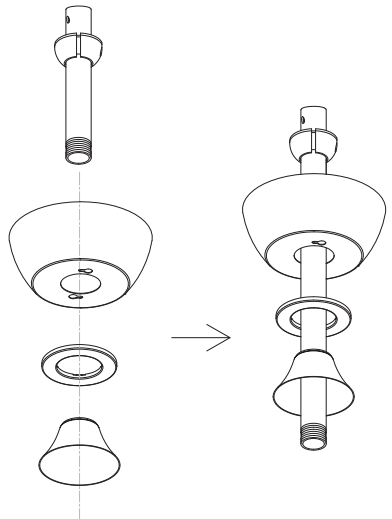
4. Assembling the Fan Housing

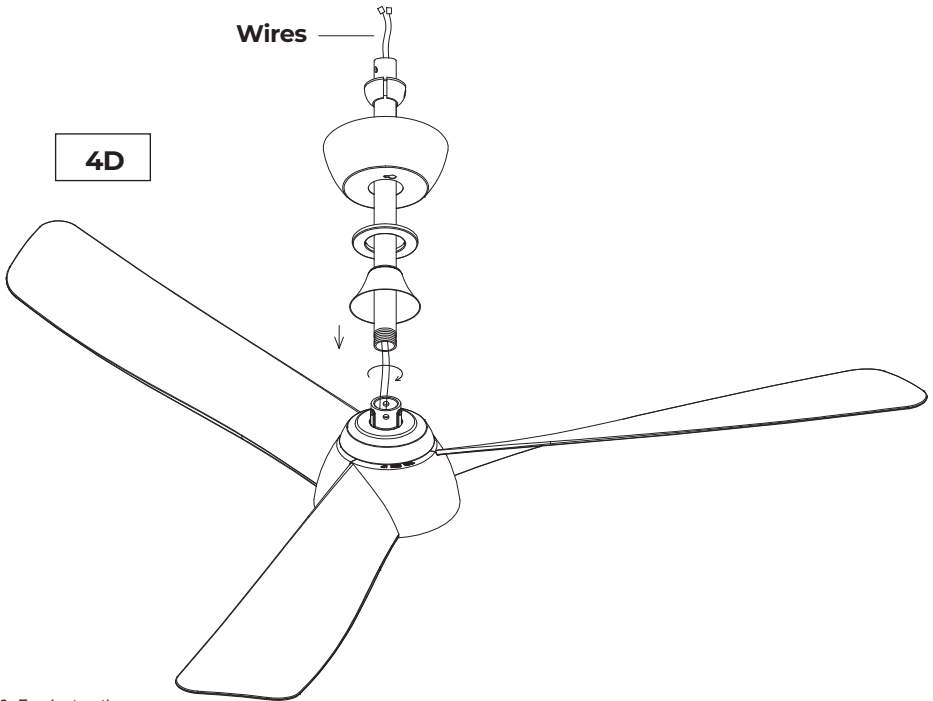
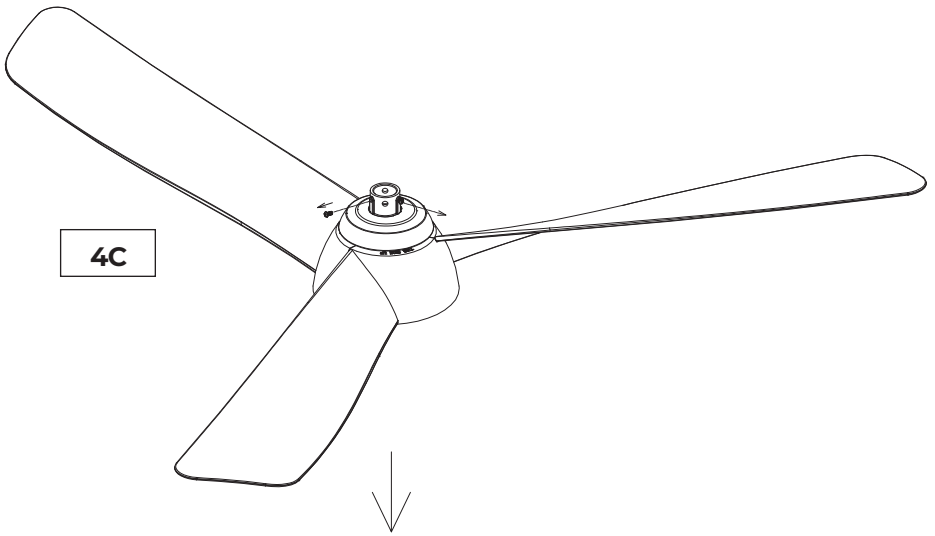
1. Remove tension screw attached to ball joint of the Downrod Assembly and remove the cotter pin (Fig. 4A).
2. On a flat surface, feed Downrod Assembly through the Canopy, Canopy Screw Ring, Coupling Cover (Fig. 4B).
3. Loosen the screws of the coupling (Fig. 4C).
4. Feed the wires up from the Motor, completely through the Downrod Assembly (Fig. 4D).
5. Install the suspension rod onto the fixture coupling. Reinstall the cotter pin and tension screw. (Fig. 4E)
6. Align Downrod and motor collar holes, re-insert pins and screws (Fig. 4E).
7. Retighten screws from Step 1 and Step 3.

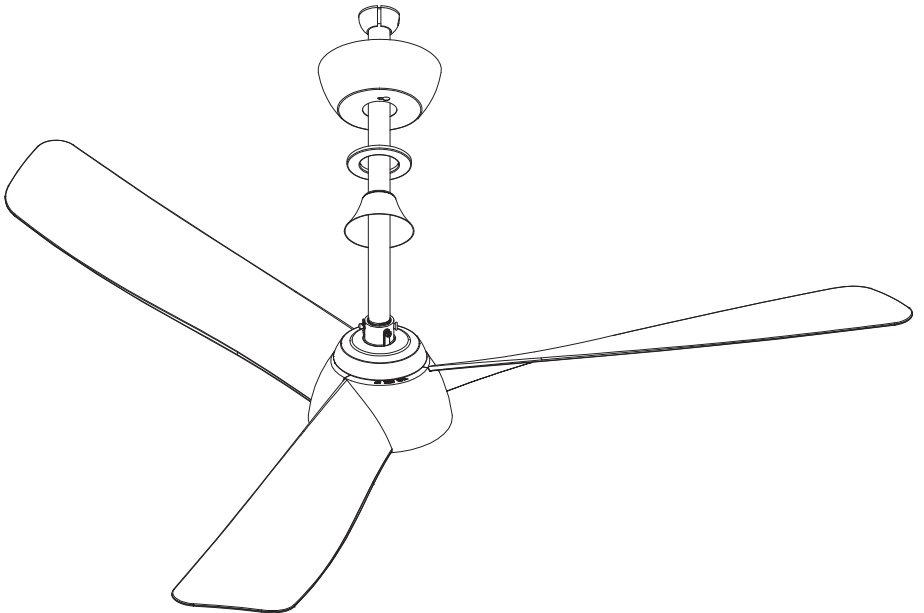
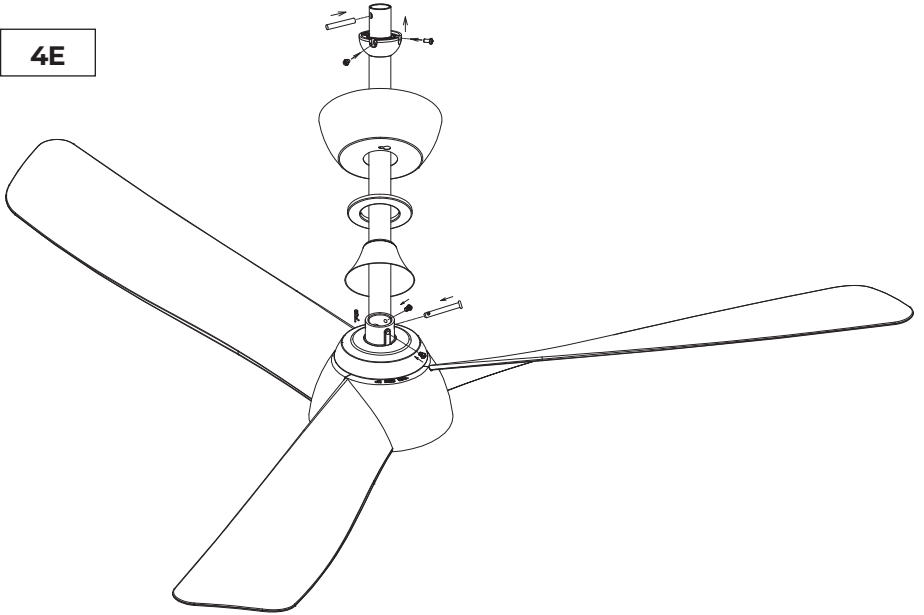

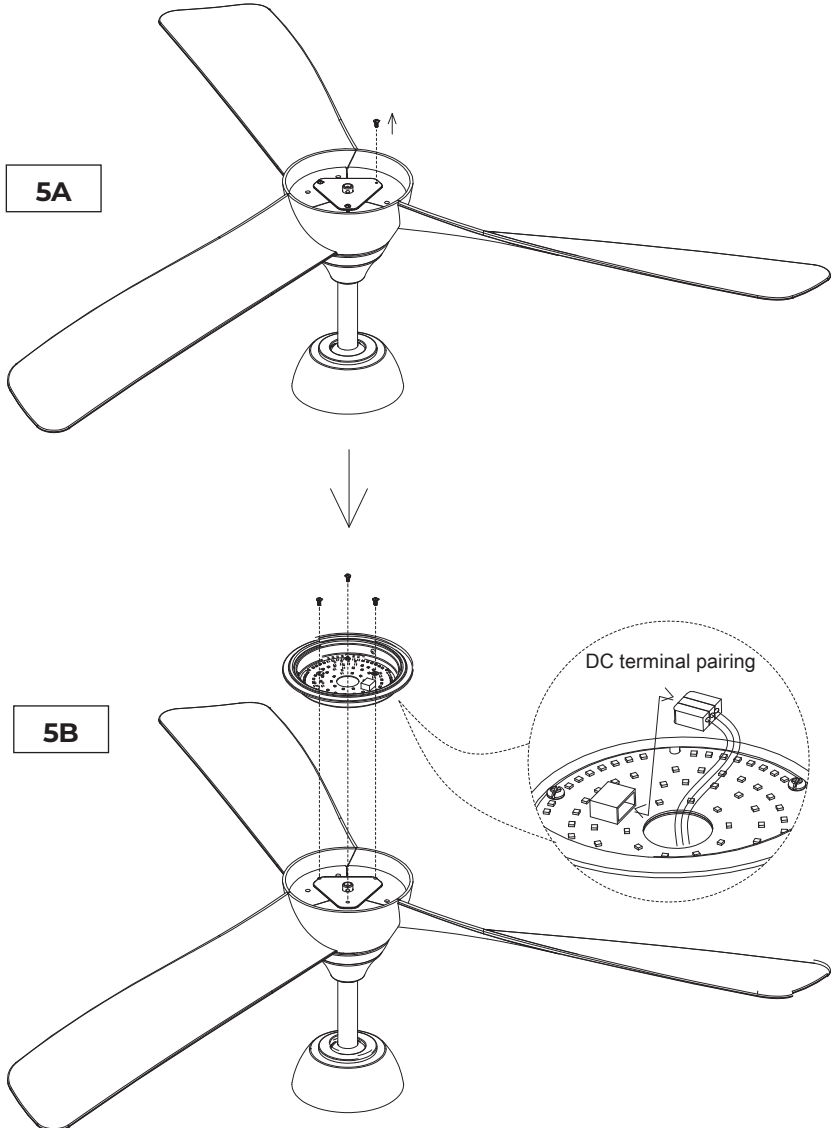

5. Installing the LED Module

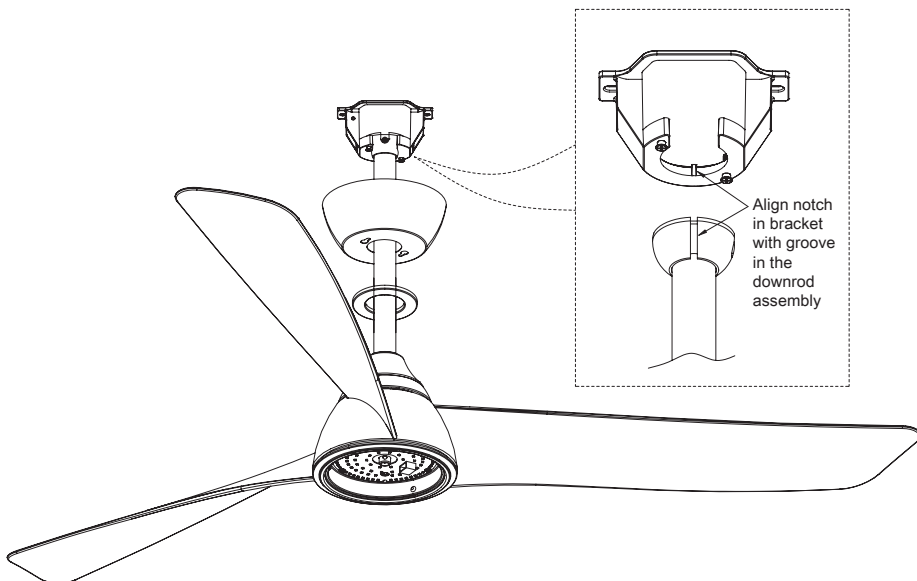
1. Remove the 3 screws from the adapter plate (Fig. 5A).
2. Align 3 holes in LED Module with the adapter plate, and secure using the 3 screws from Step 1.(Fig. 5B)
3. Attach LED wires from motor assembly to LED Module (Fig. 5B).



6. Hanging the Fan

1. Carefully rotate the fan right-side up.
2. Slide ball end of Downrod Assembly into the mounting bracket.
3. Align notch in bracket with groove in the downrod assembly (Fig. 6A).

7. Making the Electrical Connections

⚠ WARNING: Installation of this fan requires that a three-conductor cable (including ground wire) which should run between ceiling and wall outlet box. Use provided wirenuts.

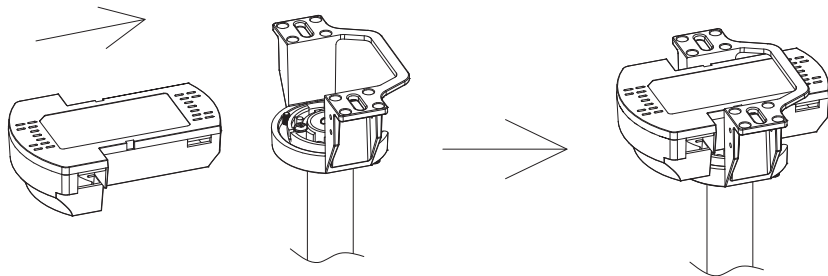

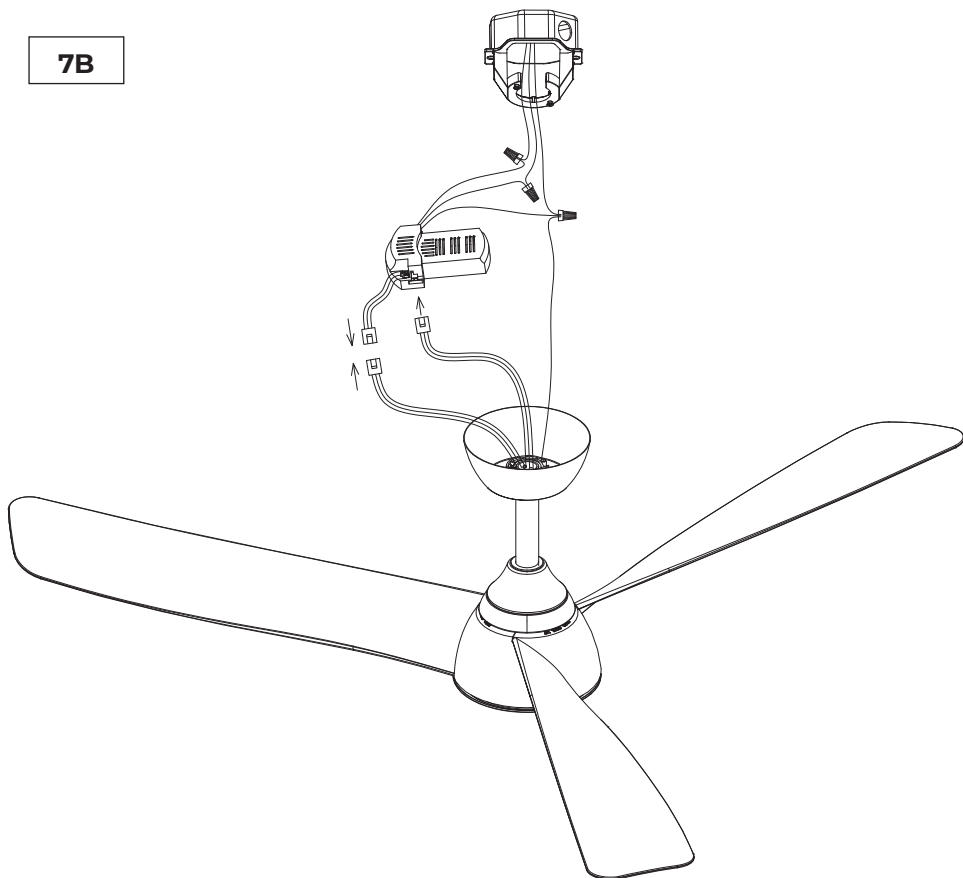

5. Connect the quick connect from the fan to the slot marked **“TO LIGHT”** from the receiver.

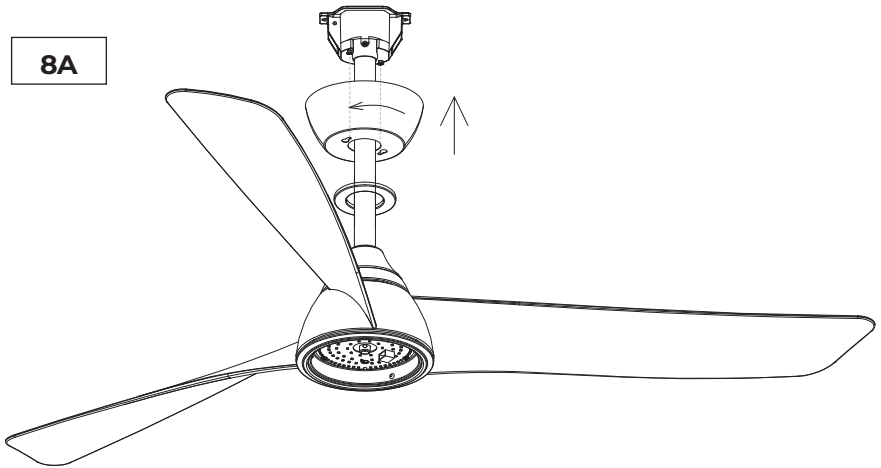

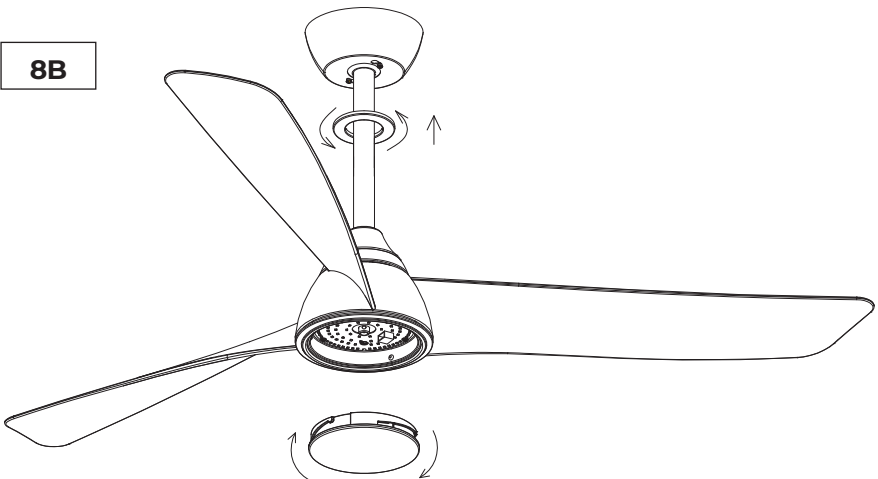
8. Finishing the Installation

1. Align canopy holes with the screws and secure to mounting bracket (Fig. 8A). Note: These screws may need to be slightly loosened first, to allow placement of canopy.
2. Install canopy screw ring as shown .(Fig. 8B)
3. Install the lampshade by twisting it into place. Make sure it is on tight. (Fig. 8B).

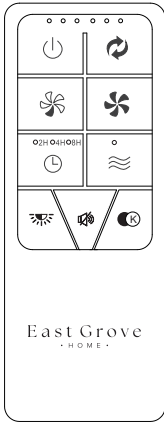
1. Press and hold OFF button within 5 seconds after power is turned on(Fig 9A). The fan will beep once after it successfully pairs with remote.



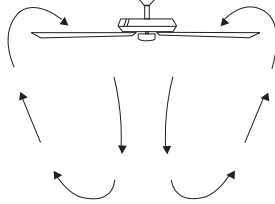

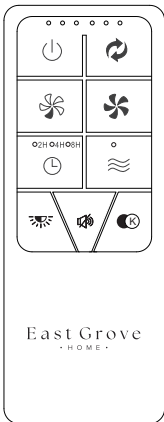
