- * Required screwdriver & mallet, not included.

Guideline For Assembling of Cam Lock (M & N)






Screw camlock bolt (M) to wood part.

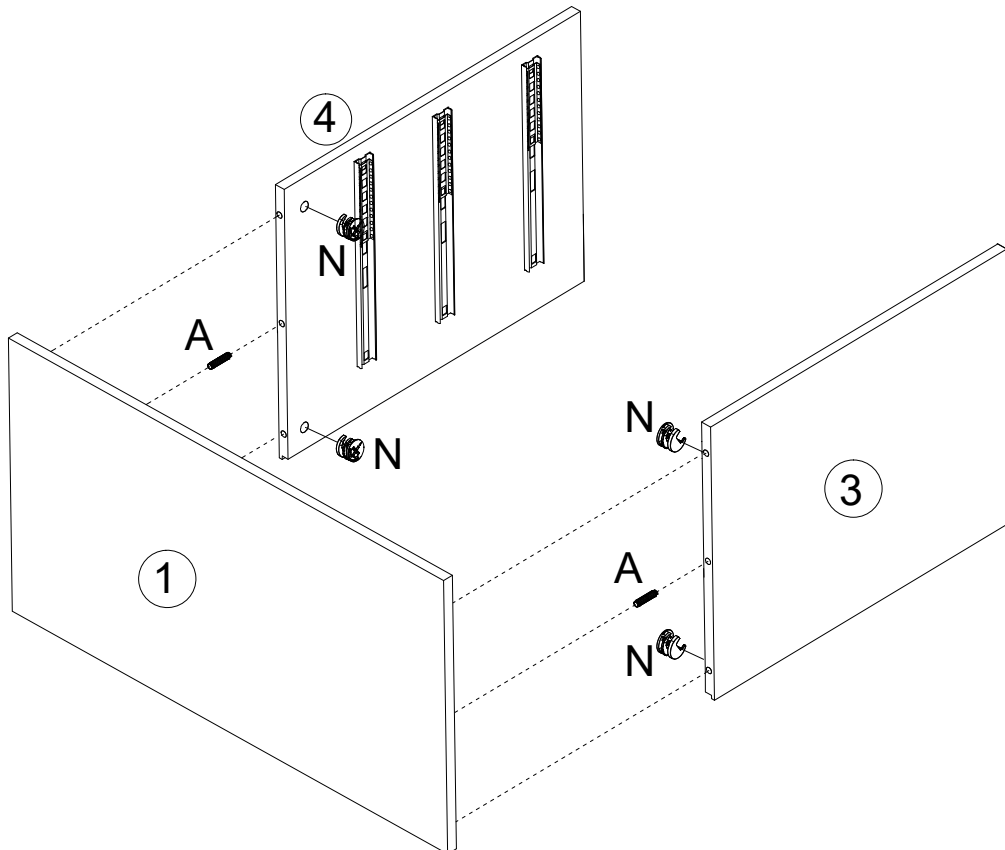
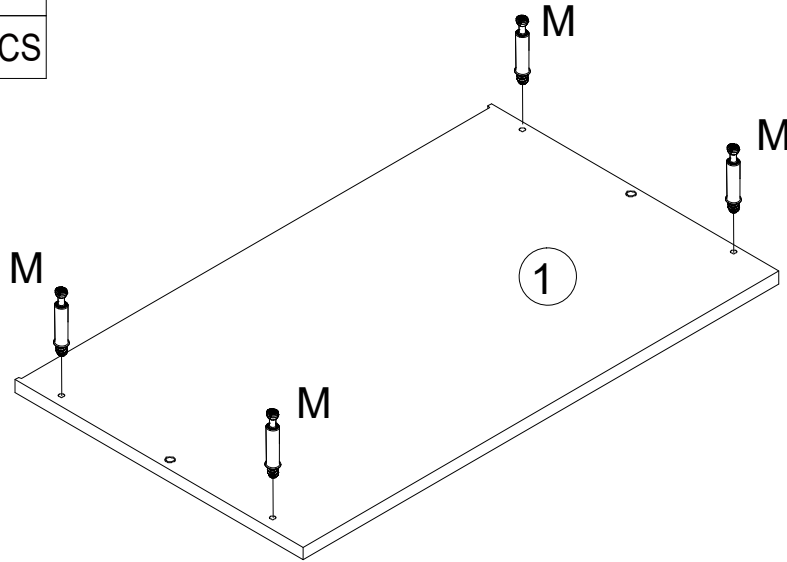
Do not assemble camlock (N) unless instructed.

To assemble camlock (N), ensure long side of the + is facing the bolt (M) before inserting into hole.

Note: Part B and Part G are screws of different lengths. Use Part B for attaching Part 13 (Side leg) to Part 14 (Crossbar), and Part G for securing Part 1 to Part 3. Using the wrong length may damage the panels.

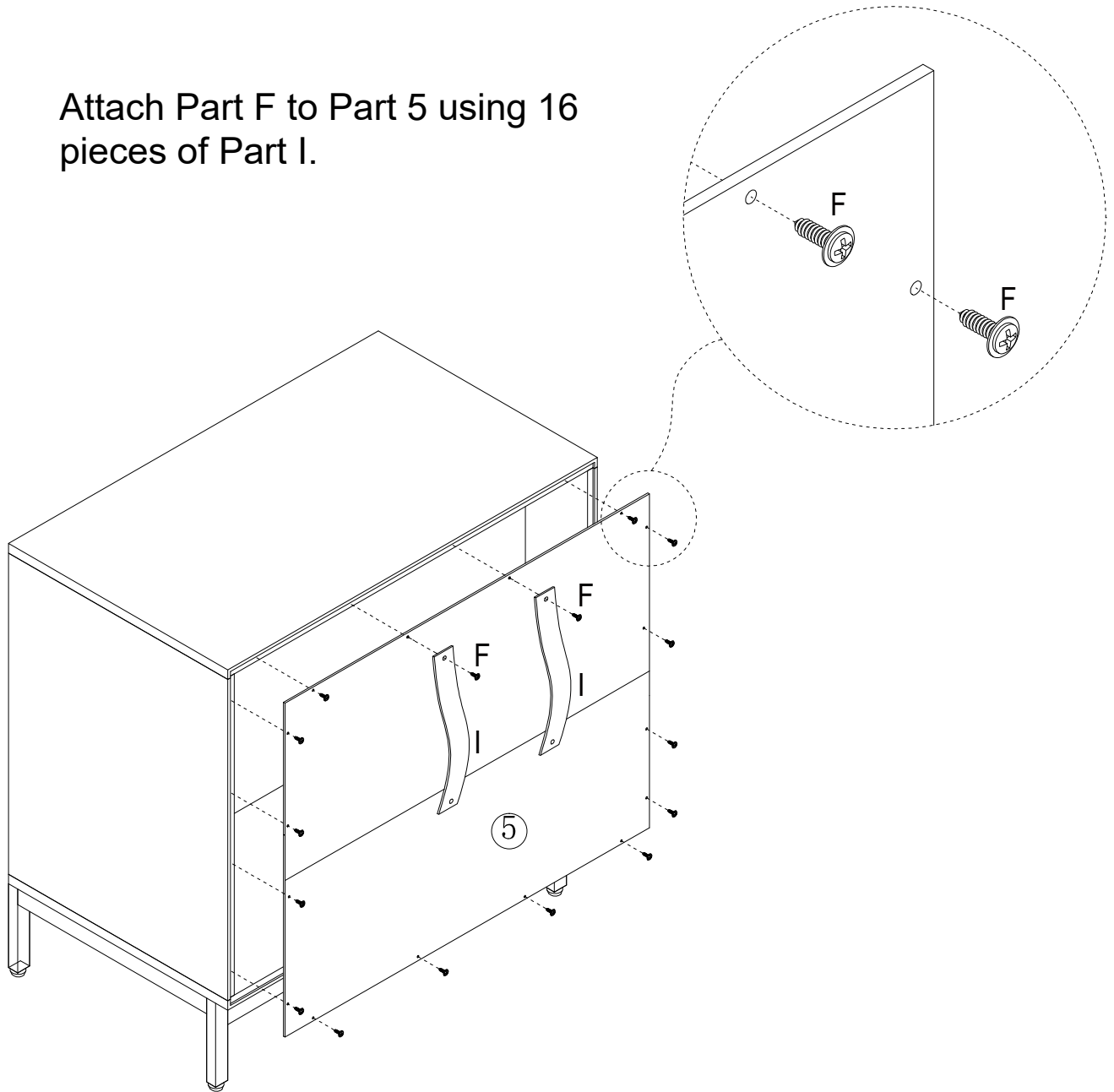

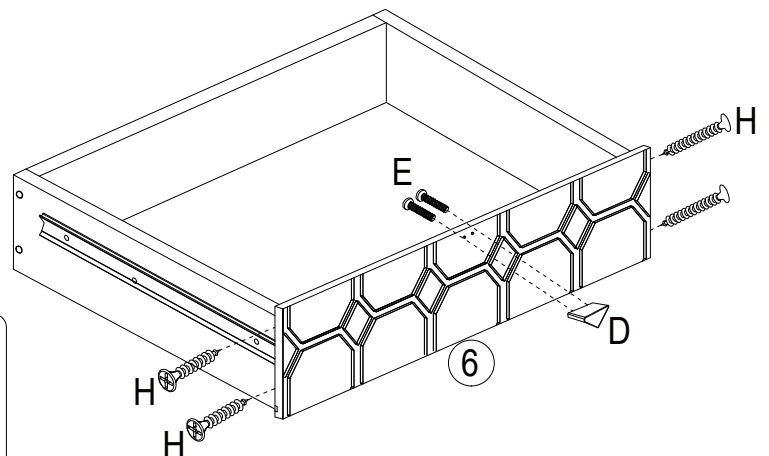
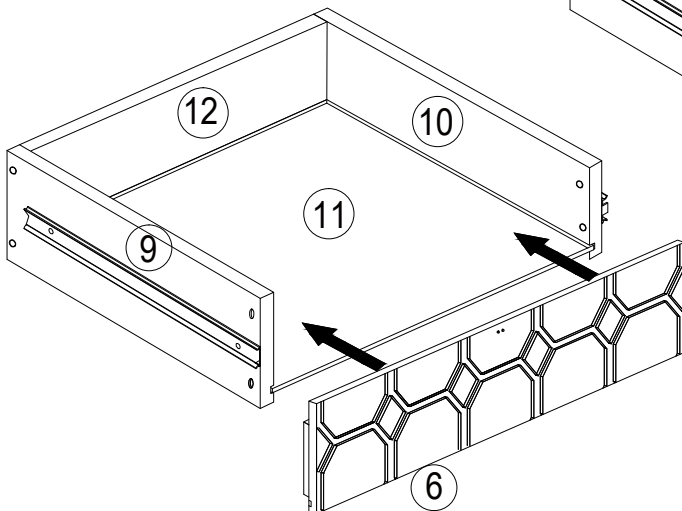
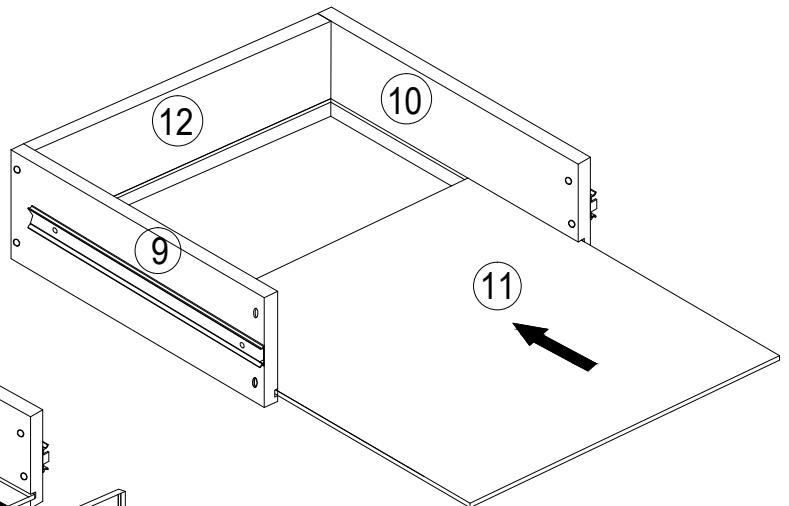
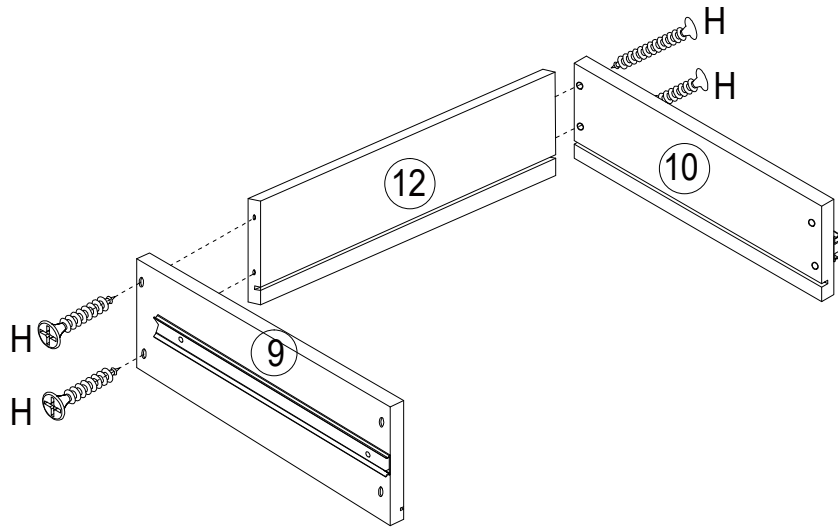
Attach Part F to Part 5 using 16 pieces of Part I.

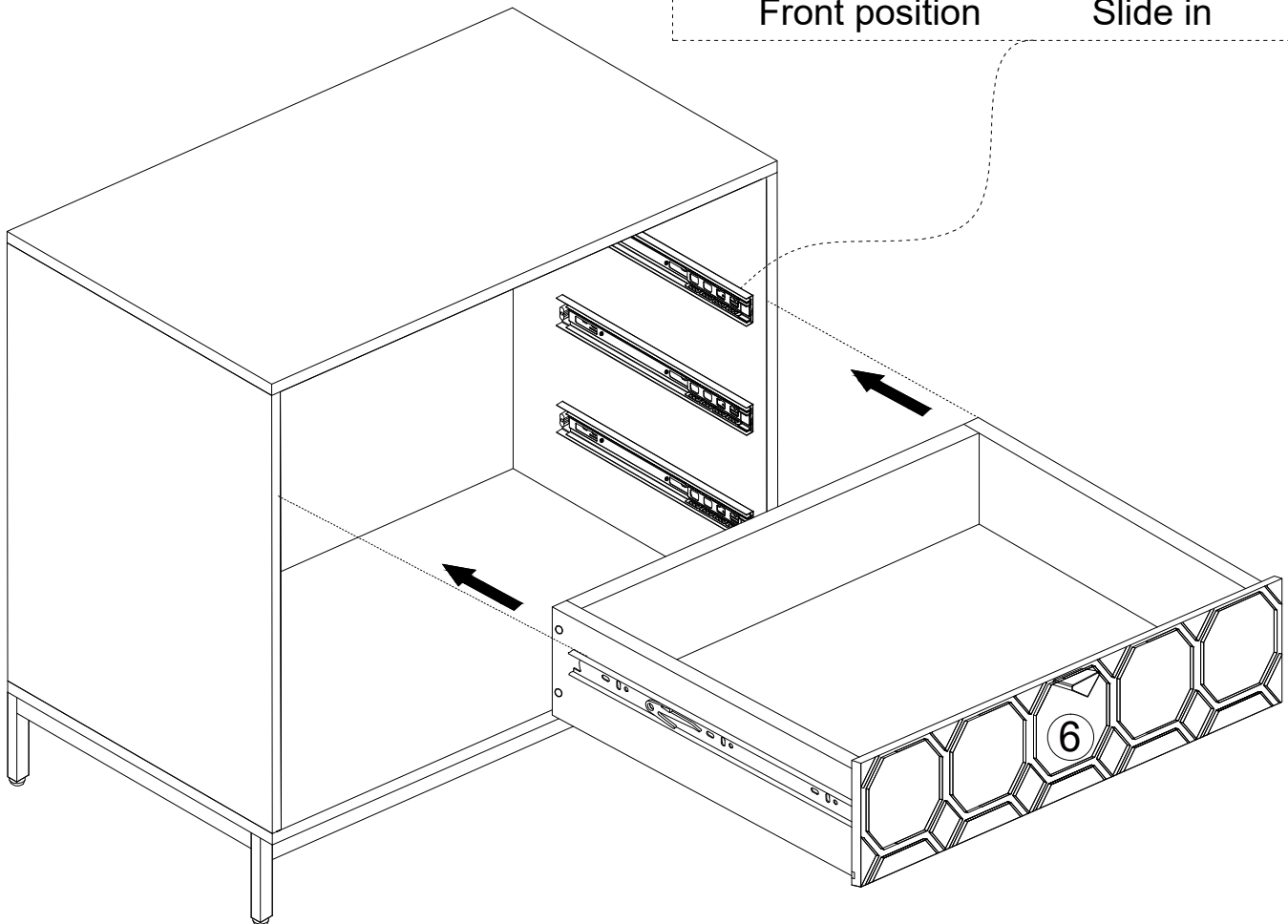
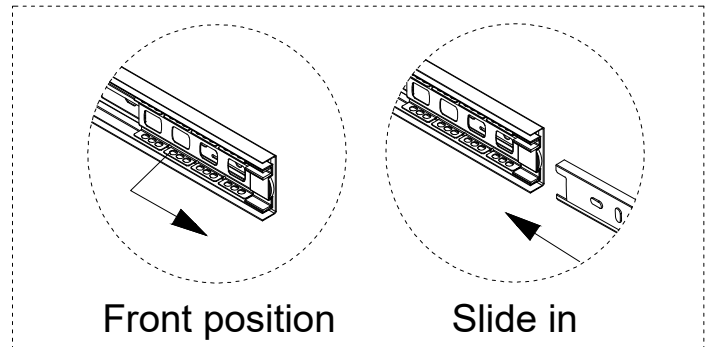


Items 6, 7, and 8 (drawers) are assembled using the same method as described above.

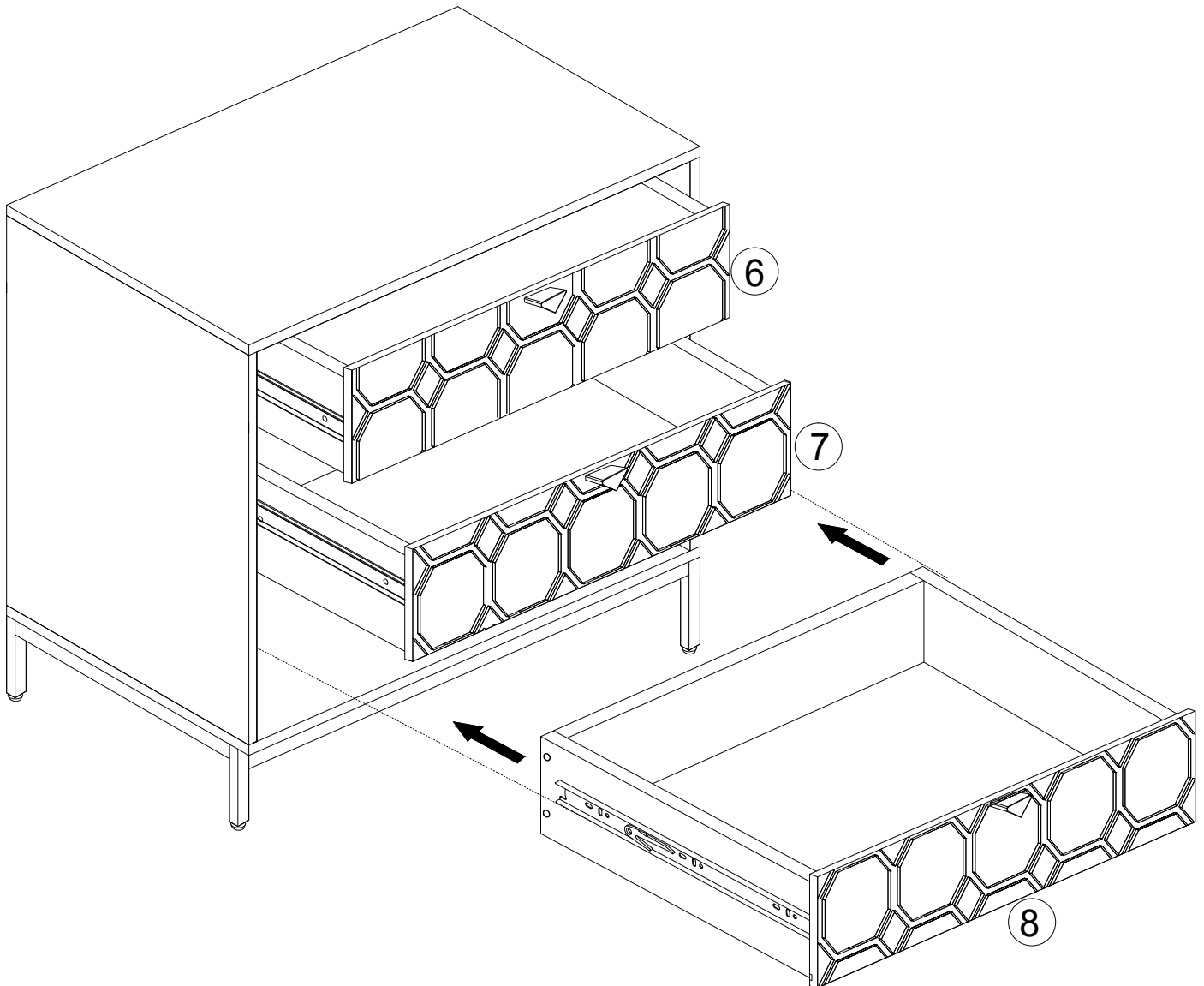
Note: Place the sliding rail to the front position before sliding in



Reminder: If the front and both ends of the drawer are tilted, do not use force, You can refer to the above steps to smoothly insert the slide rail.
The 6# and 7# and 8# suction panels are not interchangeable.

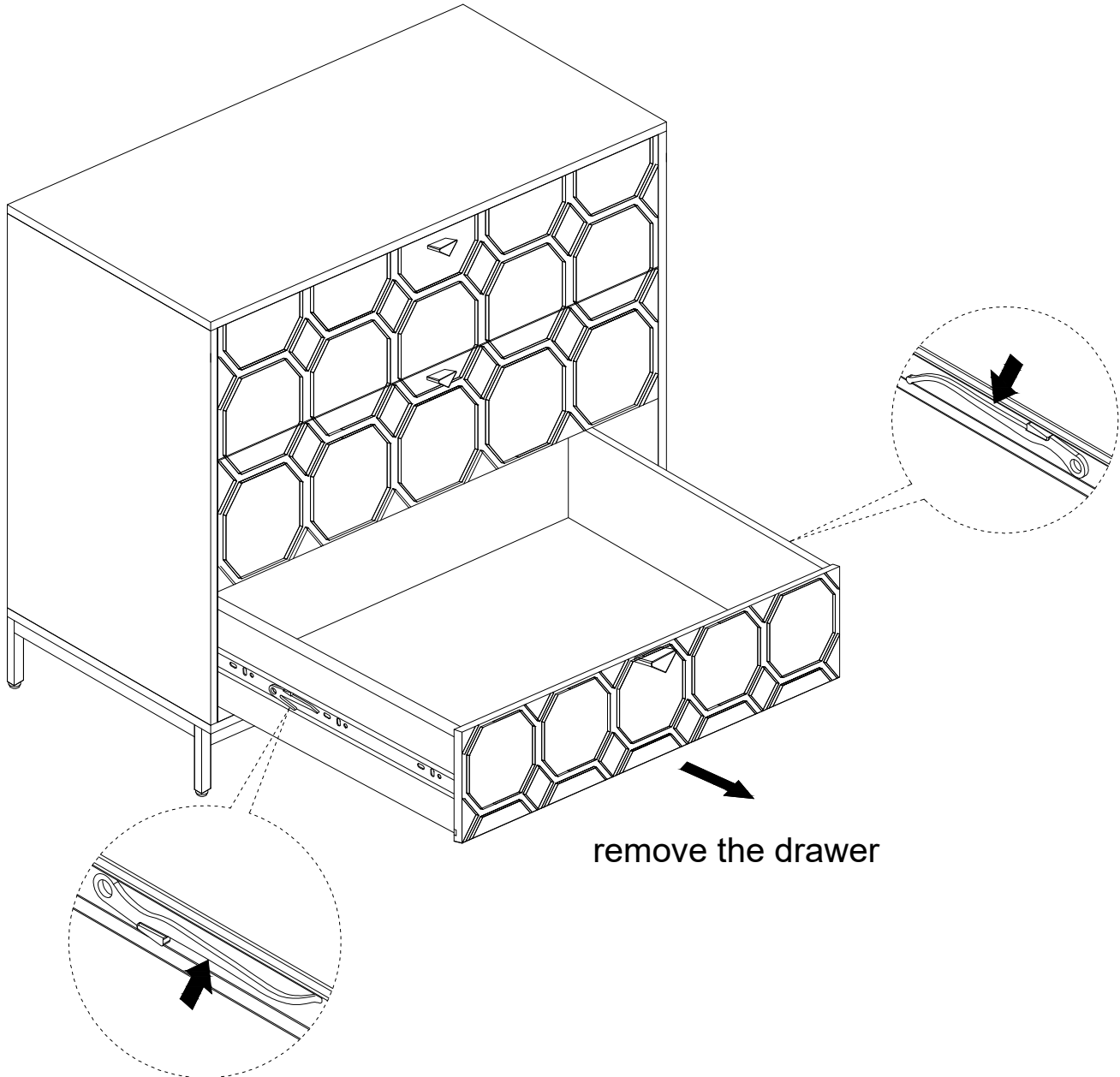

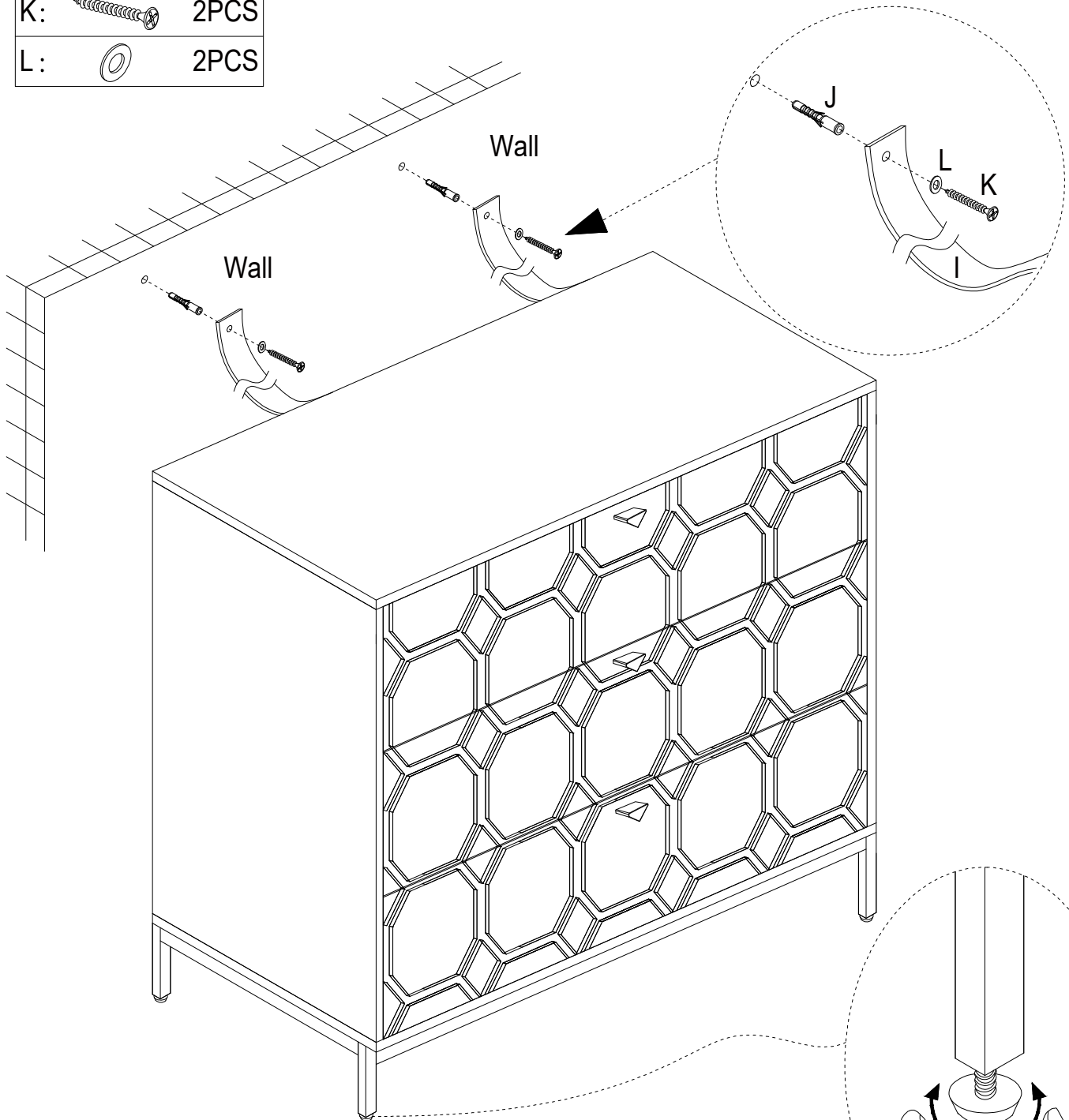
To remove the drawer, lift up on the left side buckle and press down on the right side buckle, operating both left and right at the same time, and move outward to remove it.

To install: Drill a 3/16" hole into the wall, insert wall anchor (if needed), then drive the mounting screw through the safety strap and into the wall. Tighten until the strap is snug.



Adjust the leveling feet (located at the bottom of Part 13) by turning clockwise/counterclockwise until the cabinet stands level on the floor. Ensure all feet are in contact with the ground to prevent wobbling.
