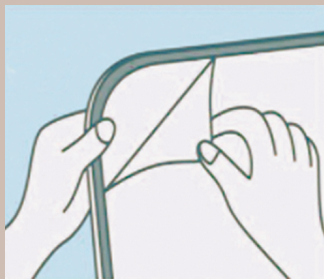


All installed carpet stair treads can be easily removed or replaced as needed.



① Clean and dry your stairs thoroughly. This ensures that the treads fit securely on the stairs without interference from dirt/debris.



② No tapes, adhesives or glue is needed; Peel off the plastic protection cover from the back of your treads.



③ Place the treads on the stairs, and press down firmly from the front edge to the back, the backing will automatically attach to smooth stairs.

Wash Care

1. Sometimes the backing of the treads is attached to the stairs very firmly, remove the treads from stairs slowly from edge to central.
2. NO machine wash. Hand wash in cold water ONLY, using mild, liquid laundry detergent.
3. Hang or lay the carpet treads flat, air-drying naturally in a shaded but warm place, preferably with a slight breeze for better airflow. (Avoid exposure to direct sunlight)
4. Replace the carpet treads after thoroughly cleaning up both the stairs and the backing of the treads.
