



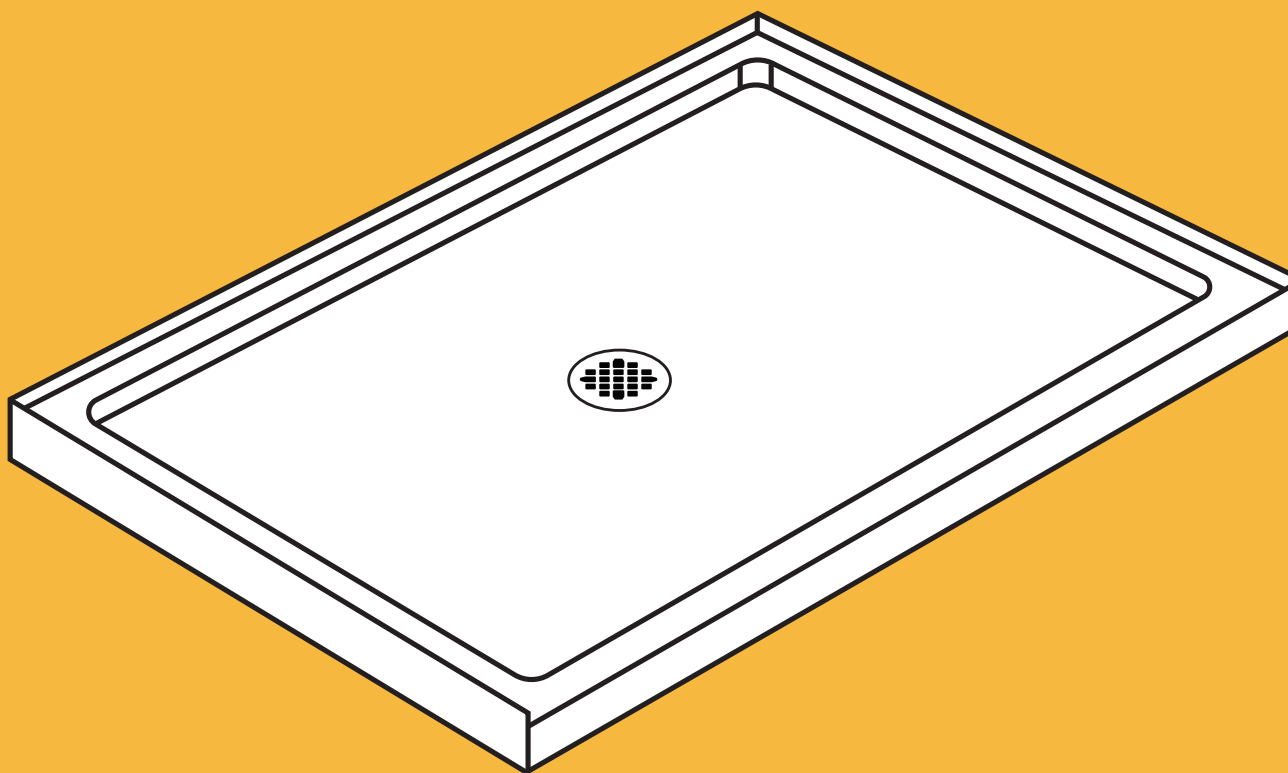

PRE-INSTALLATION CHECKLIST

Choose the Shower Base:

*Select a shower base that fits your space and matches your design preferences.

Check Local Building Codes:

*Review local regulations regarding plumbing and bathroom renovations to ensure compliance.

Measure the Space:

- *Measure the area designated for the shower base (length, width, and height).
- *Measure the existing drain to ensure compatibility with the new base.

Inspect the Shower Base:

Opened all the boxes, read the instruction and inspect the shower base thoroughly, ensure all the necessary components are included and no damaged. Do not install the base and contact our service team for support immediately.

Inspect Existing Plumbing:

- *Check that the existing drain aligns with the drain hole in the shower base.
- *Ensure the plumbing is in good condition and free of leaks.

Adjust Plumbing if Necessary:

Consider hiring a licensed plumber if adjustments are needed to the drain or supply lines.

Inspect the Subfloor:

- * Check for damage or not and repair as needed.
- * Ensure the subfloor is clean, dry, and free of debris.

Level the Subfloor:

Use a level to ensure the subfloor is even. Address any low spots or bumps.

Dry Fit the Shower Base:

Place the shower base in the intended location to verify positioning and drain alignment.

Additional Considerations

Waterproofing:

- * Consider waterproofing measures, like adding a moisture barrier or waterproof membrane if necessary.

Plan for Wall Installation:

- * If installing wall panels or tiles, ensure materials are ready and plan how they will be affixed to the walls.

Wear Safety Gear:

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



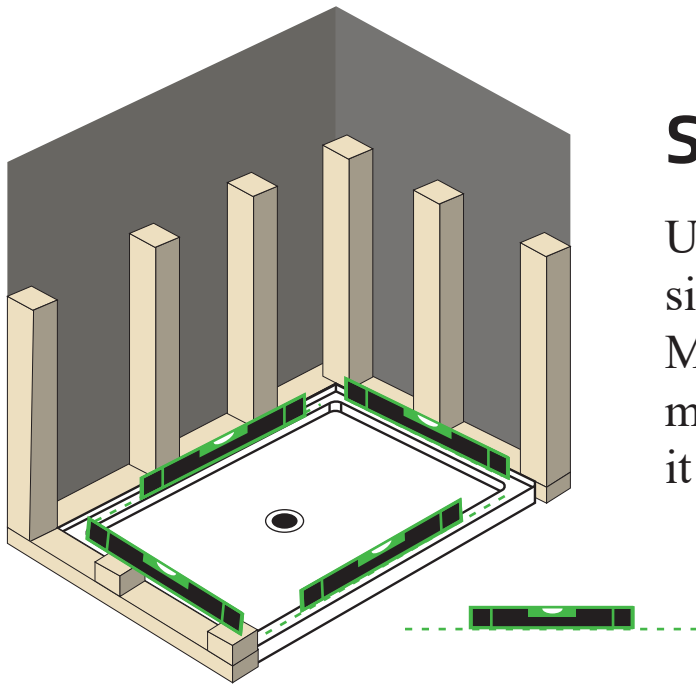
Step1

Set up the studs frame for the shower base area, it's probably measured with the angle finder, and make sure the corner and platform are 90° .



Step2

Ensure the subfloor is clean, dry and structurally sound. Place the shower base in the desired position to check for fit.

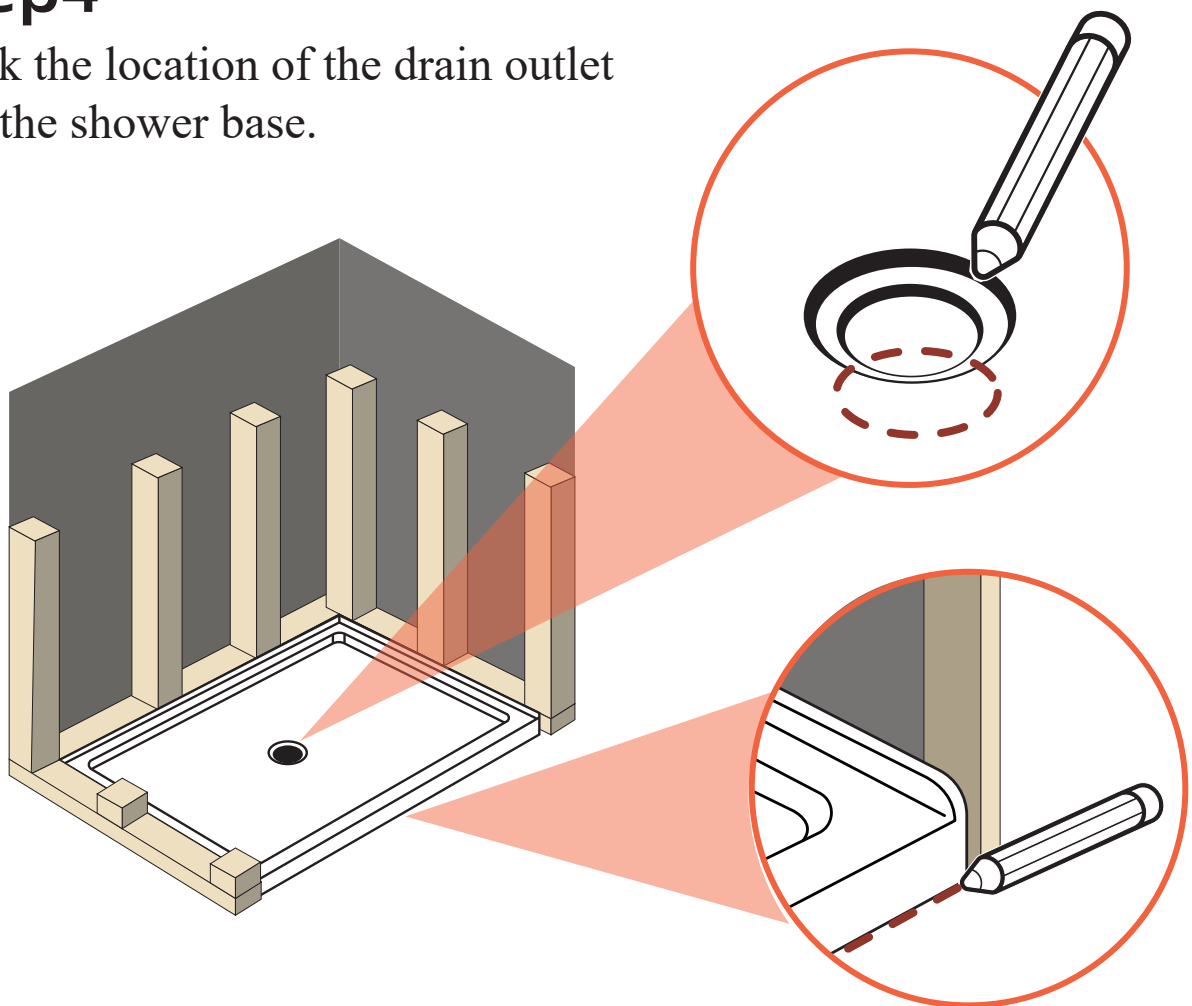


Step3

Use the level to check that the 4 sides of the shower base are leveled. Make sure all sides are leveled. You might need to adjust the subfloor if it wobbles or is not flat.

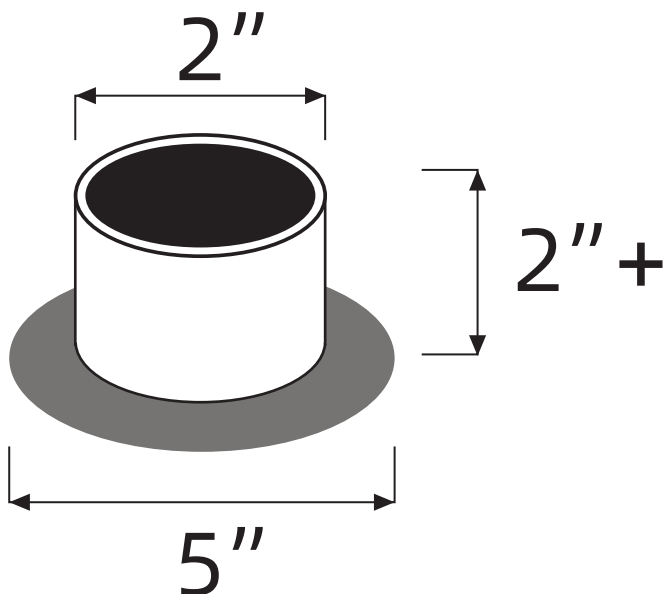
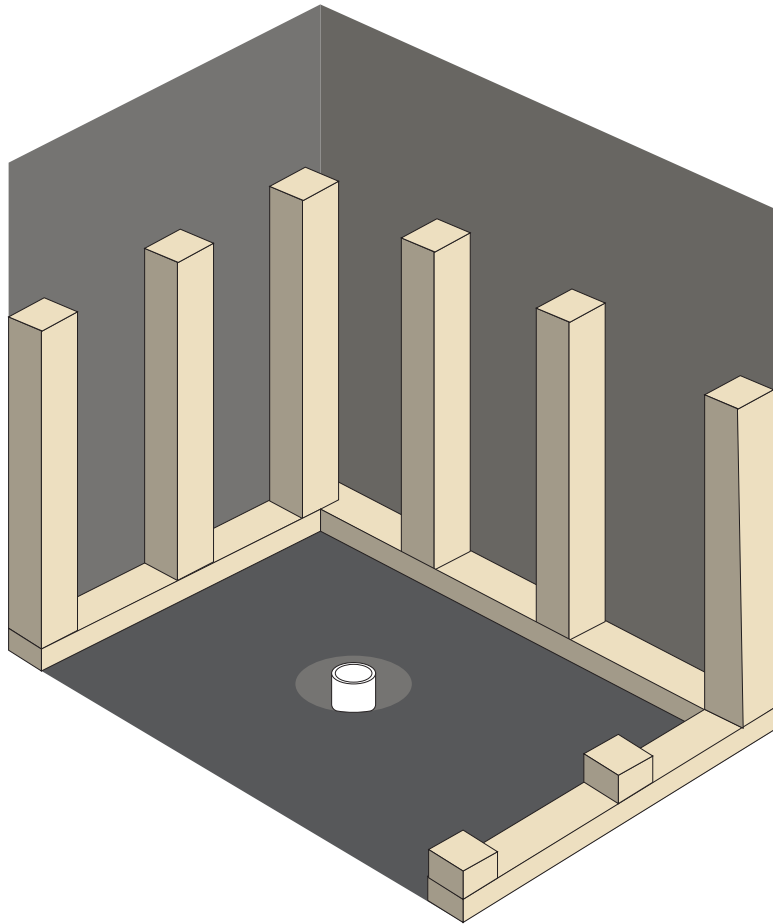
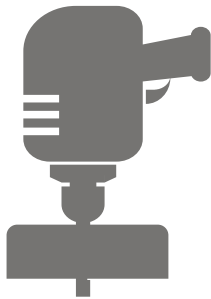
Mark the location of the drain outlet and the shower base.

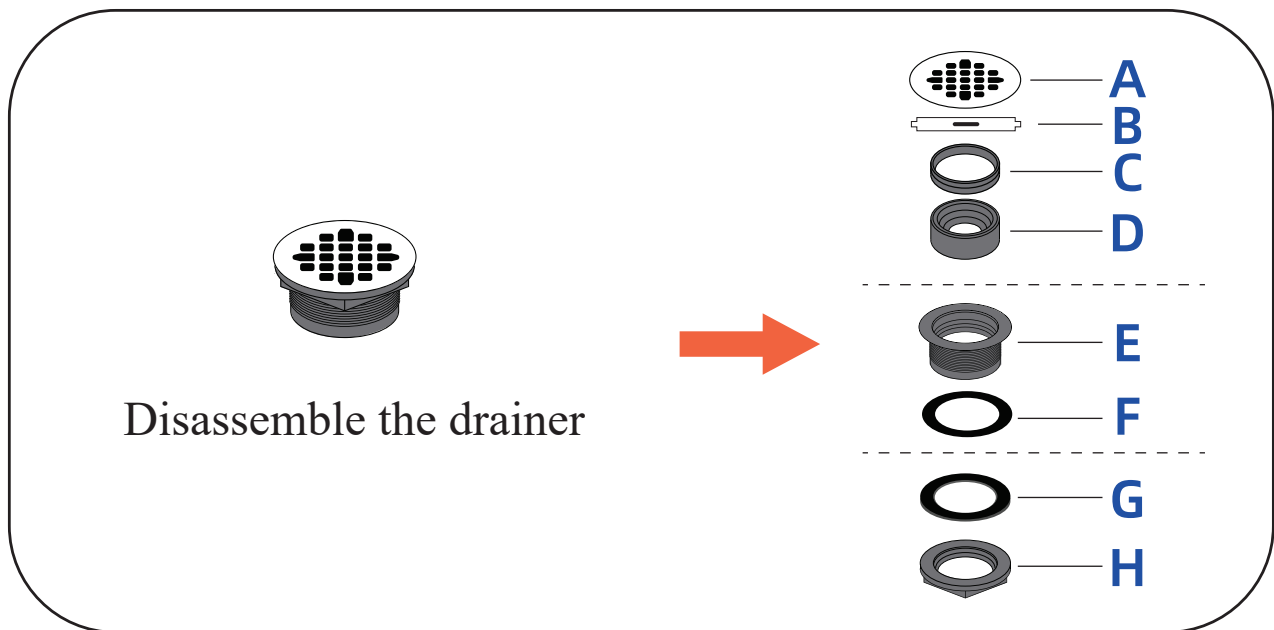


Step5

According to the marked drain location, cut a 10" × 10" opening in the subfloor.

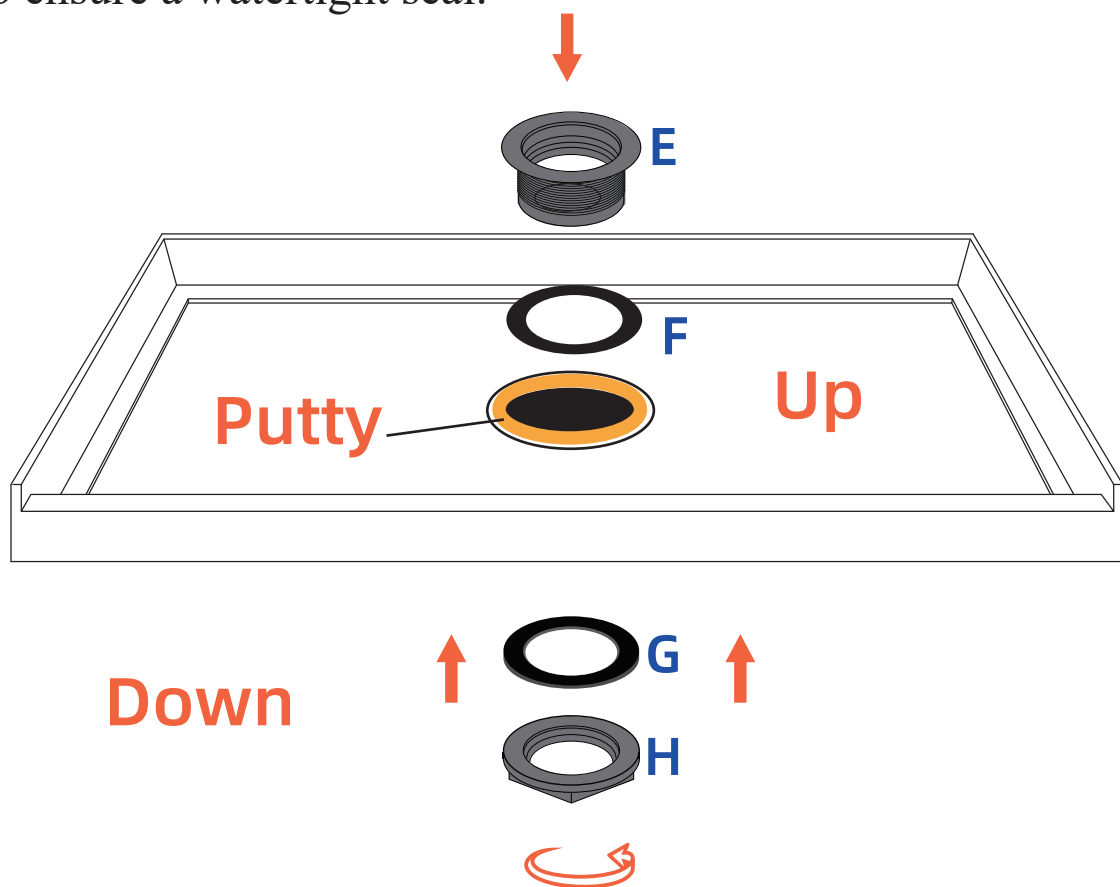
Leave 2–5 inches of clearance around the drain pipe for adjustment. Ensure the 2-inch waste pipe is centered within the opening and extends 2 inches above the floor.





Step6

According to the instructions, pre-install the drain assembly on the base. Apply plumber's putty under the drain flange before securing it to ensure a watertight seal.

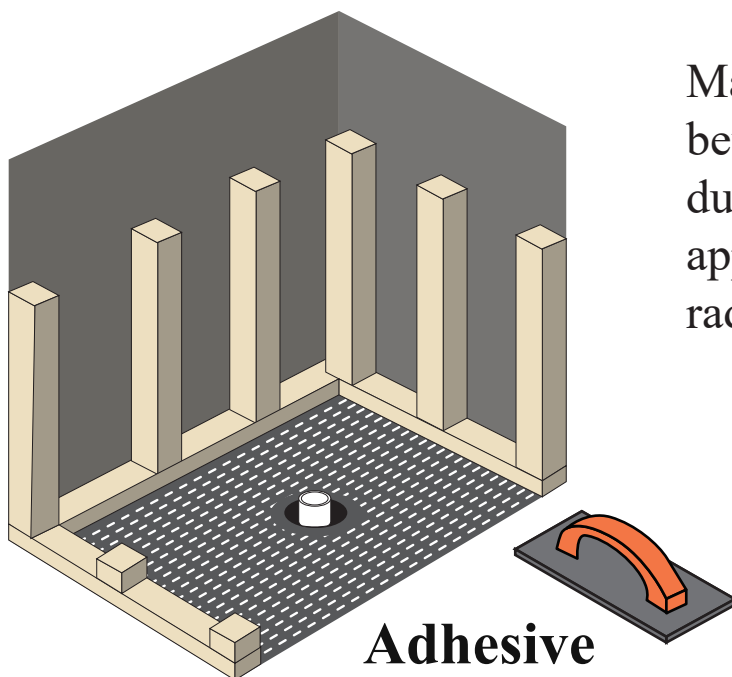
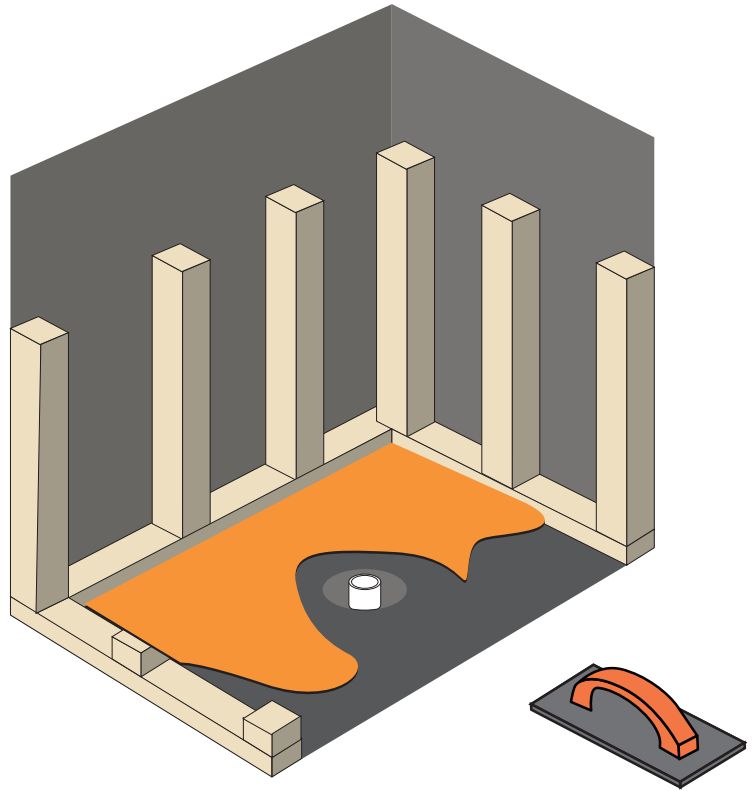


Step7

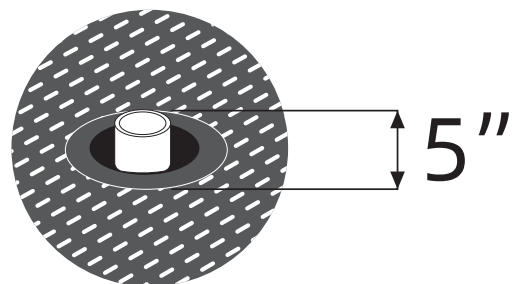
Apply a layer of thin-set mortar or construction adhesive to the area where the shower base will sit, use a notched trowel for even application.

Tips

To achieve better waterproofing, it is recommended to lay a layer of waterproofing material before applying the mortar.

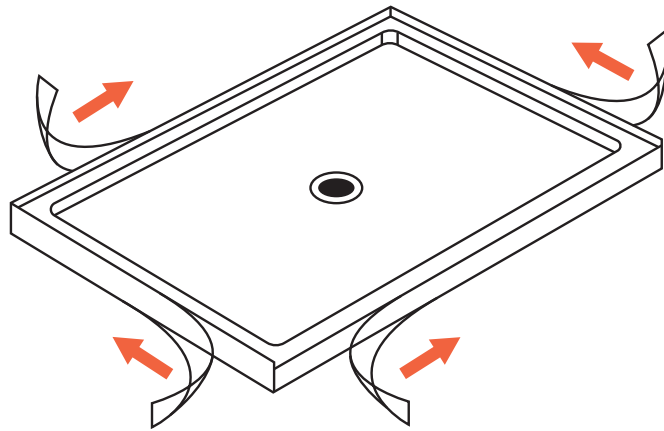


Make sure to avoid any contact between the adhesive and the drain during the installation process. Avoid applying adhesive within a 5-inch radius of the drain area.



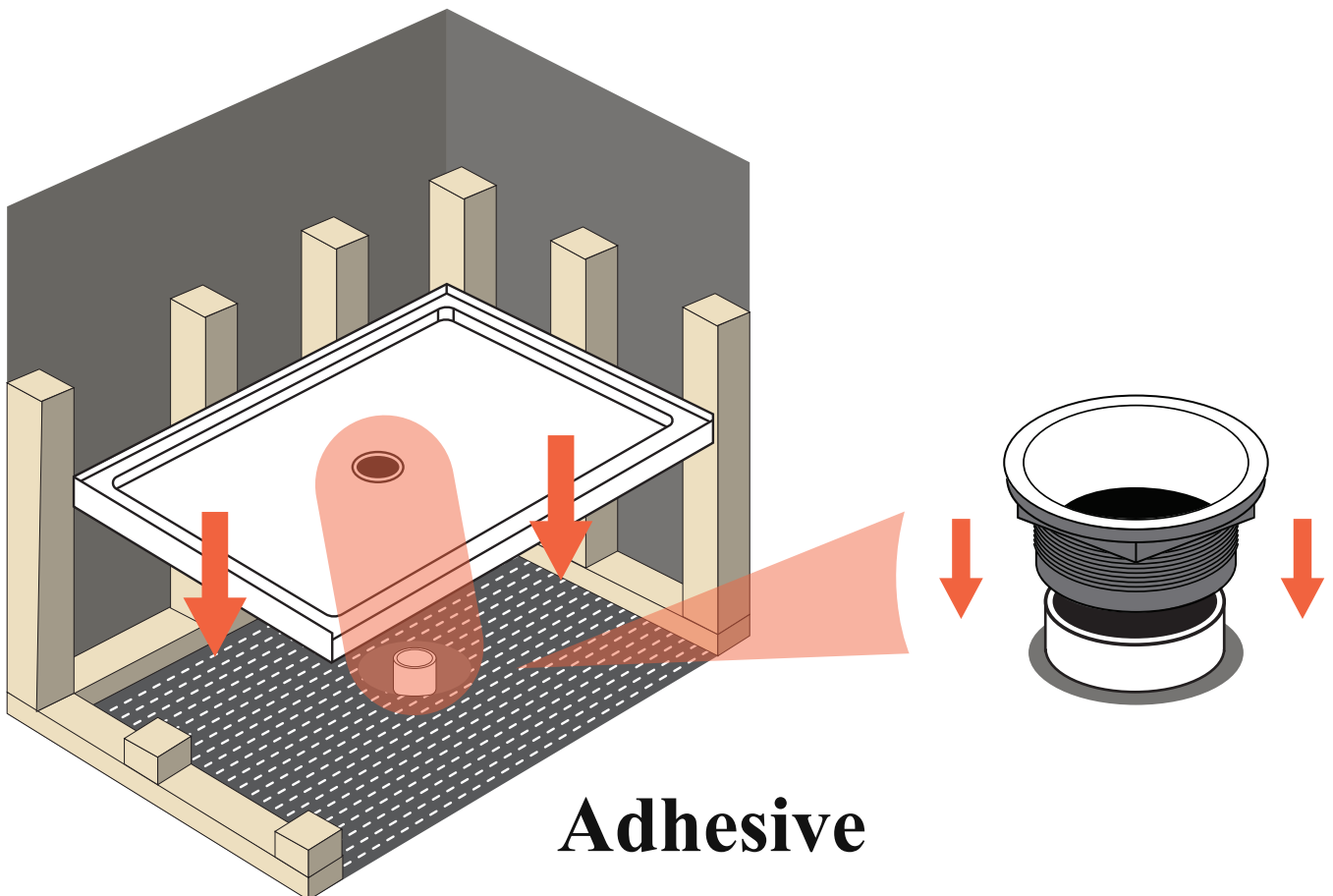
Step8

Peel off the transparent film on the edges.



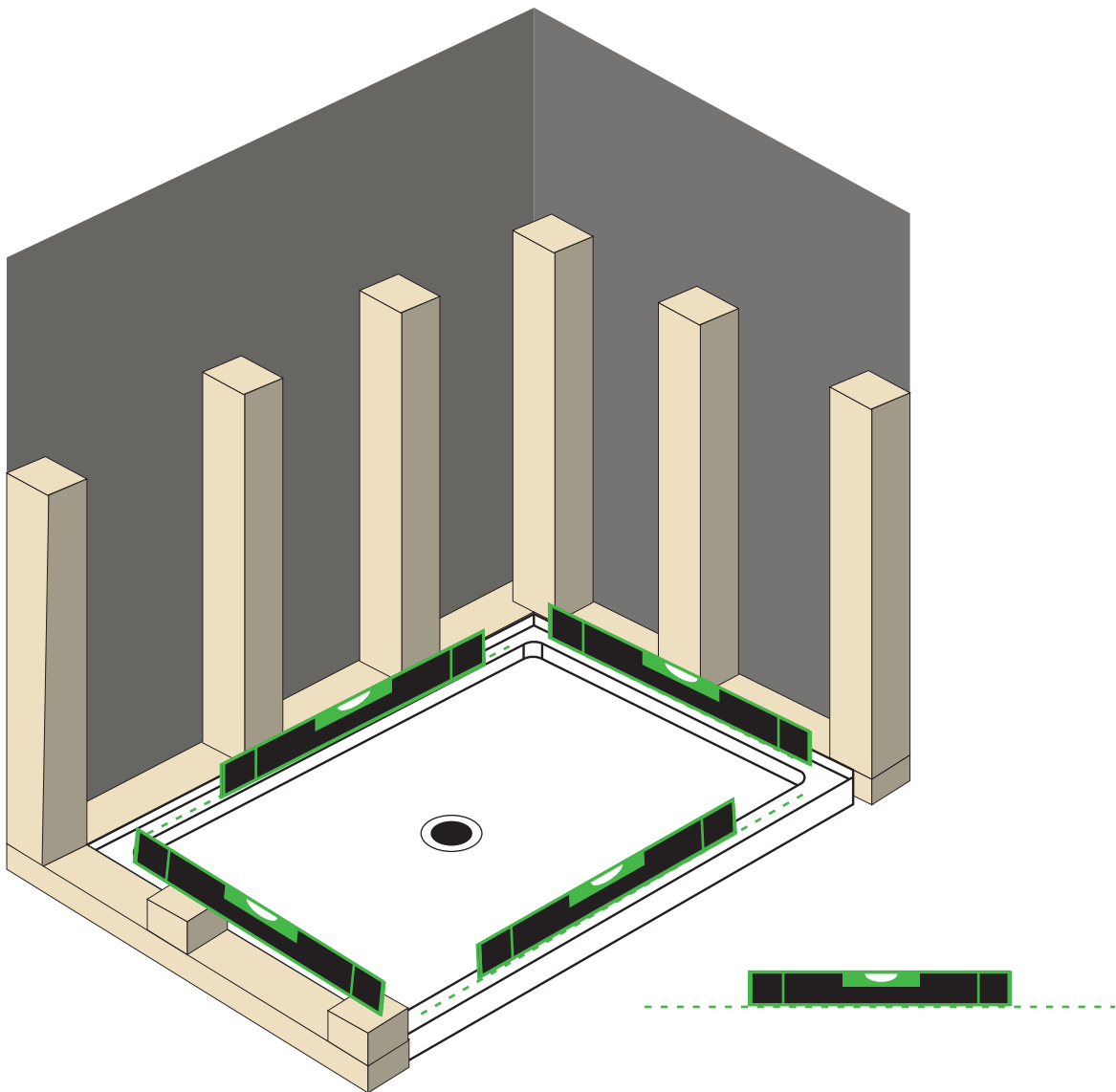
Carefully place the shower base onto the bedding material, pressing down firmly to ensure a good bond. Check again for levelness and adjust as needed.

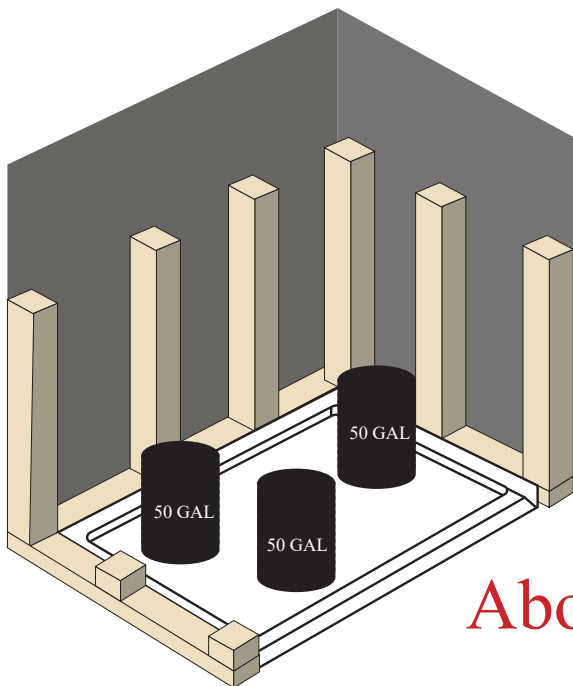
Connect the drain pipe beneath the floor to the drain assembly on the shower base.



Step9

Use the level to check that the 4 sides of the shower base are leveled. Make sure all sides are leveled. You might need to adjust the subfloor if it wobbles or is not flat.





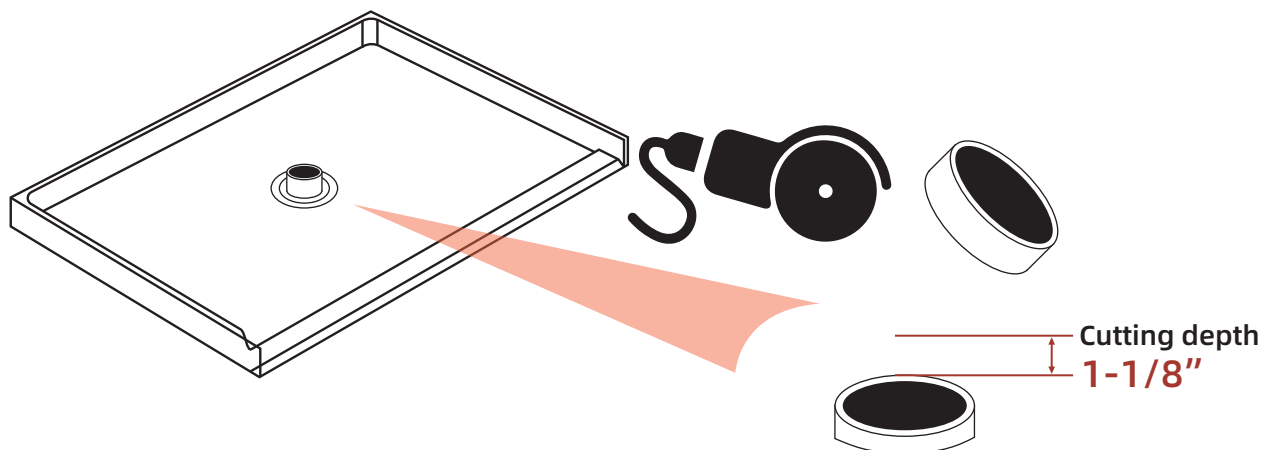
Step10

If shower base uneven, apply weight to any uneven areas and leave it in place for at least 4 hours or longer to ensure proper leveling.

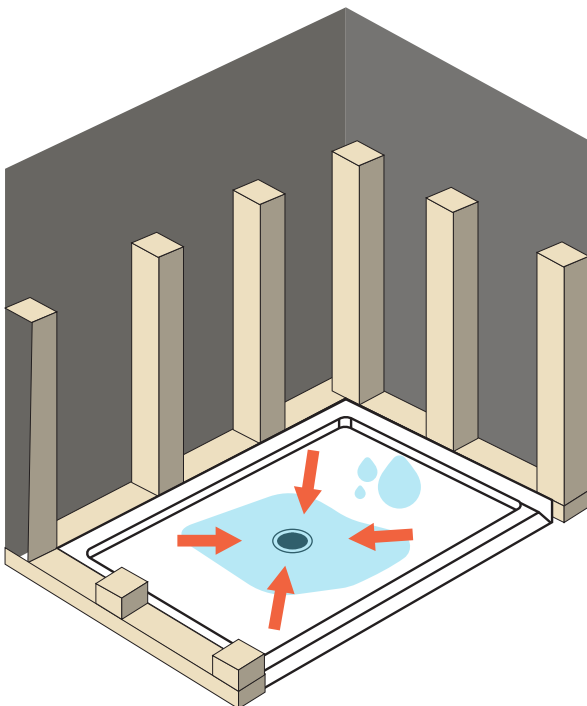
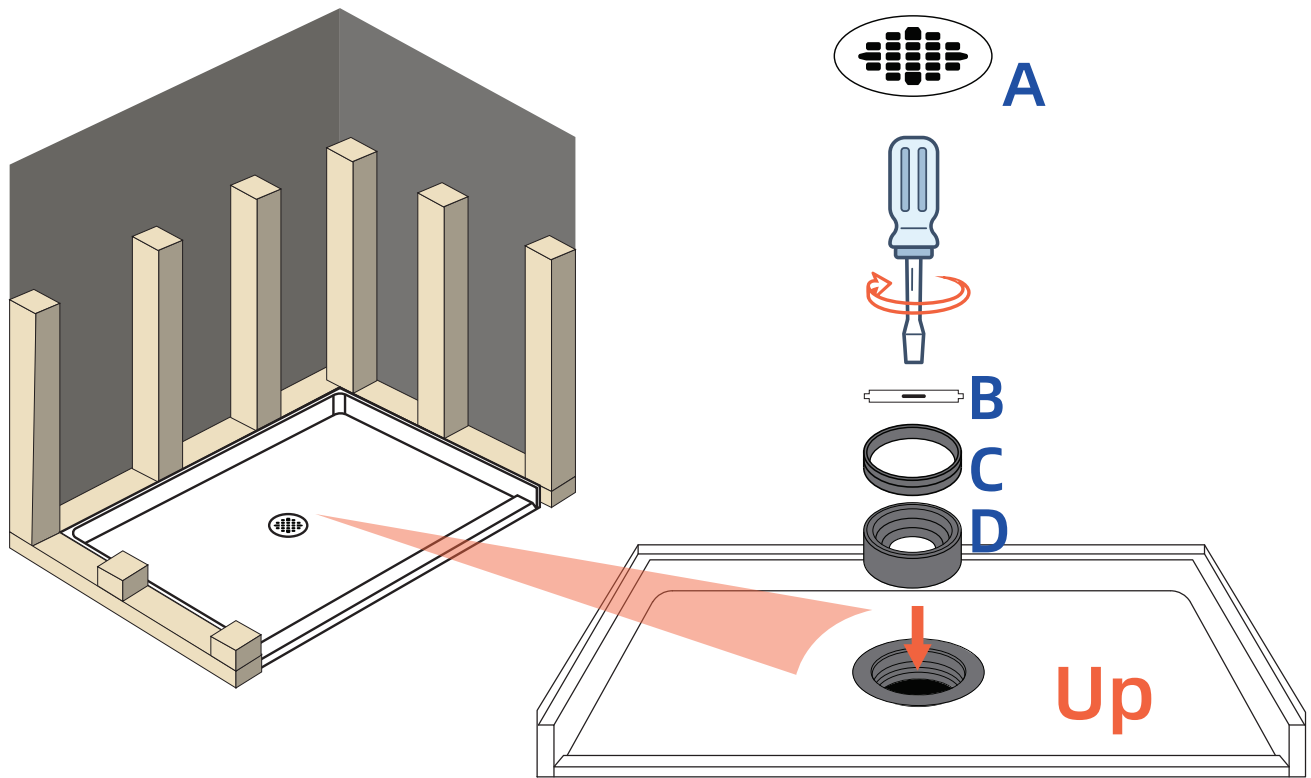
Remove the weights and check the drain opening. Cut the drain pipe so it is flush with the top of the rubber gasket using an inside pipe cutting tool.



Step12

Apply plumber's grease to the inside of the rubber gasket.
Slide the rubber gasket over the drain pipe with the beveled edge facing down.

Press firmly to ensure the gasket is fully seated and the drain connection is secure.

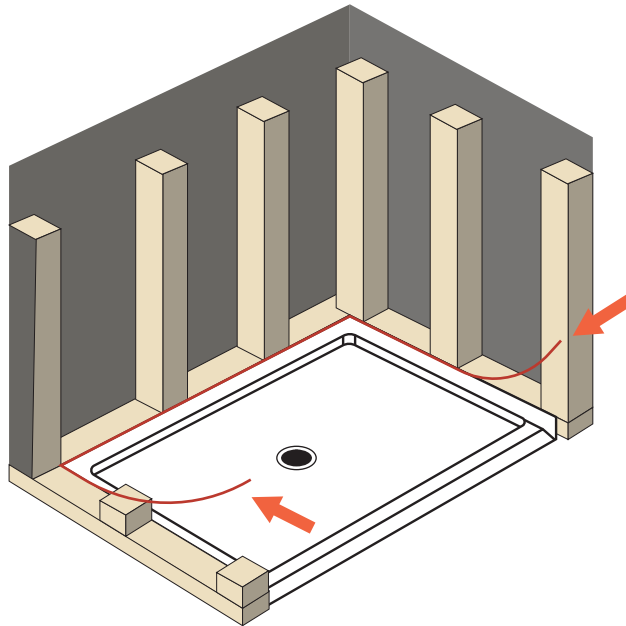


Step13

Test whether the drainage is smooth.

Step14

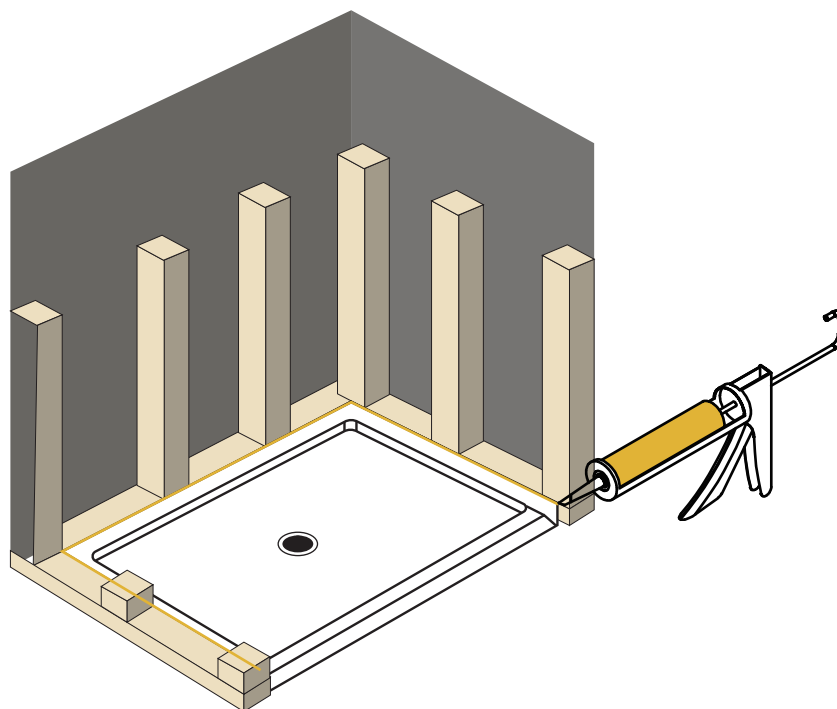
Peel off the red protective film.

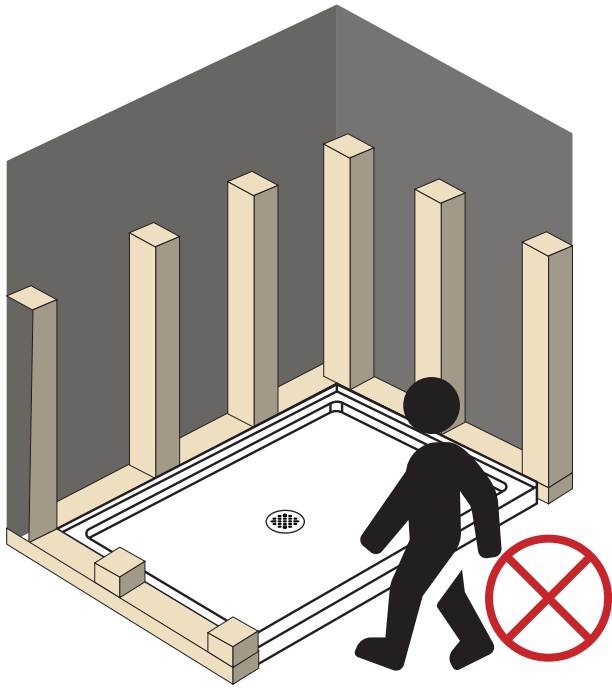


Step15

Wipe the edges clean.

Use Silicone Caulk to waterproof the three sides.

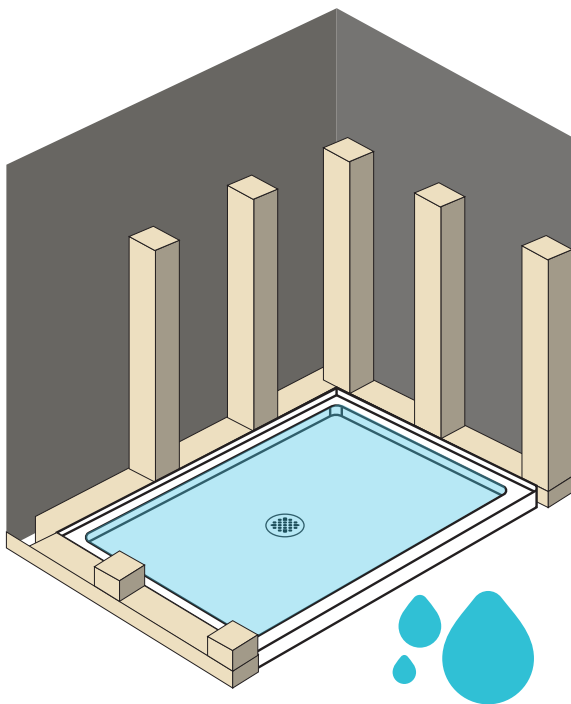

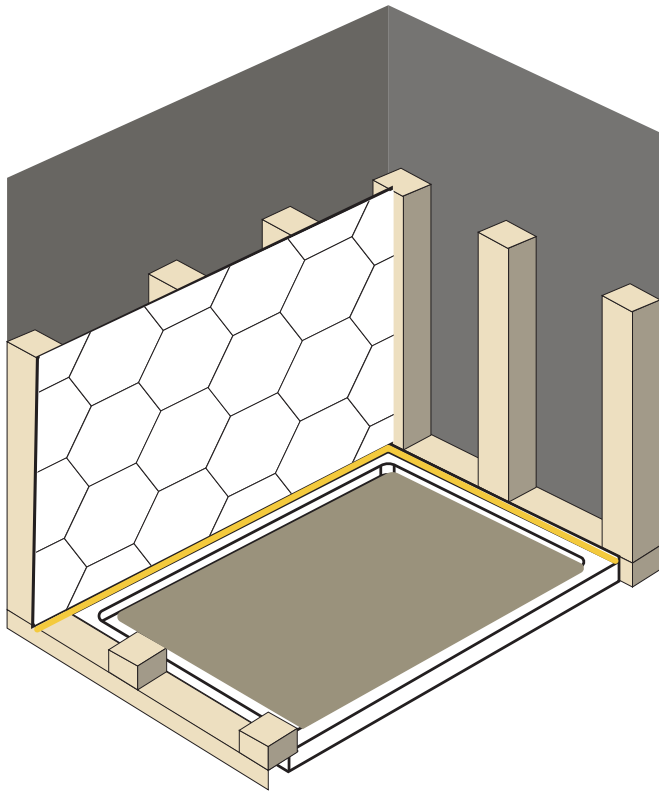
Step16

Allow your shower base to cure for at least 24 hours or follow the drying and curing times recommended by the adhesive and caulk manufacturers before placing any weight on the bottom of the shower base.



Step17

Water test for the drain and plumbing, plugged the drain, fill the shower base with a few inches of water, and check underneath the base, especially around the drain and seams, for any signs of water leakage, after letting the water sit for 30 mins, unplug the drain and ensure water drains properly without any abstraction.

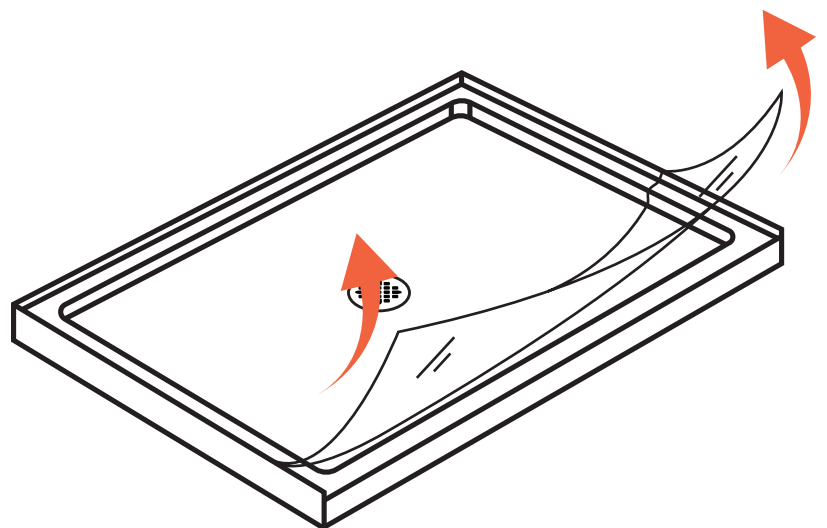
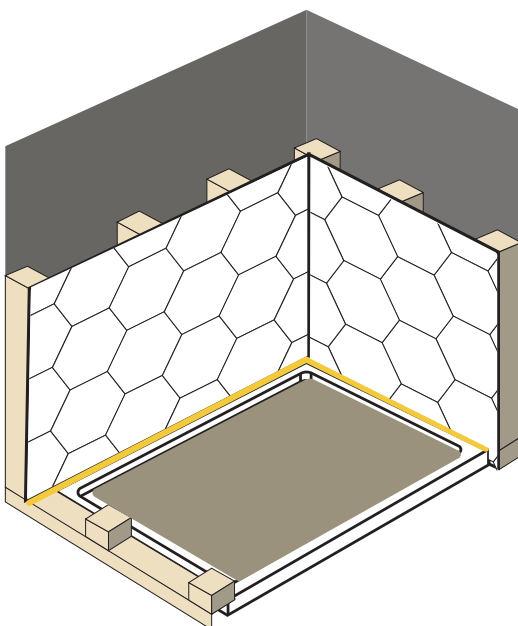


Step18

When decorating the walls, the surface of the shower base needs to be covered with other materials to prevent scratches.

Step19

Kindly Reminder: There is a transparent protective film on the base surface, please don't forget to tear it off before actual use.



CARE & MAINTACE

Maintaining an acrylic shower base is relatively easy and can help prolong its lifespan while keeping it looking good. Here are some effective maintenance tips:

1. Regular Cleaning:

- **Use Mild Cleaners:** Clean your acrylic shower base regularly with a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals, bleach, or abrasive scrubbers, as these can scratch or damage the surface.
- **Soft Cloth or Sponge:** Use a soft cloth, sponge, or a non-abrasive scrub pad for cleaning. This will help prevent scratches while effectively removing soap scum and dirt.
- **Rinse After Use:** After each shower, rinse the base with warm water to remove any soap residue and prevent buildup.

2. Preventing Soap Scum and Hard Water Stains:

- **Squeegee After Use:** Use a squeegee to wipe down the walls and shower base after each use. This can help minimize water spots, soap scum, and mineral deposits.
- **Dry the Area:** After squeegeeing, use a soft towel to dry the surface if possible, reducing the moisture that promotes soap scum and mold.

3. Addressing Stains:

- **Baking Soda Paste:** For tough stains, create a paste with baking soda and water, apply it to the stain, let it sit for a few minutes, and then gently scrub with a soft cloth or sponge.
- **Vinegar Solution:** A mixture of equal parts water and white vinegar can help remove hard water stains. Spray the solution on the affected area, let it sit for a few minutes, then rinse and wipe clean.

4. Avoiding Damage:

- **No Abrasive Tools:** Avoid using steel wool or harsh scrubbing pads, as they can scratch the acrylic surface.
- **Hot Items:** Never place hot items directly on the acrylic surface, as extreme heat can cause warping or damage.
- **Avoid Heavy Impacts:** Be cautious not to drop heavy objects onto the shower base, as this can cause cracks or dents.

5. Check for Cracks or Damage:

- **Regular Inspections:** Periodically inspect the shower base for any signs of cracks, chips, or discoloration. If you notice damage, address it promptly to prevent further issues.
- **Repair Kits:** If you find a small crack or chip, consider using an acrylic repair kit specifically designed for fixing minor damage to acrylic surfaces.

6. Maintain Surrounding Areas:

- **Seal Grout Joints:** If your shower base is part of an enclosed unit with tile walls, make sure the grout joints are sealed to prevent moisture from seeping behind and causing damage.
- **Check Caulking:** Regularly inspect the caulking around the shower base. If you notice it cracking or peeling, remove the old caulk and reapply new silicone caulk to prevent water leakage.

7. Use a Shower Mat:

- **Non-Slip Mat:** Consider using a non-slip shower mat or rug in your shower to protect the base from scratches and provide added traction.

8. Avoiding Heavy Cleaning:

- **Limit Strong Chemicals:** Avoid using harsh chemicals, bleaches, or products containing alcohol or ammonia, as these can degrade the acrylic over time.

LIMITED WARRANTY COVERAGE

1 YEARS LIMITED WARRANTY

GETPRO products are made with quality materials and excellent craftsmanship to provide the customers a long-lasting product. In the case of any defects in materials or craftsmanship under regular use were inspected in the first one year of delivery, GETPRO will provide replacement parts at no charge, or at its option, replace any product or part of the product that is deemed defective, under normal installation, use, service and maintenance. This warranty applies only to the original purchaser. Proof of purchase will be required in the case of a claim.

GETPRO will, as its option

- (1) Repair or replace the defective part(s) or product(s) at no charge;
- (2) Issue a refund of the original purchase price of the product(s) (Valid within 30 days from the date of delivery);
- (3) Issue a credit to be applied toward the purchase of a new GETPRO product shipping/delivery charges may apply and are in GETPRO's sole discretion.

This limited warranty shall not apply to goods that have been subject to accident, negligence, improper installation, product abuse, product misuse, or use of cleaners containing abrasives, alcohol or other organic solvents, whether performed by a contractor, service company, or yourself, are excluded from this warranty.

GETPRO responsibility under this limited warranty is limited to only to replacement parts and no other costs.

GETPRO will not be responsible for labor charges and/or damage incurred by installation, repair, or replacement, nor for any indirect incidental or consequential damages, losses, injury, or costs of any nature relating to this product.
