Using Camlocks

Connect the male camlock as directed in the assemble instructions using a scwdriver.

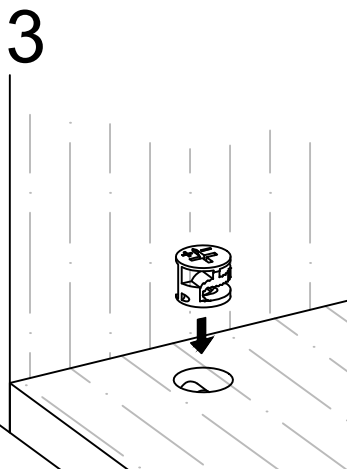


Push the male camlock into the entry hole.



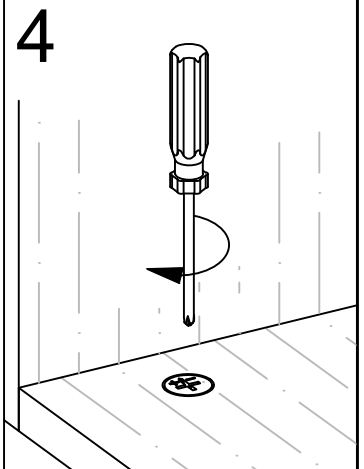
Insert the female camlock as shown in the instruction.

Note: ensure that the arrow on the top of the camlock points towards the entry hole for the male camlock.

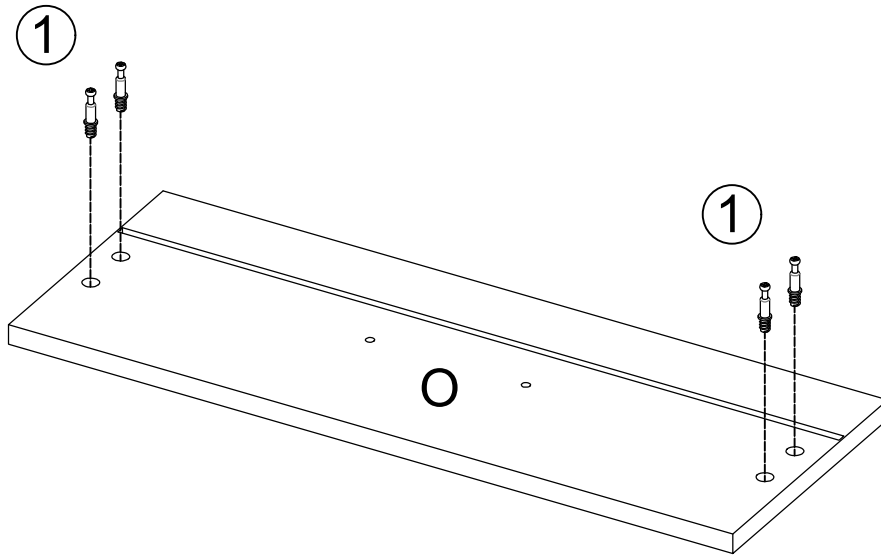


Turn the female camlock clockwise with a scwdriver. You should feel a click when the camlock is locked in place.

The joint is now secure.

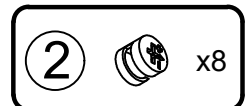
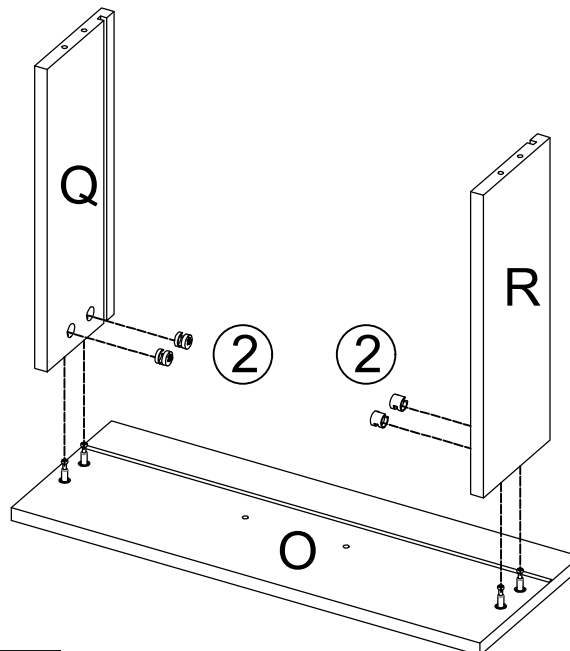

Cam Lock Fastening System

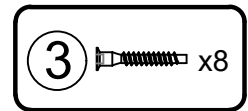
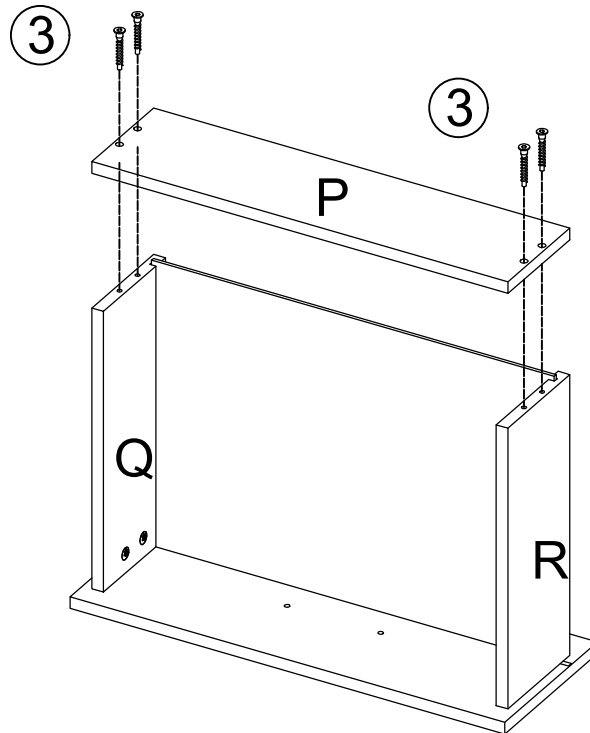
Please point the arrow upward to the mounting hole when installing Part ②. then use screwdriver to tighten it in the "+" direction.
