### **Charleston Mailbox System** Build Instructions

## ADDRESSES OF DISTINCTION MAILBOXES + STREET SIGNS, BUILT TO LAST.

Tools Required: phillips head screw driver, 7/16" wrench or pliers, and allen key.

#### STEP 1

Place (2) Number Plate Screws through the top of the Number Plate. Slide the (2) Small Rubber Washers onto the bolts. Place the bolts through the pre-drilled holes on top of the Mailbox. Open the mailbox and tighen the (2) Wing Nuts onto the bolts. See Illustration A1


#### STEP 2 (Fig 1)


Position the Mounting Plate on top of the Charleston Bracket. Insert (4) 1/4 - 20 x 3/4" Screws through the bottom of decorative base into mounting plate and fasten to the bracket with (4) 1/4" Lock Washers and (4) 1/4" Hex Nuts. See Illustration A2


#### STEP 4 (Fig 2)

Finish the look of your mailbox by sliding the 2 1/2" Charleston Base onto the bottom of the post. Insert the 2 1/2" Pineapple Finial on top of the post and secure with (1) 1/4" - 20 x 1/4" Set Screw. Secure the base with (3) 1/4" - 20 x 3/8" Set Screws after system is installed. Place (1) 3" Hex Bolt near bottom of pole to secure in concrete. Your mailbox is ready to be installed in the ground.






#### Charleston Mailbox System

#### STEP 3 (Fig 2)

Attach the decorative bracket and mounting plate assembly from Step 2 to the 2 1/2" Post using (2) 3" Hex Bolts. Attach the mailbox to the mounting plate using (4) Type A Screws. Insert the screws into the corresponding predrilled holes on the sides of mailbox and mounting plate.

#### Do you install with concrete?

All mailboxes installed by Addresses of Distinction are installed using concrete. We warranty all installations for a period of one year. When your mailbox is installed, please wait 24 hours before applying pressure to the post, as it takes some time for the concrete to fully cure.
