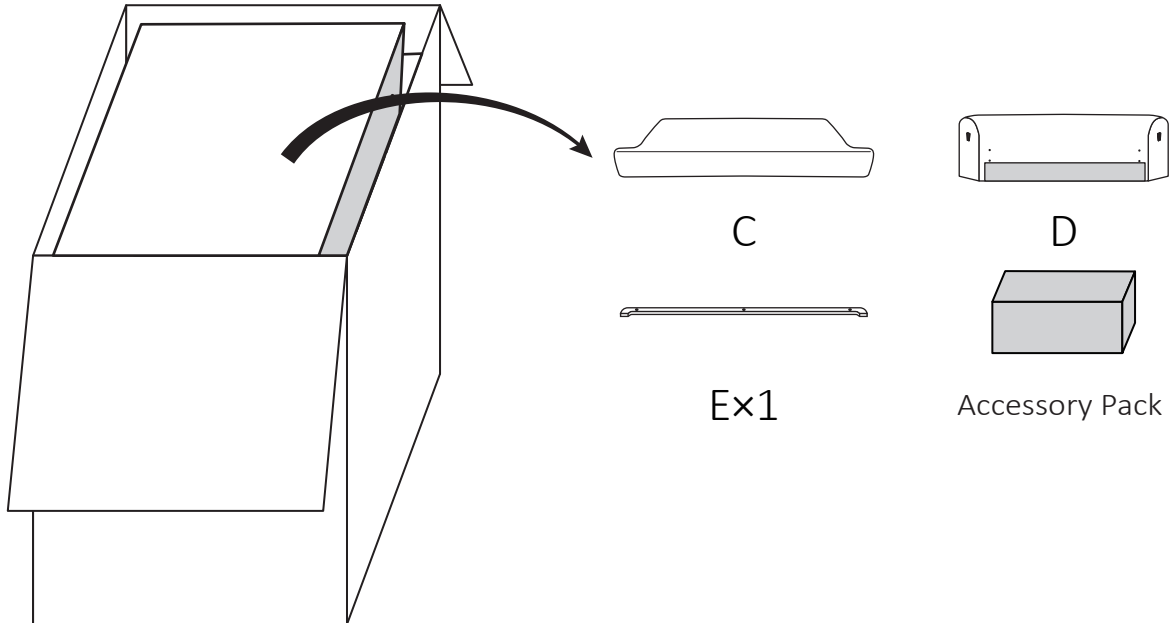
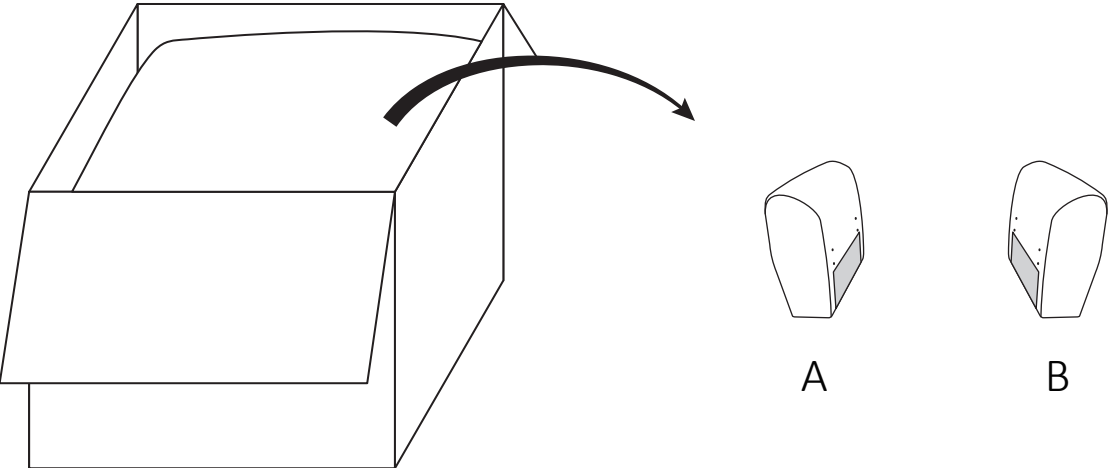
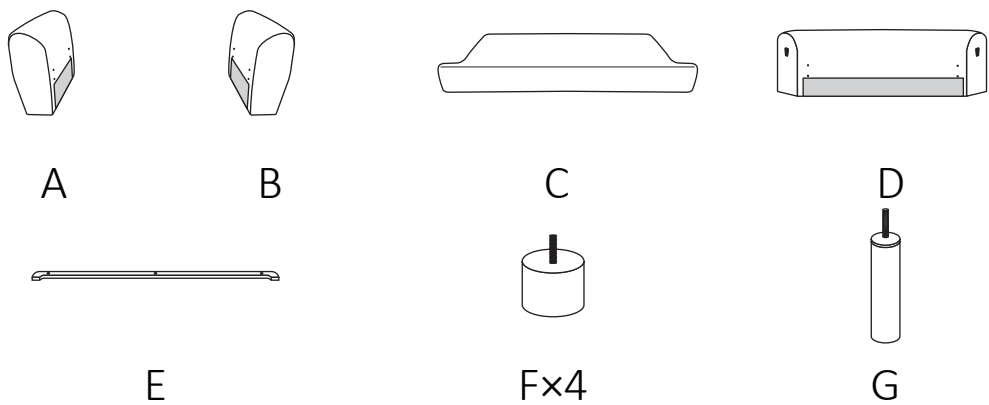
Assembly Steps

Overview

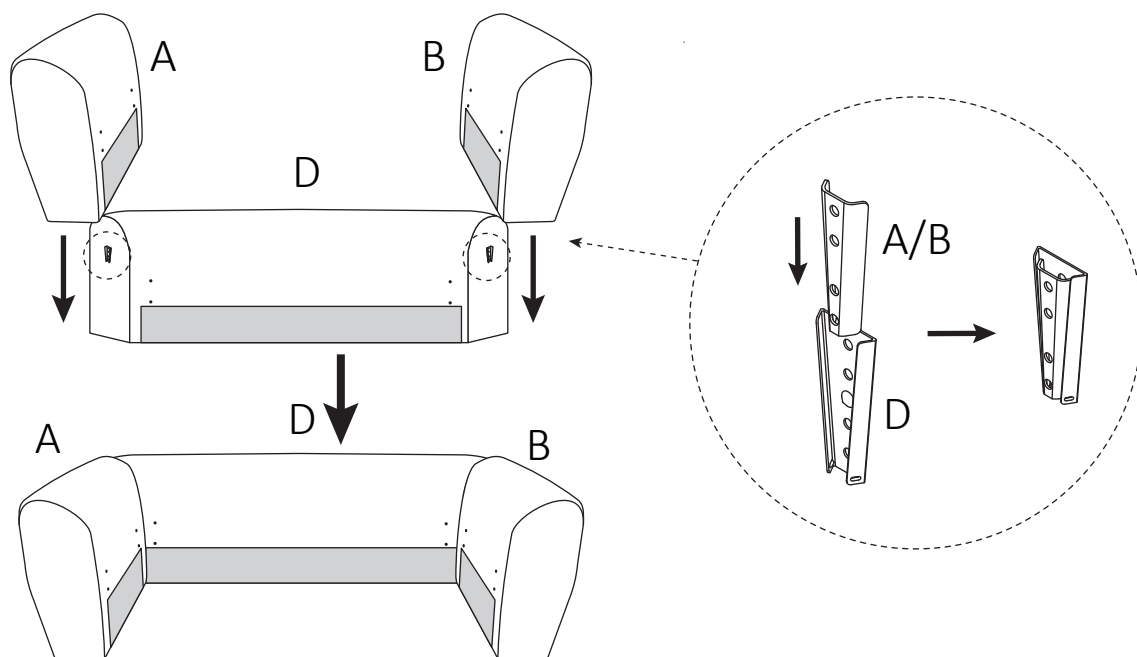


This sofa has multiple parts and may require up to 45 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the 3 Seater Sofa parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions herebelow to familiarise the parts and steps before assembly.

Note: It is recommended that you have an adult partner to assist during the entire assembly process.

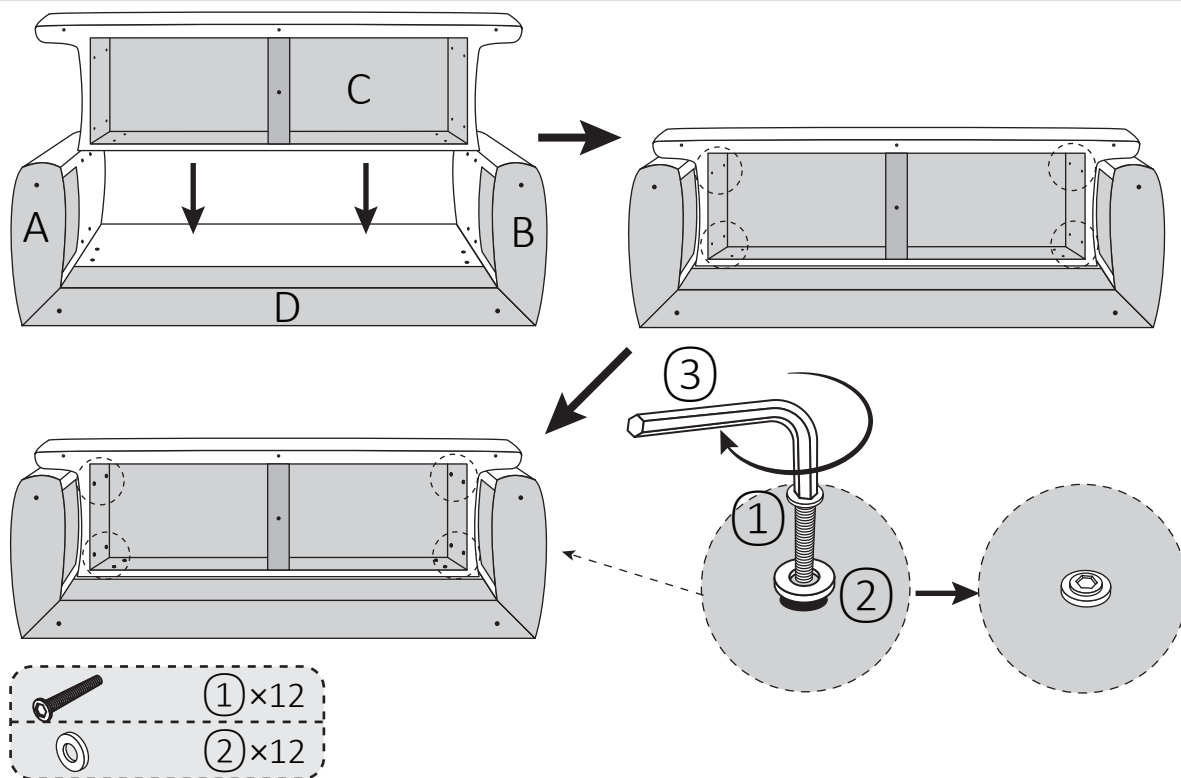
Step 1	
Take out the Sofa Base (C), Backrest (D), Bottom Trim (E) and Accessory Pack from the Carton "2-1", cut open the Accessory Pack to take out the Sofa Leg (F), Center Leg (G), Long Screws (①), Washer (②) and Allen Wrench (③) place them on a clean, non-marring surface.	
Step 2	
Take out the Left Armrest (A) and Right Armrest (B) from the Carton "2-2", place them on a clean, non-marring surface.	
Step 3	
Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.	

Step 4



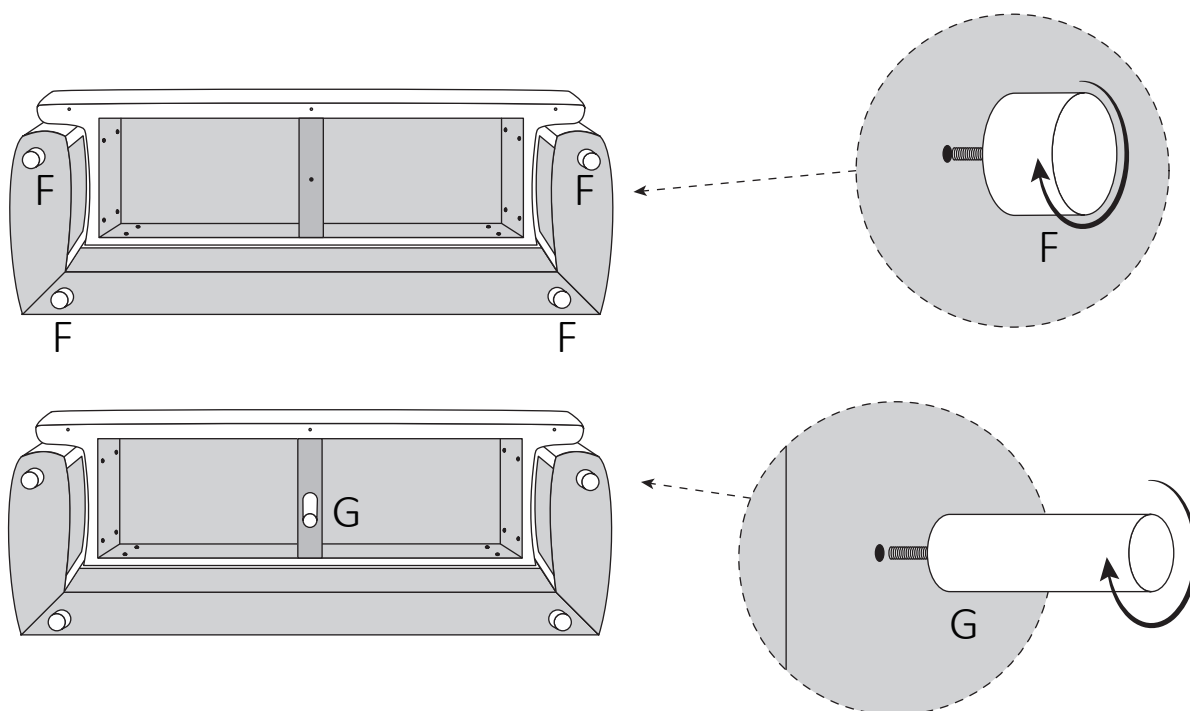
First, place the Backrest (D) vertically on a cushioned surface. Then, align the Left Armrest (A) and Right Armrest (B) closely against the Backrest (D), insert them vertically downward, and use the trapezoidal connectors on all three parts to secure them together.

Step 5



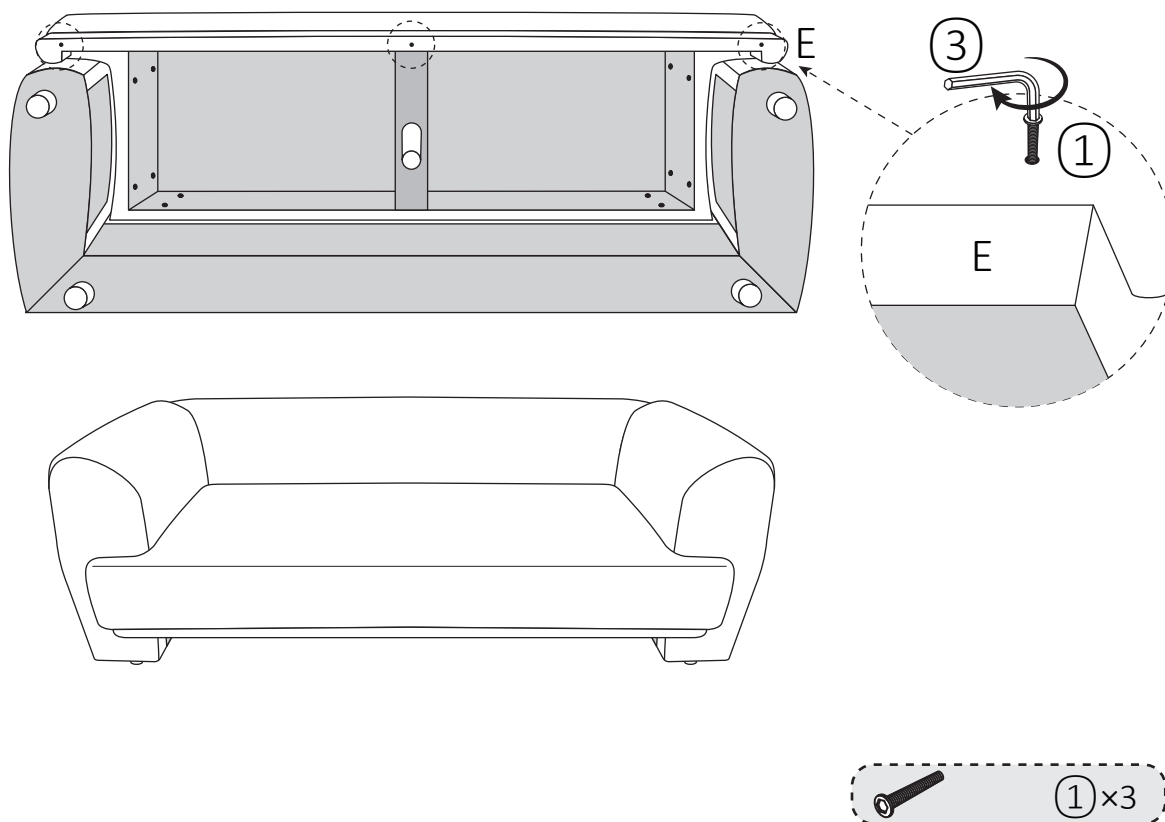
First, lay the assembled components from the previous step down so that their bottom faces forward. Then, place the Sofa Base (C) downward onto this assembly. Align the holes of both parts, and use Long Screws (①) and Washers (②) to install them into the corresponding holes, connecting the two parts. When tightening the Long Screws (①), do not fully tighten them initially; wait until all holes are installed before fully tightening them.

Step 6



Following the previous step, rotate and install the Sofa Leg (F) and Center Leg (G) onto the bottom of the aforementioned assembly, as shown in the diagram.

Step 7



Following the previous step, align the Bottom Trim (E) with the edge of the Sofa Base (C) and match their holes as shown in the diagram. Hold the Bottom Trim (E) in place by hand, then secure it using Long Screws (①) to complete the entire installation.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
