- 5.Do not place hot appliances, such as curling irons and hot hair dryers directly on the countertop. Wipe spills immediately.

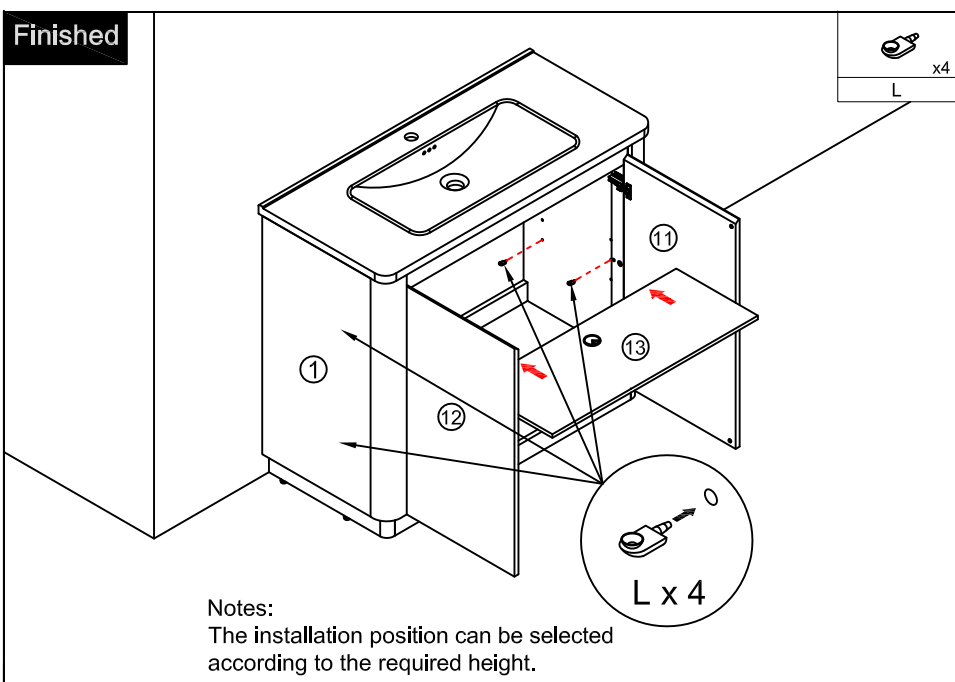

Installation instructions for combination cabinet skirting board

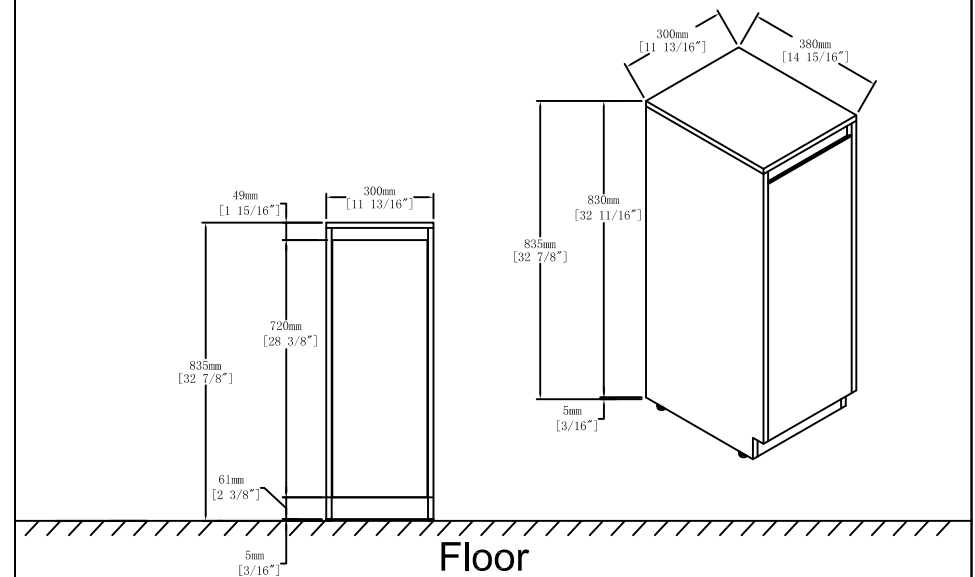
When two main cabinets are combined with one middle cabinet, a No. 10 wooden board can be added to the bottom of the middle cabinet as needed, and glass glue can be applied according to the diagram for bonding.



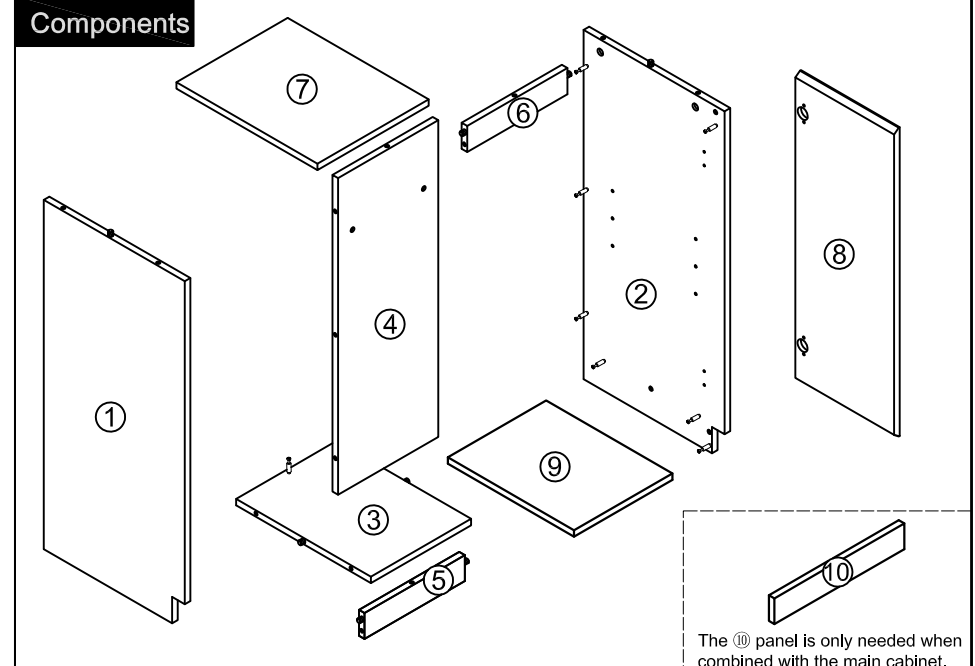
When combining a single main cabinet and an intermediate cabinet, the length of the bottom skirting board can be cut according to the actual length, and it is recommended to shorten it by 25mm.



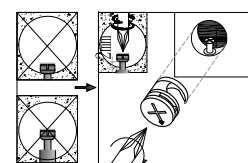
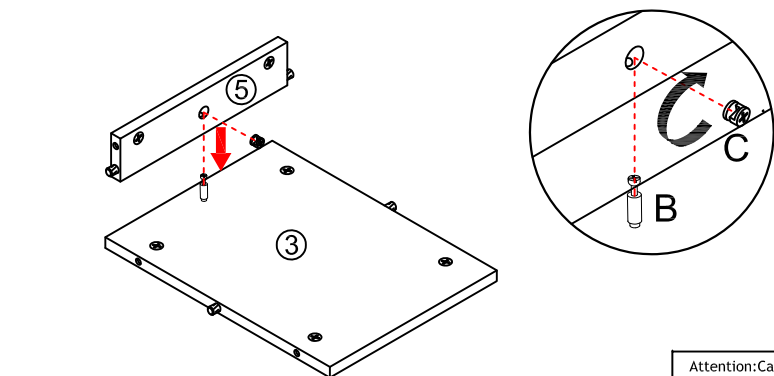
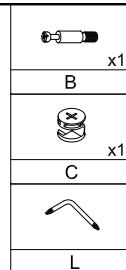

Note: The opening direction of the door panel can be installed as left or right according to one's own needs.

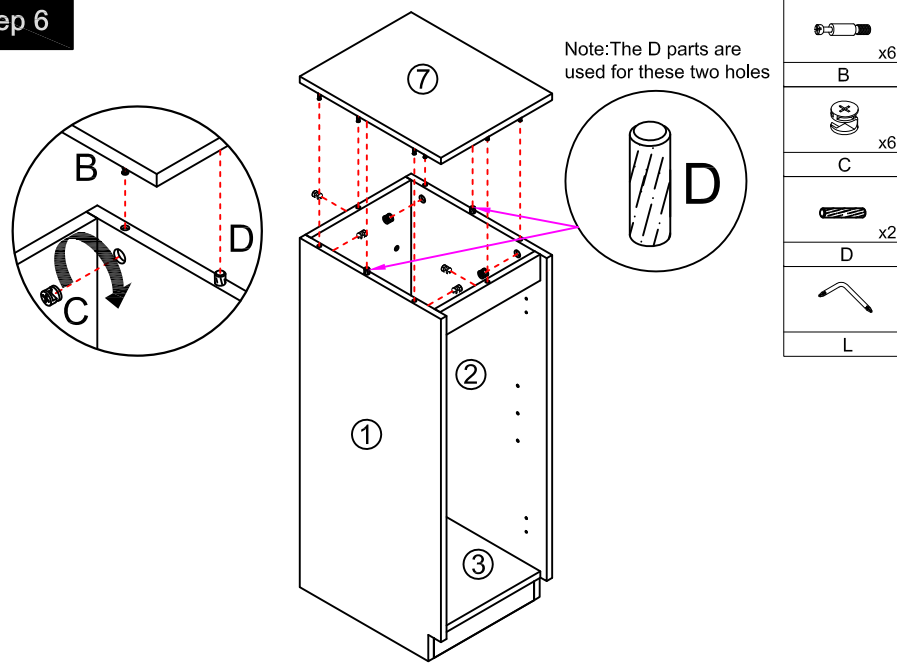

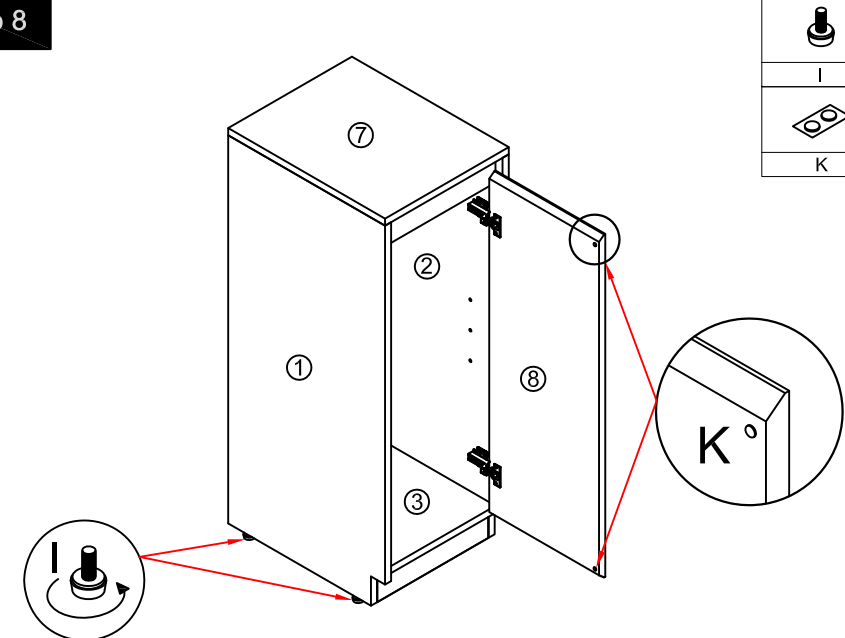
