







Please avoid placing your table close to radiators or other direct sources of heat.
Avoid leaving heavy items on your table as it may cause the top to move under the application of continuous weight.
The table is not suitable for use in humid environments or outdoors.
It is best to avoid exposing your furniture to continued bright sunlight as it can affect the colour. Any fluid spills should be removed as quickly as possible.
Always lift your table when moving as dragging may cause damage to your furniture or flooring.

AFTER CARE

Wipe the surfaces with a damp cloth and an occasional use of a normal household furniture polish. Please do not use detergents, bleach or chemicals on your furniture.
RETAIN THE ALLEN KEY PROVIDED TO TIGHTEN THE LEGS OCCASIONALLY. Do not stand or step on this table.
Ensure your table sits evenly on your floor by adjusting the levellers whenever necessary.

BUILD YOUR FURNITURE ON A SOFT CLEAN COVER TO AVOID COMPONENTS BEING MARKED OR DAMAGED DURING ASSEMBLY.

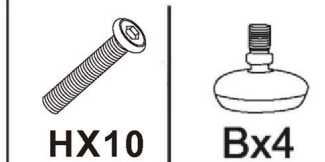
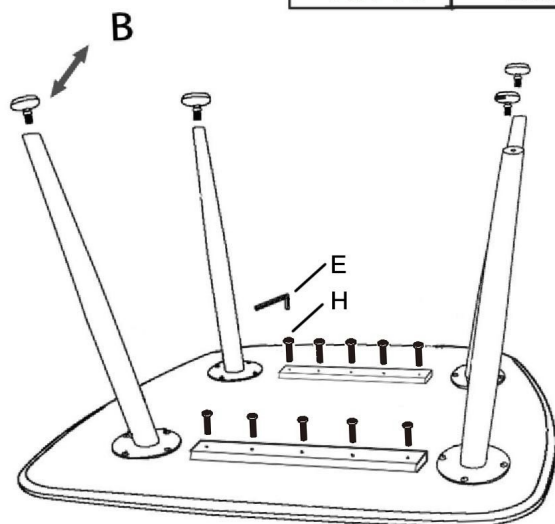
Place your table top on to a smooth clean surface.

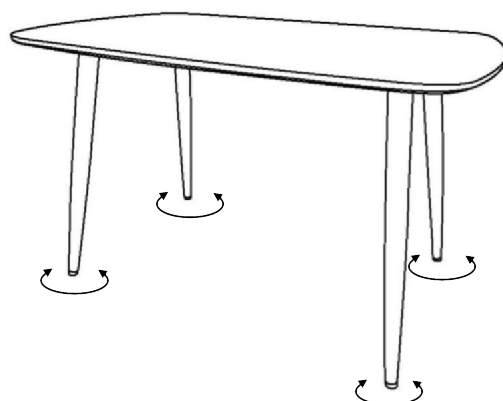
Insert bolts D into the corresponding holes in the underside of the tabletop, do not fully tighten. Once all

Affix 2 steel support bars using bolts provided into the corresponding holes in the underside of the table top, do not fully tighten. Once all bolts are inserted then fully tighten each bolt. Affix adjustable feet into the end of each leg do not fully tighten

Carefully with two people lift and turn the table onto its legs, place the table into the correct position within your room, if required adjust the levellers by turning until your table sits evenly on the floor. Do not drag or push the table when moving, it must be
