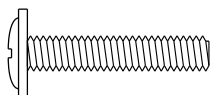
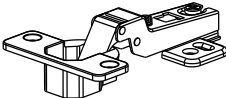
Assembly Tips

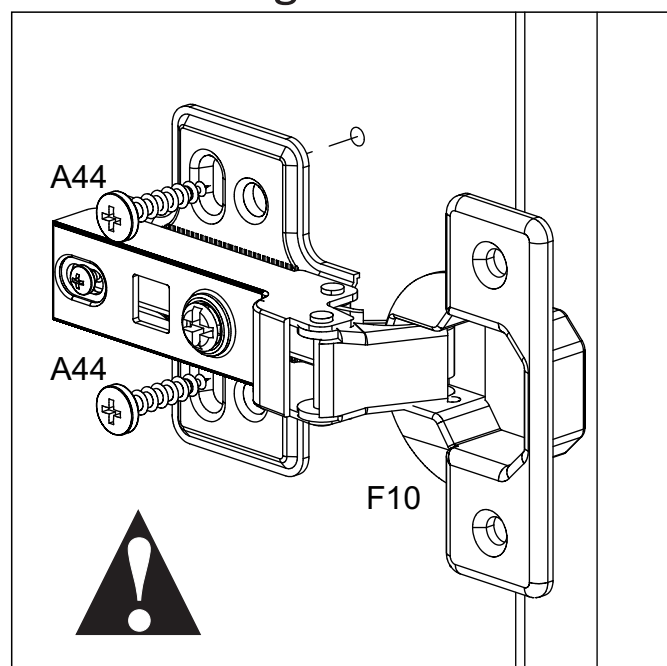
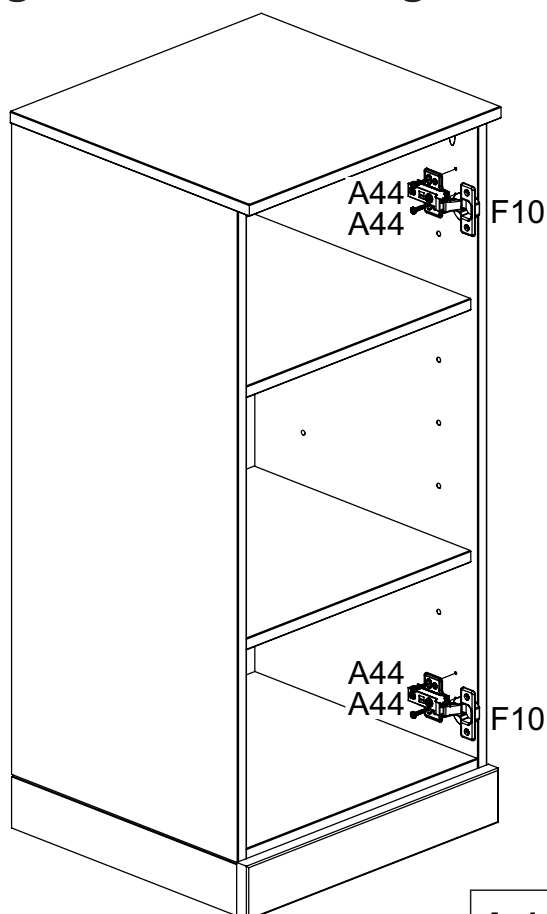
If the hinge (F10) is detached, attach it to the hinge plate by aligning and pushing it in until it clicks securely into place.



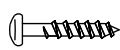
