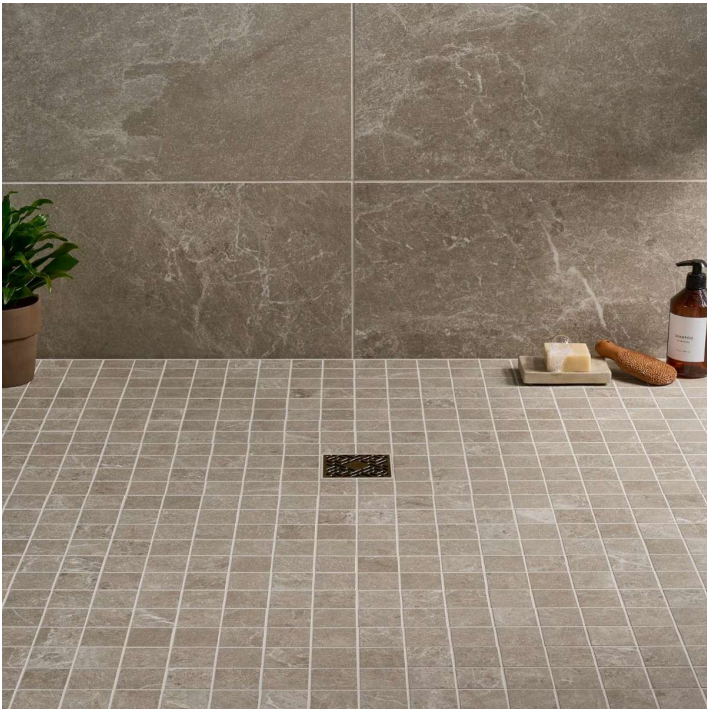


ZENTECH GREIGE BEIGE 2X2 MATTE PORCELAIN MOSAIC TILE

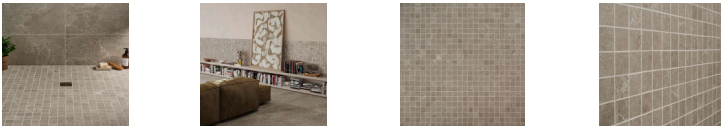
