

3-Light Gold Ceiling Spotlight Installation Guide

SAFETY WARNING

Always turn off the main power supply before installation!
Installation by a licensed professional electrician is highly recommended.
Ensure the use of voltage and bulbs that comply with local standards.

Tools Required

Phillips Screwdriver
Wire Strippers
Electrical Tape & Wire Nuts

Installation Steps

Step 1: Turn Off Power

Go to the main circuit breaker panel and turn off the power to the installation area.

Step 2: Install the Mounting Bracket

1. Unscrew the decorative nuts on the sides of the canopy to remove the mounting bracket.
2. Pass the supply wires through the center hole of the bracket. Secure the mounting bracket to the ceiling junction box using screws.

Step 3: Connect the Wires

Connect the fixture wires to the supply wires using wire nuts. (US market standard color coding):

(Live): Black wire to Black (Live) supply wire.

(Neutral): White wire to White (Neutral) supply wire.

(Ground): Green or bare copper wire to the supply ground wire.

Ensure connections are wrapped with electrical tape for safety.

Step 4: Mount the Fixture

Tuck all wires neatly into the junction box. Lift the fixture, align the holes on the canopy with the screws on the mounting bracket, and secure it by tightening the decorative nuts on both sides.

Step 5: Install the Bulbs

Insert compatible bulbs (GU10 type) into the three cylindrical light heads and secure them.

Step 6: Adjust the Lighting Angle

Gently rotate and tilt the cylindrical spotlight heads to direct the light exactly where you need it (e.g., artwork, tables, or walls).

Step 7: Restore Power and Test

Turn on the power at the circuit breaker and the wall switch to test if the fixture works properly.

Maintenance Tips:

Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the gold finish. DO NOT use chemical cleaners or abrasive materials, as they may damage the protective coating.
