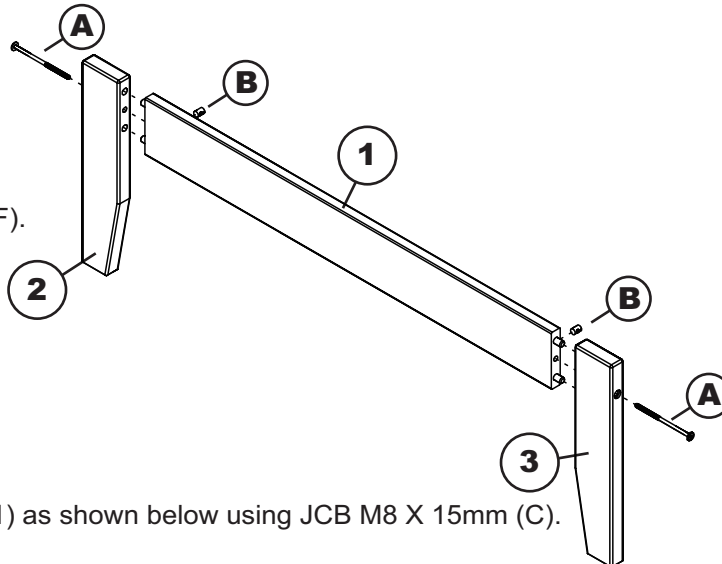

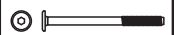

Step 1

Attach the legs (2) and (3) to foot rail (1), using JCB M6 X 110mm (A) and barrel nut (B).
Tighten with the Allen wrench M4 (F).

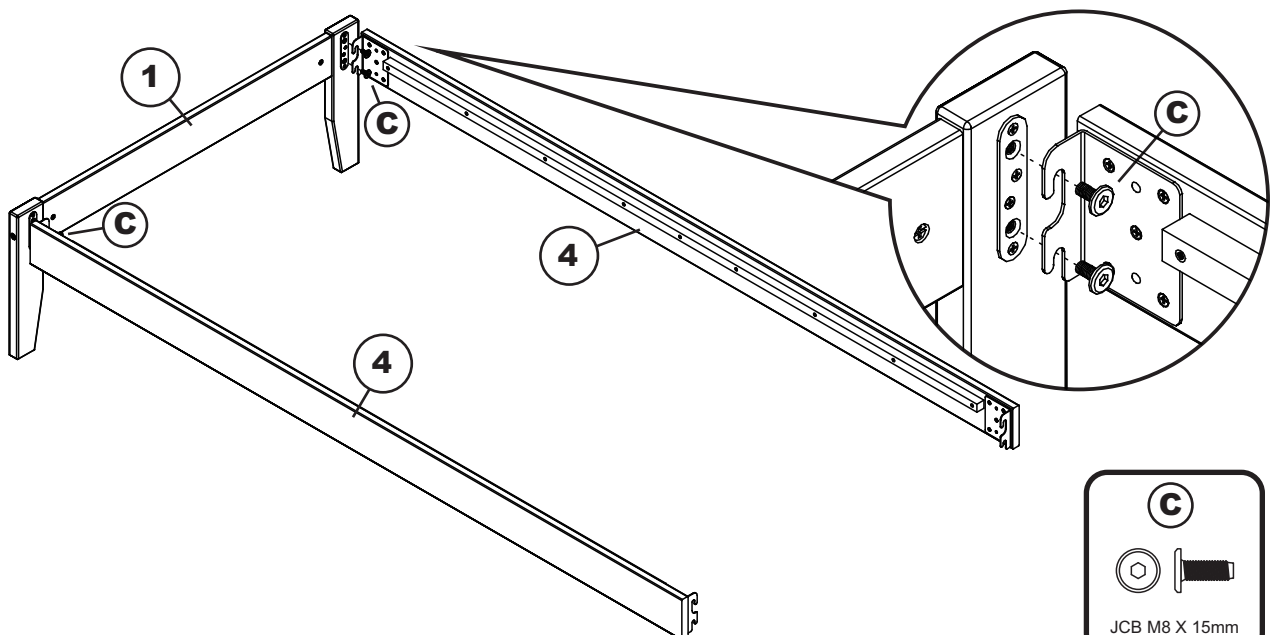

Attach side rails (4) to the foot rail (1) as shown below using JCB M8 X 15mm (C).
Tighten with Allen wrench M6 (E).

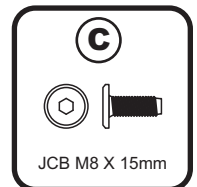
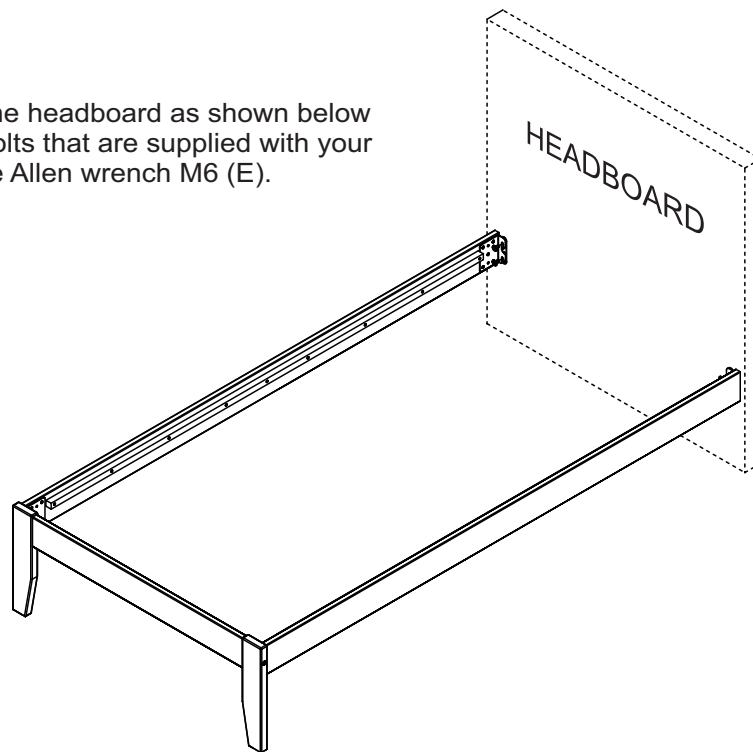

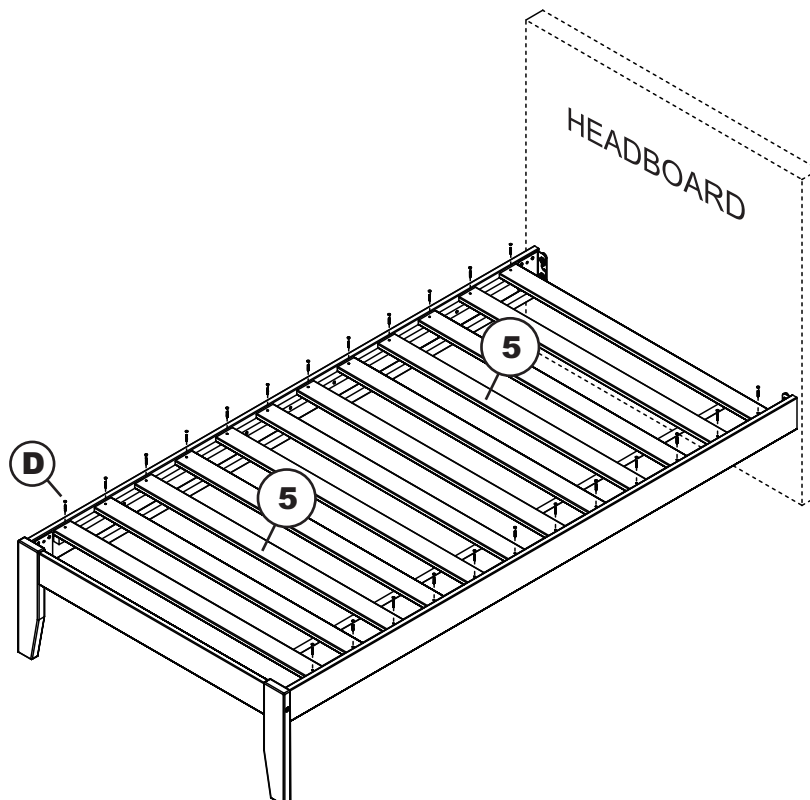
Step 3

Attach open bed frame to the headboard as shown below using 4 JCB M8 X 15mm bolts that are supplied with your headboard. Tighten with the Allen wrench M6 (E).



Step 4

Attach 2 slat kit (5) to the open bed as shown below using wood screws 1 1/4" (D). Tighten with Phillips head screw driver. (customer supplied)

**Step 1**

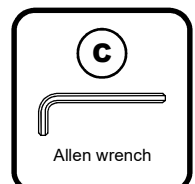
Lay the drawer face (02) on smooth, flat surface so the drawer bottom (05) groove is facing upwards. Attach the drawer sides (03) to drawer face (02) using JCB M6 X 1" (A). Align groove inside drawer side with groove in drawer face. Tighten with Allen wrench (C).

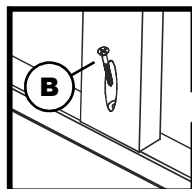
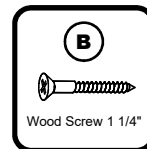
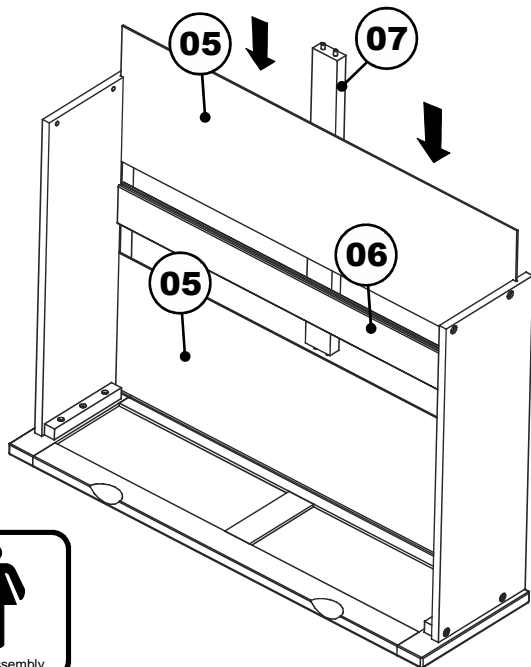

Step 2

Guide the drawer bottoms (05) and drawer middle (06) in carefully so that they align inside grooves. Be sure it fits fully into the face and side groove before attaching the drawer back (04).

Attach drawer center support (07) to bottom of drawer face using wood screw 1 1/4" (B). Tighten with Phillips head screw driver. (Customer supplied)

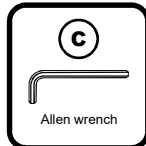
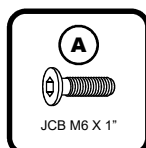
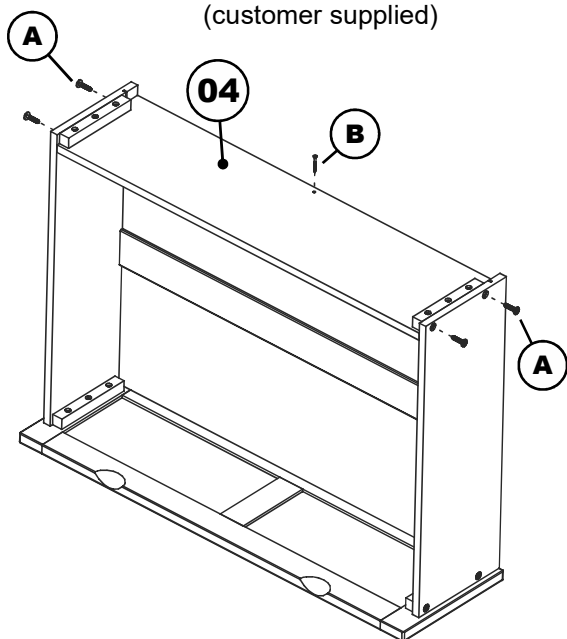

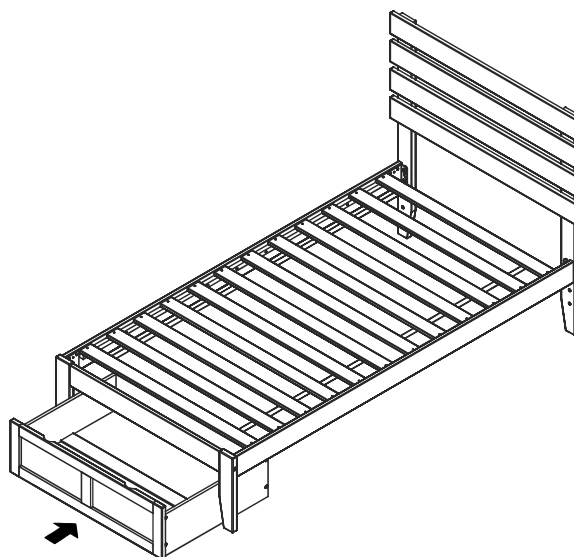
Step 3

Attach drawer back (04) to bed drawer assembly as shown. Use JCB M6 X 1" (A). Tighten with Allen wrench (C). Use wood screws 1 1/4" (B) to finish attaching drawer center support (07) to drawer back (04). Tighten with Phillips head screw driver. (customer supplied)



Step 4

Lastly, insert bed drawer to the bed as shown below.
