

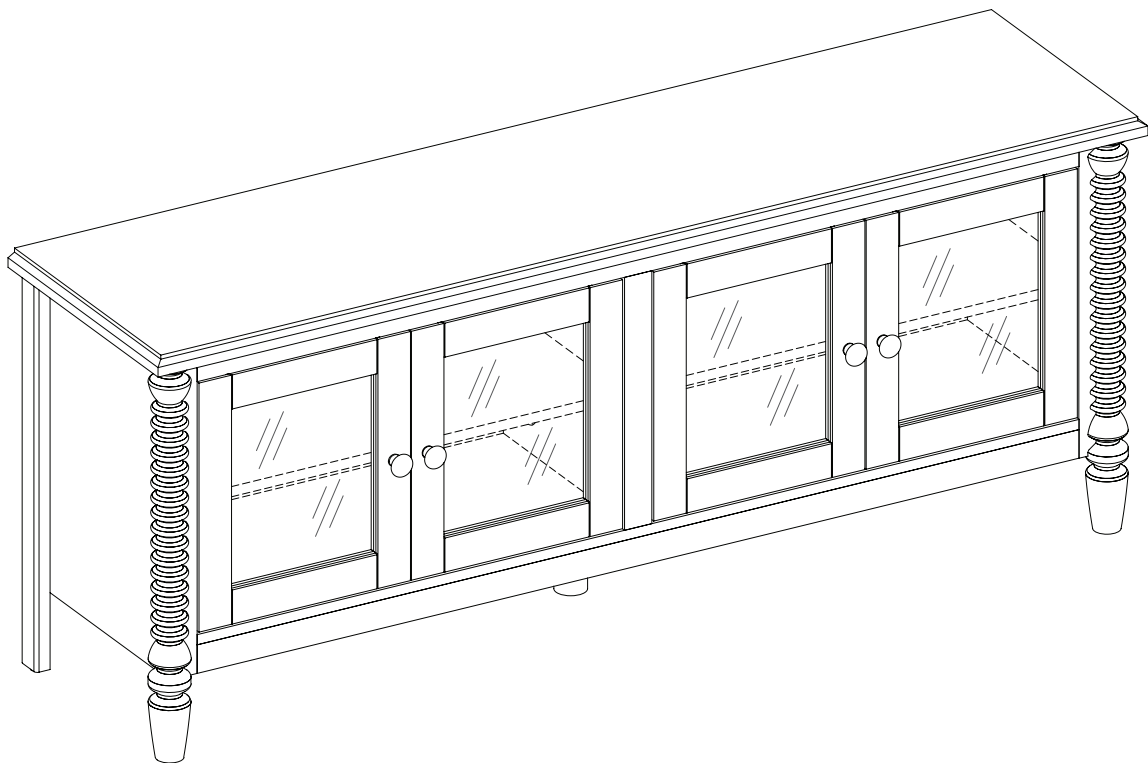

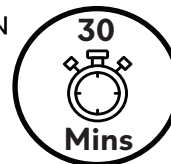

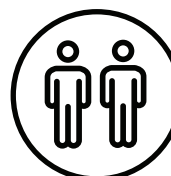
Set up a clean and soft workplace to get started and avoid damage during the assembly. It also helps to double-check you've got all the pieces and parts before diving in to assembly.

How to Get Started

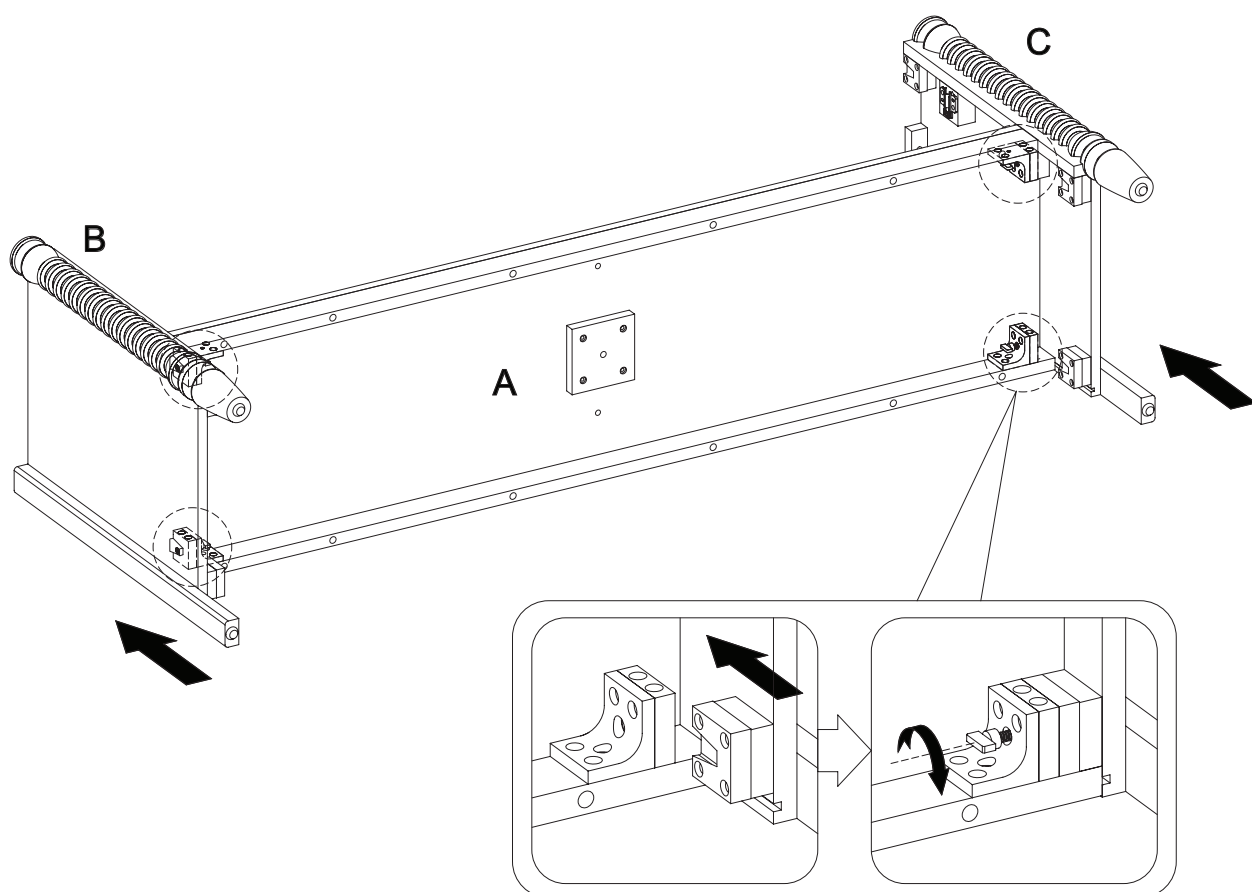


1. Get your panels ready, following the Assembly Instructions.
2. Match up the triangular male and female pieces—think of it as a little puzzle!
3. Let gravity lend a hand as you slide the hardware together at each aligned hardware piece.
4. Give the thumbscrew a twist in the center to lock everything in place.

Step 1

ATTENTION: To reduce the risk of damage to your furniture, please lay down a blanket, cloth, or cardboard on the floor prior to assembly.

Let's get started! Grab the bottom panel (A) and slide it in between the left panel (B) and right panel (C), make sure everything lines up, secure it in place with the thumb screws (BB) - easy, right?



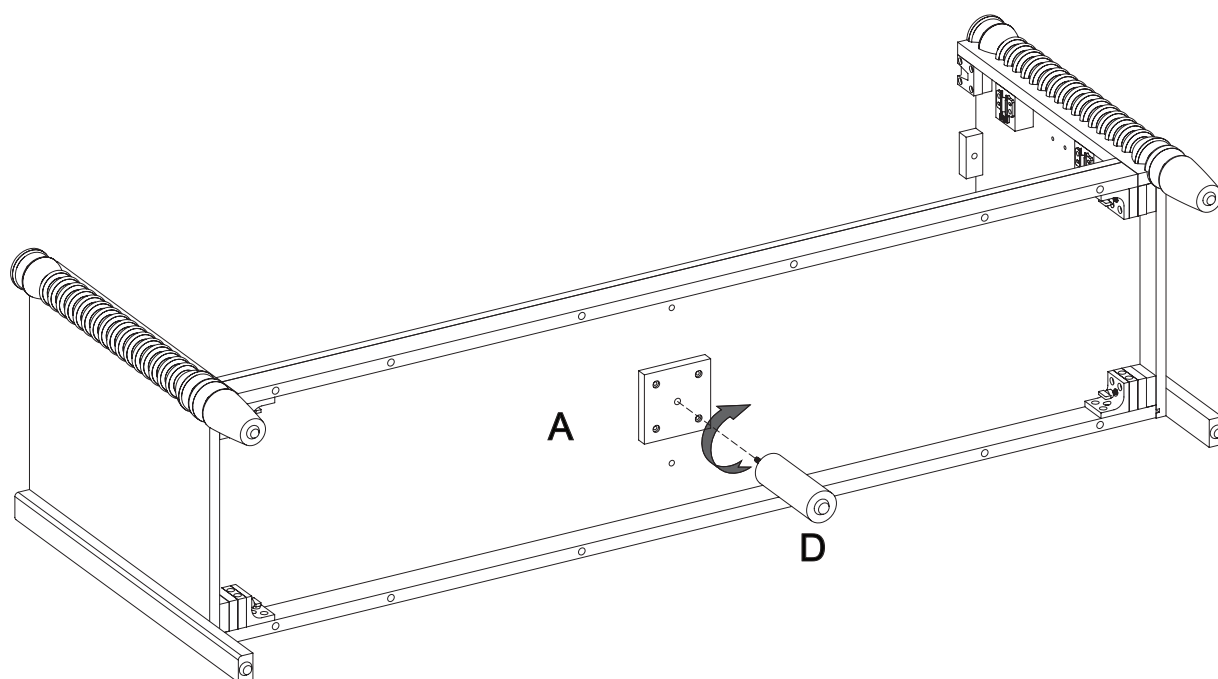

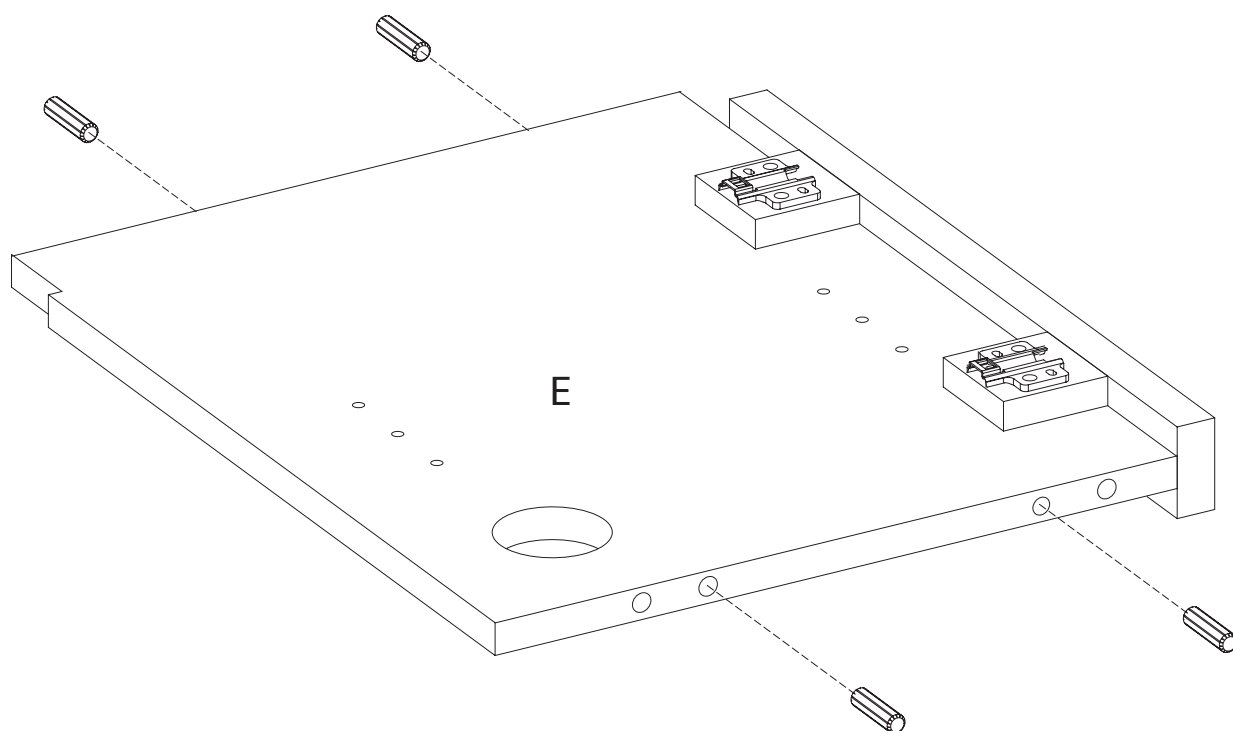
Step 2

Insert the center foot (D) into the pre-drilled holes in the bottom panel (A) and rotate clockwise until the foot is securely fixed to the bottom panel (A).



Step 3

Insert the wood dowels (AA) to the pre-drilled holes in the partition (E).



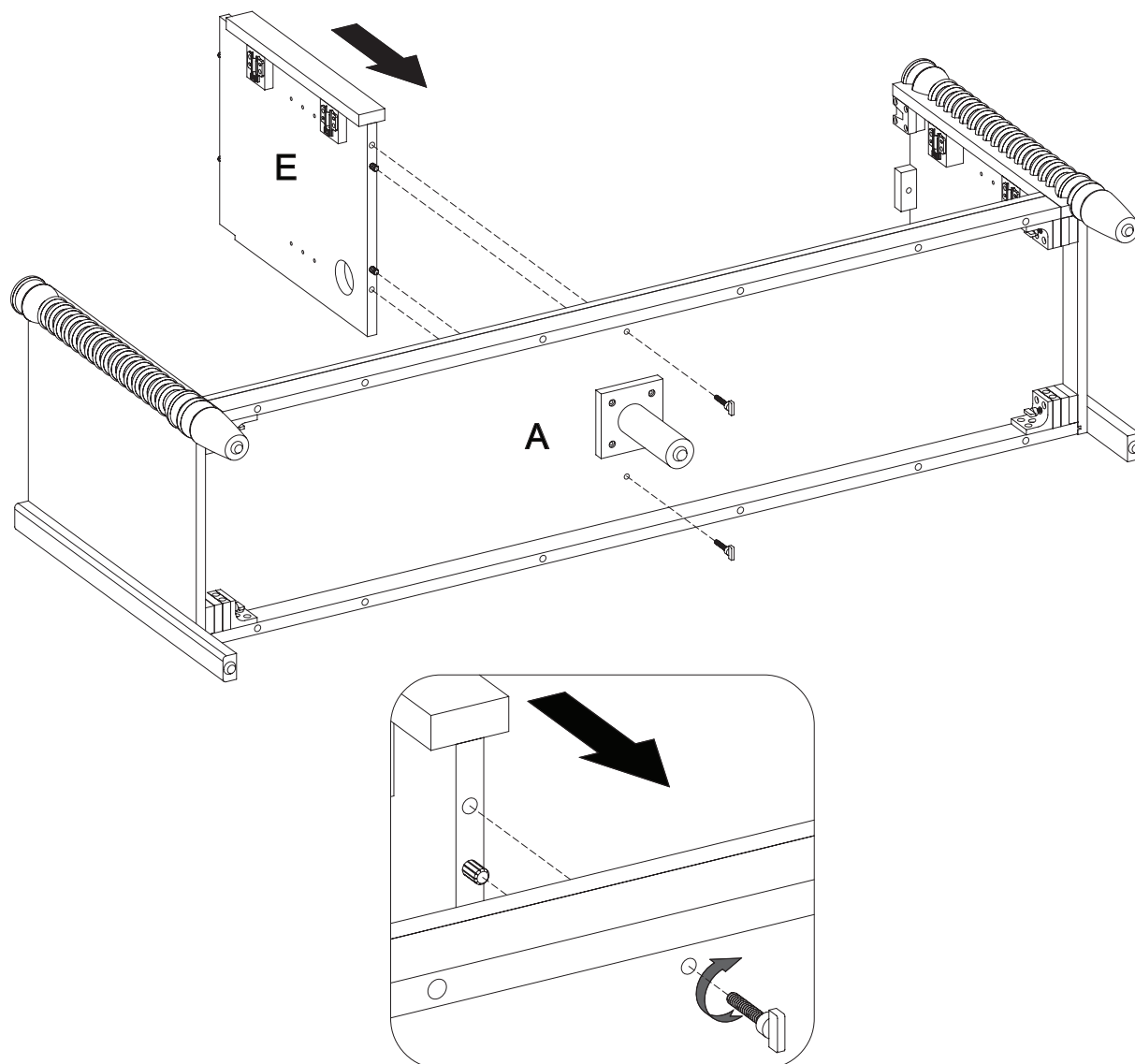

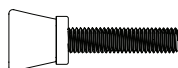

Step 4

Secure the partition (E) to the bottom panel (A) using the thumb screws (BB).



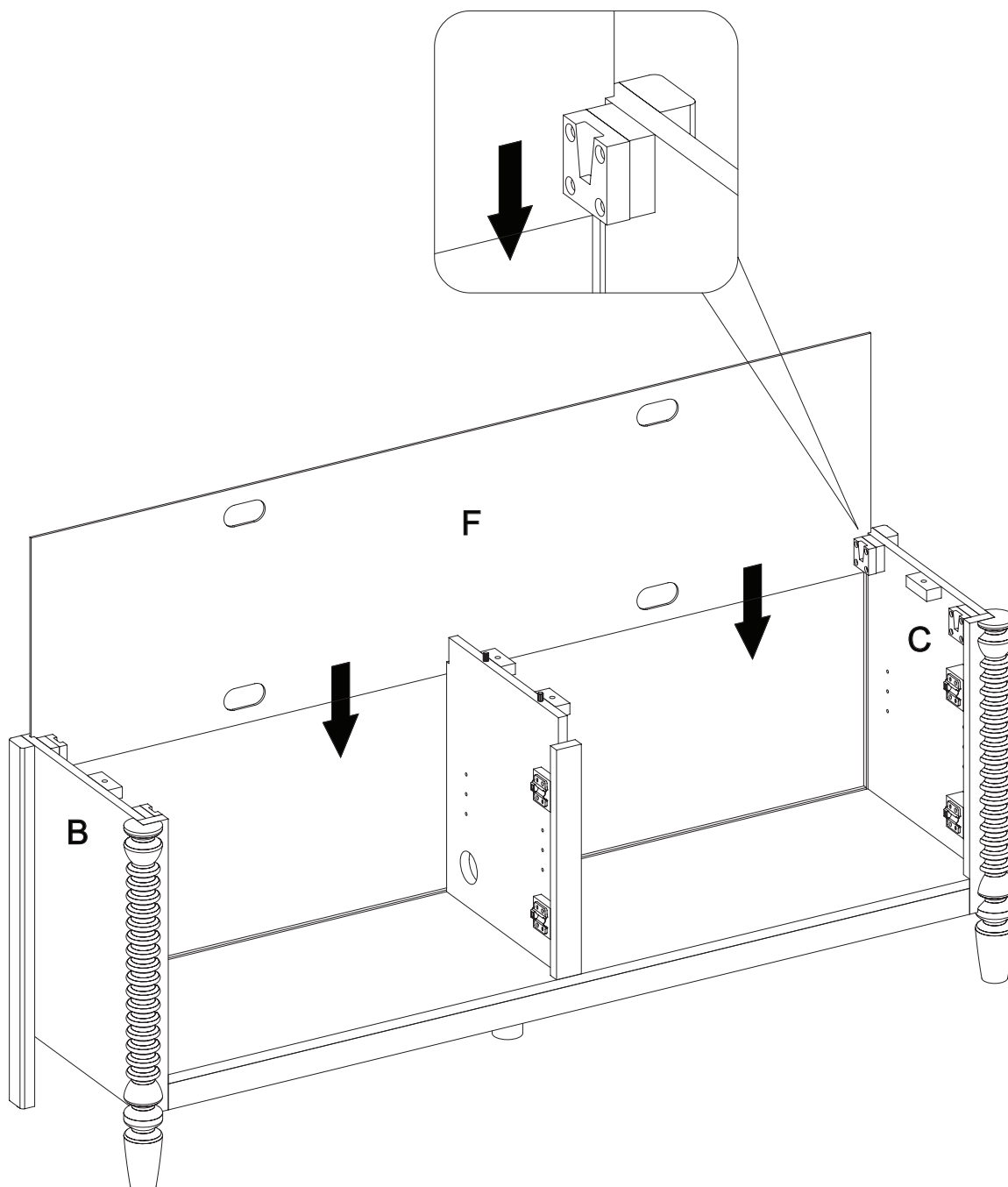

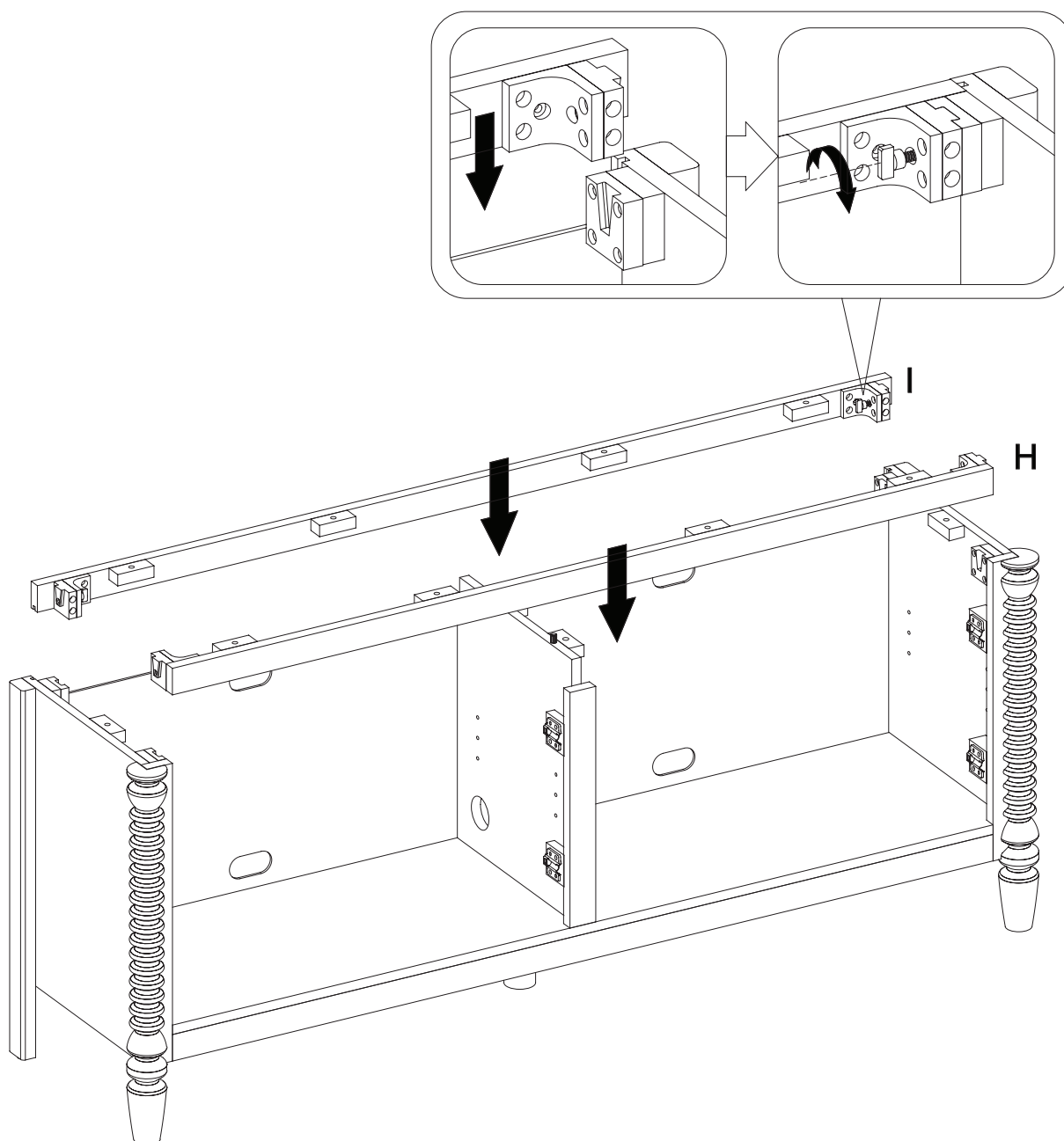
Step 5

Take the back panel (F) and slide it into the hardware in the left panel (B) and the right panel (C). Lock it into place and secure it with thumb screws (AA).

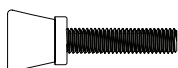


Step 6

Attach the top front rail (H) and the top back rail (I) to the main assembly, then use the thumb screws (AA) to tighten it.



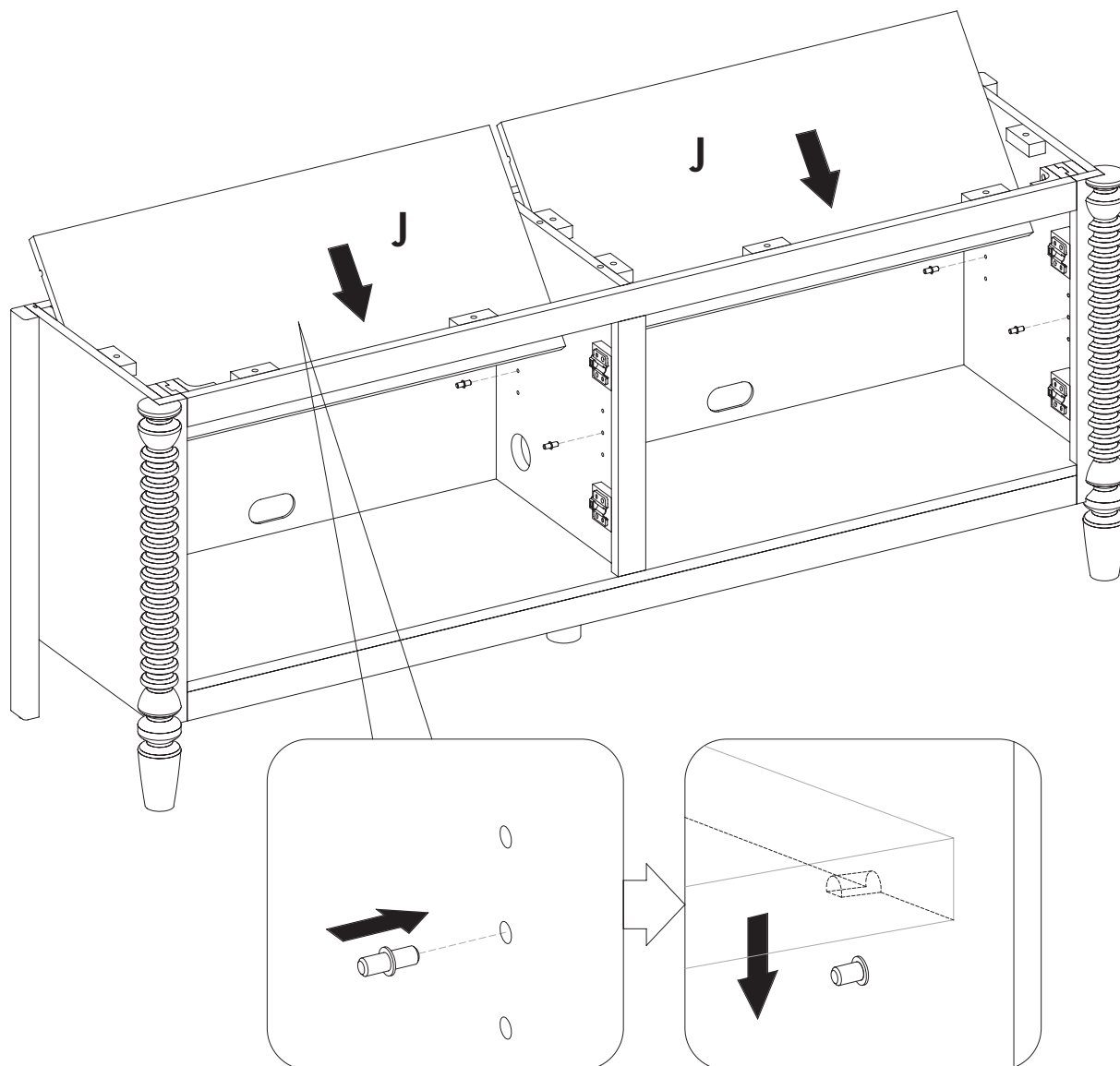

Step 7

Choose the shelf height as needed to insert the shelf pin (CC). then ,put the adjustable shelf (J) on the shelf pin from the top.



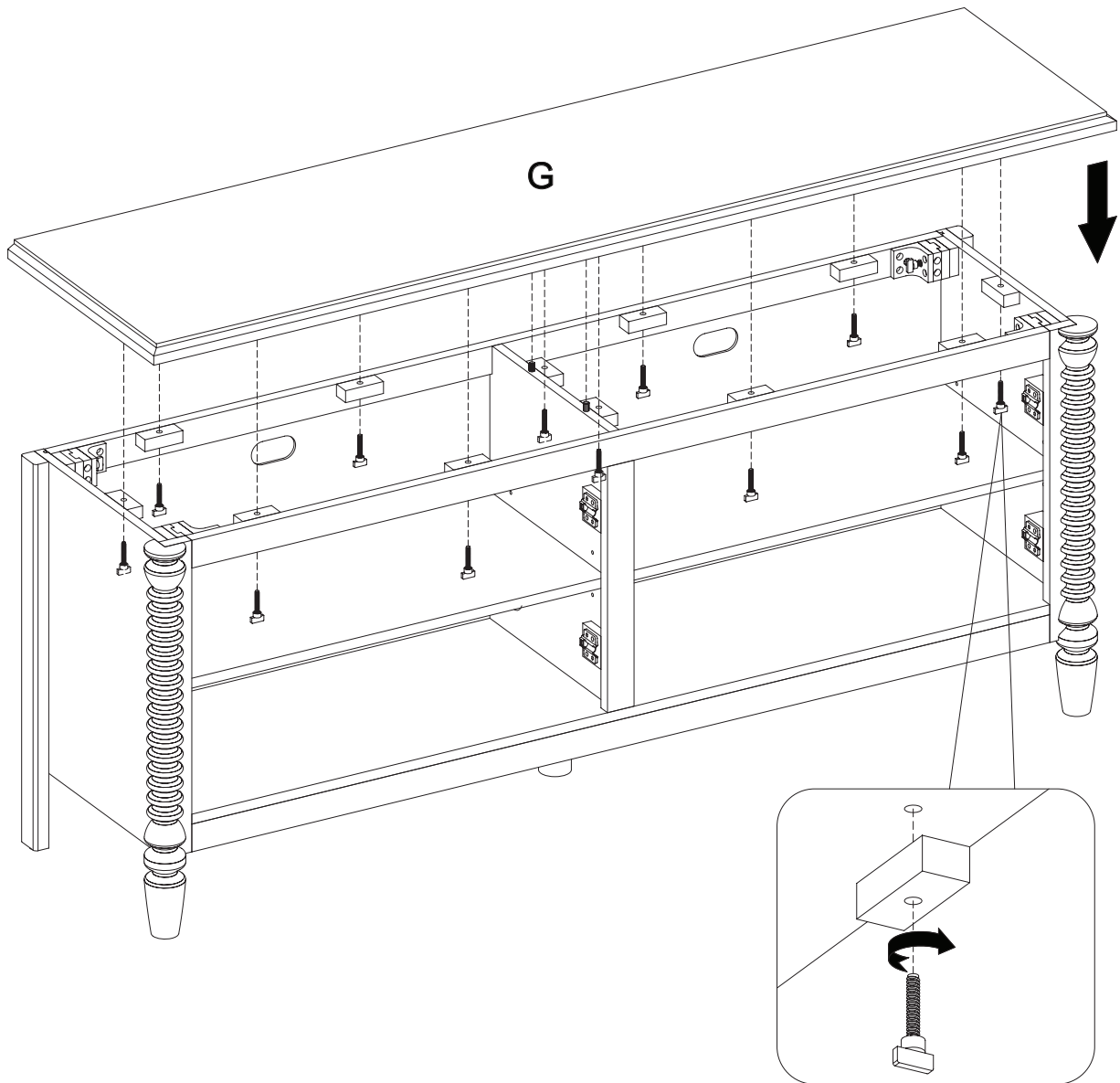

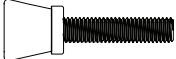

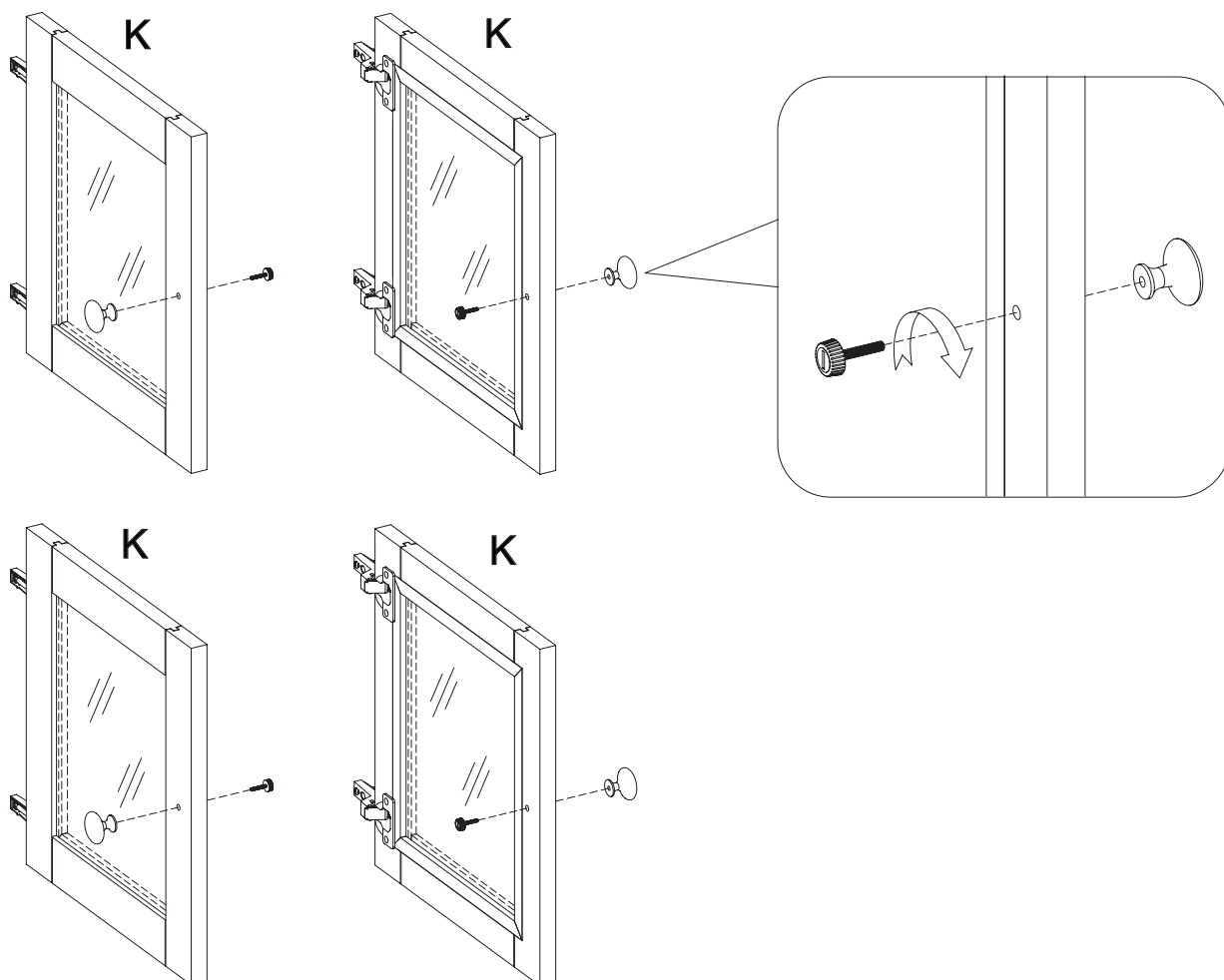
Align the holes to the wood dowels, and use the thumb screws (BB) to secure the top panel (G) to the main assembly.

Step 9

Let's attach the handles. Align the knob (DD) to the pre-drilled holes on the outside of the door (K). Insert the bolts (EE) on the other side to secure it in place.

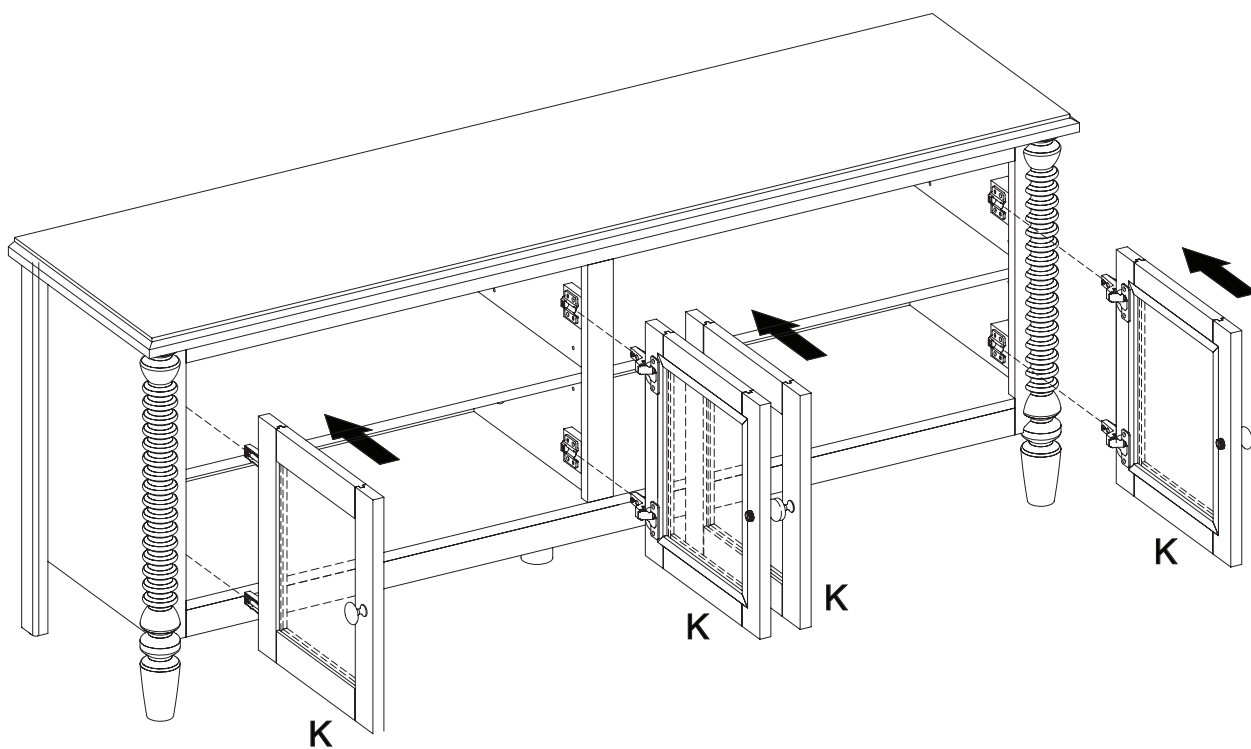
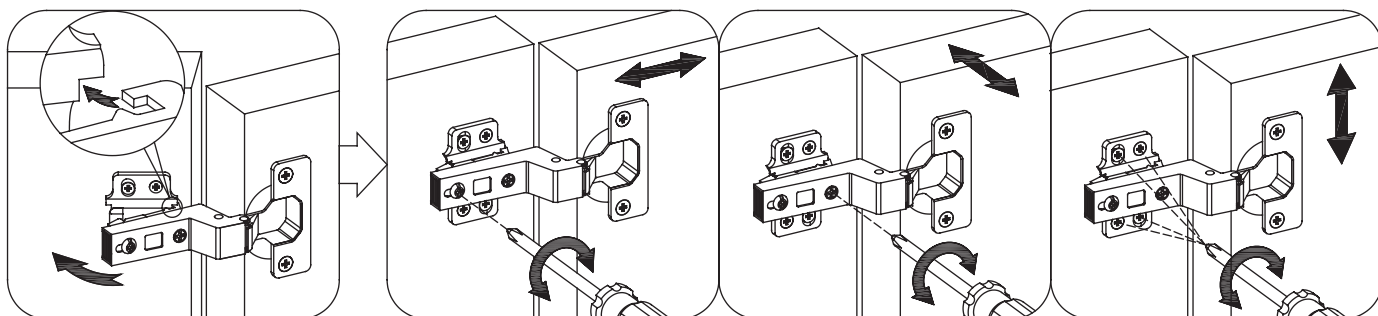

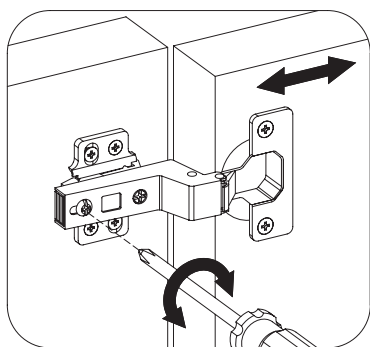

Step 10

Screw the assembled door (K) into the pre-drilled holes in the assembled unit using the pre-attached screws as shown.

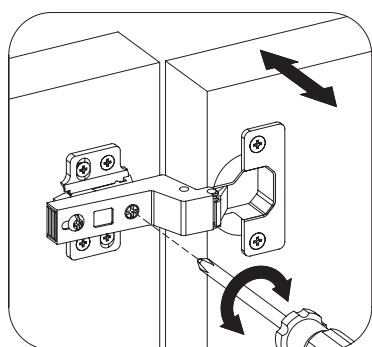


Note: If you find the doors need to be adjusted slightly, turn the appropriate screw as illustrated.



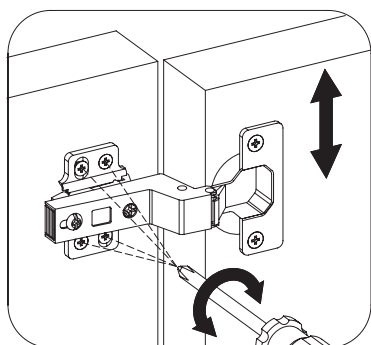
TO ADJUST DOOR FORWARD OR BACKWARD

Loosen the screw and slide the hinge into position, then retighten.



TO ADJUST DOOR RIGHT OR LEFT

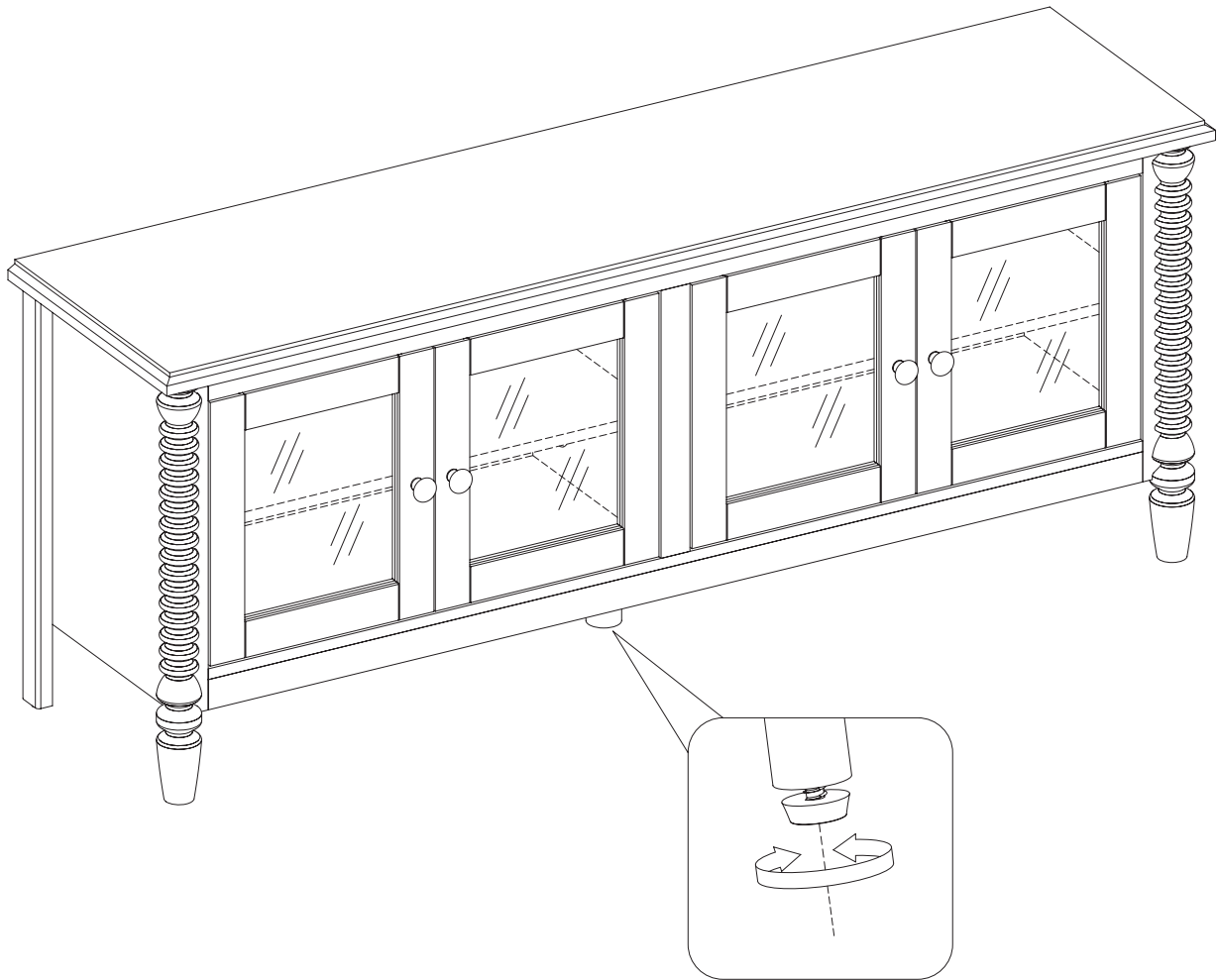
Loosen the screw to move the door away from the hinge. Tighten to move the door toward the hinge.

TO ADJUST DOOR UP OR DOWN

Adjust the four screws at the top and bottom of the hinge. Each screw should be loosened or tightened in small increments.

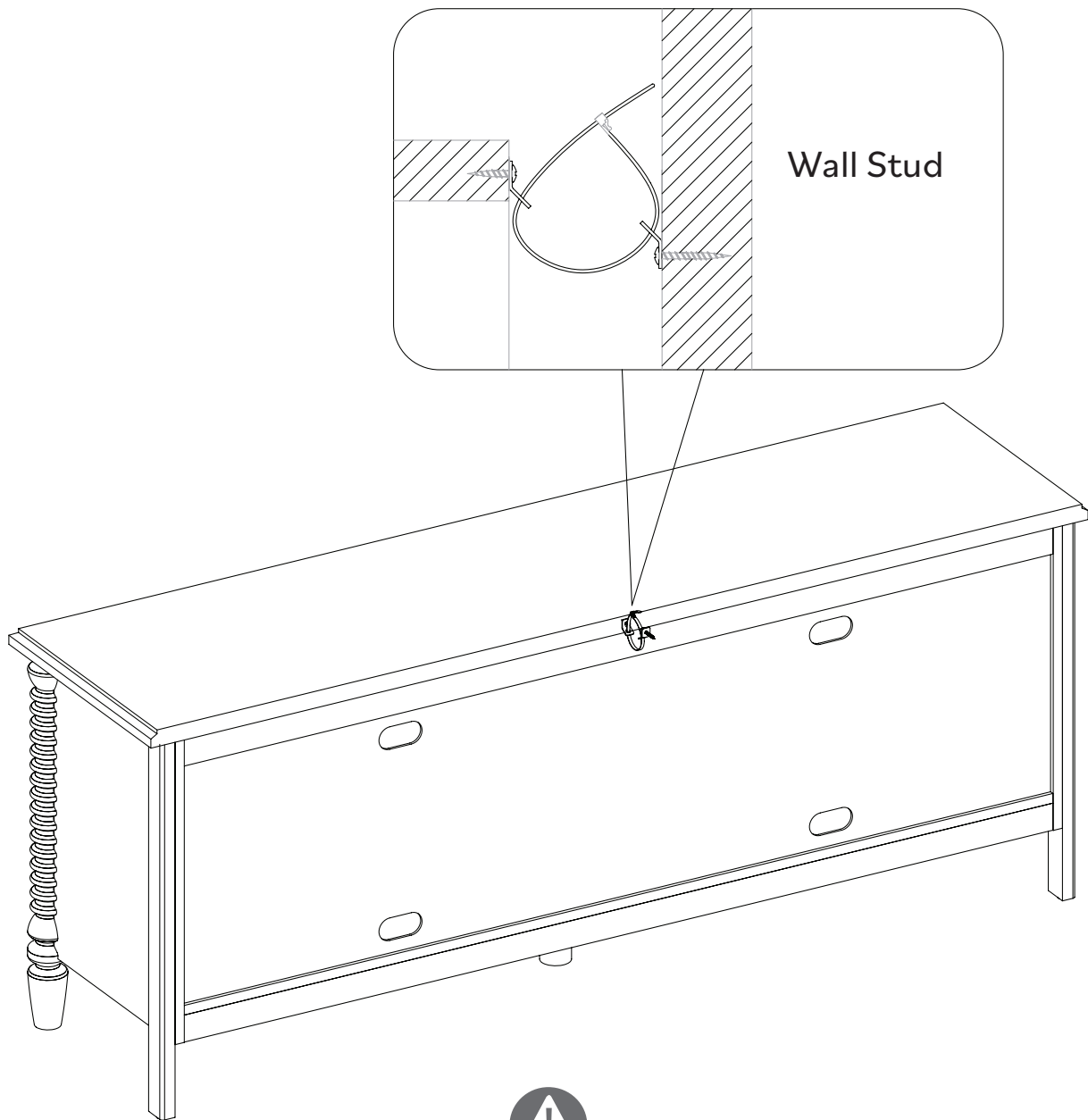
Step 11



Note: It is very important that your unit is properly leveled. After moving your unit to its final location, you may need to adjust the floor levelers.

Step 12

Attach the tip-restraint hardware (FF) to the back before securing it to the wall, as shown below.



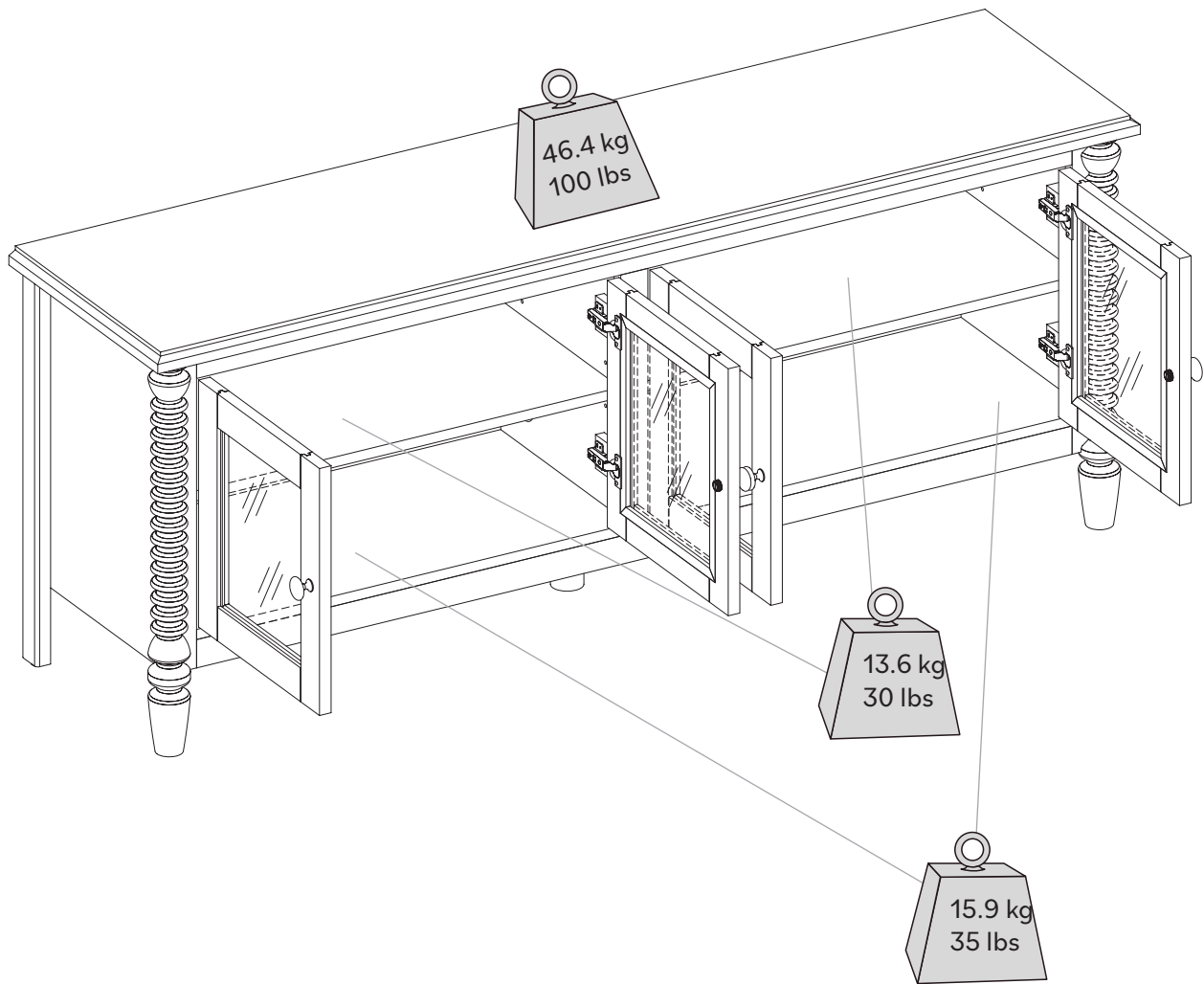
Warning: You must install the tip restraint hardware to help prevent any accidents or damage to the unit. We strongly recommend attaching the tip restraint hardware to a wall stud and your unit. For all other wall types, please visit your local hardware store to obtain the proper hardware.
