- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



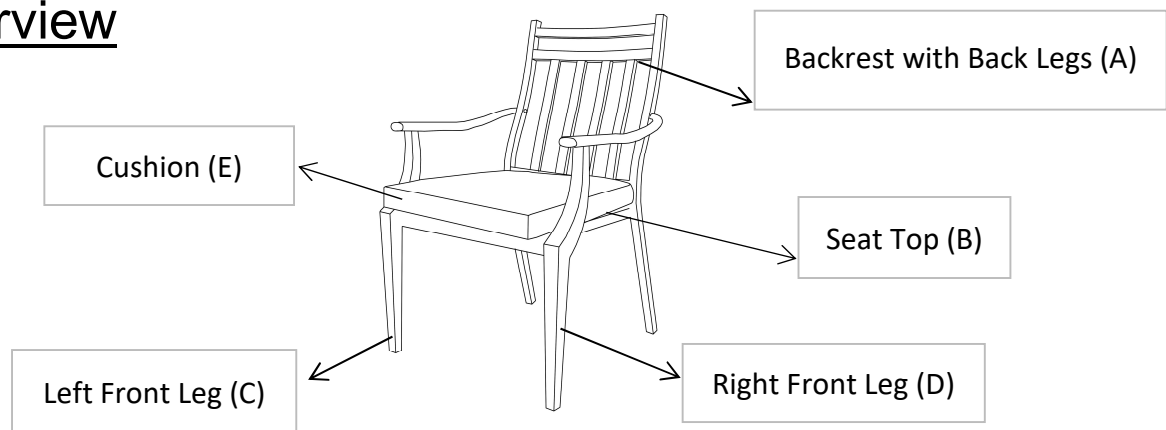
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-

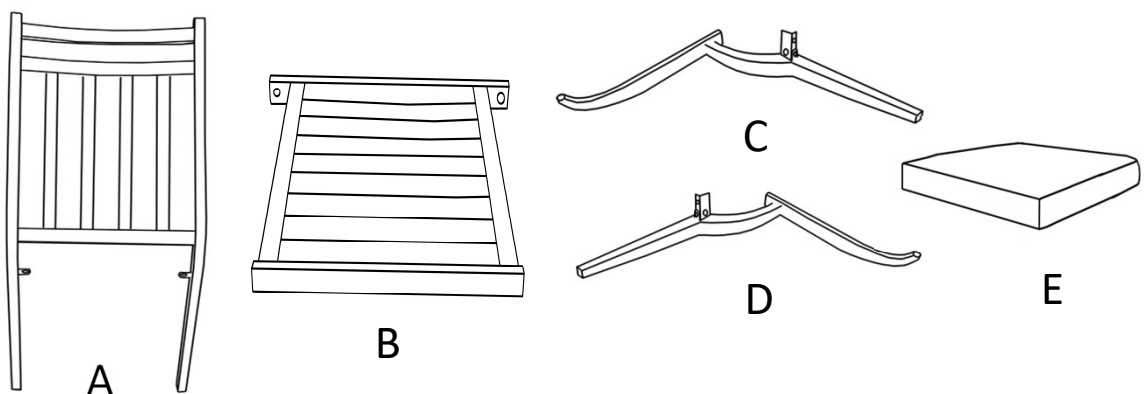
Assembly Steps

Overview



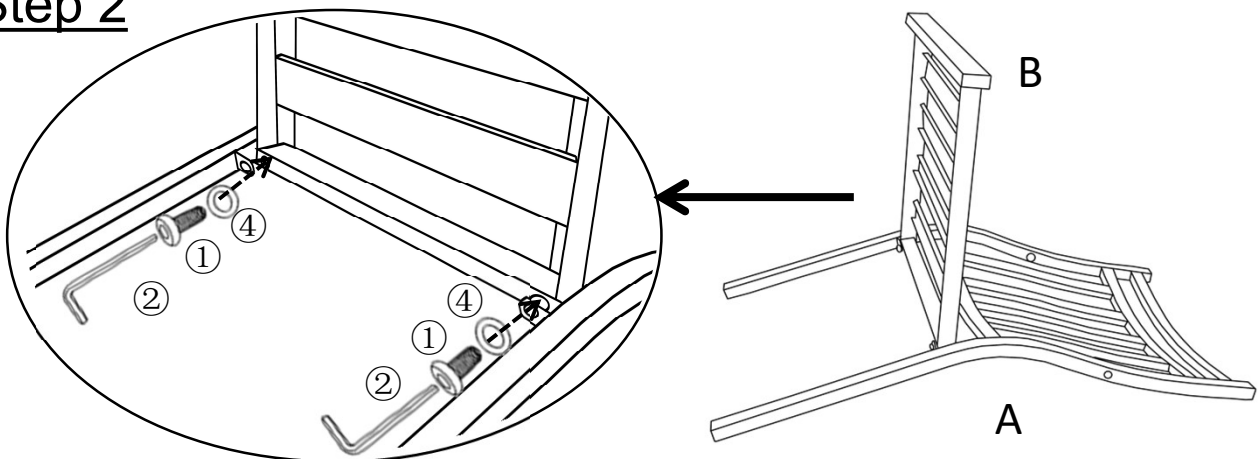
This Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 20 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chair parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

Step 2

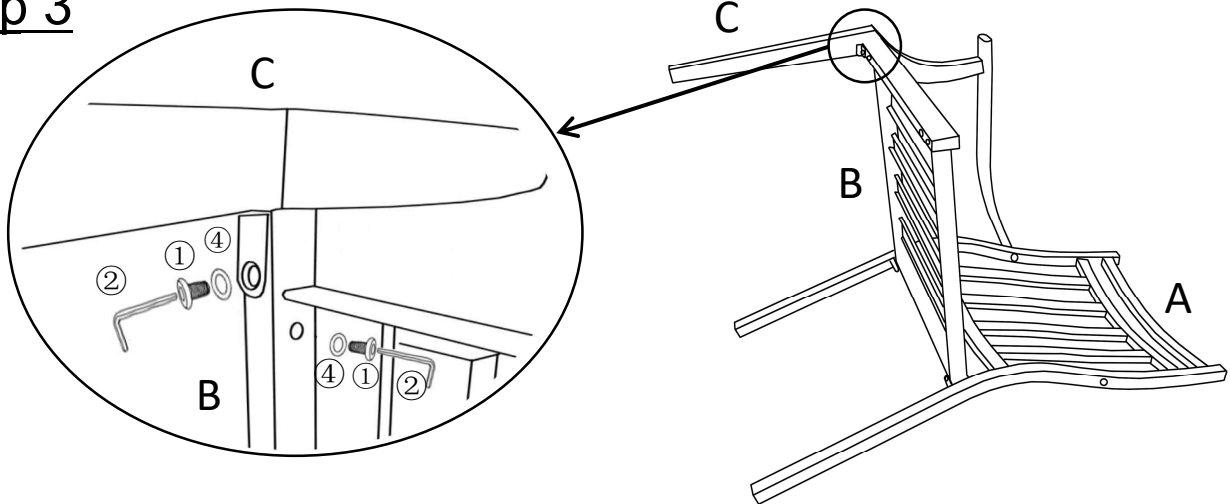


Lay the Backrest with Back Legs(A) facedown onto a clean, non-marring surface.

Attach Seat Top(B) to Backrest with Back Legs(A) using Bolts(①) and Washers(④) with Allen Wrench(②).

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

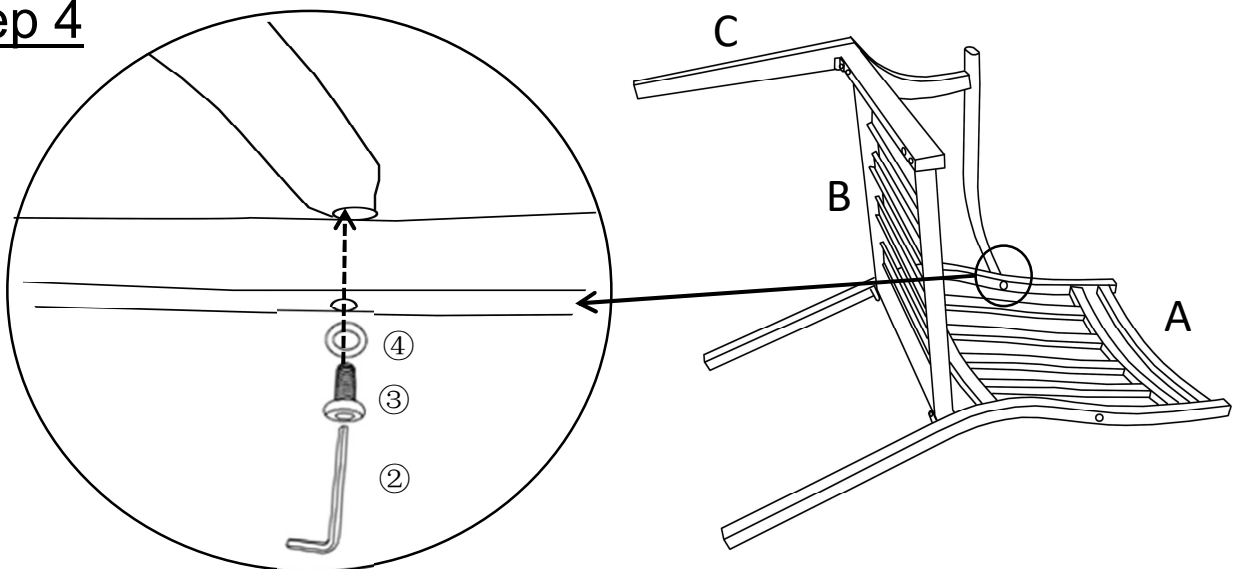
Step 3



Attach the Left Front Leg(C) to Seat Top(B) using Bolts(①) and Washers(④) with Allen Wrench(②).

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

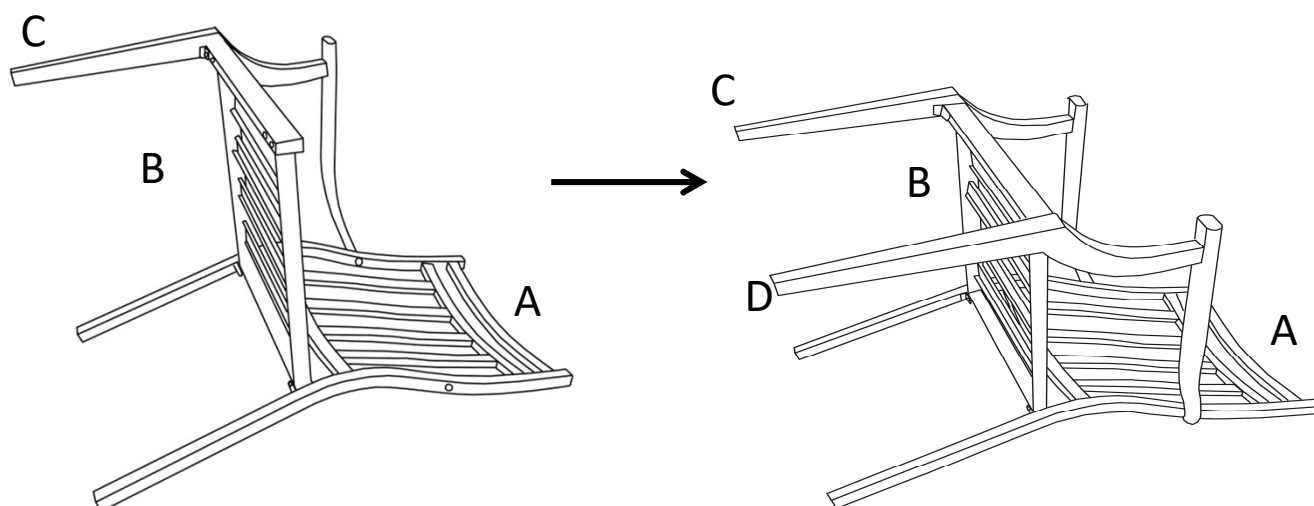
Step 4



Attach the Left Front Leg(C) to Backrest with Back Legs(B) using Bolt(③) and Washer(④) with Allen Wrench(②).

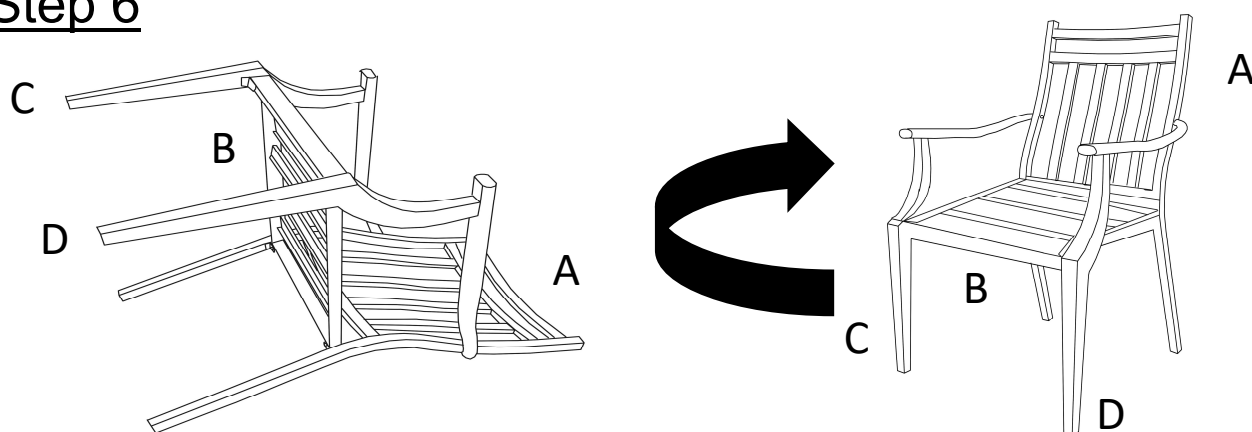
Do not fully tighten the Bolt.

Step 5



Repeat Step 3 & Step 4 to assemble Right Front Leg(D).

Step 6



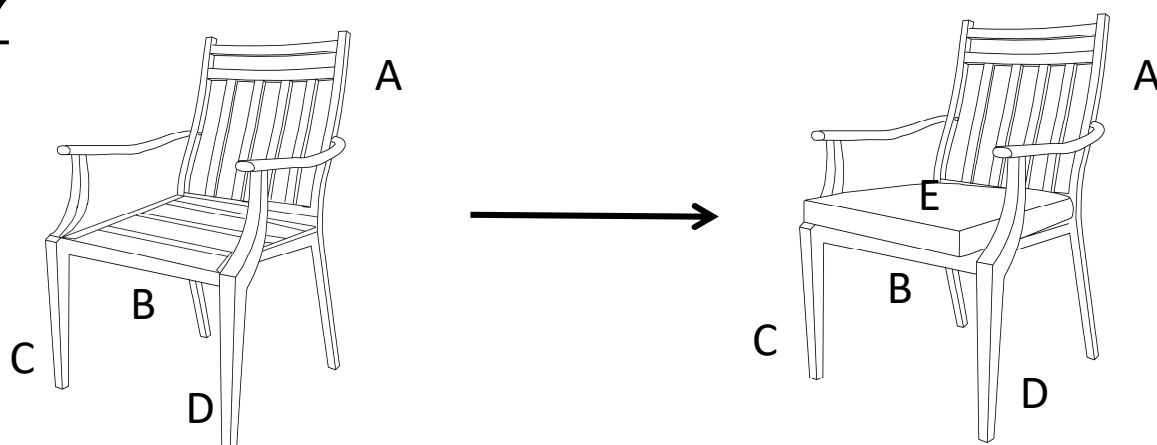
Stand the Chair up.

Carefully sit onto the Chair.

This pressure will help align all parts at all joints.

In a sequential manner, tighten all Bolts at all joints.

Step 7



Place the Seat Cushion(E) onto the Chair.

Your Chair is ready for use.

This Chair can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

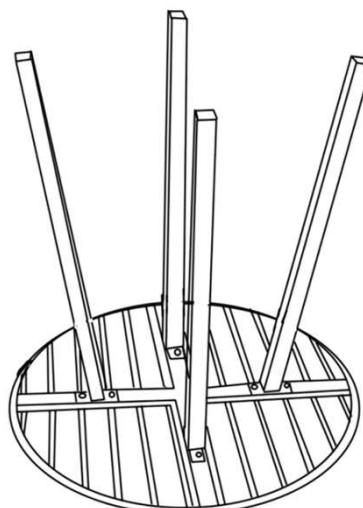
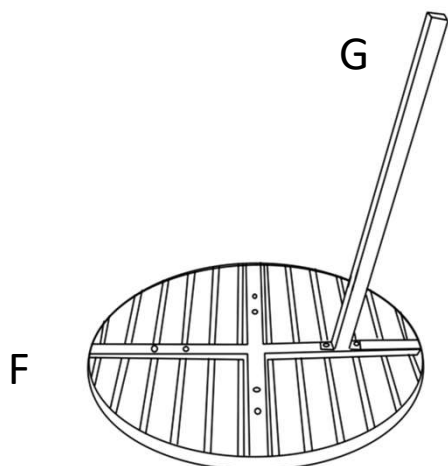
Step 2



Lay the Table Top(F) facedown onto a clean, non-marring surface.
Attach the Table Leg(G) to Table Top(F) using Bolts(5) and Washers(7) with Allen Wrench(6).

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

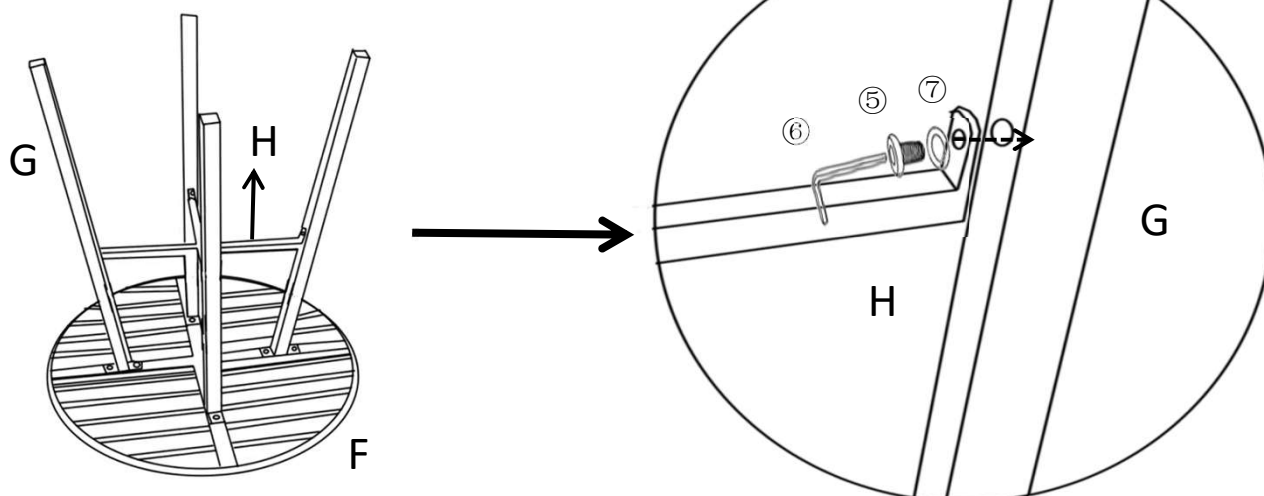
Step 3



Attach the Table Legs(G) to Table Top(F) using Bolts(⑤) and Washers(⑦)with Allen Wrench(⑥).

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

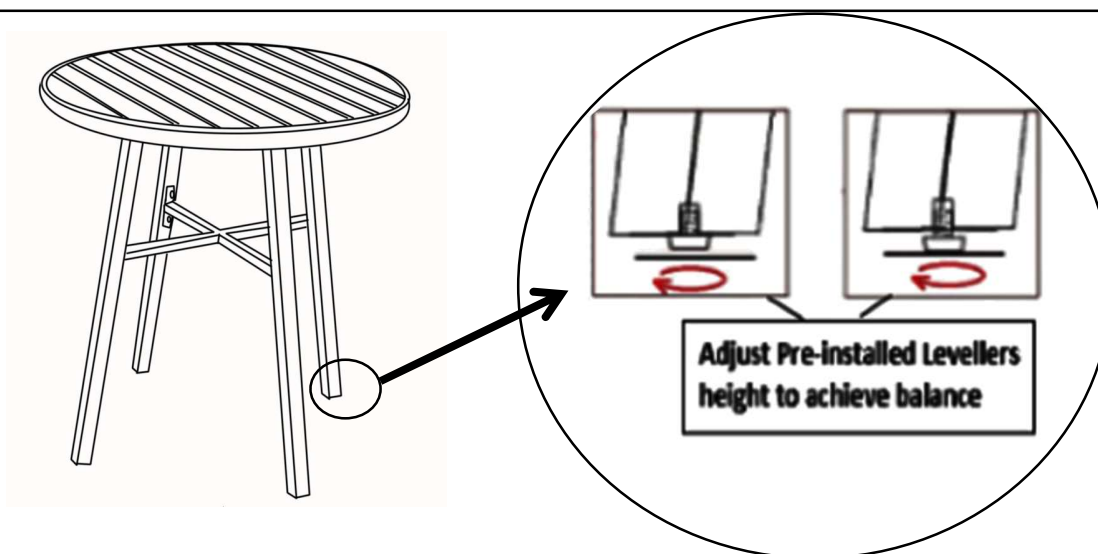
Step 4



Attach the Support Ring(H) between Table Legs(G) using Bolts(⑤) and Washers(⑦)with Allen Wrench(⑥).

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 5



Stand the Table up.

Place the table on a **LEVEL SURFACE** to see if it wobbles.

If it wobbles, tighten by turning the Leveller clockwise.

Repeat the same step to install the three remaining Levellers

Test again for evenness on a **LEVEL SURFACE**.

If no wobbles found, lay down the table and proceed to tighten all the Bolts.

Step 6



Your Table is ready for use.

This Table can only be used on a flat, level surface.
