

Ceiling Fan Sizing

FOR ALL YOUR SPACES

1

Determine the square footage of your space.

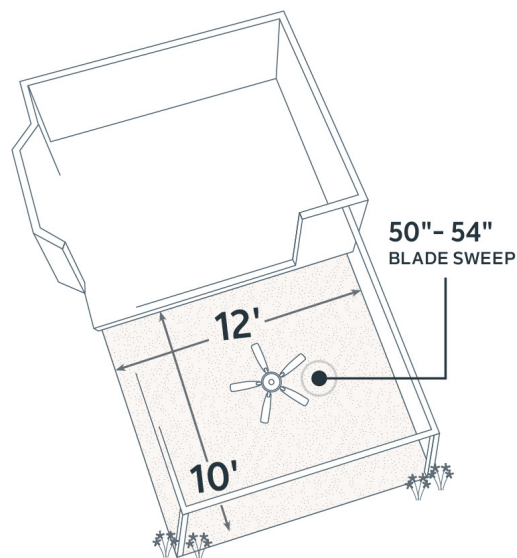
Measure the length and the width of the space and then multiply.
For example:

$$\begin{array}{ccccccc} \text{10 Ft.} & \times & \text{12 Ft.} & = & \text{120 Sq. Ft.} \\ \underbrace{\hspace{1.5cm}} & & \underbrace{\hspace{1.5cm}} & & \underbrace{\hspace{2.5cm}} \\ \text{Width} & & \text{Length} & & \text{Space Area} \end{array}$$

Find the right size ceiling fan.

SPACE SIZE	BLADE SWEEP
90 SQ. FT. OR LESS	15" - 42"
90 - 100 SQ. FT.	44" - 48"
100 - 150 SQ. FT.	50" - 54"
150 - 300 SQ. FT.	56" - 70"
300+ SQ. FT.	70"+ or Multiple Fans

High ceilings or outdoor spaces?

Size up! These spaces require a larger fan for better airflow. Ideal fan installation should have a clearance of 8-9 feet under the blades.
