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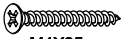
Drill 2 holes on the wall at the required position for anti-falling device installation.

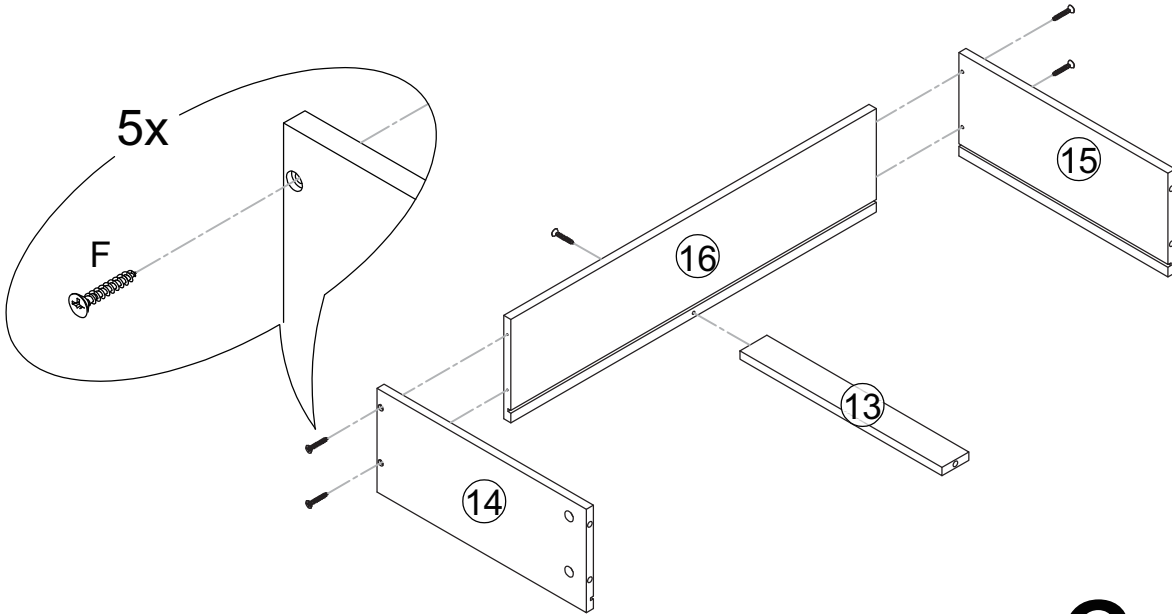
