IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read and understand this entire manual before attempting to assemble, install or operate the product. **WARNING**:

Disconnect power by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box. (All electrical steps should be performed by a qualified person or electrician.)

Ensure wiring and outlet box are compliant with national and local electrical codes, including the NEC. SkyOutlet requires installation on the branch circuit solid 12 or 14 AWG wire.

CAUTION:

To reduce risk of fire, use three (3) E26 **Max 60-watt** incandescent A19 bulbs or CFL/LED equivalent (bulbs not included). This fixture is meant for indoor use, **SUITABLE FOR DRY LOCATIONS AND DAMP LOCATIONS**.

APPENDIX Additional Wiring Diagram

IMPORTANT: If you have multiple wires inside your outlet box, you will need to determine which lead is the live or switched lead and insert this lead into L1. If you are not sure how your house is wired, contact 1-866-885-4649 for questions or contact an electrician. When multiple wires are connected together use a solid wire 12 or 14 AWG JUMPER LEAD (included) to insert into the receptacle terminal. **Do not use L2**.
