If your water gauge is not pre-assembled, assemble the parts as shown in the diagram.



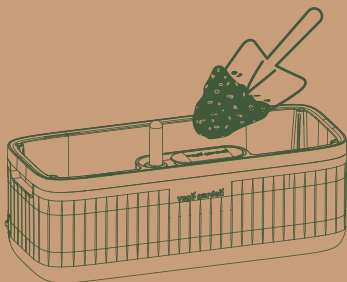

Filling with Soil



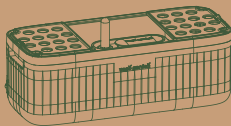
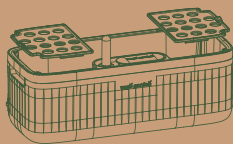
Fill the planter's inner shell with potting soil (about 6 dry quarts).



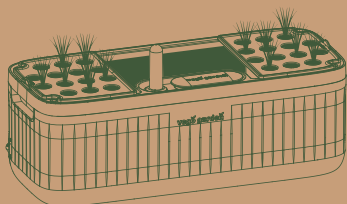
Using The Onion Grow Guide

The Onion Grow Guide can serve as a seed spacing guide, a mulch, and a support collar for your herbs, like green onions.

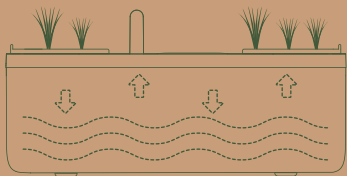
- To use as a spacing guide, simply set on the planter after filling with soil, and seed through the holes for perfect spacing.



- To use as a support collar, replant your already-cut green onion bulbs through the holes and watch them regrow!

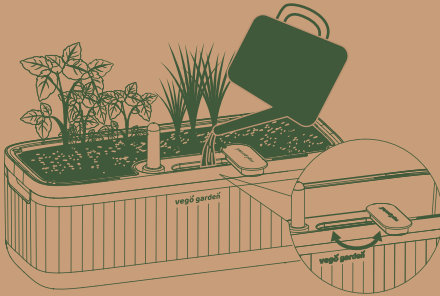


- The grow guide acts as a great, reusable mulch to prevent moisture loss from soil.





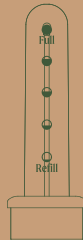
Filling with Water



After planting, open the water cover and pour water into the tank.

Maximum

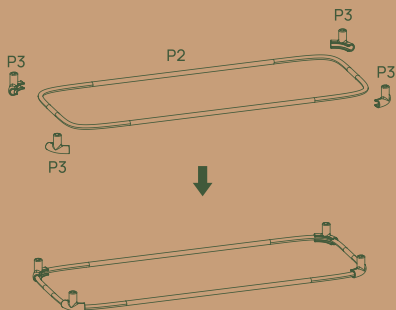
When the indicator inside the water gauge reaches the full mark, stop adding water and close the cover. Add more water once the indicator is below the refill mark.



Trellis installation

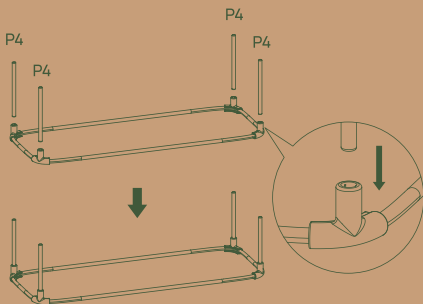
Snap the four corner connectors onto the trellis ring.

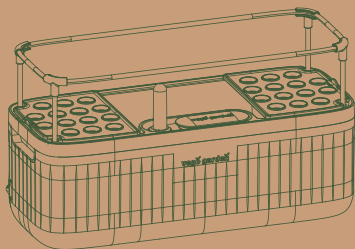
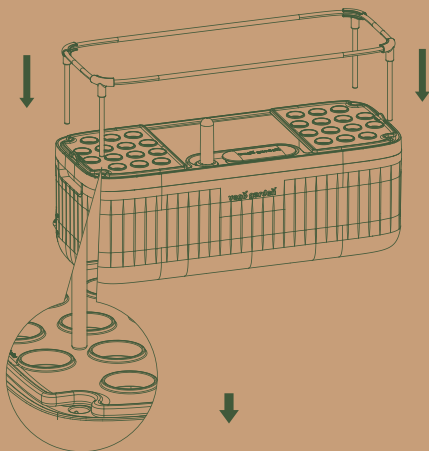
Insert the trellis poles into the corner connectors, and push until fully inserted.

Set the trellis aside for later installation.

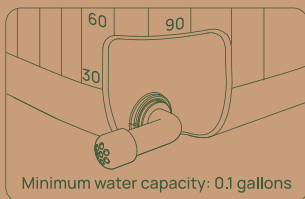
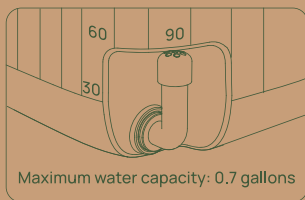
Flip the trellis over, and install trellis into planter.





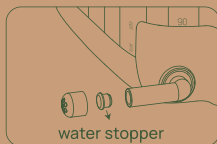
Water Level Regulator

The water level regulator is located at the back of the planter. Use the regulator to adjust the volume of water retained in the outer shell.

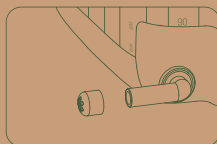


When rotating to the left or right, the 90, 60, 30 marks indicate the angle of the regulator. When the stopper is installed, the water level inside the planter will be level with the tip of the regulator.

When using the planter indoors, ensure the stopper is securely installed to prevent water leakage.



When using outdoors, remove the stopper to prevent rain from oversaturating the soil. Reinstall pest cap to prevent bugs like mosquitos from entering the water reservoir.





Reminders

1. When watering, stop once the indicator inside the gauge reaches the full position. Watering excessively past the full position may lead to oversaturation of soil and undermine plant growth.
2. The top layer of soil may be dry during the first week of planting. Top-water for a week and allow time for root growth.



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
