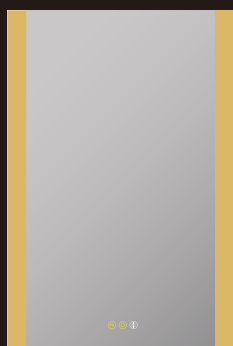
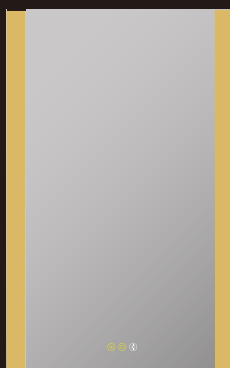

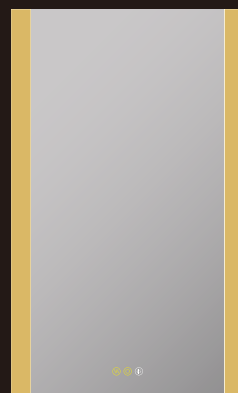

QUICK INSTALLATION OVERVIEW

1. *Check package contents*
2. *Determine wall mount or recessed installation*
3. *Cut wall opening (if recessed)*
4. *Mount brackets*
5. *Wire the cabinet*
6. *Mount the cabinet*
7. *Install hinge cover and door bumper*

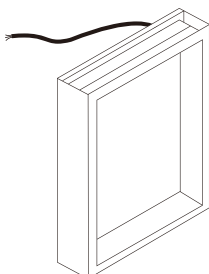

WARNING: An Electrical option cabinet must be wired to a 20 Amp GFI (GroundFault Interrupter) protected circuit when used in bathrooms and all other locations required by the National Electric Code.

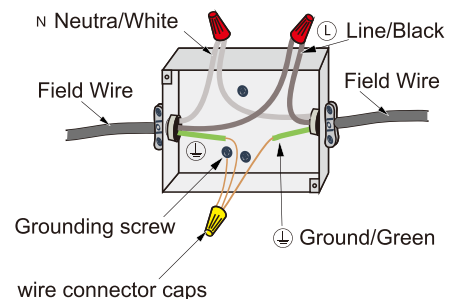
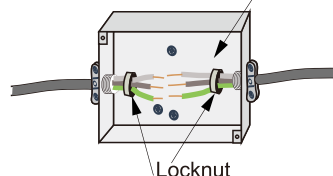
The electric wire comes through the access hole on the back of the medicine cabinet, exact location of access hole varies depending on the product models. Please refer to the actual product for the exact location.



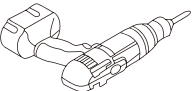
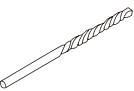
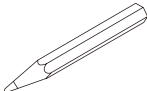
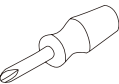
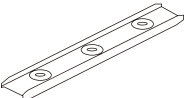

- ❶ Lift the medicine cabinet above the top bracket(7). Press it firmly against the wall, then lower it into place on the bracket.
- ❷ Secure the bottom bracket(6) to the medicine cabinet using the short screw(1), Do not overtighten.
- ❸ Install the bottom bracket(6) onto the wall with the long screw(3) , then fully tighten the short screw(1) to secure the medicine cabinet in place.

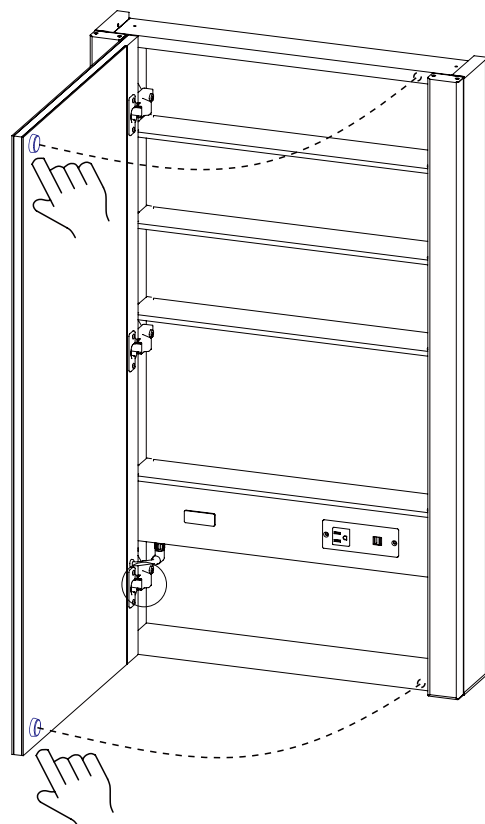
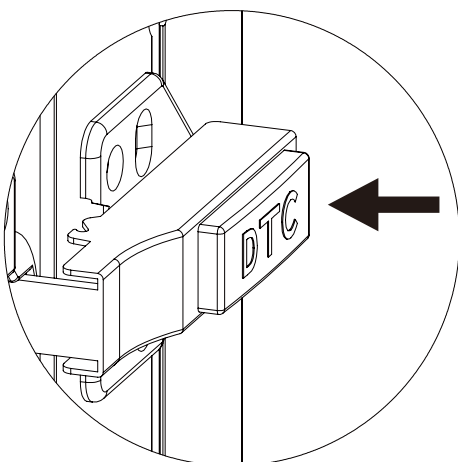

Carefully place the medicine cabinet into the prepared wall opening. Secure it using the long screws(3) through the side brackets.

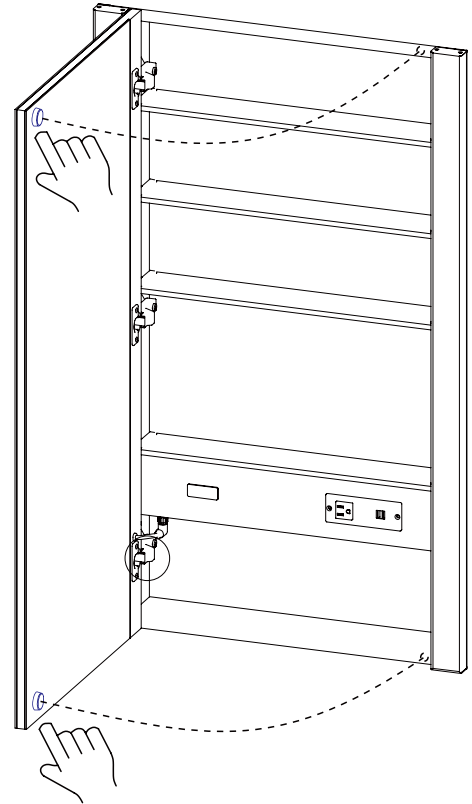
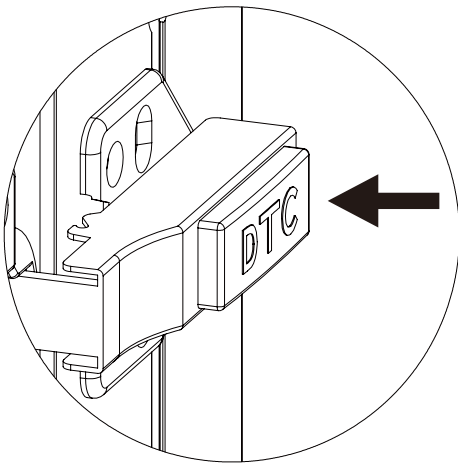

HOW TO ADJUST THE HEIGHT OF TEMPERRED GLASS SHELF

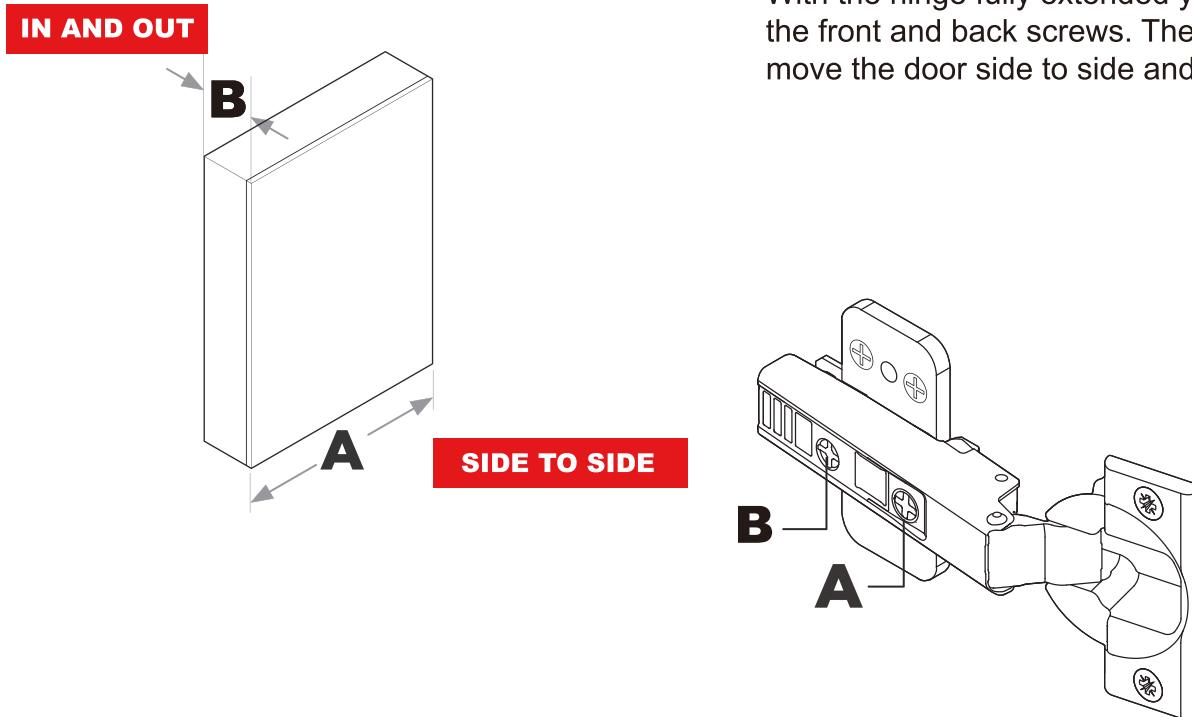
Loosen the screw on each clamp, slide them along the groove to adjust the shelf to your desired height. Ensure that both clamps are aligned at the same level before retightening.



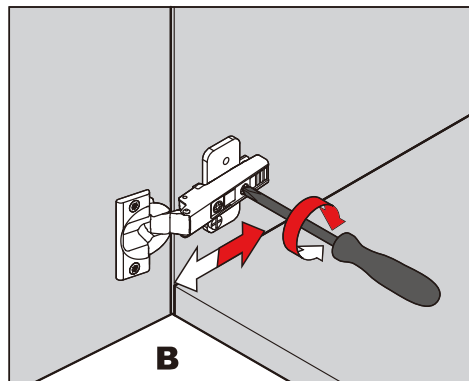
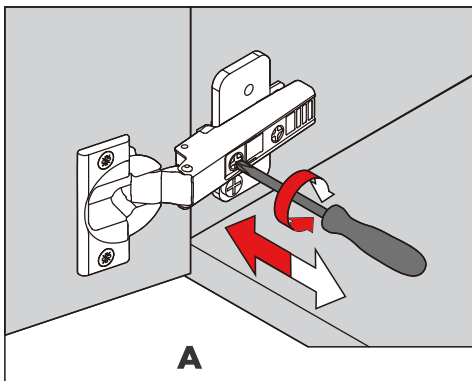
OPTIONAL DOOR ADJUSTMENT

Doors may need to be adjusted after the initial shipping of the cabinet. The cabinet doors have a three-way adjustment feature.

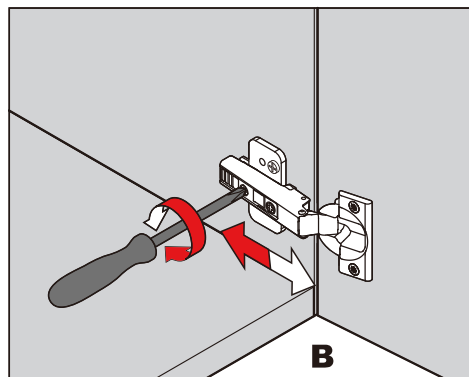
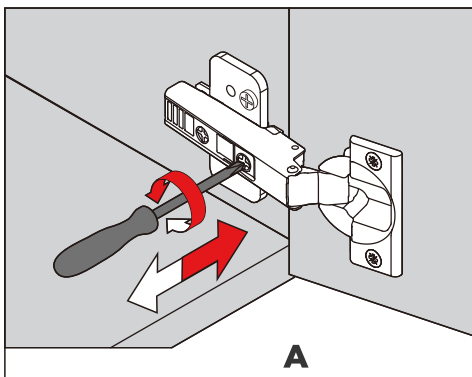
Side-to-side, level, and depth can be adjusted. With the hinge fully extended you can access the front and back screws. These screws will move the door side to side and in and out.



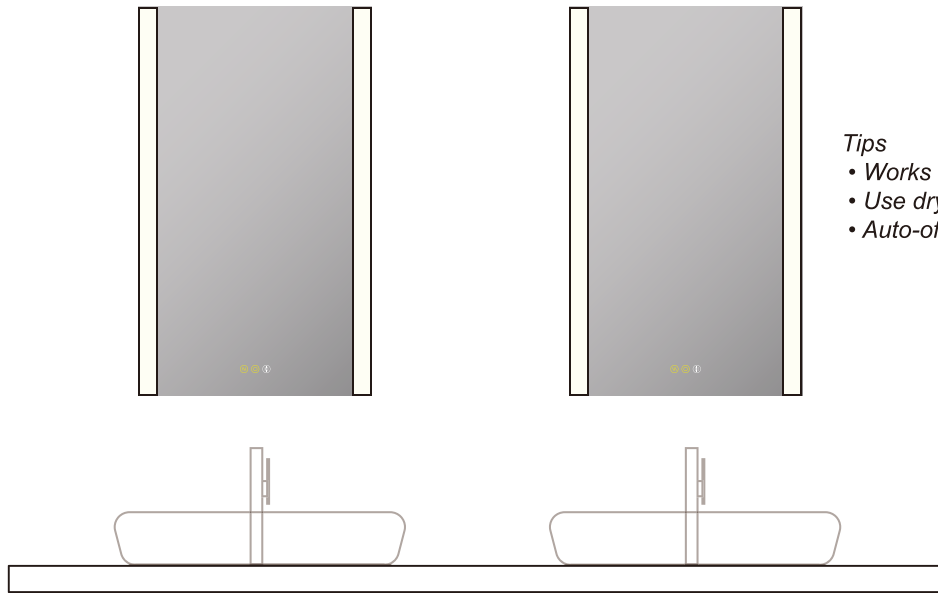
LEFT SIDE

Tips

- Works only when power is on
- Use dry fingers to touch
- Auto-off after 1 hour (defogger)

Lighting Button



- Standby: White
- Tap once → Light ON (button turns yellow)
- Press and hold → Adjust brightness

Defogger Button



- Standby: White
- Tap once → Defogger ON (yellow)
- Tap again → Defogger OFF

Color Temperature Button



- Standby: White
- Tap to cycle through:
 - 3000K – Warm White
 - 4000K – Natural White
 - 6500K – Cool White

Use and Maintenance:

The interior is constructed of mirrored glass and aluminum. Use only a damp cloth to clean. Ammonia or vinegarbased cleansers can damage mirrors.

When cleaning, spray the cloth, not the mirror, or surrounding surfaces, Do not use abrasive cleansers on any parts of the light fixture. Clean mirror weekly with soft damp cloth. Avoid direct water spray. Ensure ventilation if installed in humid environment.

Limited Warranty Two Years Term

We warrant to the original purchaser that our products are free from significant defects in material and workmanship for a period of two (2) years from the date of delivery. We will, at our discretion, repair, replace, or adjust any products found to have significant defects, provided that the defects are reported to us in writing within the warranty period. Installation costs are not covered by this warranty.
