

Instant Screen™ - Installing

Note: The Instant Screen™ can be hung in two different ways. The first method involves the tension rod which will act like a curtain on the top of your opening. You can also use Velcro™ strips at the top of the opening to hang the screen. The Velcro™ strips are industrial-strength and a more permanent solution than the rod.

Installing with the tension rod method

This installation method involves the tension rod, which will act like a curtain over the top of your opening. First, measure your opening. Then unscrew the rod to fit your opening, slip it through the slot at the top of your screen, and put it in place. You can adjust the rod as needed. Just make sure the rod is tight to prevent it from slipping. For extra stability, you can add the smaller Velcro™ strips provided to the sides of your opening. The Instant Screen™ has a weighted bottom to help keep the screen straight.

Installing with the Velcro™ Method

You can use Velcro™ strips at the top of the opening to hang the screen. First, measure your opening. Next, place the screen in the opening to get an idea of where you want to put the Velcro™ strips. Peel off the backing on the long Velcro™ strips and place them one at a time at the top of the opening. Now simply attach the screen to the strips. For extra stability, you can add the smaller Velcro™ strips provided to the sides of your opening. The Instant Screen™ has a weighted bottom to help keep the screen straight.
