

Warnings

The Just FloatTM recreational float is designed to be recreational. It is not a lifesaving device. Users should heed the following warnings to enjoy using the Just FloatTM recreational float safely. FAILING TO FOLLOW THESE WARNINGS MAY RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH.

- Users of the Just Float™ recreational float should wear life jackets if using the product in open water (i.e., anywhere other than a swimming pool). A life jacket is also recommended for use in a swimming pool for anyone who is not a strong swimmer.
- Users should not dive headfirst from the Just FloatTM recreational float because of the risk of injury from hitting the bottom surface or an obstruction. Users who jump from the Just FloatTM recreational float must ensure that the water is deep enough that they will not hit the bottom surface and that when jumping they are not near other individuals or obstructions, including items in and under water and the sides of pools or slides, ladders, or diving boards.
- Users should not jump onto the Just FloatTM recreational float from an elevation above it as it could damage the product and could lead to injury.
- Users should not swim under the Just FloatTM recreational float because of the risk of being injured by someone on the pad or jumping off the pad.
- If the Just FloatTM recreational float is used in open water (i.e., something other than a swimming pool), the user must be aware of currents and tides that may move the Just FloatTM recreational float away from where the user intended to use it and possibly into dangerous conditions or too far from shore for the user to safely swim back.
- The Just FloatTM recreational float should not be used where there are moderate to high waves or wakes or rough waters because they can cause the Just FloatTM recreational float to flip or be thrust into an object (e.g., a dock) or a person or to be disengaged from any tether to which it was attached.
- If the Just FloatTM recreational float is used in open water (i.e., something other than a swimming pool), the user should use marking buoys to alert boaters and others of the Just FloatTM recreational float's presence.
- Users should consider the total weight of all users of the Just FloatTM recreational float and not overcrowd it such that it sinks.
- Users should not tow, pull, or push the Just FloatTM recreational float with any motorized vessel.
- Adults should supervise children when they are using the Just Float[™] recreational float
- If you bring a pet onto the Just FloatTM recreational float, you should use a pet life jacket and supervise your pet.
- The surface of the Just FloatTM recreational float can be hot in sunny weather. Splashing some water on the surface will help cool it off.
- Users should take care when using the Just FloatTM recreational float in very cold water because of the risk of hypothermia.
- Users under the influence of alcohol or drugs should not use the Just Float™ recreational float because it will be difficult to balance and to maintain control of oneself.
- Users should secure the Just FloatTM recreational float when it is not in use so that unauthorized/unsupervised persons will not use it.
- Ensure all users are made aware of the tethering-grommet system location when the Just Float™ recreational float is anchored. The bungee rope and grommet attachment should remain below the playing surface at all times.
