

ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

- 1. Remove all packaging materials, staples and packing straps from the carton.
- 2. Refer to Parts List and Hardware List and ensure they are complete before you start assembling.
- 3. Place all wooden parts on a clean, flat and soft surface (e.g. carpet or rug) to prevent parts from getting scratched.

SAFETY PRECAUTION:

- 1. KEEP ALL HARDWARE PARTS OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
- 2. DISPOSE PLASTIC PACKAGING MATERIAL IMMEDIATELY TO AVOID ANY RISK OF SUFFOCATION TO CHILDREN AND ANIMALS.


TIPS FOR ASSEMBLY:

- 1. Allow ample room for assembly and in close proximity to where product will be placed.
- 2. Assemble the product on a surface that does not scratch or damage the exterior gloss and finish of the furniture.
- 3. Please check all of the parts and quantities are included before assembly. Contact customer service for missing parts.
- 4. Identify all of the parts, hardware and quantities required for each step.
- 5. During assembly, do not over-tighten any fittings as this may cause damage.
- 6. DO NOT USE POWER TOOLS TO ASSEMBLE THIS PRODUCT.
- 7. Always place the product on a flat stable surface.
- 8. Do not sit or stand on the partially assembled product; only use the product for which it is intended.
- 9. This product is made of reinforced hollow board. Excessive pressure can cause irreparable damage. Avoid standing or kneeling on any parts of the product during assembly.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Use a slightly damp cloth to clean the product. Do not use bleach or abrasive cleaning material.
- Check all the fittings periodically and re-tighten as necessary. Do not use the product if any of the parts is damaged or broken
- · Never allow any kind of liquid to remain on your furniture. Absorption can cause wood to warp or delaminate.
- Do not place hot items (e.g. hot drinks) directly onto the wood surface.
- Do not drag and/or pull the furniture.





Instructions For Fastening CAM-BOLT




CAM-BOLT

Place Cam-bolt on the designated pre-drilled hole on the panel. Use a Phillips Screwdriver to screw in Cam-bolt vertically until shoulder is snug and flushed with panel. Do not over-tighten or under-tighten Cam-bolt. See illustrations below.




Instructions For PRE-INSTALLED CAM-LOCK to lock Cam-bolts




Use a Flat-head Screwdriver to turn pre-installed Cam-lock clockwise to lock onto the head of the Cam-bolt. Turn until it is snug (about one half a turn) -- over-tightening could damage Cam-lock or/and Cam-bolt.

STEP 1




- a) Position Drawer Left, Back and Right Panels (15, 16 & 17) as shown (note the groove on each panel is at the bottom). Use Screw (C3) to fasten (15 & 16) to (17). Do not tighten (C3) completely until both screws are in place in each panel.
- b) Insert Drawer Bottom Panel (18) via the groove on (15, 16 & 17).

STEP 2




- a) Place Drawer Front Panel (14) with the inside-face facing up (see Drawing 2A) on a material that does not scratch or damage its exterior face. Next, use a Phillips Screwdriver to screw in Cam-bolt (A2). Refer to page 3 for instructions to screw in Cam-bolt.
- b) Insert Screw (D) from the inside-face of Drawer Front Panel (14) to fasten Drawer Knob (E) on the exterior face of (14).







b) Use a Flat Screwdriver to turn pre-installed Cam-lock clockwise to lock onto Cam-bolt. Refer to page 3 for instruction on using Cam-lock.




- a) Place Left & Right Bottom Panel (11 & 12) bottom-side (the side with pre-installed cam-locks). facing up.
- b) Insert Wood Dowel (F) and Cam-bolt (A1) into designated holes on (12) ensure (A1) is inserted fully. Use a Flat Screwdriver and turn pre-installed Cam-lock on (12) clockwise to lock onto cam-bolt.
- c) Attach Left Bottom Panel (11) to (12 via Cam-bolts and Wood Dowels fitted on (12) as shown. Next, use a Flat Screwdriver and turn pre-installed Cam-lock on (11) clockwise to lock onto cam-bolt. Leave Left & Right Bottom Panel (11 & 12) bottom-side up and proceed to STEP 5.




Identify bolt holes for Metal Tube (4) on (Left & Right Bottom Panel (11 & 12). Fasten (4) to (11 & 12) using Bolt (B1). Use a Phillips Screwdriver to drive (B1).






Place Left Metal Frame (1) to fit Left Bottom Panel (11) as shown. Use Bolt (B1) to fasten (11) to (1) and Right Bottom Panel (12) to Right Frame (2). Use a Phillips Screwdriver to drive (B1). Do not tighten (B1) completely until both bolts are in place on each panel.




Place Bottom Panel (6) as shown. Align bolt holes on Drawer Guide (13) to designated bolt holes on (6). Use a Phillips Screwdriver to drive Bolt (B2) to fasten 13) to (6). Do not tighten (B2) completely until both bolts are in place on each guide.




- a) Screw in Cam-bolt (A2) into designated holes on Left Front Panel (7), Right Front Panel (8), Left Back Panel (9) and Right Back Panel (10).
 - For illustrative assembly purposes these panels are position vertically as shown. It is easier and recommended to screw in the the cam-bolts with the panel placed flat down (on a material that does not to scratch or damage the exterior surface of each panel).
- b) Attach each panel to Bottom Panel (6) via Cam-bolt (A2) as shown.
- c) Use a Flat Screwdriver and turn pre-installed Cam-lock on (6) clockwise to lock onto cam-bolt.

STEP 10

- a) Place Top Panel (5) bottom-side up (see Drawing 10A) on a material that does not scratch or damage its surface. Next, screw in Cam-bolt (A2) into the designated holes on (5) with a Phillips Screwdriver.
- b) Turn Top Panel (5) right-side up (see Drawing 10B) and align Cam-bolts (A2) on (5) to designated holes on Left & Right Front and Back Panels (7, 8, 9 & 10, respectively).
- c) Use a Flat Screwdriver to turn pre-installed Cam-locks on the panels. (Note: Cam-locks on (7 & 8) are located on the inside face of the panels; whereas (9 &10) are on the outside face of the panels.






Place completed assembly in STEP 10 to fit within metal framework completed in STEP 7.

STEP 12



- a) Use Screws (C1) & Bolt (B1) to fasten Left Metal Frame (1) to Front Side Panel (7) and Right Metal Frame (2) to Front Right Front Panel (8).
- b) Use Screw (C2) to fasten Left & 5ight Back Panel (9 & 10) to Comer Metal Tube (3) . Do not tighten all the screws and bolts completely until they are all in place.




Insert the Drawer completed in STEP 3

STEP 14



Attach Drawer Stopper (19) to the underside of Top Panel (5) using Dowel (F).



Fasten Drawer Stopper (19) to the underside of Top Panel (5) using Bolt (B2). Use the provided Screwdriver (G) to reach into the drawer to drive (B2) into the underside of the Top Panel (5).
