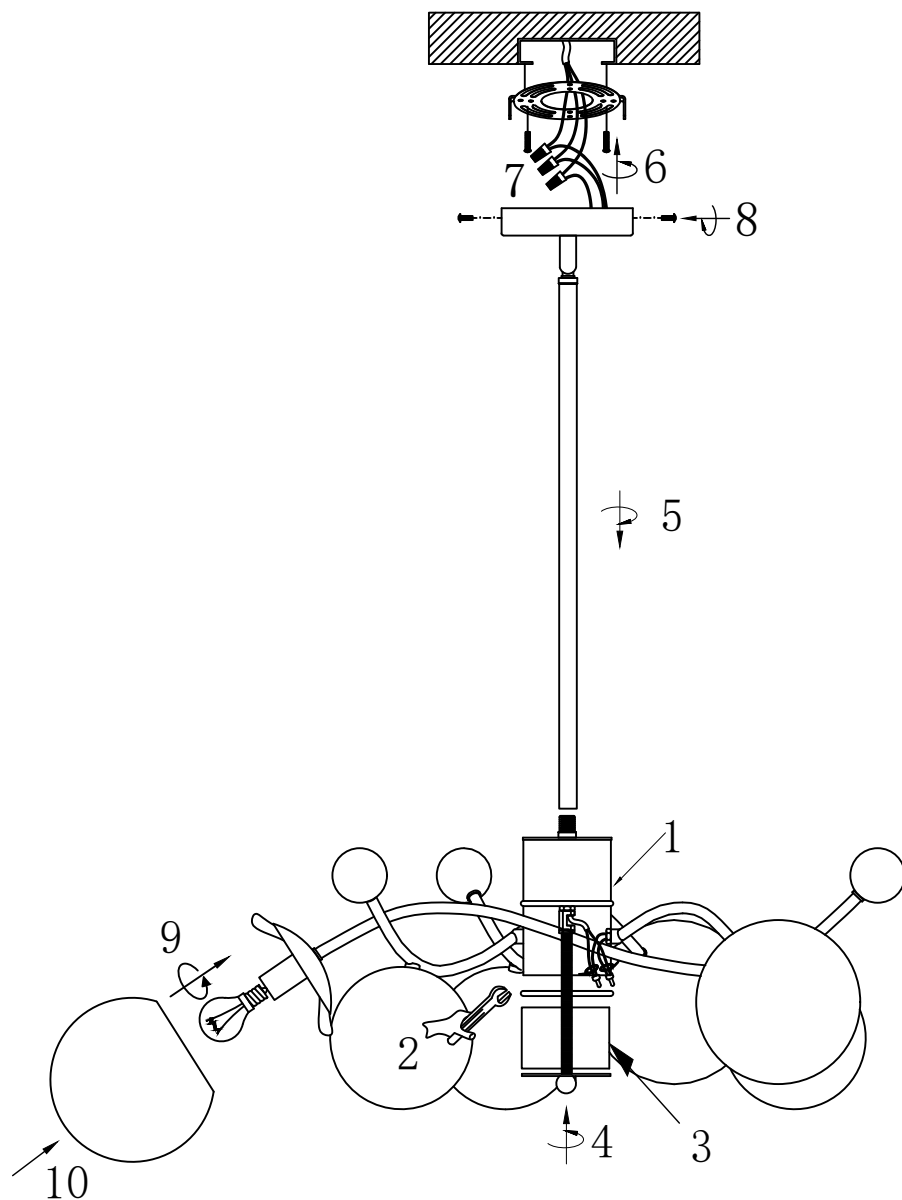


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Attach the curved pipes to the main connecting tube using the provided nuts.
2. Use a wrench to securely tighten the nuts.
3. Slide the connecting tube's associated components onto the threaded nipple in the correct order.
4. Tighten the metal decorative finial at the bottom of the tube to secure the components in place.
5. According to your desired height, connect downrod sections between the light fixture and the swivel joint.
6. Securely attach the mounting plate to the UL-listed ceiling junction box using the provided screws.
7. Wiring Connections
 - Use wire connectors to connect the black (hot) wire to the black wire, the white (neutral) wire to the white wire, and the ground wire to the grounding terminal.
 - Ensure no exposed conductors remain outside wire connectors or outside the junction box.
8. Align the canopy with the mounting plate, and secure it using the provided screws.
9. Install the recommended light bulbs into the sockets.
10. Press the spring clips and carefully fit the glass shade onto the fixture.
11. Restore power at the circuit breaker. Turn on the light switch to test the fixture.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
