


WALL CABINET

PARTS LIST

Your Wall Cabinet should include the following parts. Please inspect box contents to ensure you have received all components.

If you are missing any parts, need assistance with assembly or have questions, please contact us.

You will need a Phillips screwdriver for assembly which is not provided.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


STEP 1

Position WALL BRACKET (D) on wall at desired height, making sure it is level.

Mark off mounting location on wall through oval holes on WALL BRACKET (D). If ANCHORS (G) are required, drill holes in marked locations. Insert ANCHOR (G) completely into each drilled hole.

Fasten LONG SCREWS (F) through oval holes on WALL BRACKET (D) into wall or anchors tightly with a Phillips screwdriver.


Note: Please consult a local contractor if you are unsure if your wall is able to bear the load of the wall cabinet.



STEP 2

Lift CABINET BODY (A) and hang it carefully on WALL BRACKET(D) through four hooks on back side of cabinet. Two people are needed, DO NOT attempt this alone.

There are two slots on back side of cabinet. Align these two slots to two small round holes on WALL BRACKET (D). Insert SHORT SCREWS (E) through slots from inside of cabinet and fasten tightly to WALL BRACKET (D) with a Phillips screwdriver.




ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 3

Open cabinet door by lifting up door handle.

Attach SHELF SUPPORT (C) by hooking it over position tab at desired height. Make sure all four SHELF SUPPORTS (C) are at same level.


Tilt SHELF (B) diagonally to move it inside cabinet. Place SHELF (B) on top of all four SHELF SUPPORTS (C).



USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

OPEN AND CLOSE DOOR

Open door by lifting up door handle. Close door by pushing down door handle until it fit inside slot on bottom edge of cabinet body. The door will not stay closed if the handle is not in the slot.




SHELF ADJUSTMENT

Ensure all items have been removed from shelf.

To adjust shelf height position, take shelf out of cabinet, re-attach shelf supports to position tabs at desired height.


Tilt shelf diagonally to move it inside cabinet. Place shelf on top of all shelf supports.

- 7. Do NOT use nails to mount the cabinet.
- **8. Do NOT use wall cabinet unless all screws are securely tightened.** Check regularly to ensure screws have not loosened during use of cabinet.
- 9. Do NOT hang on the cabinet.
- 10. Do NOT let children play under the cabinet.
- 11. Keep hands and other items away from gas lift when closing the door. Hands may be pinched or items damaged.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Avoid harsh, abrasive cleaners, and other corrosive chemicals.
- Do not use scouring pad for cleaning.
- This item is not certified for outdoor use.

1 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

Wall Cabinet

We warrant to the original consumer purchaser ("Purchaser") of the Wall Cabinet ("Product") that each Product shall be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of 1 year from the date of original purchase. Our obligation under this warranty shall be limited to repair or replacement of, or adequate compensation for the Product which shall not be greater than the amount of the purchase price of the Product, at our option, during the warranty period. All replaced parts and Products become our property and must be returned to us.

This warranty excludes normal wear and tear of the Product and its parts or components, and damage arising from any of the following: negligent use or misuse of the Product, use contrary to this User's Manual, or alteration by any one other than us. The warranty period of 1 year shall not be extended or renewed by the repair or replacement of, or compensation for, the Product. Any warranty implied by applicable law is limited in duration to one year from the date of purchase and is subject to the same conditions and limitations as is provided for our express warranty.
