Assembly Instructions

PACKAGED

(A) 1-Table Top Assembly

(E) 10-Machine Screws

(B) 1-Top Bridge Plate

(F) 10-Flat Washers

(C) 1-Center Turning

(G) 10-Lock Washers

(D) 3-Legs

(H) 3-Wood Plugs

(I) 1-Glue Pack

Read all instructions before starting assembly.

Step #1 Remove all the contents from the package checking that all of the components listed in "Packaged" are included. Prepare a flat, protected work surface where the product can be assembled.

Step #2 Align one leg (D) over dowel holes in center turning (C). Attach one lock washer (G) and one flat washer (F) onto one machine screw (E). Position screw into large single hole opposite the two dowel holes and drop the screw into the turning so the end of the screw is sticking out on opposite side. Align your screw driver to hold the screw while pushing leg into dowel holes. Securely tighten* the screw into the insert while pushing leg toward the center turning. Repeat procedure for remaining legs.

<u>Step #3</u> Apply a small bead of glue to the upper inside edge of the large bottom screw holes and tap wood plugs (H) into position.

Step #4 Align the top bridge plate (B) over the top end of the center turning (C). Attach one lock washer (G) with one flat washer (F) onto one machine screw (E). Push the screws thru the bridge plate into three matching insert holes in the center turning and securely tighten*.

<u>Step #5</u> Place table top assembly (A) into upside down position on protected surface. Align assembled bridge plate over matching bridge plate insert holes on bottom side of top assembly. Attach one lock washer (G) with one flat washer (F) onto one machine screw (E). Push screws thru bridge plate into matching insert holes and securely tighten*.

Step #6 Place assembled unit into upright position.

(*) Caution: DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.
