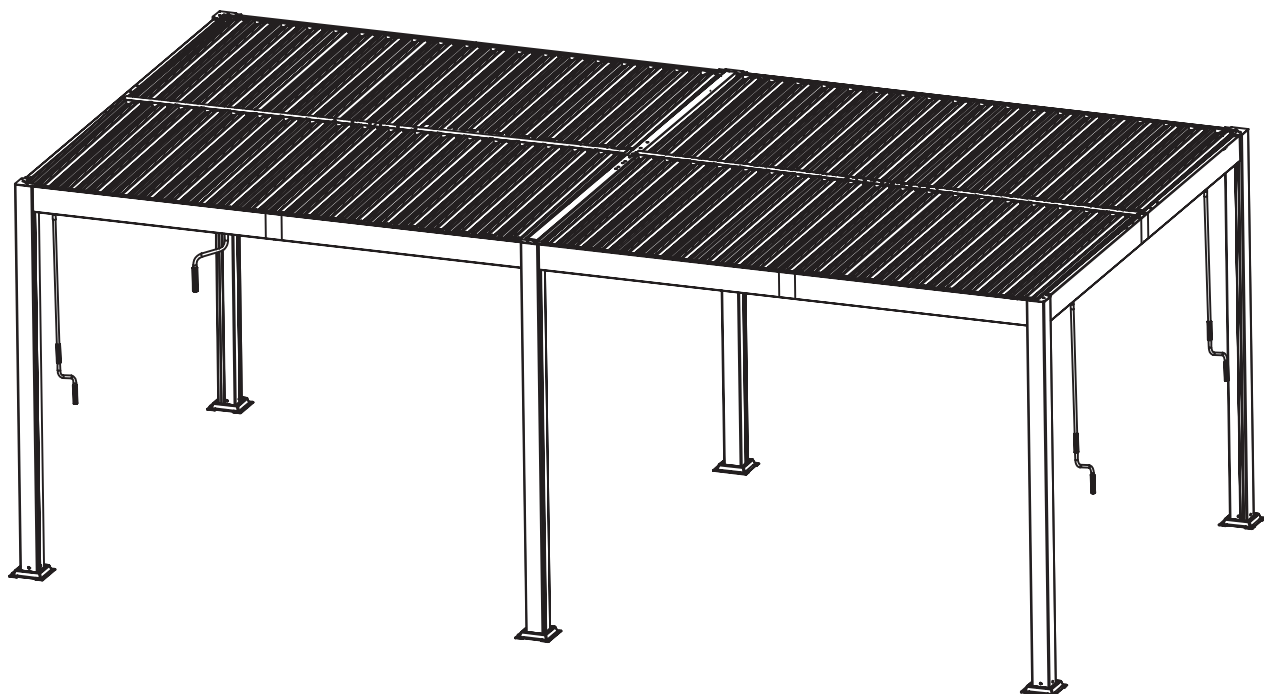

Get Ready: Think Ahead!

Prep Work: Before you dive into setting up your pergola, make sure to check out your local building codes. These codes might have specific guidelines on footings, placement, and other key details. Don't skip this step!

Understand the Guide: We've put together detailed instructions for you. Take some time to go through them. They're packed with crucial info and handy tips that'll make your installation smoother and even more satisfying.

Tools & Supplies: You're going to need some basic tools and materials. The anchoring method and foundation type you choose will determine what exactly you'll need. So, make a comprehensive list based on your plan to stay organized.

Before You Start Assembling

Instruction Manual: This manual's got everything you need for setting up your carport. Go through all the instructions before starting. As you assemble, following the steps in order is key to getting it right.

Check Your Parts: Make sure you've got all the necessary parts and the right quantities as listed. They should all be in your package, neatly packed within the carton. We've thrown in some extra fasteners too, just to make things easier for you.

Exploded View Diagram: This diagram shows all the parts (except screws and bolts). Look over everything before you start. Getting familiar with the hardware and fasteners now will save you time and hassle during installation.

¡Prepárate: Piensa con anticipación!

Trabajo Previo: Antes de comenzar a instalar tu nuevo cobertizo de metal, asegúrate de verificar los códigos de construcción locales. Estos códigos podrían incluir pautas específicas sobre cimientos, ubicación y otros detalles clave. ¡No te saltes este paso!

Entiende la Guía: Hemos preparado instrucciones detalladas para ti. Tómate el tiempo de revisarlas. Están llenas de información crucial y consejos útiles que harán que tu instalación sea más fluida y satisfactoria.

Herramientas y Suministros: Vas a necesitar herramientas básicas y materiales. El método de anclaje y el tipo de base que elijas determinarán exactamente lo que necesitas. Así que haz una lista completa basada en tu plan para mantenerte organizado.

Antes de comenzar con el ensamblaje

Manual de Instrucciones: Este manual tiene todo lo que necesitas para instalar tu cobertizo. Lee todas las instrucciones antes de empezar. Durante el montaje, sigue los pasos en orden para asegurarte de que todo se haga correctamente.

Verifica las Piezas: Asegúrate de tener todas las piezas necesarias y en las cantidades correctas según lo indicado. Todo debería estar en tu paquete, ordenado dentro de la caja. También hemos incluido algunos sujetadores extra para facilitarte las cosas.

Diagrama de Vista Explotada: Este diagrama muestra todas las piezas (excepto tornillos y pernos). Revisa todo antes de empezar. Familiarizarte con el hardware y los sujetadores ahora te ahorrará tiempo y molestias durante la instalación.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS...

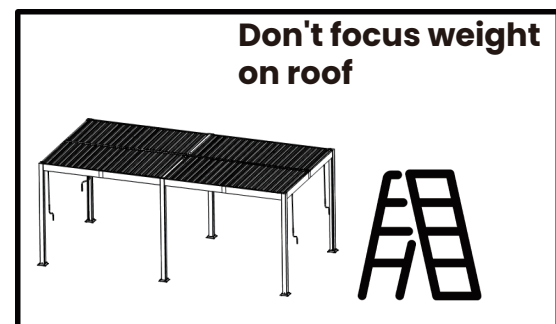
Safety precautions *MUST* be followed at all times throughout the construction of your building!



Exercise caution when using tools during assembly. It's particularly important to be well-versed in the use of any power tools involved in the process.



Ensure that children and pets are kept at a safe distance from the construction area until the building is fully assembled. This precaution minimizes distractions and reduces the risk of accidents.



Roof Safety Warning:
Never put your full weight on the building's roof. Always ensure that a step ladder is fully extended and placed on level ground before climbing it.



Wind Advisory:
Avoid assembling your building on a windy day. Large panels can act like sails in the wind, making them hard to control and posing safety risks during construction.

Complete Check:
Before starting assembly, verify that you have all the parts and hardware listed. A partially assembled building can be vulnerable to damage, even from mild winds.

PRECAUCIONES DE SEGURIDAD

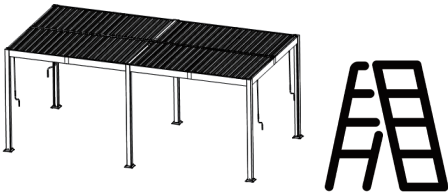
Tenga precaución al usar herramientas durante el ensamblaje. Es especialmente importante estar bien familiarizado con el uso de cualquier herramienta eléctrica involucrada en el proceso.

No permita niños ni mascotas en el lugar de trabajo



Asegúrese de que los niños y las mascotas se mantengan a una distancia segura del área de construcción hasta que el edificio esté completamente ensamblado. Esta precaución minimiza las distracciones y reduce el riesgo de accidentes.

No concentre peso en el techo



Advertencia de seguridad en el techo:
Nunca ponga todo su peso sobre el techo del edificio. Asegúrese siempre de que una escalera de mano esté completamente extendida y colocada sobre terreno nivelado antes de subir.

Aviso de viento



Aviso de viento:

Evite ensamblar su edificio en un día ventoso. Los paneles grandes pueden actuar como velas en el viento, lo que los hace difíciles de controlar y representa riesgos de seguridad durante la construcción.

Revisión completa:

Antes de comenzar el ensamblaje, verifique que tiene todas las piezas y herrajes listados. Un edificio parcialmente ensamblado puede ser vulnerable a daños, incluso por vientos suaves.

ASSEMBLY TIPS & TOOLS

Weather Awareness:

Choose a clear and calm day for your installation. Avoid building assembly on windy days, and be cautious if the ground is wet or muddy.

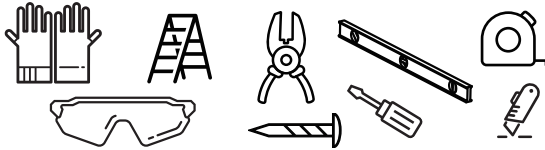
Team Effort Required:

Assembling your building is a three-person job at minimum. One can hold parts or panels in place, while the other secures them and manages the tools, ensuring a quicker and safer assembly process.

Gathering Your Tools and Supplies:

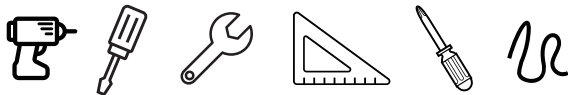
Prepare by listing the basic tools and materials necessary for assembly. Your choice of anchoring method and base type will determine the complete list of materials required.

- No. 2 Phillips Screwdriver (Magnetic Tip Preferred)
- Utility Knife or Scissors
- Pliers
- Carpenter's Level
- Tape Measure

RECOMMENDED TIME SAVERS



- Power Drill (Cordless, Variable Speed)
- Nut Driver or Wrench
- Square
- String (for squaring the frame)
- Awl (to align holes)

BASE PREPARATION TOOLS



- Lumber and/or Concrete
- Hammer and Nails
- Spade or Shovel
- Hand Saw or Power Saw

Choosing and Preparing Your Site:

Select an ideal spot for your building before assembly begins. Opt for a level area with effective drainage.

Ensure ample space around the construction area for easy movement and assembly of parts. Check that there's sufficient clearance at the entrance for doors to open fully. Additionally, you'll need enough external space around the building for attaching panel screws from the outside.

Prior to starting the assembly of any parts, make sure your base is in place and the anchoring system is set up and ready for action.

CONSEJOS DE ENSAMBLAJE Y HERRAMIENTAS

Conciencia sobre el clima:

Elija un día claro y calmado para su instalación. Evite el ensamblaje del edificio en días ventosos y tenga precaución si el suelo está mojado o embarrado.

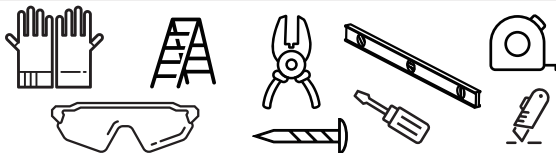
Trabajo en equipo requerido:

El ensamblaje de su edificio es un trabajo que requiere un mínimo de tres personas. Una puede sostener las piezas o paneles en su lugar, mientras que la otra los asegura y maneja las herramientas, lo que asegura un proceso de ensamblaje más rápido y seguro.

Recolección de herramientas y suministros:

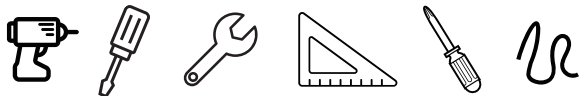
Prepárese haciendo una lista de las herramientas y materiales básicos necesarios para el ensamblaje. Su elección de método de anclaje y tipo de base determinará la lista completa de materiales requeridos.

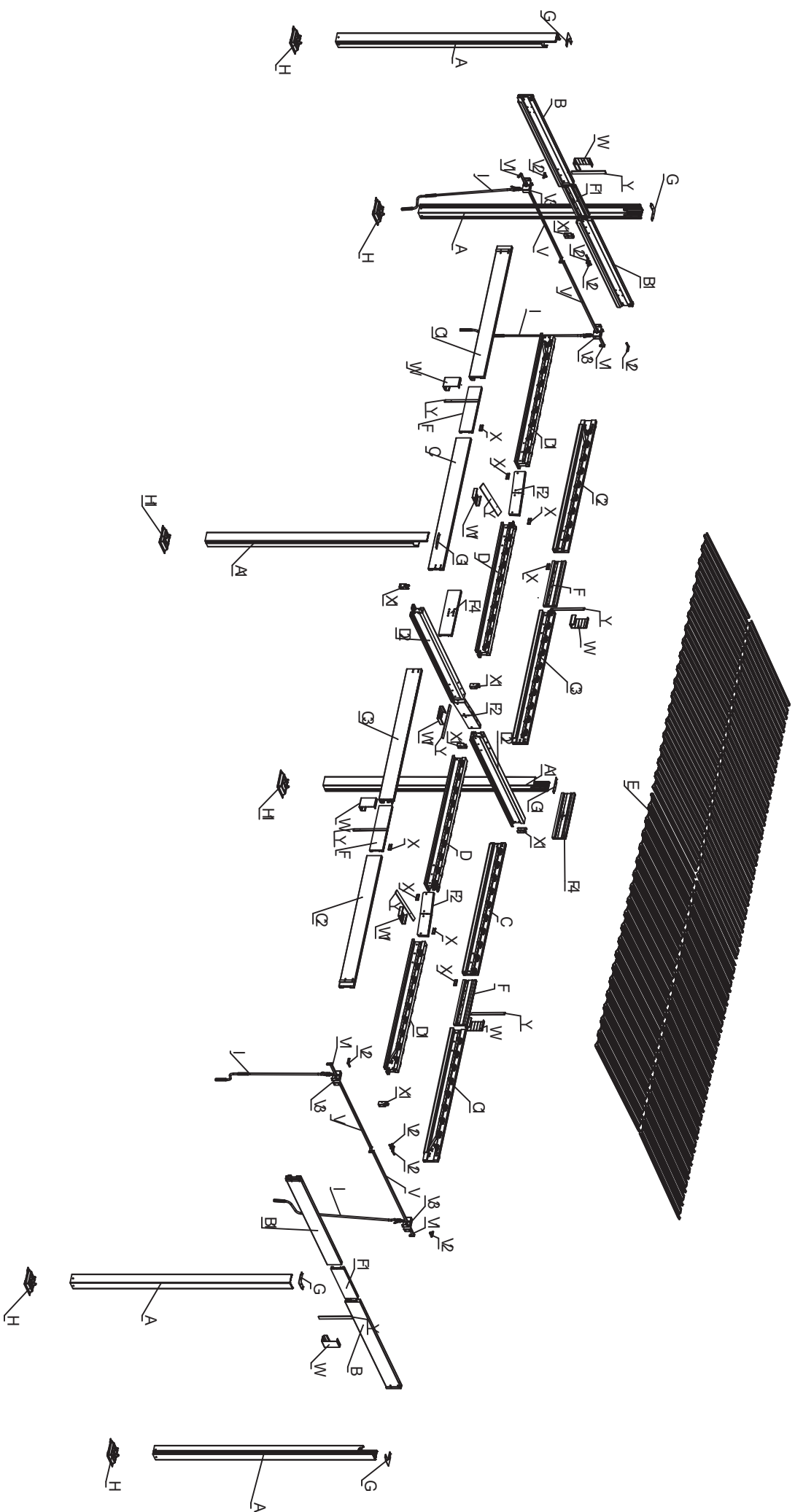

Elegir y preparar el sitio:

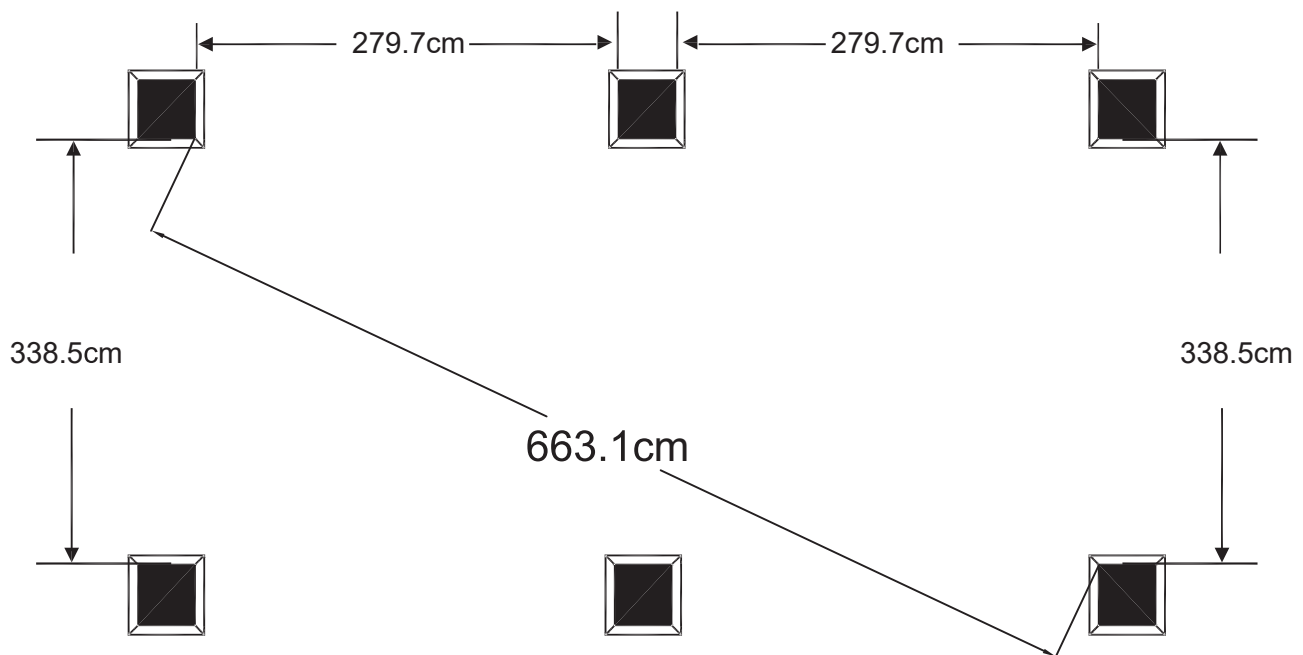
Seleccione un lugar ideal para su edificio antes de que comience el ensamblaje. Elija una zona nivelada con buen drenaje.

Asegúrese de tener suficiente espacio alrededor del área de construcción para facilitar el movimiento y el ensamblaje de las piezas. Verifique que haya suficiente espacio libre en la entrada para que las puertas se abran completamente. Además, necesitará suficiente espacio exterior alrededor del edificio para fijar los tornillos de los paneles desde el exterior.

Antes de comenzar el ensamblaje de cualquier parte, asegúrese de que la base esté en su lugar y que el sistema de anclaje esté preparado y listo para usar.



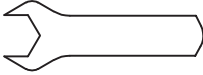
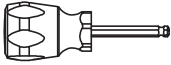
